### GAME STORYLINES

- ▶ This week's match-up is the back end of a rare, in-season home-and-home series with New Mexico State. The Rainbow Warriors defeated the Aggies, 41-21, in the first meeting on Sept. 25 in Las Cruces.
- ▶ UH forced three turnovers in that game and scored 24 points in the final 17 minutes to break away for a 20-point victory and its first road win of the year.
- ▶ Saturday's game will also mark the first regular season home game played in front of spectators in nearly two years. A limited capacity of 1,000 is expected. UH's last regular season home game with fans was Nov. 30, 2019 vs. Army. UH's last game in Honolulu with fans was during the 2019 Hawai'i Bowl versus BYU.
- ▶ UH will pay tribute to the late Colt Brennan throughout Saturday's game. The legendary quarterback passed away in May at the age of 37. The native of Irvine, Calif., set multiple school and NCAA records during a decorated career that also saw him become a Heisman Trophy finalist. He helped lead UH to an unforgettable 12-0 regular-season in 2007. Brennan was inducted into the school's Circle of Honor this year.
- ▶ Hawai'i leads the all-time series with New Mexico State, 9-0, which began in 1978. The teams met every year from 2005-11 while as members of the Western Athletic Conference.
- ▶ UH has won all five meetings in Honolulu — including a 45-34 victory in the final meeting as WAC rivals.
- ▶ UH has scored 40 points or more in seven of the nine meetings and have averaged 43.8 points per game in the series.
- ▶ The Aggies (1-6) were idle last week and enter the match-up having lost their last three games, most recently a 55-28 loss at Nevada, Oct. 9 in Reno.
- ▶ NMSU's only win this season was a 43-35 victory over South Carolina State. The Aggies are 0-4 on the road this season.
- ▶ UH has a 24-27 all-time record against Independents.
- ▶ UH has scored a touchdown on its opening drive in each of the last three games including a 74-yard pass play from Chevan Cordeiro to Nick Mardner in Hawai'i's win at NMSU. Running back Dae Dae Hunter also scored on the first play in last week's loss to Nevada on a 75-yard rush.
- ▶ Quarterback Chevan Cordeiro is 64 yards away from 1,000 career rushing yards. When he reaches that mark, he will become just the third UH signal caller joining Michael Carter and Glenn Freitas to reach that mark.
- ▶ In its first three home games, UH out-scored its opponents 45-7 in the first quarter.

## NEW HOME STADIUM

For the next several years, UH will play its home games on-campus at the retrofitted Clarence T.C. Ching Athletics Complex. The stadium will seat approximately 9,000 in 2021 with plans to seat 15,000 or more in 2022. Previously, Hawai'i played its home games at Aloha Stadium, which was shuttered at the conclusion of the 2020 season. UH had an all-time record of 211-145-4 in 46 seasons at Aloha Stadium.

## MEDICAL POLICY

The UH Sports Media Relations Office abides by federal law pertaining to the releasing of injury information. We will not disseminate any information about a student-athletes' injury without written consent. The only information given to the media will be if a student-athlete is "probable," "questionable," or "doubtful" to play. However, the student-athlete may release information about his/her injury.

## WE ARE THE "RAINBOW WARRIORS"

In an effort to standardize the school's nicknames, UH officially changed its men's team nickname to "Rainbow Warriors" on July 1, 2013. The school's women's teams are still referred to as "Rainbow Wahine." The word "Wahine" (pronounced wah-HEE-nay) means woman in the Hawaiian language. The rainbow has been part of the nickname since 1923 and Warriors were first adopted in 1974.

## WHAT'S AN 'OKINA?

**What's that punctuation mark in the word Hawai'i?** In the Hawaiian language, it's called an 'okina, which translated literally in English means separator. Phonetically it is referred to as a glottal stop, similar to the sound that would be made in the English oh-oh. The 'okina is actually a letter in the Hawaiian language and typed out looks like a backwards, inverted apostrophe. The practice of the UH Sports Media Relations office is to use the 'okina in all Hawaiian words in which they occur.

## LAST TIME OUT

**LAST WEEK VS. NEVADA**  
**NEV 34, UH 17 — Oct. 16, 2021**  
**Mackay Stadium; Reno, Nev.**

▶ Nevada defeated UH for the first time since 2018.

