**THE GAME:** The 50th season of Stanford women's basketball begins on Wednesday, Nov. 8 when the No. 15 Cardinal hosts Hawai'i at 7 p.m. Ben Ross and Joaquin Wallace have the call on GoStanford.com's live stream and Tim Swartz will handle the radio broadcast on GoStanford.com and the Varsity Network.

**THE RUNDOWN:** Already the winningest coach in women's college basketball history (1,186), Tara VanDerveer enters the season 17 victories away from breaking Mike Krzyzewski's record (1,202) to become the winningest coach in college basketball history (men's or women's) ... Stanford returns 58.5 percent of its minutes played, 58.7 percent of its points, 44.3 percent of its rebounds and 54.5 percent of its assists from 2022-23 ... The Cardinal is 37-12 all-time in season openers and has won 24 home openers in a row ... Stanford is in the preseason AP poll for the 24th consecutive season and at No. 15 is one of a national-best six Pac-12 teams in the rankings ... The Cardinal has been in the top 15 in every poll since March 5, 2018, a stretch of 98 in a row and the second-best active streak in the nation (UConn - 354) ... Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Stanford has held 85 of its last 104 opponents to under 40.0 percent shooting and is 76-9 in those games ... The Cardinal is 92-12 (.885) over the past three seasons, second in the country in wins and third in winning percentage ... Cameron Brink, the team's leading returning scorer and rebounder, is a preseason AP All-American and on watch lists for the Naismith Trophy, Wade Trophy and Lisa Leslie Award ... Second among active players in career 3-point percentage (.421), Hannah Jump is on the watch list for the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award.

**VS. HAWAII:** Stanford is 11-0 all-time against the Rainbow Wahine and is facing Hawai'i outside of Honolulu for the first time since a 106-76 win in Maples Pavilion on March 18, 1990, an NCAA Tournament win on the way to the Cardinal's first national title. Tara VanDerveer's first win as head coach at Stanford came against Hawai'i on Nov. 22, 1985, 68-65, at the Anheuser-Busch Classic in San Jose. The Cardinal beat Hawai'i in the Rainbow Wahine Showdown last season on Nov. 27, 68-39, behind 15 points, nine rebounds, five blocks and three steals from Cameron Brink.

**SNAPSHOT »**

- Stanford returns four starters and nine letterwinners to a team that posted a 29-6 overall record a season ago and was regular-season co-champions of the Pac-12 with a 15-3 league mark.
- The Cardinal made its 35th consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022-23, but did not advance out of the opening weekend for the first time since 2007, snapping a streak of 14 consecutive Sweet 16's.
- Stanford has won at least 20 games for 22 straight seasons and has had double-digit Pac-12 victories for 36 consecutive years. Its 22-season streak with 20+ wins is the third-longest active stretch in the nation behind Connecticut (30) and Baylor (23).
- Stanford is ranked No. 15 in the preseason AP poll and has now appeared in those rankings 625 times out of 844 total polls since 1976-77 (74.1 percent), second all-time behind Tennessee (775), with an average positioning of 6.9.
- Stanford has now been ranked in the AP preseason poll 36 times out of a possible 48 such rankings. Of the 36 times it has appeared in the preseason rankings, this is just the seventh time the Cardinal has been slotted outside the top 10, joining 2016-17 (No. 11), 2015-16 (No. 16), 2005-06 (No. 11), 2000-01 (No. 11), 1998-99 (No. 19), 1987-88 (No. 20).
- The last time Stanford was outside the preseason AP top 10 in 2016-17, it won 32 games, made the program's 13th Final Four and won its 12th Pac-12 Tournament championship
- Stanford was picked to finish third in the Pac-12 preseason coaches' poll. The Cardinal totaled 100 points and two first-place votes. Utah was the leading vote getter, receiving seven first-place votes and collecting 116 points, while UCLA was second (109 points, three first-place votes).

**SEASON OPENERS »**

- Stanford is 37-12 all-time in season openers and has won five in a row. The Cardinal's last such loss came at No. 5 Ohio State on Nov. 10, 2017, 85-64.
- The Cardinal has won 24 consecutive home openers. Stanford hasn't dropped its first game of a season in Maples since falling to No. 24 Illinois, 76-58, on Nov. 19, 1998.

**50th SEASON OF STANFORD WOMEN'S BASKETBALL »**

- The 2023-24 season marks the 50th in the history of the Stanford women's basketball program.
- The Cardinal is 1,210-352 (.775) all-time, third in Division I history by wins and fourth by percentage. Tennessee has 1,451 wins in 69 seasons and UConn has 1,271 victories in 49 seasons.
- Not included in NCAA records, Stanford played in the first intercollegiate women's basketball game against rival California on April 4, 1896 at a San Francisco armory on Page Street the day before Easter. The Cardinal won, 2-1.

**TARA AT THE TOP »**

- A five-time national coach of the year (1988, 1989, 1990, 2011, 2021) and 17-time Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Tara VanDerveer, who prior to coming to Stanford served as head coach for a combined seven seasons at Idaho (1978-80) and Ohio State (1980-85), has accumulated a 1,186-265 (.817) record as a collegiate head coach and a 1,034-214 (.829) record at Stanford.
- VanDerveer has more wins to her name than 355 of the NCAA's 360 Division I programs and surpassed Pat Summitt (1,098) as the winningest coach in women's college basketball history on Dec. 15, 2020.
- VanDerveer owns the sixth-highest winning percentage (.817) among Division I women's basketball coaches all-time and her 38 20-win seasons are the most in college basketball history.
- She has accounted for 1,034 of Stanford's 1,210 total victories since its first varsity season in 1975.

