Series Record: Hawai'i has a 33-0 record against UC Irvine. Earlier this season, UH held off the Anteaters to win in four sets (Oct. 17), but it took a last second Rainbow run in the fourth to seal the win and prevent the match from going to five sets. Last season, after sweeping UCI at home on Oct. 4 (25-17, 25-19, 26-24), UCI gave UH all they could handle on the road as the 'Bows survived after beginning the match down 2 sets to win a five-set marathon on Oct. 31 (21-25, 22-25, 26-24, 25-18, 15-7).

IRVINE, Calif.—The No. 8 University of Hawai'i women's volleyball team 23-1, 13-0 Big West) will attempt to capture the Big West title outright on Tuesday night when they take on the UC Irvine Anteaters (12-13, 6-7 BWC). With three games remaining and Cal Poly and Long Beach State tied for second place at 11-3 mark, the Rainbow Wahine clinched at least a share of the conference title on Sunday after defeating UC Davis in four sets (23-25, 25-17, 25-22, 25-17). The 'Bows are riding an 18-match win-streak, the longest since UH won 19 consecutive matches in 2012.

Hawai'i rose five spots this week to No. 27 in the RPI, but UH fell one slot to No. 8 in the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) poll on Monday.

The Rainbow Wahine continues to lead the NCAA with 3.37 blocks per set average. Olivia Magill has been solid at the net and is ranked No. 5 in the nation averaging 1.59 blocks per set which is tops in the Big West Conference as well. Right behind her in the league rankings are teammates Emily Maglio and Nikki Taylor who sit in second (1.25 BPS) and third (1.23 BPS). With its strong blocking and stingy defense, UH is ranked No. 6 in the NCAA holding opponents to a .143 hitting percentage for the season.

Hawai'i also continues to lead the league in five statistical categories: hitting percentage (.287), blocks (3.36 p/s), kills (14.05 p/s), service aces (1.52 p/s) and opponent hitting percentage (.145). Hawai'i has swept 13 of its opponents this season, including a streak of six consecutive 3-0 victories from Sept. 20 - Oct. 9. Their last three-set sweep came on Nov. 7 at CSUN.

UH's Nikki Taylor earned her fourth Big West Player of the Week on Monday after a 21-kill performance that helped the 'Bows clinch at least a share of the conference title. She added nine digs to just miss out on recording her sixth double-double of the year. She also contributed five blocks, including one solo. Taylor reached the 20-kill plateau for the sixth time this season, and the second match in the last three.

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ATTENDANCE

The Rainbow Wahine finished ranked No. 2 in the nation last year with 120,776 fans coming to 18 matches in the Stan Sheriff Center to average 6,709 per match. Since attendance records were compiled by the NCAA in 1998, Hawai'i was tops in the NCAA for the first 15 seasons. Nebraska has claimed the top spot the last two seasons averaging over 8,000 fans per match. UH had it's largest crowd of the season with 8,667 tickets issued in their match vs UCLA on Sunday, Sept. 6.

-In conference, UH is ranked No. 1 in five of seven statistical categories:

- hitting percentage (.287)
- blocks per set (3.36), No. 2 is UC Davis with 2.29 blocks per set
- opponent hitting percentage (.145)
- kills per set (14.05)
- service aces per set (1.52)

-UH is the last undefeated team in the conference at 13-0

-UH has won their last 18-straight matches. UH's win streak is the longest since the Rainbow Wahine won 19-straight in 2012.

-UH has swept 13 of its opponents this season—including a streak of six consecutive 3-0 wins from Sept. 20-Oct. 9. On Oct. 11, Long Beach State snapped their sweep streak by taking the 'Bows five sets for the third straight match between the two teams dating back to last season (2014)

-Olivia Magill leads the conference in both hitting percentage (.393) and blocks per set (1.59).

-Emily Maglio is No. 2 in the Big West in both hitting percentage (.382) and blocks per set (1.25)

-Nikki Taylor is ranked No. 5 in the NCAA averaging 5.38 points per set (kills + blocks + aces)

-Nikki Taylor is No. 1 in the BWC with 0.43 service aces per set; No. 2 with 4.27 kills per set; No. 3 with 1.23 blocks per set

-Tayler Higgins is No. 3 in the BWC with 9.63 assists per set and No. 2 with 0.32 service aces per set

-Libero Savannah Kahakai is ranked No. 6 averaging 3.75 digs per set.