▶ Powered by two runs of 75+ yards, Dae Dae Hunter finished with a career-high 174 rushing yards on just eight carries (21.8 avg.) and two touchdowns. His 174 yards were the most since Diocemy Saint Juste had 202 versus San Jose State in 2017 while his 81-yard TD run was the longest since Paul Harris' school record 95-yarder vs. UC Davis in 2015

▶ Calvin Turner Jr. did not score a touchdown in a game for just the second time this season.

▶ UH had its third punt blocked this season. Entering 2021, UH had a nation-leading streak of 154 straight games without a blocked punt, dating back to 2008.

▶ UH committed five turnovers which were the most by Hawai'i under Todd Graham and the most since the 2019 season opener vs. Arizona (6 TOs).

▶ Dae Dae Hunter's 75-yard touchdown run on UH's first offensive play was UH's longest play from scrimmage this year until his 81-yard run just a quarter later.

▶ UH has dropped five of its last six (true) road games dating back to last season.

**LAST MEETING VS. NEW MEXICO STATE**  
**UH 41, NMSU 21 - Sept. 25, 2021**  
**Aggie Memorial Stadium; Las Cruces, N.M.**

▶ The teams met for the first time since 2011 and UH improved to 9-0 all-time versus the Aggies and 4-0 in Las Cruces.

▶ UH picked up just its second win in its last 21 non-conference road games dating back to 2010.

▶ UH snapped a four-game losing streak in (true) road games dating back to last season.

▶ The Warriors recorded season-highs in sacks (4) and tackles-for-loss (9).

▶ UH scored a defensive touchdown for the first time under Todd Graham when Quentin Frazier deflected a NMSU backward pass, which was recovered by Cameron Lockridge for a 5-yard return in the second quarter.

▶ UH's 74-yard scoring connection between Chevan Cordeiro and Nick Mardner was the team's longest play from scrimmage this year.

## TEAM NOTES

## HAWAII IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

▶ Hawai'i is in its 10th season in the Mountain West and owns a 24-51 (.320) all-time mark — 13-26 at home and 11-25 on the road.

▶ Since the conference moved to two divisions in 2013, UH is 14-24 against the West and 5-16 versus the Mountain.

▶ UH captured a share of the West Division title in 2019 and made its first-ever appearance in the MW Championship game, eventually falling at Boise State.

## TROPHY GAMES

▶ UH will play three of its four rivalry trophy games this season, having already lost its opportunity to regain the Dick Tomey Legacy Trophy after a 17-13 setback to San José State on Sept. 18.

▶ UH will look to regain the Paniolo Trophy when it meets Wyoming, Nov. 27 in Laramie. UH currently holds possession of the Island Showdown Trophy, which it competes for against UNLV and will meet in Las Vegas, Nov. 13.

## MAGIC NUMBER

▶ Over the last two decades, when UH's offense generates 500+ yards of total offense, it usually results in a victory.

▶ Since 2000, UH is 72-10 when generating 500+ yards of total offense.

▶ Under coach Todd Graham, UH has reached 500+ yards four times, all resulting in victories.

## UH ON NATIONAL TELEVISION

▶ UH has made 118 all-time appearances on national TV and owns a 29-87-2 (.254) record.

▶ The Warriors are 9-14 on national television dating back to 2019 including an 1-4 mark this season.

## ROAD WARRIORS

▶ In the last decade (not including COVID-shortened 2020 season), UH has played no less than six road games a year, including a program-high seven this season.

▶ In those seven road games, UH will travel approximately 40,400 air miles, the highest total since 2016 when UH totaled 46,568 air miles, that included trips to Sydney, Australia and Ann Arbor, Mich., in back-to-back weeks.

► Since 2016, UH is 13-20 in road/neutral site games and 10-10 in MW road games. In the eight seasons prior, UH went 11-37 in road/neutral site games and 9-23 in league contests.

## OTHER TEAM NOTES

► UH's six turnovers forced (4-INT, 2-FR) against Fresno State were the most in a game since a 2011 road loss at San Jose State.

► Senior receiver Jared Smart did not catch a pass against Fresno State, which snapped a 29-game streak dating back to 2019.

► UH's 27-21 win over No. 18 Fresno State snapped a 13-game losing streak against nationally ranked teams that stretched over a decade.