**EXHIBITION RECAP »**

- Seven players scored in double figures, Stanford shot better than 46 percent from behind the arc and the No. 15 Cardinal rolled past Dominican in its lone exhibition on Nov. 1, 126-53.
- Elena Bosgana and Kiki Iriafen led the way with 19 apiece, while Bosgana added a game-high four assists and Iriafen pulled down a game-high 14 rebounds.
- Freshmen Nunu Agara and Courtney Ogden each finished with 16, combining to go 12-of-21 from the floor, while fellow first-year Chloe Clardy had eight points and three steals.
- Jzaniya Harriel and Hannah Jump both put up 13, Harriel going 2-of-3 from deep and Jump 3-of-4.
- Brooke Demetre had 12 boards and Cameron Brink contributed 10 points and four blocks in 14 minutes.

**NUMBERS OF NOTE »**

- The Cardinal is 601-98 (.860) all-time at Maples Pavilion, including 185-18 (.911) since the start of 2010-11, the fourth-best percentage in that time behind UConn (.953), Baylor (.949) and FGCU (.920).
- Stanford has won 57 of its last 60 games against unranked opponents.
- Stanford has won 58 of its last 61 games when at least four players hit double figures in scoring.
- Stanford has won 129 of its last 135 games when holding a halftime lead.
- The Cardinal has won 48 consecutive games when scoring at least 80 points. Its last such loss came at California on Jan. 31 2019, 81-80.
- Stanford is 90-8 when Hannah Jump makes one 3-pointer and 48-2 when she scores in double figures.
- Stanford is 45-6 when Cameron Brink has at least three blocked shots and is 23-1 when she blocks at least five.
- Stanford is 14-1 when Kiki Iriafen scores in double figures.

**ON THE BRINK OF HISTORY »**

- Cameron Brink is on watch lists for the Wade Trophy, Naismith Trophy and Lisa Leslie Award, and is a preseason Associated Press All-American.
- The two-time reigning Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year, Brink is coming off a junior season in which she finished second nationally with a school-record 118 blocks and was third in the country in blocks per game (3.47).
- The 2023 WBCA Defensive Player of the Year was also one of just two players to average at least 15.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 3.0 blocks per game last season (Taiyanna Jackson – Kansas) and recorded the program's first triple-double with blocks when she had 16 points, 11 rebounds and 10 rejections in a win over Oregon on Jan. 29.
- Brink's 10 blocks set the Stanford single-game record and were the most for a Pac-12 player since Washington State's Nike McClure had 12 against Colorado on Feb. 25, 2017.
- A WBCA All-American as both a sophomore and junior, Brink is one of three multiple-time WBCA All-Americans in the country this season (Caitlin Clark – Iowa; Elizabeth Kitley, Virginia Tech).
- The nation's leading active shot blocker with 297 in her career, Brink will enter her senior season looking to become the 17th Division I player with 400 career rejections. Oregon State's Ruth Hamblin (2013-16) owns the Pac-12 record with 425 career blocks.
- Brink entered last season shooting just 62.7 percent in her career from the free throw line, but turned that weakness into a strength as a junior. She shot 84.8 percent (156-of-184) on free throws last season and ended the year with a program-record 48-straight makes.
- Brink's 118 blocks last season were more than 262 Division I teams had in total.

**SHOOTERS SHOOT »**

- Back for her fifth season on The Farm, Hannah Jump is on the watch list for the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award, which recognizes the nation's top shooting guard.
- Last season, she was one of only two players to average better than 44.0 percent from deep while making at least 100 3-pointers (Kate Mager – Iona) and just the ninth major conference player to do that since 1999-2000.
- Jump was an All-Pac-12 pick a season ago, one in which she broke Stanford's single-season record for 3-point makes (100), ranked ninth nationally in 3-point field goals and eighth in percentage (44.1).
- Jump heads into this season second among active players in career 3-point percentage (.421).
- She is 29 3-pointers shy of breaking the school record (Kiana Williams - 311) and 91 away from breaking the Pac-12 record (373 - Sydney Wiese - Oregon State).

**THE ART OF THE ASSIST »**

- Talana Lepolo handed out five or more assists in 11 of her 34 appearances a season ago and with 125 total finished with the sixth-most assists among freshmen in program history. She had the most assists for any Cardinal freshman since Nicole Powell in 2000-01 (142).
- Against San Diego State in last season's opener on Nov. 7, she had 11 assists and no turnovers, the most assists in a game by a Stanford freshman since Marta Sniezek had 13 against Washington on March 4, 2016.

- Cameron Brink, Talana Lepolo, Elena Bosgana and Stavi Papadaki all represented their countries across the globe in various tournaments this summer.
- Brink won the 2023 FIBA 3x3 World Cup in Vienna, Austria for the United States and was named tournament MVP playing alongside Cierra Burdick, Linnae Harper and Hailey Van Lith.
- Lepolo won a gold medal with the U.S. at the 2023 FIBA U19 Women's World Cup in Madrid by averaging 3.1 points, 2.7 assists and 1.6 rebounds in 17.7 minutes over seven games.
- Bosgana appeared in two games for Greece at the FIBA Women's Eurobasket in Israel and Slovenia in June and was the leading scorer at the FIBA U20 Division B Women's European Championship in Craiova, Romania in August, averaging 19.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 2.7 assists.

- Since leaving The Farm following the 2019-20 campaign, Brown had lived in Michigan, working as an athletic director for Okemos Public Schools and raising her two children with her wife, Malissa.
- Also back is first-year assistant coach Erica McCall, a former two-time team captain who just wrapped up a five-year professional career in the WNBA.
- Named a 2016-17 honorable mention All-American by both the Associated Press and the WBCA, McCall led the Cardinal to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including Final Four runs in 2014 and 2017, and a 118-28 overall record.