Almost Full Strength

Against UC Irvine (Oct. 17) UH began the match down three starters. Setter Kendra Koelsch had started five-straight matches in place of Tayler Higgins who suffered a badly sprained ankle in UH's first road match at Cal State Fullerton. Higgins however, made her return to the court in the second set against the Anteaters. McKenna Granato started both of UH's last two matches in place of Kalei Greeley who sat out to nurse some nagging injuries. In Saturday's match against the Anteaters, UH opposite Nikki Taylor was also out after colliding with Koelsch in the UC Davis match the night before. She was not cleared to play for that match against UCI. It snapped a streak of 38-straight starts for Taylor who missed the first eight matches last year as a sophomore due to injury.

In Taylor's absence, the versatile Annie Mitchem got her third start of the season, shifting to opposite from middle hitter. Mitchem came through in the clutch for UH, racking up career-high numbers with seven kills, two service aces, three blocks and 13 digs to combine for a career-high 10.5 points. But it proved to be a costly outing as Mitchem suffered a fracture dislocation of her right pinky during the match. She had surgery on the finger the following Wednesday and will be out for at least another three weeks.

Although Mitchem went down, UH's 6-5 middle hitter, freshman Natasha Burns was just cleared for practice this after suffering a broken hand during training camp early this fall.

Against UC Riverside (Oct. 30) was the first time all six starters from the beginning of the season were back together since October 3rd's match at UC Riverside.

Rainbow Roofers

The Rainbow Wahine continue to lead the NCAA averaging 3.36 blocks per set. Led by senior middle hitter Olivia Magill at the net, UH ranks No. 1, 2 and 3 in the Big West in blocks. Magill is averaging 1.59 blocks per set (which ranks her at No. 8 in the NCAA) with 130.0 total blocks with 14 solo and 116 block assists. Sophomore middle hitter Emily Maglio No. 49 in the nation and is second in the league with 1.25 rejects per set. She has six solo blocks and 80 block assists. Junior opposite Nikki Taylor is third in the BWC and No. 55 in the NCAA with 1.23 blocks per set with an even 100.0 total blocks and nine solo.

With the addition of newcomers 6-5 Natasha Burns, 6-3 Annie Mitchem, 6-3 Casey Castillo, and 6-0 McKenna Granato, the Rainbow Wahine have the tallest team in program history. The team averages 6-0 tall for the first time ever. UH has had 10 teams that averaged 5-11, the last time coming in 2010.

Taylor Earns Fourth BWC Player of the Week Award

Nikki Taylor earned her fourth Big West Player of the Week award this season on Monday, Nov. 16. Taylor's 21-kill performance at UC Davis helped the Rainbow Wahine to clinch at least a share of the 2015 Big West title. It is her fifth career Player of the Week award from the Big West.

Taylor, a junior opposite from Honolulu, O'ahu and Kaiser High School, helped to lead the 'Bows to a four-set win at UC Davis on Sunday. It was the sixth time this year and eighth time in her career that she's tallied 20-or more kills in a match and 19th match with double-digit kills this season. Taylor added nine digs to just miss out on recording her sixth double-double of the season. She was also was in on five blocks including one solo block.

It is just the fourth time in UH history that a Rainbow Wahine has earned a weekly conference award four times in a season. Only Heather Bown (1999-WAC), Kim Willoughby (2001-WAC) and Emily Hartong (2012 and 2013-Big West) have accomplished the feat. The program record for most weekly conference honors is five and Angelica Ljungquist (1996-WAC) and Kanani Danielson (2009-WAC) are

the only two Rainbow Wahine to do that.

For Taylor, it is her sixth-career Big West weekly accolade. As a freshman in 2014, she earned BWC Player of the Week on Nov. 25 and last season as a sophomore, she was named Big West Defensive Player of the Week on Nov. 24.