► UH dropped its first season opener since 2016. UH had previously won four straight season openers and five in the last six years.

► UH's 34-point loss to UCLA was the largest margin of defeat in a season opener since 2012 at USC (49-10) and its 269 yards of offense was its least in a season opener since 2013 (231 yards vs USC).

► UH's first win at its new home the Clarence T.C. Ching Complex was against Portland State which coincidentally was its first win at its old home, Aloha Stadium.

► UH's win over Portland State was its 18th consecutive over a FCS opponent dating back to the 2001 season. The average margin of wins in those games have been 27.7 points.

► UH won its seventh consecutive home-opener dating back to 2015.

► A total of 16 members of the 2021 team currently hold bachelor degrees.

## OFFENSE NOTES

## ALL-EVERYTHING

► Jacksonville transfer Calvin Turner, Jr. is the team's most versatile athlete and this season has lined up at slot receiver, running back, wildcat quarterback, and returner on kickoffs and punts.

► Turner's first touchdown of the year, a circuitous 34-yard run in the first quarter against Portland State, ranked first on ESPN's Top 10 college football plays of the week.

► His highlight reel 14-yard scoring run against New Mexico State, in which we reversed field 20 yards on a jet sweep and eluded numerous would-be tacklers, ranked No. 3 in ESPN's Top Plays.

► Against Oregon State, Turner finished with seven catches for 106 yards for his second career 100-yard receiving game and scored three TDs (2 rushing, 1 receiving), marking the fourth multi-TD game of his UH career and the second time he scored three TDs in a game (also vs. Boise State).

► The senior has scored at least one touchdown in 12 of 16 games played at UH.

► Leads the team in receptions (39), touchdowns (8), and all-purpose yards (864) and is second in receiving yards (484).

## ALL DAE (DAE)

► Running back Dae Dae Hunter has been a big part of the UH offense this season as the team's

leading rusher (558 yards, 78 carries) and third-leading receiver (16 rec., 144 yards).

► In last week's loss to Nevada, Hunter had scoring runs of 75-yards and 81-yards and totaled 174 yards on eight carries in the first half before leaving the game due to injury.

► The Denver, Colo., native also eclipsed 100-yards twice at home this season, rushing 16 times for 128 yards and one TD against Portland State and a career-high 21 rushes for 127 yards against Fresno State.

► Career-high 83 yards receiving against Oregon State, which included three catches of 20+ yards, and career-high seven receptions at UCLA.

► Has four catches of 20+ yards on the season including a career long 30-yard reception against San Jose State.

## TEXAS GUNSLINGER

► With starter Chevan Cordeiro nursing an injury, true freshman quarterback Brayden Schager has started the last two games.

► In his starting debut, the Dallas, Texas native finished 11-of-27 for 116 yards and two TDs in UH's upset victory over nationally ranked Fresno State.

► Schager became the fifth straight UH quarterback to win in his starting debut and the second straight freshman (Chevan Cordeiro) to do so.

► Also started last week's road game at Nevada and had a career-high 205 yards on 22-of-39 passing despite throwing four interceptions.

## CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

► As he did all last year in his first full season as the team's starting quarterback, Chevan Cordeiro has displayed a strong arm and quick feet.

► The Honolulu native has thrown for 1,410 yards and seven touchdowns this season and eclipsed 300-yards in a game twice — 366 at Oregon State and 305 versus Portland State.

► Cordeiro now has 4,784 career passing yards, which ranks 10th all-time in school history and 5,720 career total offense yards, which ranks No. 9 all-time.

► Cordeiro missed the team's last two games due to injury which snapped a string of 14 straight starts.

► Last season he finished with 483 rushing yards and was the first UH quarterback to lead the team in rushing since Michael Carter in 1991 (1,092 yards). This season he has 195 yards rushing which ranks third on the team.

► Eclipsed 200+ passing in 12 of 14 games since the start of 2020.

## IN THE NICK OF TIME

► Junior wideout Nick Mardner has become the team's deep ball threat.

► The junior leads the team with 502 receiving yards and his 20.1 yards per reception leads all Mountain West receivers and ranks 13th nationally.

► The Mississauga, Ontario native has led the team in receiving yards in four games this season including a pair of 100-yard outings.

