Javelin & Invite Hammer will be contested at the University of Minnesota. The gophers have a track surface runway for the Javelin and the ability to handle over 70 meter Hammer throws.

The meet will follow rules so as to be compliant for any world ranking marks that could be achieved. That means we will check spikes/shoes before track races and have a camera on the long jump/triple jump board during the competition.

Heat Sheets: Heat Sheets will be sent to coaches and posted on both Hamline Athletics and Wayzata Results

Check In: Athletes should check in no later than 15 minutes prior to their event starting with their Field Official for field events or the Clerk Table for hip numbers located under the west end of the bleachers.

Implements: All implements must be weighed in 15 minutes prior to the start of the first throwing event. Weigh Ins will open 1 hour before the start of the first throwing event.

Athletic Trainer: A certified athletic trainer will be located on the football field near the East 20 yard line and the 100 start line on the west end of the track.
