- The Rainbow Wahine have been on hiatus since a 72-50 loss on the road at UC Santa Barbara on Feb. 13. The 'Bows were scheduled to play last week at home against CSUN, but the Matadors opted out of the season due to COVID-19 concerns back in November 2020.
- UH currently sits at No. 6 in the Big West Conference standings, while LBSU comes in at No. 3. In some manner, the 'Bows still control their destiny and could climb as high as No. 4 by the season's end. On the flip side, UH could drop as low as No. 8.
- Sophomore Kasey Neubert has emerged as a stable threat for the 'Bows since cracking the starting lineup on Jan. 22 against Cal State Fullerton. Neubert has started seven consecutive games, averaging 8.5 points and 7.9 rebounds a game. She sits atop the conference in field goal percentage at 53.2% and is currently No. 5 in rebounds per game.
- Defense and rebounding have been two calling cards for UH in terms of facing Big West opponents. The 'Bows are allowing opponents to shoot 29% from three-point territory and 38% from the field, ranking them at No. 3 and No. 4 in those categories. UH also sits in the top three of rebounding margin per game at plus two.
- Freshman Daejah Phillips started off the season strong, scoring double figures in her first three games, averaging 14 points per game. In the next five games, teams adjusted to her attacking style, and Phillips struggled, averaging just four points per game. Her recent stretch has been much improved at 16 points per game over three games.
- The matchup between the 'Bows and the Beach is about as evenly split as it can get, with UH having a slight edge at 21-20 in the all-time series. Throughout the last four seasons, the two teams have split their yearly series, with each team winning at home all four years. The last time UH won at Walter Pyramid was on Jan. 7, 2016. The 2015-16 campaign also marks the last time either team swept a season series.

2020-21 Rainbow Wahine Basketball Quick Facts

MAKE IT RAIN

Over the past three seasons, the UH offensive attack has been known for shooting the three and setting new records from long distance. During the 2019-20 season, UH set the record for the most made three-pointers in a game at 18 on Jan. 18, 2020, against Cal State Fullerton. For the 2020-21 campaign against Cal Poly on Feb. 5, the 'Bows shot an astounding 41 three-pointers for a new program record on attempts, hitting 15 in the process.

NO THREES FOR YOU!!

The defensive performance by UH against Cal State Fullerton was impressive, holding the Titans to a total of 90 points over two games. But one big reason for the success was how UH protected the perimeter. Using a combination of different looks with their defensive scheme, the 'Bows held the Titans scoreless from three-point land as they went 0-for-10. The last time UH held a team without a three-point bucket was on Jan. 26th, 2019, against UC Santa Barbara, as the Gauchos went 0-for-16, scoring just 35 points.

DON'T GIVE HER SPACE

Amy Atwell is well known for her sharpshooter mentality as she entered play for the 2020-2021 season, ranked No. 3 in the nation for three-point shooting at 45.3%. So far this season, she is hitting 31% from long distance.

MAKE YOUR MARK

Entering the series with UC Santa Barbara, Atwell has hit 115 three-pointers, recently passing Melanie Azama (1991-94) for No. 9 overall in program history. Next up on the list is a three-way tie between Jade Abele (2002-05), Kylie Galloway (1998, 2000-01), and Janevia Taylor (2004-07) to move up to No. 6 overall at 117.

2020-2021 HAS BEEN TOUGH

Early on in the season the 'Bows were hit with multiple harmful blows. Sophomore point guard Nae

Nae Calhoun and junior center Channel Noah have been lost with knee injuries, while freshman guard Teionni McDaniel elected to opt-out for the season.

LOOKING FOR THE THREE BALL

Over the years, the' Bows' fans and followers have come a custom to the three-ball and it being a valuable tool for the offensive scheme. Throughout the season UH has struggled from long range shooting 29% from beyond the arc. UH has shot north of 30% from long distance over the last two years, dipping to 28% during the 2017-18 season. But its not the end all be all as UH shot 27% from deep during the 2014-15 campaign and the 'Bows won 23 games.

RETURN OF THE BIG WEST HONOREES

At the end of the 2019-20 campaign, the Big West Conference released its end of the year awards, and three of the four were named to return to UH in 2020-2021. Senior forward Amy Atwell returns as the reigning Sixth Man of the Year and honorable mention selection from last season and the 'Bows top returning scorer at 10.6 points per game. Senior Jadynn Alexander was named to the All-Defensive squad and will continue her role as the 'Bows top defender. Sophomore point guard Nae Nae Calhoun will build off her impressive freshman season where she was picked to the All-Freshman team.