It is the seventh weekly Big West honor bestowed upon Hawai'i this season. Tai Manu-Olevao was named Big West Player of the Week on Oct. 19, while Savannah Kahakai (Sept. 14) and Olivia Magill (Oct. 12) earned BWC Defensive Player of the Week honors.

Currently, Taylor is ranked No. 5 in the NCAA and No. 1 in the Big West averaging 5.38 points per set (kills + blocks + aces). She is also ranked No. 21 in the nation in aces per set (0.43); No. 29 with 4.27 kills per set. Taylor is also No. 3 in the BWC with 1.23 blocks per set behind teammates Magill and Maglio.

Taylor made history for the UH women's volleyball program becoming the first Rainbow Wahine to ever be named espnW's National Player of the Week. Taylor also became the first Hawai'i player to ever be voted conference Player of the Week for three consecutive weeks. She was just the third player from the Big West to accomplish the feat and the first to do so in 20 years. Taylor joined just Pacific's Dominique Benton-Bozman (1995) and Long Beach State's Antoinette White (1991) as the players to earn three-straight Big West weekly Player of the Week awards.

The 6-3 opposite from Honolulu and Kaiser High School came up big for the Rainbow Wahine in their thrilling, five-set win over the second-ranked Gators. Taylor slammed a career-best 27 kills and added a season-high 17 digs in the win. She hammered the set-winning kill in set two to knot the match at a set apiece and then delivered the final dagger on match point against Florida.

Magill on the Block

Senior middle hitter Olivia Magill is one of the main reasons why UH continues to lead the NCAA in blocking. She is currently ranked No. 8 in the NCAA and No. 1 in the Big West averaging 1.59 blocks per set. Magill also leads the league with a .393 hitting percentage. She is third on the team with 205 kills (2.50 per set). Overall, Magill leads UH with 130 total blocks with a team-high 14 solo. Magill leads UH with 116 block assists.

In UH's first match against UC Irvine, Magill came through in the clutch for Hawai'i. With UH trailing 23-24 and the Anteaters serving to force a fifth set, Magill got a kill in the middle to stave off set-point. Then, with the 'Bows down to one substitution and defensive specialist Clare-Marie Anderson still in the back row, Magill had to step behind the end line to serve for the first time in her collegiate career. Magill served two balls in...UH won the two points to steal Set 4 to defeat UCI, 3-1.

In UH's five-set victory over defending Big West champion Long Beach State, Magill and her fellow front-row players tallied a season-high 20 blocks—the most since UH posted 20.0 blocks against St. Johns last season on Sept. 6, 2014. Magill tied her season-high with 11 blocks, including a career-high three block solos that helped to hold the 49ers to just a .097 hitting percentage. Magill also contributed solidly on the offensive end against LBSU with eight kills and no errors in 21 attacks for a .381 hitting percentage.

In the Chevron Rainbow Wahine Invitational, she earned all-tournament honors after tallying a team-high .415 hitting percentage with 34 kills in 65 swings with seven errors. Magill was also in on 13 blocks for the Chevron Invitational.

In UH's last tournament, the Outrigger Resorts Volleyball Challenge, she was voted to the all-tournament team with a team-high 20 blocks to go with her 23 kills and four digs.

Last year as a junior transfer from Arizona, Magill had a stellar first year at Hawai'i garnering AVCA All-America honorable mention honors. The Big West first teamer dominated in conference on on both sides of the net with league highs in hitting percentage (.405) and blocks (1.34). She finished the season ranked 16th in the nation with her attacking mark while lifting the 'Bows to the nation's sixth-best blocking average of 3.00. The Shoreline, Wash. native had her best outing early in 2014, recording 15 kills and a team season-high 12 blocks against St. John's (9/16). She posted double-figures in kills in 15 matches and hit north of .400 in 17 contests highlighted by her eight-kill, zero-error performance at Cal State Fullerton (11/1) which garnered her league player of the week honors.

