# 2013 Harding Football Game Notes

## Today's Game

- The Harding football team will open its 63rd season of intercollegiate football Thursday when it travels to Weatherford, Okla., to meet Southwestern Oklahoma State at Fast Lane Field.
- Harding and Southwestern Okla. are meeting for the ninth time with the Bisons leading the series 5-3 overall and 2-0 since the beginning of the Great American Conference.
- Thursday's game is the first of 10 GAC games for the Bisons. The 2013 season will be the first in program history that every game of the regular season is a conference game.
- Harding head coach Ronnie Huckleba is in his seventh season as head coach of the Bisons. HU is 4-1 in season openers under Huckleba and has won the last four straight.
- The Bisons are 39-20-3 (.653) all-time in the first game of a season and have won 10 of their last 11. Harding has never opened a season against Southwestern Okla.

## Head Coach Ronnie Huckleba

Harding is in its seventh season under head coach Ronnie Huckleba. Now in his 28th season as a coach at Harding, Huckleba has a 31-31 overall record as head coach. Under Coach Huck, the Bisons are 23-23 in conference games and 11-19 on the road.

## AFCA Poll

Harding is receiving votes in the AFCA Preseason Coaches' Poll. The Bisons received 106 poll points, just two points out of the Top 25. Henderson St. is the only GAC team ranked in the preseason poll, coming in at No. 13.

## Preseason GAC Poll

Harding was picked to finish third of 11 teams in the GAC Preseason Coaches' Poll. Southwestern Okla. was picked to finish seventh. Henderson State is the preseason favorite.

## Road Renaissance

Harding tied a school record with five road wins last season. The Bisons were 5-0 on the road during the regular season, matching the mark of the 1972 team. Harding's lone road loss came at Northwest Mo. St. in the NCAA playoffs.

## The Series with Southwestern Okla.

Harding and Southwestern Okla. have played eight times, beginning in 1994 with a 39-27 Bison victory in Searcy. Harding leads the series 5-3 overall and 2-0 in GAC games. The teams have met twice in Weatherford and split those games with Southwestern Okla. winning 18-0 in 1995 and Harding winning 20-9 in 1998.

Harding rushed for 479 yards on 64 carries and had eight rushing touchdowns vs. Southwestern Okla. in a 70-28 victory in 2011. It ranks as the third-best rushing game in program history in terms of yards gained and the second-most rushing touchdowns. The Bisons gained 556 yards in the game, the ninth-highest total in program history.

Southwestern Okla. passed for 438 yards and four touchdowns in that game. It ranks ninth in passing yards in a game by a Harding opponent.

Harding has won the two GAC games against Southwestern Okla. by a combined score of 108-35. In the two games, the Bisons have rushed for 837 yards and 12 touchdowns on 123 carries, an average of 6.8 yards per rush.

## Harding vs. Southwestern Okla. – Last Meeting

Fourteenth-ranked Harding rushed for 358 yards and four touchdowns and controlled ball-possession in a 38-7 victory over Southwestern Okla. on

Nov. 10, 2012 in Searcy.

Harding sophomore wide receiver Donatella Luckett scored on a 46-yard reverse in the first quarter and caught a 31-yard touchdown pass from Keenan Kellett to put the Bisons ahead 28-7 with 9:59 left in the third quarter.

Harding also got rushing touchdowns from D'Nico Jackson-Best, Kelvin Martin and Christian Pletta.

Southwestern Okla. quarterback Dustin Stenta completed 11-of-25 passes for 136 yards and a 17-yard touchdown pass to Teverick Boyd. The Bulldogs gained 217 total yards.

Harding had more than 32 minutes of possession, thanks largely to converting 6-of-12 third downs.

## The Roster

Harding currently has 134 players on its roster, 89 active players and 45 red-shirts. Below is a breakdown of the 2013 Harding Football active roster:

- Class: Seniors (16), Juniors (24), Sophomores (19), Redshirt Freshmen (28), Freshmen (2).
- Harding has nine seniors who have been with the Bisons throughout their collegiate careers: WR Alex Finley, LB Erik Ragsdale, RB Ty Finley, DL B.J. Jones, DB Ishmael Siryon, DB Philip Mion, K Adin Menkin, OL Jeremiah Vivio, OL Dallan Hudson.
- Harding has two true freshmen on its active roster -- QB Matt Markham and DL Trevon Biglow.
- The Bisons have 45 offensive players, 41 defensive players, and three special teams players on the opening day roster.
- Offensively, Harding has five quarterbacks, 13 running backs, seven wide receivers and 20 offensive linemen.
- Defensively, the Bisons have 16 defensive linemen, eight linebackers and 17 defensive backs.
- K John Gay, K Adin Menkin, and P Nathan Kadlec are the three special teams players.
- Harding's active roster has student-athletes from 15 different states. The leaders are Arkansas (28), Texas (20), California (8), Tennessee (7), Florida (5), Oklahoma (4).

## Who's Back

Harding has 37 letterwinners returning off last seasons' team that finished 9-2 overall, 7-1 (2nd place) in the Great American Conference. Harding returns eight players who started last season on offense and one (Erik Ragsdale) on defense.

## Who is from around here?

Harding has four active players from Oklahoma -- DL Cordell Zalenski (Durant), RB Russell Ward (Hollis), Romas Roberson (Hollis), and Trevon Biglow (Oklahoma City). It is 70 miles from Oklahoma City to Weatherford, 117 miles from Hollis to Weatherford, and 218 miles from Durant to Weatherford.