LOCAL CONNECTION

Every fan wants more of their home state represented on their favorite team, and Hawai'i isn't any different. Of the nine newcomers, three hail from Aloha State, including junior transfer Dakota Viena and the freshmen pair of Kelsie Imai and Kylie Yung.

MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICAN NOMINEES

Last season coach Beeman and staff signed four incoming freshmen who were nominated as McDonald's All-Americans. For the 2021 signing class, Beeman and company can add another as guard Trinity Slocum a signee from Meridian, Idaho was recently nomianted.

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

Before starting the season, head coach Laura Beeman and the Rainbow Wahine program received national attention for being featured by Sports Illustrated. Writer Michael Rosenberg explained the difficulties both the men's and women's teams face at UH in terms of having a season. Both Beeman and men's basketball head coach Eran Ganot was interviewed for the piece, documenting how much they want to compete but understand times are tough in dealing with COVID-19. Rosenberg lays out how both programs are in a state where precautions have kept the virus in check, but because of the location and other states struggling, scheduling opponents have been tough.

The 2020-21 season marks head coach Laura Beeman's ninth at the helm of the 2016 Big West Tournament champion Rainbow Wahine basketball team. She and her staff have revitalized the Hawai'i program, leading the Rainbow Wahine to their first conference title since 1997-98 with the 2015 Big West regular season championship, and the program's first NCAA Tournament berth since 1998 following its 2016 Big West Tournament championship. Before reaching the 2016 NCAA Tournament, Hawai'i advanced to the Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT) in three-straight years from 2013-15.

In her eighth season at Hawai¹⁷, Beeman begins the year with a 133-125 (.515) overall record and a 80-50 (.615) mark in the Big West

UH and Beeman returned to national postseason play in 2019. The 'Bows rode the momentum of a late season surge to the Big West Tournament Championship game, securing a spot in the WNIT. It was the fifth time in her seven seasons Beeman has lead UH to a national postseason tournament.

After leading Hawai'i to three consecutive WNIT appearances in her first three seasons on the job, Beeman guided UH to the Big Dance in 2016 by way of a Big West Tournament championship. The Rainbow Wahine earned the No. 2 seed in the Big West Tournament and knocked off both Long Beach State (semifinals) and UC Davis (championship game) by double-figures to take home the program's first conference tournament championship in two decades. Hawai'i earned a No. 14 seed in the 2016 NCAA Tournament and fell to No. 3 seed and No. 10 ranked UCLA.

To date, while at UH, Beeman has coached 17 All-Big West Selections (First Team-5; Second Team -6; Honorable Mention-5); four Big West "Sixth Player of the Year" awardees; one BWC "Defensive Player of the Year"; and four BWC All-Freshman Team players.

Tia Kanoa headlined a squad featuring four all-conference selections at the end of the 2018-19 season. Kanoa was named to the second time, as Leah Salanoa and Courtney Middap were named as honorable mentions. Myrrah Joseph rounded out the selections as she was named to the All-Freshmen team.

Sarah Toeaina brought first-team all-Big West honors to Hawai'i for the fourth consecutive year in 2017-18, earning the recognition after averaging 16.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game with a 45.3 field goal percentage.

In 2015-16, senior Destiny King earned first-team all-Big West honors, sophomore Megan Huff took home second-team All-Big West and Big West Sixth Player of the Year honors, and senior Ashleigh Karaitiana also earned second-team All-Big West honors.

Beeman—the 2015 Big West Coach of the Year—guided the 'Bows to a Big West-best 14-2 conference record and 23-9 overall mark in 2014-15. The 'Bows opened the conference season with a pair of road losses, but went on to reel off 15-straight wins en route to capturing the regular season crown and a spot in their third consecutive WNIT tourney. The win streak was UH's longest since 1997-98 when Hawai'i won 19-straight under former head coach Vince Goo. Overall, UH's 2014-15 overall record was the best since the 'Bows recorded a 23-8 overall record in 2001-02. Beeman and her crew also posted UH's best conference record since 1997-98 when the Rainbow Wahine went 13-1 in the Western Athletic Conference.

Beeman's consistent trademark has been defense and rebounding. The 2015-16 season marked the second straight that UH led the Big West in the majority of the defense and rebounding statistics, including field-goal percentage defense, a-point field-goal percentage defense, rebounding, rebounding margin, offensive rebounds, and defensive rebounds.

One of the passions of Coach Beeman, her staff and her players has been getting involved in multiple service opportunities to give back to the local communities. The coaches and players have conducted free basketball clinics to youth on the North Shore and have spent hours helping at Waikiki Health's Youth Outreach (YO!) program working with local at-risk and homeless youths. The team also sponsored a "YO!" Sneaker Drive at one of their games last season. The Rainbow Wahine have participated in the American Cancer Society's "Relay for Life", Spe-

cial Olympics, and have participated in several elementary school reading programs.