Higgins Hitting Her Stride

Junior setter Tayler Higgins had UH's offense clicking on all cylinders before she went down with an ankle injury in UH's first road match of the season at Cal St. Fullerton (Oct. 2). She missed the next five matches, but made her first appearance back in UH's match vs. UC Irvine in the middle of the second set. She rejoined the the starting line-up for UH's final two home matches against UCR and CSUF and has come on strong dishing out a balanced attack for the Rainbow Wahine. She is third in the league in assists average (9.63 per set) and No. 2 in conference averaging 0.32 service aces per set (22 total). Overall she has 655 total assists through 24 matches. She is fourth on the team with 151 digs and has been in on 25 blocks. She has tallied five double-doubles this year, her latest came against Cal Poly (Sept. 26) with 37 assits and 10 digs.

Last season, the setter from Honolulu, O'ahu played and started in all 29 matches. Higgins led team with 1,115 assists and 39 service aces while notching 55 kills with a hitting percentage of .352 for the season. She was in on 61 blocks and was second on the team with 254 digs. Higgins tallied a career high 53 assists against UC Irvine (10/31) and dealt out eight service aces vs. New Mexico (9/4). She had a career-high seven blocks to go along with 10 kills vs UC Santa Barbara (10/26). She had a career-high 19 digs vs UC Irvine (10/31).

Manu-Olevao Finishing Strong Down the Stretch

Manu-Ole-WOW! After shaking off a slow start to the season, senior captain Tai Manu-Olevao has been coming through for the Rainbow Wahine when they needed her the most. She ramped up her play to earn her first ever Big West Player of the Week (Oct. 26) honors after recording a team-high 27 kills in UH's two matches against UC Davis and UC Irvine. Manu-Olevao was the lone Rainbow Wahine to record double-digit kills with 12 in UH's sweep over UC Davis, hitting .375 for the match with just three errors in 24 swings with five digs and two assists. Against UC Irvine, she recorded a season-high 19.5 points with a team-high 15 kills and a career-high seven blocks in the four-set victory over the Anteaters. Her two solo blocks also were a career-high. She notched her second double-double of the season with 11 digs and 15 kills. For the week, she averaged 3.86 kills, 2.29 digs and 1.00 blocks per set. Manu-Olevao was the fourth Rainbow Wahine to earn a weekly conference honor this season.

Earlier this season, the senior from Punahou School came through in a big way for Hawaii'i in their five-set win over then-No. 2 Florida. Manu-Olevao pounded a season-high 16 kills with just four errors in 45 swings against the Gators—including set-point in the fourth set to knot the match at 2-2. She also added seven digs and two blocks in the statement match. Since then, she has provided the fire for the team's continued success.

Overall this season, she has played in all 24 matches, starting in 22 of them. She is second on the team with 223 kills and has 146 digs and 37 blocks—including 11 solo. She recorded her first double-double of the season with 12 kills and 12 digs against Big West rival, Long Beach State (10/11).

Manu-Olevao is the lone four-year senior for the 2015 squad. Last year she appeared and started in 25 matches at outside hitter and led the team in kills (289) and was second on the team with 34 aces. She finished the season with 210 digs and 54 blocks while recording six double-doubles on the season. Manu-Olevao put down a career-high of 21 kills vs. UC Irvine (10/31) and tallied a then-career-high hitting percentage of .417 against UC Riverside (11/28). Manu-Olevao earned all-Big West first team honors and was

Koelsch in the Clutch

Sophomore setter Kendra Koelsch stepped right in and Hawaii'i did not miss a beat when starting setter Tayler Higgins went down with an injury in the first set at Cal State Fullerton (10/2), Koelsch had to come in in with a moment's notice and the team kept rolling.

Through the last six matches, Koelsch dished out 197 assists with 42 digs, 11 kills and two service aces. Koelsch also proved to be formidable at the net, notching 29 blocks (three solo) which was the second most to Magill's 37 during that span.

At CSF, Koelsch had three kills and a career-high 31 assists with four digs and four blocks. Then, in her first start of her career at UH at UC Riverside, she dished out a career-high 33 assists with a career-high six digs and career-high six blocks.

Koelsch continued to improve in every start, culminated in a career-match against Long Beach State in which she recorded career-highs in assists (41), digs (13) and blocks (9) while evenly distributing the kills with three players notching 12 kills each (Taylor, Manu-Olevao, and Greeley).

