SETTING THE SCENE



PLAYER TO WATCH

Running back Carson Gresock has emerged as one of the top rushers in the OVC/Big South. The redshirt junior leads the OVC/Big South with 12 rushing touchdowns and third with 691 yards while his 7.1 average yards per carry ranks second in the league. Gresock has put up a touchdown in six of nine games, including three games of multiple scores.

His four-touchdown performance at Lindenwood ties the NCAA season best by any player. Gresock also posted a pair of scores in road games at Eastern Illinois and No. 8 Tennessee Tech.

» The Gardner-Webb University football team hits the road for the final time in the regular season, traveling to Nashville, Tenn. for an OVC-Big South Football Association matchup with the Tigers of Tennessee State on Saturday, Nov. 15. Kickoff from Nissan Stadium is scheduled for 1:30 p.m. EST and will be broadcast on ESPN+.

» The Runnin' Bulldogs (6-4, 4-2 OVC-Big South) hit the road looking for their fourth win away from Spangler Stadium this season. Gardner-Webb improved to 4-2 in the OVC/Big South following a stellar 27-24 win versus Southeast Missouri State last Saturday. The Runnin' Bulldogs used a dominant defense, recording a program-record 11 sacks while Cole Pennington led the offense with 337 yards of total offense and two touchdowns (1 passing, 1 rushing).

» Senior punter Brady Braun was recently named a Phil Steele Midseason All-American. Braun leads the nation with 49.6 yards per punt while forcing opponents into four fair catches and pinning the ball inside the 20 on eight occasions. He has a long punt of 61 yards on the year.

» Gardner-Webb enters the weekend averaging just under 28 points per game while achieving more than 400 yards of total offense on six occasions. The Runnin' Bulldogs present a balanced attack, rushing for 190 yards per game while also collecting 239 yards per contest through the air.

» Tennessee State (2-8, 0-6 OVC-Big South) hosts the Runnin' Bulldogs while looking for its first win inside conference play in 2025. The Tigers have been outscored by their opponents 28-13. TSU earned wins in non-conference play over North Carolina A&T and Howard. Reggie Barlow enters his first year at the helm of the Tigers after successful stints at Alabama State and Virginia State.

» Saturday's contest marks the third meeting between the two programs with Tennessee State taking a 23-20 win over the Dawgs in Boiling Springs last year. The game will be broadcast on ESPN+ while you can listen on GWU's radio network at 101.1 Varisty Radio.

CRIS REISERT

HEAD COACH | 2ND SEASON | OHIO DOMINICAN '11

In 2025, Reisert enters his second season at Gardner-Webb. He most recently spent five seasons as the head coach at Tiffin University (Ohio), where he compiled an overall record of 40-11 (.784 win pct.) and a Great Midwest Conference (GMAC) record of 32-4 (.889).

During the 2024 campaign, Reisert compiled an overall record of 4-8 with a 3-5 mark within the Big South/OVC. He picked up his first win at the helm of the Runnin' Bulldogs on September 21, a 42-21 victory at Presbyterian.

At Tiffin, Reisert led his team to three GMAC championships (2019, 2020, 2023) and was named GMAC Coach of the Year in each of those championship seasons. This past season, his most successful team posted an 11-1 record, completing the regular season unbeaten before losing in the second round of the Division II national playoffs. With Reisert also handling offensive coordinator duties, the 2023 Tiffin Dragons finished ranked in the top 25 nationally in scoring offense (43.7 PPG, 6th), total offense (482.9 YPG, 4th), scoring defense (16.2 PPG allowed, T-16th), and total defense (281.2 YPG allowed, 22nd).

During his tenure at Tiffin, Reisert's other notable accomplishments included the first two Division II playoff berths in school history (2019 and 2023), the highest national ranking in school history (No. 9), and the program's first win over its primary rival (University of Findlay) in 22 years. In total, Reisert's team defeated Findlay three times in five meetings. Reisert's 40 total wins in five seasons were the most career wins by any head coach in his first five seasons in Tiffin's history.

Prior to Tiffin, Reisert spent two seasons as the offensive coordinator at his alma mater, Ohio Dominican University in Columbus. In seven seasons as the primary play caller, Reisert's teams have averaged 38 points per game and 455 yards per game.

