





The grad is completing 59% of his passes while throwing for a league second-best 10 scores. Hampton is third in the league with 1,245 passing yards. He has added 279 yards rushing and 4 TDs.

Haynes is a key leader on the Gardner-Webb defense as he leads the team with 42 total tackles, including 26 solo. He has added 5.5 tackles for loss and 2.0 sacks as well as a forced fumble. His season-high 11 tackles at Ohio was the second consecutive game reaching double-digit stops.

SCOUTING UT MARTIN SKYHAWKS

UT Martin comes into the contest with a 2-5 overall record but improved to 2-1 in OVC/Big South play with a narrow 32-31 win versus Western Illinois last weekend. The Skyhawks lone loss in conference came at Lindenwood, a 30-14 setback. UTM is averaging 17.7 points per game while the defense allows 31.2 per contest. The Skyhawks use a balanced attack, gaining 949 on the ground and 1,370 yards through the air. Jase Bauer, fresh off a conference offensive player of the week nod, has thrown for 1,212 yards and five scores to go along with a team-best five rushing touchdowns while Bryce Bailey has hauled in a team-high 25 passes for 375 yards and three touchdowns. John Gentry has toted the rock 63 times for 268 yards but has yet to find the endzone this season. Jacob Stevenson anchors the defense with 43 total tackles, including 20 solo. Keyshawn Johnson has added a conference-leading 9.0 tackles for loss and 5.5 sacks. Cade Hechter is 7-for-8 on field goals this year, with a long of 41 yards. Jaren Van Winkle averages 41.6 yards per punt.

CRIS REISERT

HEAD COACH | 2ND SEASON | OHIO DOMINICAN'11

In 2025, Reisert enters his second season at Gardner-Webb. He most recently spent five seasons as the head coach at Tiffin University (Ohio), where he compiled an overall record of 40-11 (.784 win pct.) and a Great Midwest Conference (GMAC) record of 32-4 (.889).

During the 2024 campaign, Resisert compiled an overall record of 4-8 with a 3-5 mark within the Big South/OVC. He picked up his first win at the helm of the Runnin' Bulldogs on September 21, a 42-21 victory at Presbyterian.

At Tiffin, Reisert led his team to three GMAC championships (2019, 2020, 2023) and was named GMAC Coach of the Year in each of those championship seasons. This past season, his most successful team posted an 11-1 record, completing the regular season unbeaten before losing in the second round of the Division II national playoffs. With Reisert also handling offensive coordinator duties, the 2023 Tiffin Dragons finished ranked in the top 25 nationally in scoring offense (43.7 PPG, 6th), total offense (482.9 YPG, 4th), scoring defense (16.2 PPG allowed, T-16th), and total defense (281.2 YPG allowed, 22nd).

During his tenure at Tiffin, Reisert's other notable accomplishments included the first two Division II playoff berths in school history (2019 and 2023), the highest national ranking in school history (No. 9), and the program's first win over its primary rival (University of Findlay) in 22 years. In total, Reisert's team defeated Findlay three times in five meetings. Reisert's 40 total wins in five seasons were the most career wins by any head coach in his first five seasons in Tiffin's history.

Prior to Tiffin, Reisert spent two seasons as the offensive coordinator at his alma mater, Ohio Dominican University in Columbus. In seven seasons as the primary play caller, Reisert's teams have averaged 38 points per game and 455 yards per game.

In his stops at Ohio Dominican and Tiffin, Reisert has built a reputation for leaving an immediate impact. In 2017, his first at Ohio Dominican, the offense improved by 11.5 points and 123 yards per game, as compared to the previous season. He authored the same success in year one at Tiffin (2019), boasting a 13-point and 83-yard improvement on average.

Reisert is ready to begin work at Gardner-Webb. "It is a tremendous honor to be selected as the head football coach at Gardner-Webb University," Reisert asserted. "This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for me and my family and we can't wait to get started building upon the amazing tradition of Gardner-Webb football. Thank you to President Downs, Dr. Goodrich and the Board of Trustees for the opportunity; we are eager to join the Cleveland County community and get to work!"

In 2021, Reisert was selected to the American Football Coaches Association's 35 Under 35 list. Other stops in his coaching career include three seasons as tight ends coach at Elon University (2014-2016), one season as an assistant offensive line coach at Ball State University (2013), and two seasons in a prior stint at Ohio Dominican as the wide receivers coach (2011-2012).

As a player, Reisert started four years at quarterback for Ohio Dominican, where he was named the 2007 National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) National Player of the Year and a two-time All-American. He was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2019.

Reisert holds a bachelor's (2009) and master's degree (2011) in business administration from Ohio Dominican. He and his wife Emily have two children, a son Hawkins and a daughter Lennox.

LAST TIME OUT.....

Gardner-Webb opened a 21-0 lead at Eastern Illinois before hanging on for a 21-10 win over the Panthers. The Runnin' Bulldogs defense held EIU to 229 yards while Carson Gresock led the way with six carries for 137 yards and a pair of scores. Cahari Haynes recorded eight tackles, including 2.5 for loss and one sack on the way to his second conference defensive player of the week accolade.

THE NEW HEAD BALL COACH

Head coach Cris Resiert enters his second season at the helm of the program. Prior to GWU, Resiert spent five years at Division II Tiffin University where he compiled an overall record of 40-11 as well as a Great Midwest Conference (GMAC) record of 32-4.

BEWARE OF DAWG

Gardner-Webb returns seven starters from offense and five on the defensive side of the ball. Paired with a very good recruiting class the Runnin' Bulldogs are in a good position to compete for a Big South/OVC Championship. GWU has won four conference champiosnhips, the most recent being 2023.

UC Davis Runs Away from Northern Arizona

WACO, TEX.— In a shootout of two top 20 ranked teams, it was UC Davis who came out on top. The Aggie offense scored 35 points in the second half while their defense sacked the Northern Arizona quarterback six times in a 45-24 win. UC Davis quarterback Caden Pinnick was the star of the show, completing 25 of 29 passes for a career high 348 yards and five touchdowns. The Aggies remain at No. 6 in this week's AFCA FCS Coaches Poll, presented by Hudl, while the Lumberjacks drop five spots to No. 21.

The top five remained intact after seven weeks of action. No. 1 North Dakota State took down another ranked opponent, this time it was then-No. 9 Southern Illinois, 45-17. The loss only dropped the Salukis three places to No. 12. No. 3 Tarleton State moved its record to 7-0 after beating Utah Tech, 41-23. The Texans will host No. 23 West Georgia, who are looking to rebound after dropping a tough one to No. 17 ACU, 30-13.

Idaho lost to Northern Colorado, 49-33, and dropped out of the top 25, making room for Southeastern Louisiana. The Lions come in at No. 22 and are 4-2 on the season. They had a bye this past weekend and will face Northwestern State on October 18.