► Had 120 yards and a TD on four catches against

► QB **Chevan Cordeiro**, who backed-up former Alabama and current Miami Dolphins QB Tua Tagovailoa at Honolulu's Saint Louis School, continues the school's tradition of FBS QBs which includes Heisman Trophy winner Marcus Mariota.

► As a youngster, OL **Gene Pryor** was an extra in Eddie Murphy's "Daddy Day Care," and appeared in commercials for ice cream and "Barney & Friends."

► WR **Jared Smart**'s father Keith is famously known for hitting the game-winning shot in the 1987 NCAA Championship game.

► OL **Micah Vanterpool** has a YouTube channel "The Big Mik Show" with over 500 subscribers and over 40 videos.

► QB **Brayden Schager** and his family founded the HP Buddy Bowl, an annual football event in Texas for special-needs youth. As a 10-year-old, he had the top bracket out of 8.5 million entries in ESPN's 2013 NCAA Tournament basketball pool.

► TE **Hekili Keliiliki**, who is of Hawaiian descent, went to high school in Arkansas and is fluent in Mandarin after serving a two-year mission in Brisbane, Australia. He is UH's nominee for the Wuerffel Trophy. Keliiliki is a double major in biology and Chinese; is an Eagle Scout; and serves on the school's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee.

► QB **Kamali'i Akina**'s father Duane is a 40-year veteran coach who served as an assistant at UH (1983-85) and currently coaches at Stanford. "Kama" played for Todd Graham at Arizona State, where he redshirted in 2016.

► RB **Dior Scott** was prominently featured in Netflix's hit series "Last Chance U" which chronicled the 2019 season of Laney College in Oakland, Calif. Scott and senior WR **Jared Smart** were teammates on the 2018 squad that captured the CCCAA Championship.

► DB **Noa Kamana** comes from a football-playing family as his father Carter (Michigan State), brother Tim (Wyoming), grandfather John (USC), and uncle John Jr. (USC) all played collegiate football.

► Navy transfer DL **Alema Kapoi**'s cousin is UFC champion Max Holloway. In addition, his brother Micah played football at Wisconsin and mother Patti (Sua) played softball at UH and was the 1991 Jack Bonham Award recipient.

► DB **Cameron Lockridge** is the grandson of baseball great Ken Griffey Sr. and nephew of Hall of Fame outfielder Ken Griffey Jr.

► LB **George Hooker**, currently a member of the Hawai'i National Guard, won the U23 National Championship in Greco-Roman wrestling in 2020 while attending Northern Michigan University. He last played football in high school in Nashville, Tenn.

► WR **Tru Edwards** is the son of NFL player and Biletnikoff winner Troy Edwards.

► WR **Grey Ihu** is named after Earl Grey tea, a favorite of his mom's.

► LB **Riley Wilson**'s father played for the legendary Ohio State coach Woody Hayes.

► WR **Jonah Panoke** has three children.

New Mexico State, including a career-long 74-yard reception, and had 110 yards on six catches and a TD against Oregon State.

**O-LINE EXPERIENCE**

► The offensive line boasts 142 combined starts between five different players.

► Ilm Manning and Gene Pryor anchor the all-important tackle positions. Manning has started 41 of 43 career games and earned all-Mountain West second-team honors in 2019. Pryor meanwhile has been a stalwart at right tackle, starting all but two games since 2019 with 29 career starts.

► Solo Vaipulu enters his fourth year with the program with the second-most career starts (35). He has been a mainstay at guard since entering the program in 2018 however he missed the last four games due to injury.

► Kohl Levao, who missed virtually all of the last two seasons, has started 26 games at center, guard and tackle and is one of the team's top pro prospects.

**OTHER OFFENSE NOTES**

► UH had two players go over 100 yards receiving against Oregon State — Nick Mardner (110) and Calvin Turner, Jr. (106) — a first since the 2019 Hawai'i Bowl.

► UH has had 10 or more receivers catch a ball in a single game twice this season — 11 at Nevada and 10 at UCLA.

► Jonah Panoke made his first appearance of the season against San Jose State and recorded three catches for 27 yards.

► Newcomer Dedrick Parson scored a pair of touchdowns in UH's win over Portland State while Aaron Cephus scored his first career touchdown as a Rainbow Warrior also in that game.

