LEADING OFF

THIS WEEK

Coming off of a 2-1 weekend against a trio of Big Ten opponents in Minneapolis, Hawaii returns to Les Murakami Stadium to host 2022 Super Regional team UConn for a four-game series starting Friday. The two teams will play at 6:35 p.m. Friday, Saturday and Monday while playing a day game starting at 1:05 p.m. Sunday. The Rainbow Warriors and Huskies will be meeting each other for the first time.

BIG WEEKEND

The Rainbow Warriors concluded a six-game road trip by going 2-1 against three Big Ten opponents at the Cambria College Classic. UH knocked off host Minnesota, 3-2, on Friday before topping No. 18 Maryland, 9-3, to close out the weekend Sunday. The win over the Terrapins was Hawaii's first over a top-20 opponent since 2021. The 'Bows used the long ball to help secure the two wins, as **MATT WONG** hit a two-run homer in the first inning of the Minnesota win while **JACOB IGAWA** and **KYSON DONAHUE** hit back-to-back jacks in the ninth inning of Sunday's win.

SUNDAY FUNDAY

Hawaii has enjoyed massive success in Sunday games over the last two seasons under head coach **RICH HILL**. The Rainbow Warriors are 14-2 on Sundays since the start of 2022 with nine straight Sunday victories. UH has outscored teams 157-65 in Sunday games under Hill, scoring double-digit runs eight times while holding teams to three or fewer runs 10 times.

UH is outscoring opponents 157-65 in Sunday games under Hill and have scored double-digit runs eight times while holding teams to three or fewer runs 10 times. During its current 10-game Sunday winning streak, the Rainbow Warriors are averaging 12.2 runs per game and have scored 10 or more runs seven times during that stretch.

A BIG WEEKEND

Hawai'i is coming off of a 2-1 weekend against a trio of Big Ten opponents at the Cambria College Classic over the weekend. The Rainbow Warriors closed out their two-week road trip by picking up wins over Minnesota and then-No. 18 Maryland in Minneapolis, beating the host Golden Gophers 3-2 on Friday before knocking off the Terrapins, 9-3, on Sunday. UH got help from the long ball to pick up the two wins, as **MATT WONG** hit a key two-run homer in the first inning vs. Minnesota and **JACOB IGAWA** and **KYSON DONAHUE** hit back-to-back homers in the ninth inning to break open the win over Maryland. On the mound **HARRY GUSTIN** turned in the longest start by a UH pitcher this year in the win over the Gophers, going five innings, while **CONNOR HARRISON** finished the weekend with a save in each of the two wins, working 3.1 innings out of the bullpen.

PLAYING FOR HAWAII'

For the second straight year, the Hawai'i roster will have a strong local flavor to it as 20 of the 40 players on the roster are local products. Head coach **RICH HILL** has made it a point of keeping the best local talent home, as UH has suited up 20 homegrown players in each of the last two seasons. The Rainbow Warriors haven't had that many local products on the roster since the 2000 season.

PARTY AT THE LES

One of the best venues in the country has remained one of the hottest tickets nationally in recent years, as Hawai'i has continued to pack Les Murakami Stadium. The Rainbow Warriors have led The Big West in average attendance every year since joining the league in 2013 and have consistently been in the top 35 nationally in average attendance and the top five among teams in the western U.S. in average attendance since the NCAA began reporting yearly attendance figures in 2014. After one home weekend in 2023, UH leads the conference and is second among teams in the west in attendance.

FRESH FACES

A number of newcomers have made an instant impact over the first two weeks both in the lineup and on the mound. Seven different new faces have gotten a start on the field while seven newcomers have made an appearance on the mound, led by **BEN ZEIGLER-NAMOA** who has started all but one game while also getting the nod on the mound once. The JC transfer and Maui native is hitting .345 and is tied for the team-lead with 10 RBIs while he also got the ball in the finale vs. Wright State, throwing three shutout innings in a win.

ELITE COMPETITION

Hawai'i's 50-game regular season includes 13 games against teams that made it to the 2022 NCAA Tournament. The Rainbow Warriors host three 2022 tournament teams for a weekend series, opening with defending Horizon League champs Wright State (Feb. 17-19) before hosting 2022 Super Regional team UConn (Mar. 10-13) while closing the regular season at home against Big West champion UC Santa Barbara (May 25-27). The 'Bows also play single games at San Diego and vs. Maryland.

RICH WITH EXPERIENCE

A veteran of the collegiate coaching ranks, **RICH HILL** heads into his second season leading the Hawai'i baseball program and 36th year overall as a collegiate skipper. Hill is currently seventh among active Division I head coaches in career wins with a record of 1,113-766-4 over his tenures at Cal Lutheran, San Francisco, San Diego and Hawai'i. He is one of eight active coaches with at least 1,000 career wins while his 35 years of head coaching experience are tied for fourth among current head coaches.