All season long, Koelsch has provided a lift for the Rainbow Wahine. In UH's epic five-set win over Florida, she sparked UH while setting a career-high at the time with 27 assists while getting two blocks and three digs. She and junior setter Tayler Higgins split time in the lineup against the Gators with Higgins staying in to serve and play some back-row while Koelsch would come in to play at the net.

Koelsch also came through in the clutch in the season opener against Idaho. After entering the match in late in the second set. UH had been down 19-23 to the Vandals and Koelsch came in with the 'Bows trailing 21-23. She sparked the 'Bows and had two key dump shot kills, including a reverse, left-handed one that allowed UH to capture the second set and a 2-0 set lead.

Overall, Koelsch has seen action in all 24 matches. She has 303 assists, 20 kills, 49 blocks and 53 digs this season.

Maglio Steady In the Middle

Sophomore middle hitter Emily Maglio has started all but one match this season. She is second in the conference both on offense and defense, averaging 1.25 blocks per set with a .382 hitting percentage. This has been a breakout year for the young Canadian. Overall she has put down 126 kills with 86 total blocks—including six solo.

In Week 6, she recorded 11 kills with just one error for a team-high .556 hitting percentage. At UC Riverside, she rejected a career-high seven attempts by the Highlanders. Maglio now has amassed 69 total blocks and is No. 2 on the team and in the conference averaging 1.35 blocks per set. She has 87 kills (1.71 kps) three assists and 12 digs this year.

Maglio buried a career-high 12 kills against CSU Bakersfield in UH's final non-conference game. Maglio had four kills in the first set, caught fire in the second set, pounding down six kills in six attempts for a perfect 1.000 hitting percentage. She added two more kills in the third for her 12 total kills. Maglio finished the night 12-for-18 with three errors. She was also tied with a match-high five blocks with Taylor.

Kahakai Anchoring the Back Row

Sophomore libero Savanah Kahakai continues to be the anchor of the defense for the Rainbow Wahine. She has started all 24 matches at the libero positions and she leads UH with 311 digs to average 3.75 digs per set. She also has 68 assists and has come on strong with her serves as well. Kahakai has popped up double-digit digs in 19 matches this year.

In Week 3 of the season, Kahakai led UH in digs in all three of Hawai'i victories in the Outrigger Resorts Volleyball Challenge en route to earned Big West Defensive Player of the Week honors. The Honolulu native out of Farrington High School registered double-digit digs against San Diego State, Florida and Eastern Washington totaling 42 over the three tournament matches. She had 13 digs against the Aztecs and 10 versus the Eagles. Her best effort came when it was needed most—Kahakai notched a career-high 19 digs in Hawai'i's five-set takedown of the Gators. She also contributed in other ways, chipping in with eight assists and a service ace against Florida.

Greeley Comes Back

Sophomore Kalei Greeley missed UH's two matches against UC Davis and UC Irvine but has come back and has been on the mend since then. Greeley came back with more pop and has been an effective and consistent player for the Rainbow Wahine. Overall, she has started 22 matches and is fourth on the team with 165 kills while recording 42 blocks, 152 digs and 13 service aces.

Last year, Greeley earned all-Big West freshman team honors after seeing action in all 29 games, with 26 starts. She finished her rookie season third on the team with 264 kills to go along with 233 digs and 51 blocks. She also tallied 17 assists and 19 service aces. Against UC Santa Barbara, she had a career-high 19 kills and earlier in non-conference play had a career-best hitting percentage of .433 vs San Diego State (8/31). Greeley recored a career highs of five blocks vs UCLA and 16 digs against UC Irvine. Arguably her best overall match came against San Diego State (8/31) when she notched 15 kills, three aces, and nine digs in just her third career match.

Mitchem to Miss Six Weeks Due to Injury

Highly touted junior college transfer Annie Mitchem put up career-high numbers for the Rainbow Wahine as she started in place of opposite Nikki Taylor in UH's last match vs. UC Irvine. But, after the match, she found out that she had suffered a fracture dislocated little finger on her right hand. She had surgery on it the following Wednesday and will miss up to six weeks total.