► Stanford transfer tight end Caleb Phillips scored UH's first touchdown of the 2021 season on a 1-yard catch from Chevan Cordeiro against UCLA.

**DEFENSE NOTES****BALL HOGS**

► UH is tied with Boise State for the Mountain West lead and tied for third nationally in takeaways with 16 turnovers forced. Iowa is the nation's leader with 20.

► UH and Boise State are also tied for the conference lead in interceptions (8) while UH, BSU, and Fresno State are tied for the lead in fumbles recovered (8).

► UH's six turnovers forced against Fresno State were the most in a game since 2011.

► UH has forced multiple turnovers in four of seven games this year.

**LEADER OF THE PACK**

► No one can question the productivity of Khoury Bethley who has been a mainstay in the defensive line-up throughout his career.

► The Chino, Calif., native has accumulated 244 tackles, 16.0 tackles-for-loss, six sacks, four interceptions, four forced fumbles, and 20 passes defended in 45 career games.

► Bethley had perhaps his best career performance in UH's upset win over Fresno State with nine tackles, two interceptions, one forced fumble that earned him two national player of the week awards (Nagurski and Jim Thorpe) and Mountain West Defensive Player of the Week honors.

► The senior posted a pair of strip sack fumbles in back-to-back weeks against New Mexico State and Fresno State, the latter led to UH's game-winning field goal.

► Leads or tied for the team lead in tackles (51), forced fumbles (3), and interceptions (2).

► Shined in UH's last two bowl wins with single-game highs in tackles (14), tackles-for-loss (3) and sacks (2) against Houston in last season's New Mexico Bowl win over Houston and picked off two passes against BYU in the 2019 Hawai'i Bowl that later earned him AP All-Bowl team honors.

**A TACKLING MACHINE**

► Darius Muasau, a preseason All-Mountain West first team selection, was named to the watch lists for both the Bronko Nagurski and Chuck Bednarik awards which are presented to the nation's top defensive player.

► The Mililani, O'ahu native ranks second on the team in tackles with 46 and also has 5.0 tackles-for-loss, 3.0 sacks, two pass break-ups, one forced fumble, and three quarterback hurries.

► Has three games this season with 10+ tackles against New Mexico State (11), UCLA (11), and Nevada (10).

► Last season Muasau led all of FBS with 68 solo tackles and ranked seventh with 104 total tackles. Ranked fifth nationally in tackles per game (11.8) while also leading the team in team in tackles-for-loss (9.5) sacks (4.5), and quarterback hurries (7).

**CORTEZ ISLAND**

► Cornerback Cortez Davis enters his third season with the Warriors and is among the nation's leaders in passes defended.

► After earning all-conference accolades in each of his first two years, the senior is on pace for another with a team-leading 10 pass break-ups along with one interception.

► Davis is second in the Mountain West and tied for fourth nationally with an average of 1.6 passes defended per game.

► The native of Decatur, Ga., has started 28 of 30 career games and is on the watch list for the Jim Thorpe Award, which annually recognizes college football's outstanding defensive back.

► Intercepted his first pass of the season and the second of his career with a second-quarter pick of Fresno State's Jake Haener.

**WELCOME BACK CAP'**

► Safety Eugene Ford, who suffered a season-ending injury in UH's loss to Wyoming last season, is one of the team's top defenders this year.

► Playing both the SPUR and safety positions, the Venice, Calif., native is tied for fourth on the team with 33 tackles along with one forced fumble.

► Ford had started 33 games since his freshman campaign and entered last season as one of four team captains.

## OTHER DEFENSE NOTES

► The Warriors recorded season-highs in sacks (4) and tackles-for-loss (8) in a road win at New Mexico State.

► Hugh Nelson II, who started for an injured Cameron Lockridge against Fresno State, sealed the game with an interception – his second of the season – on the Bulldogs' final possession.

► UH scored a defensive touchdown for the first time under Todd Graham against New Mexico State when Quentin Frazier deflected a backward pass, which was recovered by Cameron Lockridge for a 5-yard return in the second quarter. It was UH's first fumble recovery for a TD in four years (last by Solomon Matautia vs BYU in 2017).

## SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

## ROCKET SHIP

► Matthew Shipley has excelled at handling both placekicking and punting duties this season.

