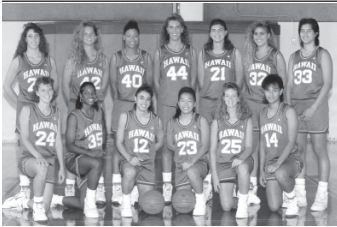

With top players Tania Brunton and Nani Cockett lost to injury, UH suffered its worst season under head coach Vince Goo. The Rainbow Wahine begin play in the new Stan Sheriff Center and win their first-ever game in the arena, an 82-61 win versus New Mexico (Nov. 25). Defending NCAA champion North Carolina ended UH's school-record 30-game home win streak the very next day (Nov. 26). The team set new marks for futility with 20 losses, including 11 straight losses in the months of January and February.