In his stops at Ohio Dominican and Tiffin, Reisert has built a reputation for leaving an immediate impact. In 2017, his first at Ohio Dominican, the offense improved by 11.5 points and 123 yards per game, as compared to the previous season. He authored the same success in year one at Tiffin (2019), boasting a 13-point and 83-yard improvement on average.

Reisert is ready to begin work at Gardner-Webb. "It is a tremendous honor to be selected as the head football coach at Gardner-Webb University," Reisert asserted. "This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for me and my family and we can't wait to get started building upon the amazing tradition of Gardner-Webb football. Thank you to President Downs, Dr. Goodrich and the Board of Trustees for the opportunity; we are eager to join the Cleveland County community and get to work!"

In 2021, Reisert was selected to the American Football Coaches Association's 35 Under 35 list. Other stops in his coaching career include three seasons as tight ends coach at Elon University (2014-2016), one season as an assistant offensive line coach at Ball State University (2013), and two seasons in a prior stint at Ohio Dominican as the wide receivers coach (2011-2012).

As a player, Reisert started four years at quarterback for Ohio Dominican, where he was named the 2007 National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) National Player of the Year and a two-time All-American. He was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2019.

Reisert holds a bachelor's (2009) and master's degree (2011) in business administration from Ohio Dominican. He and his wife Emily have two children, a son Hawkins and a daughter Lennox.

Lamar's defense tames Southeastern Louisiana

WACO, TEX.— In a tightly contested game, it was Lamar's defense who rose to the top. The Cardinals held the Southeastern Louisiana offense to just 56 yards passing on five completed passes and didn't allow them to score their first touchdown until the 7:23 mark in the fourth quarter. Lamar won a close game, 14-12, and moved up four spots to No. 14 in this week's AFCA FCS Coaches Poll, presented by Hudl, while the Lions dropped seven spots to No. 21.

North Dakota State still sits No. 1, but they had to work to get to 10-0 against North Dakota, winning a close one 15-10. Montana, Montana State and Lehigh remain two through four, but Tarleton State moves into the fifth spot. Tennessee Tech dropped a spot to No. 6 despite beating Eastern Illinois, 21-9, but they got that place because Monmouth (N.J.) lost to New Hampshire, 34-13, and fell from No. 6 to No. 12.

Presbyterian and Western Carolina both lost close games and dropped out of the top 25 making room for West Georgia and Lafayette. No. 24 West Georgia re-enters after a three-week layoff while No. 25 Lafayette, who is 7-3, enters for the first time this season.

2025 GARDNER-WEBB FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

IN CASE YOU WERE WONDERING

- * Gardner-Webb University's 225-acre campus is located 50 miles west of Charlotte, N.C., in Boiling Springs, N.C. The school is also approximately an hour's drive from both Asheville, N.C., and Greenville, S.C.
- * Gardner-Webb's main campus is 11.6 miles from the South Carolina state line.
- * Gardner-Webb conferred an honorary doctor of humanities degree upon legendary singer Johnny Cash on September 28, 1971 in Ernest W. Spangler Stadium. Cash also performed a concert that day in front of an announced crowd of 12,000.
- * Gardner-Webb is named after former North Carolina Governor O. Max Gardner and his wife, Faye Webb Gardner. Founded as Boiling Springs High School in 1905 and became Boiling Springs Junior College in 1928. Renamed Gardner-Webb Junior College in 1942.
- * Gardner-Webb University and Boiling Springs hosted the 1996 U.S. Olympic Trials for Cycling.
- * The first game as a junior college came on September 14, 1928 vs. Kings Mountain High School (25-6 W)
- * Ernest W. Spangler Stadium was opened on October 8, 1966 with a 21-2 win over Chowan College. Facility was renovated in 2004 to its current configuration.
- * The largest attendance for a home football game on record is 8,490 vs. No. 2 (FCS) Appalachian State on September 23, 2006.
- * The team won conference titles in 1930, 1933, 1951, 1952, 1955, 1956, 1961, 1962, 1963, 1964, 1965, 1966, 1987, 1992, 2002 and 2003, 2022. Program also appeared in the 1974 NAIA Poultry Bowl and hosted the NAIA National Championship Bowl in 1992. The Dawgs made their first appearance in the FCS Playoffs last season, defeating Eastern Kentucky 52-41 in the first round.
- * Jim Childers, a tackle from Greenville, S.C., and George Mauney, an end from Lexington, N.C., were Gardner-Webb's first All-Conference selections in 1932.