OFFENSE NOTES

RALLY WITH TWO

The UH offense has done a lot of its damage with two outs in innings, scoring nearly half of its 68 runs with two away. The Rainbow Warriors have pushed across 47.1 percent of their runs (32 of 68) with two gone, scoring multiple two-out runs in each of the six wins. Additionally, Hawai'i is hitting .298 with two outs in an inning while 10 different players have come through with a two-out RBI.

LIFT OFF

The Hawai'i bats have shown some pop over the first three weeks of the season. The Rainbow Warriors have hit 12 home runs on the year, the most by a UH team through the first 10 games of a season since at least 2002. Six different 'Bows have homered, led by **JARED QUANDT** and **KYSON DONAHUE** with three, to put UH in a tie for second in the conference in long balls.

- » UH's 12 home runs are already more than it has in a season in five of the last 10 years.
- » The 'Bows lead The Big West in multi-HR games with four.
- » Hawai'i has hit back-to-back home runs twice this season, while 10 of the 12 have come in UH's wins.
- » Seven of the home runs have come in two-strike counts while four have been to lead off an inning.

HIT THE QUANDT

Sophomore outfielder **JARED QUANDT** has gotten off to one of the hottest starts to the season of any hitter in The Big West. Quandt is currently the only player in the conference to rank in the top three of the league in batting average, on-base percentage and slugging, and is also tied for the team lead in home runs and hits. After missing last season due to injury, he has reached base in all nine games he's played in and has four multi-hit games and three-multi RBI games.

LEANING ON THE LOCAL BOYS

The Rainbow Warrior position player group once again is made up of a core group of local players. In all but one game this year, at least seven of the nine players in the lineup have been from Hawai'i while eight of the nine starters have been local products three times.

- » **BEN ZEIGLER-NAMOA** leads the team with four 2Bs and 10 RBIs while batting .389 with a .577 OBP.
- » **MATT WONG** is batting .351 and is tied for the team lead with 10 RBIs.
- » **KYSON DONAHUE** is hitting .308 with three doubles, three home runs and eight RBIs.
- » **JACOB IGAWA** has started each game in the No. 3 hole and is hitting .325 with seven RBIs.
- » **STONE MIYAO** and **JORDAN DONAHUE** have started nine of the ten games together up the middle.
- » Miyao went 5-for-10 over the weekend in Minneapolis and is hitting .333 on the year.

MIX & MATCH

After using 50 different batting lineups in 52 games a year ago, head coach **RICH HILL** again has a ton of options offensively in 2023, having used 10 different lineup combinations through the first 10 games of the season.

- » 20 different players have gotten a plate appearance.
- » Only **JACOB IGAWA** (No. 3) has been in the same spot in the lineup for all 10 games.
- » Seven of the nine spots in the lineup have had at least three different players start in them.
- » The No. 8 and 9 spots have each seen seven different players get a start there.

TROPICAL SWARM

The depth of the Hawai'i pitching staff has been on display over the first three weekends, as the Rainbow Warriors have used 15 different arms. None of those 15 have thrown more than 12 innings, although nine of the 15 that have been used have worked at least four innings.

- » Fourth in The Big West in hits allowed (81) and second in batting average against.
» ALEX GIROUX, RANDY ABSHIER and HARRY GUSTIN are the only pitchers who have thrown at least 10 innings.
» Eight of the pitchers used have an opponent batting average of under .250.

INSTANT IMPACT

Hawai'i has gotten big contributions from a number of newcomers on its pitching staff over the first two weekends. Seven new additions have gotten work over the first 10 games while the Rainbow Warriors have started a newcomer on the mound in seven of the 10 games.

- » ALEX GIROUX owns a 1.69 ERA with four hits allowed over 10.2 innings, while RANDY ABSHIER has a 3.27 ERA and seven strikeouts in 11.0 innings.
» Giroux leads The Big West and is 14th in the country allowing just 3.38 hits per nine innings.
» HARRISON BODENDORF has started a game each of the last two weeks and has an ERA of 2.00 with 10 strikeouts over nine innings.

EXPERIENCED ARMS

A number of Hawai'i's key arms from a year ago are back to help lead the pitching staff in 2023. UH returns five pitchers who made 10 or more appearances in 2022, including four of its eight pitchers that appeared in 15 or more games.

- » CONNOR HARRISON is one of five Big West pitchers with multiple saves this year, owning a 12-1 strikeout to walk ratio.
» CAMERON HAGAN has pitched in 37 career games, throwing 58.1 innings with 51 strikeouts.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

One area Hawai'i where will have to replace some key losses from a year ago is in its starting rotation. All four Rainbow Warriors who started at least five games last year are gone, including a pair of 2022 MLB Draft picks in Blaze Koali'i Pontes and Cade Halemanu.

- » Six different pitchers have earned a start in the first 10 games.
» Four of the six who have been used as starters made their first collegiate starts on the mound this year.

DEFENSIVE VERSATILITY

Versatility is a common theme among Hawai'i's position players, as several players have gotten starts at multiple positions on the field throughout their careers. The Rainbow Warriors have 12 players on their roster who have made starts at multiple positions on the field throughout their careers.