► The Liberty Hill, Texas native has converted seven consecutive field goal attempts since his only miss (48-yarder vs. San Jose State) and is 8-of-9 on the year.

► Booted the game-winning 33-yard field goal against Fresno State and set a career-long 48-yarder in the season-opener at UCLA.

► In his first year as the primary punter, the sophomore is averaging 42.0 yards per punt with a long of 53. Also has four 50+-yard punts and pinned eight inside the 20.

## BIG LEG

► Freshman Kyler Halvorsen has been the primary kickoff specialist this season and has 17 touchbacks in 35 kickoffs.

► Of his 35 kickoffs, 17 were touchbacks, five were fair-caught, two went out of bounds, and 11 were returned for a 21.5 average.

## QUICK SNAP

► Senior long snapper Wyatt Tucker has been a mainstay on special teams or the Warriors, having started all 31 games played.

► The Chino Hills, Calif., did not record a "bad" snap through his first two UH seasons until a low snap against UCLA caused punter Matthew Shipley to inadvertently take a knee.

## OTHER SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

► After going a nation-leading 154 straight games without a blocked punt, UH allowed three blocked punts this season.

► UCLA returned its blocked punt for a touchdown, marking the first time since 2004, UH allowed an opponent to do so.

## BOUNCEBACK KIDS

► Eight transfers, including seven from Power 5 programs, joined the Warriors in 2021 – Chima Azunna (Iowa State), Keola Dowling (Boise State), Zacchaeus McKinney (Oklahoma), Hugh Nelson (Georgia), Caleb Phillips (Stanford), Pita Tonga (Utah), Solo Turner (Baylor), Kolby Wyatt (Georgia)

► Other FBS transfers already on the roster include Kamali'i Akina (Arizona State), Aaron Cephus (Rice), Alema Kapoi (Navy), Adam Stack (Oregon), and Isaiah Tufaga (Oregon State).

► Six players competed at FCS programs prior to UH – Colby Burton (McNeese State), Cortez Davis (Chattanooga), Austin Hopp (Western Illinois), Dedrick Parson (Howard), Eliki Tanuvasa (Eastern Illinois), and Calvin Turner, Jr. (Jacksonville).

## TEXAS PIPELINE

► A total of 15 players, including 10 newcomers, hail from The Lone Star state.

► Only Hawai'i (41) and California (24) have more players on the 2021 roster.

## ALL IN THE FAMILY

► Two of head coach Todd Graham's three sons are on the roster – Bo (offensive coordinator) and Michael (freshman DB). UH is one of nine schools in FBS with a father coaching his son on the team.

► The 2021 squad features two second-generation Warriors – Landon Sims (Travis, 1989-92); and Harvey Welch (Gerald, 2000-04).

► UH also has two sets of brothers on its roster – Darius and Sergio Muasau and Blessman and Maurice Ta'ala.

► Four others have older brothers who once suited up for UH – Kamali'i Akina (Kainoa), Andrew Choi (Zeno), Kamuela Borden (brothers Kawika & Noah), and Justus Tavai (Jahlani). Borden's sister Anika also competed for UH's track and field team.

## DIVERSITY U

► The Warriors own one the most diverse squads in the country. UH has players from 16 different states, encompassing five time zones (Hawaiian, Pacific, Mountain, Central and Eastern).

► More than half of the 111-man roster hails from Hawai'i (41) and California (24). UH also has players from American Samoa (6) and Canada (1).

## THE (SAINT LOUIS) BROTHERHOOD

► No less than a dozen players on the roster are products of Honolulu prep football powerhouse Saint Louis School.

► Quarterback Chevan Cordeiro continues the school's tradition of quarterbacks which includes Marcus Mariota (Oregon), Jeremiah Masoli (Oregon/Ole Miss), Timmy Chang (UH), Jason Gesser (Washington State), and Darnell Arceneaux (Utah). Current Washington State QB Jayden DeLaura is also a Saint Louis alum.

► Linebackers coach Jacob Yoro also prepped at Saint Louis.

► Three former Warriors are currently on NFL 53-man rosters – P Rigoberto Sanchez (Indianapolis), WR Marcus Kemp (Kansas City), and LB Jahlani Tavai (New England).