# 2013 Harding Football Game Notes

## OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Harding ranked fourth in NCAA Division II last season in rushing yards per game (320.55). It was the third consecutive season that the Bisons have finished in the top five nationally. The Bisons had 34 rushing touchdowns and had 12 different players score on the ground.
- Harding's leading returning rusher is junior Romo Westbrook, who rushed for 655 yards on 110 carries and five touchdowns. Westbrook was an honorable mention All-American last season and was 1st Team All-Central Region and All-GAC.
- Harding returns seven of its top eight rushers from last season, losing only quarterback Kelvin Martin.
- Harding has two running backs that have 100-yard rushing games on their career resumes. D'Nico Jackson-Best rushed for 103 yards on 12 carries last season vs. Southern Nazarene, and Romo Westbrook collected 181 yards on only six carries against Arkansas Tech last season.
- The Bisons' top returning wide receiver is junior Donatella Lockett. Last season, Lockett earned 2nd Team All-GAC honors. He had 28 receptions for 453 yards and seven touchdowns and carried nine times for 122 yards and two touchdowns.
- Harding has five quarterbacks on its active roster, but none have ever started a collegiate game.
- The Bisons' projected starters on the offensive line have a combined 76 career starts. Leading the way is senior left tackle Jeremiah Vivio (31), followed by Dallon Hudson (24), Mike Thompson (11), Mike Gallaway (7), and Patrick Bingham (3). Vivio has started every game of his Harding career.

## DEFENSIVE NOTES

- For the second time in the last three seasons, Harding returns only one starter on defense. Senior linebacker Erik Ragdale started nine games last season and is Harding's leading returning tackler. He had 37 tackles, including 1.5 tackles for loss.
- Last season, Harding led the GAC in scoring defense (17.3), total defense (283.5) and red-zone defense (54.8). The Bisons ranked sixth in Division II in total defense and 10th in rushing defense and scoring defense.
- Harding's projected defensive starters vs. Southwestern Okla., have combined for 26 career starts. DE B.J. Jones and LB Erik Ragsdale have 12 starts each. NG Romas Roberson and FS Philip Mion have each started once.

## SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Harding returns all of its specialists from last season. Junior kicker John Gay is a preseason All-America honoree after making 10-of-14 field goals and 43-of-43 extra points in 2012.
- Senior punter Nathan Kadlecek ranked third in the GAC last season with 38.7 yards per punt, the fifth-best average in program history.
- Sophomore Madison Firmin returns as the long snapper, and senior Alex Finley will again be the holder.

# Head Coach Ronnie Huckeba

Harding, 1978

28th season at Harding

7th season as head coach

Ronnie Huckeba is entering his seventh season as head coach of the Harding Bison football team in 2013 and has a career record of 31-31. He was named Harding's fifth head football coach in the modern era in October of 2007 after serving 21 seasons as a Harding assistant coach.

In 2012, Huckeba led the Bisons to a 9-2 record, a No. 19 national ranking, and the team's first berth in the NCAA Division II playoffs. Huckeba's squad led the Great American Conference in scoring defense (17.3 points per game), total defense (283.5), and rushing offense (320.5). He had 15 players earn All-GAC honors, and senior defensive end Ty Powell was selected in the 7th Round of the NFL Draft by the Seattle Seahawks.

In his six seasons as head coach, Huckeba's teams have been among the nation's statistical leaders on both sides of the ball. Last season, Harding ranked in the top 10 in Division II in rushing offense (4th), total defense (6th) and rushing defense (10th).

Huckeba's teams have been in the top five nationally in rushing offense three times (2010, 2011, 2012) and in passing offense twice (2007, 2008).

Defensively, Huckeba's squad led the nation in sacks and ranked 11th in tackles for loss in 2010. In 2012, the Bisons allowed opponents to score only 17 times in their 31 trips inside the redzone, good for fourth in Division II.

Huckeba, the 2010 Gulf South Conference Coach of the Year, has victories over four nationally-ranked teams on his resume. In 2009, Harding upset 20th-ranked Ouachita Baptist on the road. Then in 2010, Huckeba's Bisons upset 12th-ranked Delta St. in Cleveland, Miss., and followed that with a win over 15th-ranked North Ala. in the 2010 season finale. His most recent win over a nationally-ranked team came in 2012, when the Bisons defeated 10th-ranked Ouachita Baptist 34-14 in Arkadelphia.

Huckeba has coached five All-America honorees in his time as head coach--quarterback David Knighton (2007), defensive back Josh Jones (2009), fullback Romo Westbrook (2012), kicker John Gay (2012), and defensive end Ty Powell (2012). He has also tutored 44 all-conference performers.

Prior to becoming head coach, Huckeba served two seasons as Harding's offensive coordinator in 2005 and 2006. He spent the previous 11 seasons as Harding's defensive coordinator.

Huckeba began his Harding career in 1986 as the secondary coach, a position he continued through 1987. In 1988, he became the front-seven coach and served in that role through 1993.

Prior to coming to Harding, Huckeba spent five seasons as the head coach at Ouachita Christian where he was named the Louisiana Class A Coach of the Year in 1985 after leading OCS to a 15-0 record and state championship.

In 1979, Huckeba began his coaching career as an assistant at Carlisle High School in Carlisle, Ark. The next year he moved on to Fort Worth Christian School in Fort Worth, Texas where he served as an assistant under Randy Tribble, winning the TAPPS state championship.

Huckeba was a standout Bison offensive lineman for Harding from 1973-76. He started at guard on the Bisons' 1976 Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference co-championship squad.

Huckeba was a three-year letterwinner, playing both tight end and defensive end at Claxton High School in Claxton, Ga., from 1969-72.

Huckeba received his bachelor's degree in education from Harding in 1978. He earned his master's degree in physical education from Harding in 1983.

Huckeba is a native of Claxton, Ga., and is an Assistant Professor of Kinesiology.

He is married to the former Peggy Jones of Schreveport, La. The couple has three children - Hope, Jeb, and Jordan.