Mitchem had seen time on the court in all 19 matches and got her first collegiate start for UH against then No. 2 Florida. Overall, she has 51 kills and 33 blocks in the 37 sets that she's played in.

For the last two years, Mitchem attended at Irvine Valley College where she earned back-to-back AVCA Two-Year College Player of the Year awards. She also earned AVCA All-America, all-region, all-state, and all-league honors in both seasons. As a freshman, she helped lead the Lasers to a 24-2 overall record and their first State Championship since 2009. In the 2013 championship match, Mitchem recorded a team-high 20 kills with eight blocks and a .444 hitting percentage. She was named conference Player of the Year in her first year ending the season ranked first in hitting percentage (.436) and blocks per set (1.61) while placing second in kills (309) and third in kills per set (3.64) as IVC went a perfect 14-0 in conference play. Mitchem became just the second player from the California Community College Athletics Association to be AVCA Player of the Year honors. She kept things going as a sophomore as the six rotation middle hitter ended the season leading the nation with a .517 hitting percentage and was fourth in blocks per set (1.24). She helped lead the Lasers to a perfect 27-0 record and in the state championship game, she buried 24 kills, hit .488 while tallying six solo blocks and seven digs en route to being voted the state tournament MVP...named the Irvine Valley College Female Athlete of the Year. Mitchem was coached by former Hawai'i men's volleyball All-American, Tom Pestolesi.

Granato Third in Big West in Service Aces

Freshman outside hitter McKenna Granato has played solidly for UH off the bench. The versatile player from Punahou School is ranked No. 5 in the league averaging .31 service aces per set. Overall, the rookie has 22 kills with 14 service aces, seven blocks and 54 digs.

Against CSU Bakersfield in which she picked up an ace and two digs. She is ranked No. 7 in the conference with 0.30 service aces per set.

This past road trip, she was the main player who came in to relieve Kalei Greeley when she went down with an injury in the first set.

Granato got her first two collegiate starts wearing the Green and White in the Hawaiian Airlines Wahine Volleyball Classic, and has played in 20 sets this season.

Granato was the 2015 Hawai'i state player of the year as a senior at Punahou School. She was also the 2014 Gatorade State Player of the Year and was a 2014 Under Armour All-American.

Anderson Reliable Server/Defender

Sophomore Clare-Marie Anderson has been a reliable server and defender playing in all 24 matches this season. Twice, she has served as the libero late in the match. Against Eastern Washington, she tallied a career-high nine digs. She's also had two service aces twice in a match this season—against EWU and CSU Bakersfield. Overall she has 51 digs, nine assists and nine service aces.

Castillo's Role Increases

Freshman Casey Castillo's role on the team just got a little bigger with middle hitter Annie Mitchem going down for a few weeks with injury. Castillo is No. 2 on the depth chart behind Taylor and now is also taking reps as a middle blocker as well.

The freshman from Oceanside, Calif. has seen action in 19 sets this season with three kills, one dig and four blocks thus far.

2015 Captains Named

Prior to the season, the team voted senior outside hitter Tai Manu-Olevao and junior setter Tayler Higgins as their team captains. Last year, Manu-Olevao served as an assistant captain to then-senior Kalei Adolpho. Manu-Olevao and Higgins coincidentally were also teammates as prepsters at Punahou School in Honolulu. The two will lead a solid, youthful squad which features 12 returnees—including five starters— and four newcomers.

The Punahou Connection

This year is the first time in program history that there are four members of the team all from the same school—ironically one in each class. Tai Manu-Olevao (senior), Tayler Higgins (junior), Clare-Marie Anderson (sophomore), and McKenna Granato (freshman) all played their stand-out prep careers at Punahou School in Honolulu, O'ahu. There have been four other teams to date which had three players from the same school. In 1993, Wendi Park, Stephanie Shota and Chastitiy Nobriga were all Pearl City High School alums and for each of the past three seasons, UH has carried three Punahou players on the roster. Higgins is the only player to have bridged the gap to have played with all of the other three Buffanblu while in high school

Huff Leaves Volleyball to Focus on Basketball

Sophomore opposite Megan Huff has decided to leave the volleyball program to focus on playing women's basketball later this year.