► Three others are on practice squads – WR Rico Bussey (Pittsburgh), CB Rojesterman Farris (Denver), and S Trayvon Henderson (Cincinnati).

► WR John Ursua (Seattle) is on Reserve/Injured list while WR Keith Kirkwood (Carolina) began his career at UH before transferring to Temple.

- Formally introduced as Hawai'i's 24th head coach on January 22, 2020 and guided UH to a bowl game in his inaugural season.
- Has 13 years of head coaching experience at the FBS level with five different programs — Rice, Tulsa, Pittsburgh, Arizona State, and Hawai'i.

- Currently ranks No. 23 for most wins among active FBS coaches with 103 career victories.
- Led 11 of his 13 teams to bowl eligibility and coached in 10 all-time bowl games with a 6-4 record.
- Won his 100th career game in Hawai'i's 28-14 victory over Houston in the New Mexico Bowl.
- Twelve of his former assistant coaches went on to head coaching positions. Eight are current head coaches including Gus Malzahn (Auburn), Mike Norvell (Florida State), Jay Norvell (Nevada), Billy Napier (Louisiana), Chris Ball (Northern Arizona), Chip Lindsey (Troy), Jake Spavital (Texas State), and Ryan Silverfield (Memphis).
- Three of his teams finished nationally ranked, including a No. 12 ranking by Arizona State in 2014.
- Won four conference divisional titles.
- Named conference Coach of the Year twice.
- Won 10 or more games in five seasons.
- His Tulsa teams led the nation in total offense in consecutive years in 2007 (543.9 ypg) and 2008 (569.9) and coached the only team in NCAA history to boast a 5,000-yard passer, 1,000-yard rusher, and three 1,000-yard receivers in a single season (Tulsa, 2007).

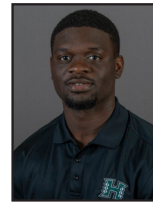

## COACHES NOTES

- Four former Warriors are on the coaching staff this year: Defensive line coach **Victor Santa Cruz** (1991-94), running backs coach **Abe Elimimian** (2001-04), cornerbacks coach **Kim McCloud** (1987-90), and graduate assistant **Jordan Pu'u-Robinson** (2012-14).
- Santa Cruz** played linebacker for the 1992 squad that captured a WAC title and defeated Illinois in the Holiday Bowl. He is Division II Azusa Pacific's all-time winningest coach with an overall record of 84-69 in 14 seasons.
- Elimimian** enters his seventh season on the staff after a playing career that saw him earn first-team all-conference honors at cornerback and play in three bowl games. His younger brother Solomon (2005-08) is UH's all-time tackles leader and retired CFL linebacker, who was the league's Most Outstanding Player in 2014. After a career of coaching on the defensive side of the ball, Elimimian moves to running backs coach this year.
- McCloud** is in his first season as cornerbacks coach after serving under former Rainbow Warrior turned head coach Dino Babers at Syracuse. McCloud four-year career (1987-90) as a Warrior defensive back included a trip to the 1989 Aloha Bowl.
- Thirteen-year coaching veteran **Trent Figg** returns to the field as not only the defensive backs coach, but also the associate head coach for the defense. In his first year at UH in 2020, Figg served as the program's Chief of Staff.
- Linebackers coach **Jacob Yoro**, who joined the program in 2017, is the lone Hawai'i native on the coaching staff. Yoro prepped at powerhouse Saint Louis School under legendary coach and former UH assistant Cal Lee.
- Offensive coordinator **Bo Graham** is head coach Todd Graham's eldest son. The younger Graham, who coached with his father at Rice, Tulsa, Pittsburgh, and Arizona State, takes over the reigns of the offense this season as well as quarterbacks coach.
- Sam Bennett** is the son of long-time collegiate coach Phil Bennett, who was once SMU's head coach. Bennett switched over to offensive tackles and tight ends coach this season after overseeing the offensive line last year.
- Marcus Davis**, who was a four-year receiver at Auburn, begins his first season at UH as the receivers coach. The Florida native competed in four bowl games, including as a starter in the 2014 BCS National Championship game.
- Former Wake Forest lineman **A'Lique Terry** begins his first season as offensive line coach. He previously worked at his alma mater and most recently at Oregon and has coached more than a half dozen players who have gone on to the NFL.