In her first season (2012-13), Beeman deftly guided her team through a difficult pre-season slate—which included the likes of Baylor, Stanford, Arkansas, and Oklahoma. The wicked schedule prepared the 'Bows in their return to the Big West Conference after 16 years in the Western Athletic Conference, Hawai'i posted a 17-14 overall record—the first winning season in seven years. The 'Bows battled hard in the BWC and finished in a tie for second in the conference with a 13-5 mark. UH closed the season strong—winning six of its last seven regular season games. Hawai'i went 8-1 in conference home games and tallied its best conference record since 2001-02. The Rainbow Wahine were able to defeat all of their conference opponents at least once with series sweeps over UC Riverside, Long Beach State, UC Davis, and CSU Northridge. The 'Bows advanced to the post-season for the first time in 10 years and for the 12th time in school history. Hawai'i players garnered six Big West honors, led by junior post-player Kamilah Jackson who became the first Rainbow Wahine to earn first team conference honors since 1995-96. Junior guard/forward Shawna-Lei Kuehu was voted "Sixth Player of the Year" and was an Honorable Mention conference player. Junior guard Sydney Haydel earned "Defensive Player of the Year" and rookie guard Ashleigh Karaitiana was named to the All-Freshman team as well as honorable mention honors.

In her second season (2013-14), Beeman and her 'Bows posted a 17-14 overall record with a 10-6 conference record good for third place and another post-season appearance. The Rainbow Wahine once again had to navigate a challenging non-conference schedule, notching wins over Washington State, Ole Miss, Chattanooga and Minnesota. Jackson became just the second player in Rainbow Wahine history to lead the team in points and rebounds all four seasons of her career—even while missing seven games down the stretch of the Big West season. But in her absence, Hawaiï banded together to continue to out-rebound their opponents 276-to-219 while Jackson was out—including a 19-rebound advantage in their win over UC Davis. UH finished first in the Big West in scoring defense, allowing just 62.8 points per game; first in 3-point field goal defense (288); rebounding defense (35.1); rebounding margin overall (+6.0) and defensive rebounding percentage (7725).

Beeman was formally introduced as the new head women's basketball coach at Hawai'i at a press conference on March 23, 2012 at Les Murakami Stadium. She came to UH with nearly 20 years of coaching experience on the both the collegiate and professional level. The San Bernardino, Calif., native established herself as one of the best junior college coaches in the nation before enjoying similar success as an assistant coach at USC and with the WNBA's Los Angeles Sparks. Beeman, 45, is the eighth head coach since the program's inception in 1974 and the third female head coach in its history.

Beeman spent her final two seasons prior to Hawai'i at USC as associate head coach under Michael Cooper where they re-established the Women of Troy as a PAC-12 power. There she helped quickly revitalize the program with 42 combined wins in the last two years. In her first season, the team finished 24-13 and advanced to the WNIT Championship game. The team ultimately finished with the program's best record in 17 years.

ultimately finished with the program's best record in 17 years.

The Women of Troy garnered an 18-win season and third-place finish in the Pac-12 in 2011-12, Beeman's final campaign at USC, including a six-game win streak to finish the regular season. In just two years, Beeman coached nearly a half dozen all-conference players, while also helping put together back-to-back nationally ranked recruiting classes.

Beeman and Cooper had previously worked together for the WNBA's Los Angeles Sparks in 2008. As an assistant under Cooper that season, she helped lead the Sparks to the Western Conference Finals after a one-year absence from the post-season. While with the Sparks, Beeman coached the No. 1 pick Candace Parker along with veteran All-Stars Lisa Leslie and DeLisha Milton-Jones.

Prior to her stint with the Trojans, Beeman made her mark at the junior college level where she enjoyed a phenomenally successful 15-year run as the head coach at Mt. San Antonio College (Mt. SAC). There she led the Mounties to 10 conference championships and four California Community College State Championships—including a string of three straight from 2006-08. Beeman was selected conference Coach of the Year four times and was voted the district and regional coach of the year in 2001. She led Mt. SAC to a school-best 37-1 record in both the 2007 and 2008 season. During her tenure with the Mounties, she produced 80 all-conference selections, 24 all-state selections, and 10 all-region selections. Beeman posted a 390-110 (.780) record during her tenure at Mt. SAC.

As a player, Beeman was an All-American guard at Cal State San Bernardino where she set the career, season and game assist records. She graduated in 1992 with a degree in business administration from CS San Bernardino and later earned a master's degree in education with an emphasis on counseling from the University of Redlands. She earned a second master's degree in education with an emphasis in physical education from