This season in volleyball, Huff has played eight sets in six matches and has recorded seven kills with one block assist. For her career, she appeared in 22 total matches with 23 kills and 15 blocks.

The 6-3 native of Federal Way, Wash. played both sports last year as a freshman. In basketball, she was named Big West Sixth Player of the Year and earned a spot on the conference's All-Freshman team as well. Last season in hoops, she averaged 16.9 minutes with 7.1 points and 4.9 rebounds per game with 20 blocked shots.

Hall Shifts to Women's Volleyball

Associate coach Jeff Hall is in his first season with the Rainbow Wahine after spending four years with the Rainbow Warrior team under men's head coach Charley Wade. Hall also serves as the women's beach volleyball head coach. His duties with the men included recruiting, team scouting and offensive game planning, as well as working with the setters in the practice gym. Hall helped the Rainbow Warriors qualify for the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation tournament twice (2011 and '13) and began the

2015 season assisting UH before switching over to the beach team.

Hall played professionally on the AVP tour for four seasons, however, has spent more than 20 years playing and coaching on the beach. He continues to play at the Outrigger Canoe Club and Queen's Beach at least twice a week.

Hall came to UH from his alma mater, the University of the Pacific, where he spent three seasons (2007-09) as assistant coach for the men's program. Prior to UOP, Hall spent three years with the UC San Diego men's and women's volleyball teams from 2004-07. Hall also was the first assistant at Grossmont College for five seasons from 2000-04, where his teams finished fifth in the state twice.

A native of St. Paul, Minn., he also coached at Mission Bay High School for three years and was the head coach of the top-ranked Seaside 18's club team in Del Mar for seven seasons. His club won the gold medal at the Junior Olympics in Minneapolis in 2006 while also producing seven Top 10 finishes nationally, including five in the Top 5.

Rainbow Wahine Starts Season Ranked No. 18; Picked to Finish First in the Big West

The 'Bows were voted for the fourth straight season to win the Big West after coming in second place a year ago with a 13-3 record. The Rainbow Wahine collected eight first-place votes en route to an 80-point total. Reigning Big West champion Long Beach State, who went a perfect 16-0 record to capturing the 2014 title, nabbed the remaining first-place vote to secure second place with 68 points. UC Santa Barbara rounds out the top three after earning 56 points.

Last year, Hawai'i had its streak of 19-straight conference titles (WAC and Big West combined) snapped as they finished in second place with a 13-3 Big West record and a 22-7 overall mark. The 'Bows appeared in its 33rd overall and 22nd-straight NCAA tournament, falling in the second round to Washington in the second round.

UH received an AVCA preseason national ranking of No. 18. In 34 years of coaches' polls, UH has never started the season ranked this low. Hawai'i's upcoming opponents—Florida and UCLA were ranked No. 4 and 20 respectively in the preseason poll, while Long Beach State, Oregon State, Wichita State, and American all received votes. LBSU, who captured the 2014 Big West crown, was the first school listed in the receiving votes category.

Returning for his 41st Season

UH head coach Dave Shoji returns for his 41st

season. With 1,150 wins, he is the winningest coach in NCAA Division I women's volleyball history, a feat he accomplished two years ago during the second week of the season. Shoji is a 12-time conference, 10-time region, and two-time national Coach of the Year. He has been Hawai'i's coach for all but the first year of the program and guided to the 'Bows to four national titles (1979, '82, '83, '87).

UC Santa Barbara (1969)

Overall Record: 1,173-197-1

Dave Shoji enters his 41st season as head coach of the Rainbow Wahine. Last season, he guided UH to its 33rd trip to the NCAA Tournament. Shoji is the all-time winningest coach in NCAA Division I women's volleyball history, setting the mark with his 1,107th victory on Sept. 6 against Santa Clara. Shoji's all-time collegiate coaching record is 1,173-197-1.