#### GAME NOTES

- The Bruins jumped all over UH from the start and never looked back in handing UH its first season-opening loss since 2016.
- UCLA scored the first 17 points of the game, took a 24-3 lead after one quarter of action, and continued to put points on the board in the second half while getting contributions from all three phases of the game.
- UH was stung by UCLA's big-play ground game early on as Zach Charbonnet rushed for 106 yards and three touchdowns in his first six carries.
- All three of Charbonnet's touchdown came on runs of 20 or more yards, including a 47-yard dash.
- UH had its first punt blocked since 2008 against Notre Dame, ending the longest streak in the nation without a blocked punt at 154 games.
- UCLA returned a blocked punt for a touchdown in the third quarter, marking the first time since 2004 (Northwestern), UH has allowed an opponent to do so.
- Matthew Shipley set a new career long when he nailed a 48-yard field goal in the first quarter to put UH on the board.
- Tight end Caleb Phillips scored UH's first touchdown of the season and the first of his Rainbow Warrior on a 1-yard catch for UH's lone touchdown of the game.
- UH has dropped 18 of its last 19 non-conference road games.

- Hawai'i ushered in a new era in emphatic fashion with a 49-35 win over Portland State in its 2021 home opener.
- Playing its first-ever on-campus game at the Clarence T.C. Ching Complex, UH raced out to 28-0 first-quarter lead and never looked back.
- UH scored on its first four possessions of the game and produced up a multitude of explosive plays with 11 plays of 20+ yards.

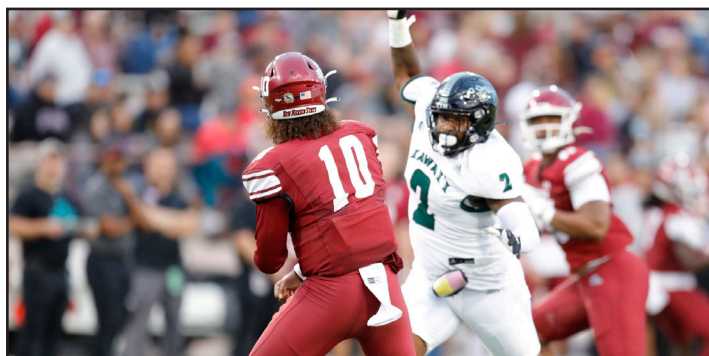

- ▶ The former Western Athletic Conference rivals met for the first time in 10 years with UH continuing its domination of the Aggies.
- ▶ The Warriors remain undefeated in nine all-time meetings against New Mexico State with four of those wins coming in Las Cruces.
- ▶ The win was just UH's second against a non-conference opponent on the road in its last 21 tries, spanning back to 2010.

- ▶ UH scored 17 unanswered points in the fourth quarter for a thrilling comeback win.
- ▶ UH ended a six-game home losing streak to the Bulldogs with its first win over Fresno State in Honolulu since 2007.
- ▶ The Warriors snapped a 13-game losing streaking against nationally ranked teams that stretched over a decade. UH's last such win came in 2010 vs. No. 19 Nevada.

- ▶ The Wolf Pack scored 17 unanswered points in a nine-minute stretch bridging the second and third quarters to break open a deadlocked game and defeat the Rainbow Warriors for the first time since 2018.
- ▶ UH was ultimately undone by five turnovers and a pair of special teams miscues that led to 24 Nevada points.
- ▶ Dae Dae Hunter racked up 174 rushing yards in the first half alone with scoring runs of 75 and 81 yards. The 75 yard run was on UH's first play from scrimmage.
- ▶ Hunter's 81 yard run gave the Warriors a 14-10 lead in the second quarter. It was the longest UH run since 2015.
- ▶ The Warriors muffed a punt and had another punt blocked, leading to 10 Wolf Pack points in the first half.
- ▶ The Wolf Pack capitalized on two UH interceptions to score a pair of third-quarter touchdowns and take a 34-17 lead going into the fourth quarter.
- ▶ Freshman Brayden Schager made his first career start on the road for UH and finished 22-of-39 for 205 yards and four interceptions.
- ▶ Matthew Shipley hit his seventh straight field goal when he nailed a 28-yarder in the second quarter. Shipley is 8-of-9 on field goals this season.