The honors have piled up for Shoji over the years. In addition to being a member of the AVCA Hall of Fame, he is an 11-time conference and nine-time region Coach of the Year, and was named the National Coach of the Year in 1982 and in 2009. Shoji was named to the list of all-time great coaches by USA Volleyball in 2002. He has also been inducted into the Hawai'i Sports Hall of Fame and was named coach of the NCAA 25th Anniversary team.

In 1975, a young Shoji took over the reins of the UH women's volleyball program. He was just 28 years old with no clue that he would turn a one-year-old program into a national powerhouse over the next four decades. The team was coming off a 9-1 campaign in 1974 that ended with the Rainbow Wahine falling to UCLA in the national title match at the AIAW Championship.

In Shoji's first four years at the helm of the program, he took the team to two more national title matches before he finally broke through to take the title in 1979 with a five-game victory over Utah State in the AIAW finals. It was the school's first-ever team national championship and a sign of great things to come for the young program.

In 1981, Shoji became UH's first full-time coach for a women's program. He led the team to another national title, this time in the new NCAA Tournament in 1982, beating the USC Women of Troy in a come-from-behind five-game thriller. Shoji would lead the team to another title in 1983 with a straight-set win over UCLA, becoming the first school to win back-to-back NCAA championships.

The Rainbow Wahine again returned to the national championship match in 1987, capping a 37-2 season with a sweep of Stanford for the program's fourth national title and third NCAA title. The team lost to Texas in the 1988 national championship match, then went through a stretch of five frustrating losses in six years to rival Long Beach State in the NCAA Regionals, holding them out of the NCAA Championships.

UH looked primed to return to the Final Four in 1995, going through the season undefeated at 29-0. After winning their regional match over Arizona State, Hawai'i was set for a national championship run. But Michigan State dealt a heart-breaking blow to those plans, coming back from being down two games to none, to hold the Rainbow Wahine out of the NCAA Championships.

Hawai'i would finally make that return in 1996, dropping just one set in the first four matches of the NCAA Tournament. But another long-time nemesis of the Rainbow Wahine, Stanford, stopped UH's bid for a national title, sweeping Hawai'i in the championship match. The Rainbow Wahine experienced another great run of success that started with the 1998 season, as transfer Heather Bown led the team from a perennial Top 25 squad and NCAA Tournament team to again a national-title contender.

Hawai'i made its way to the NCAA Regional Final in 1998 and was one of the top seeds in the 1999 tournament before a scrappy Texas A&M team beat UH in the regionals.

Following that season, Kim Willoughby came to the program, joining Lily Kahumoku to form a dynamic duo that would lead the team to great success for another four years. From 2000-03, the Rainbow Wahine advanced to the NCAA Championship national semifinal match three times, while Shoji's

2003 senior class became the winningest class in school history.

The Rainbow Wahine returned to the NCAA Championships in 2009, reaching the national semifinal match in Shoji's 35th season, giving the legendary coach his second national coach of the year award and his 10th award for conference and region coach of the year.

Under Shoji, UH volleyball finished in the Top 10 in 23 of the 28 final AVCA polls, and ranked in the top five 15 times. They have made it to the postseason in all but one year, finishing with a winning record in all 39 seasons and missing the postseason just once.

The 67-year-old was also responsible for the start of the men's volleyball program in 1978. Shoji served as the men's coach at UH from 1978-85, compiling a record of 81-48 and leading the team to a Western Collegiate Volleyball Conference title in 1980.

Shoji was a three-sport athlete at Upland High School in California, playing football, basketball and baseball. He then moved on to UC Santa Barbara, where he played baseball for a year, along with three years of volleyball. He earned All-America honors as a volleyball player in 1968 and '69. He earned his bachelor's degree in physical education in 1969.

After spending two years in the U.S. Army, Shoji returned to Hawai'i to coach the Kalani High School girl's and boy's volleyball teams. He then took an assistant coaching job at Punahou School.

Shoji and his wife, the former Mary Teneffos, reside in Manoa. They have three children, Cobey, Kawika and Erik. Daughter Cobey played volleyball at both UNLV and Michigan as a defensive specialist/setter. Both sons Kawika and Erik helped lead the Stanford men's volleyball team to a national title in 2010, with Kawika earning National Player of the Year honors.
