SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ The 2023 season marked the second for head coach **Timmy Chang**. The former record-breaking UH quarterback led the Rainbow Warriors to a 5-8 mark, including 3-5 in the Mountain West.
- ▶ Hawai'i won three of its final four games of the season.
- ▶ UH placed six members on the Mountain West's all-conference teams, including WR **Steven McBride**, who was named to the second team. WR **Pofele Ashlock**, DB **Peter Manuma**, QB **Brayden Schager**, PK **Matthew Shipley**, and DB **Cam Stone** earned honorable mention.
- ▶ OL **Eliki Tanuvasa** was selected to the College Sports Communicators Academic All-District Team for the third time in his career.
- ▶ WR **Pofele Ashlock** was named to the Football Writers Association of America Freshman All-America team as well as to *The Athletic's* Freshman All-America second-team.
- ▶ UH placed 19 on the MW academic all-conference team including fourth-year honorees **Jonah Kahahawai-Welch**, **Tamatoa Mokiao-Atimalala**, **Fo'i Sila**, and **Eliki Tanuvasa**. Second-year honorees include **Noah Kema**, **Koali Nishigaya**, **Karsyn Pupunu**, **Brayden Schager**, and **Landon Sims**. First-year honorees were **Dean Briski**, **Ethan Spencer**, **Jamih Otis**, **Ka'ena Decambra**, **Luke Felix-Fualalo**, **Kua'o Peihopa**, **Makana Meyer**, **Anthony Sagapolutele**, **John Tuitupou**, and **Dalen Morris**.
- ▶ PK **Matthew Shipley** was among 20 semifinalists for the Lou Groza Collegiate Place-Kicker Award presented by the Orange Bowl. The Liberty Hill, Texas native was also a semifinalist in 2021 and finished the season 14-of-18 in field goal attempts with a long of 51.
- ▶ UH regained possession of the **Kuter Trophy** for the first time since 2016 following a 27-13 win over Air Force, Nov. 11 in Honolulu. Hawai'i played all four of its rivalry trophy games in 2023 marking the first time in program history the team played all four in the same season.
- ▶ WR **Pofele Ashlock** led all FBS freshmen in receptions (83), was No. 2 in receiving yards (832), and No. 3 in TD receptions (9) and receiving yards per game (64.0). He was the first UH freshman in the school's Division I era to start a career with back-to-back 100-yard receiving games.
- ▶ QB **Brayden Schager** led the Mountain West in passing yards (3,542), passing touchdowns (26), and points responsible for (168) and ranked No. 2 in total offense (277.3 ypg). Schager, who finished with six 300+ yard passing games, moved up the school's all-time list to No. 5 in passing yards (6,505), No. 6 in total offense (6,565), and No. 7 in passing TDs (41).
- ▶ UH closed out the season with a frantic, walk-off victory over Colorado State, Nov. 25 in Honolulu. PK **Matthew Shipley** kicked the game-winning 51-yard field goal as time expired in a 27-24 victory. The 51-yarder was a career-long and his second game-winner of the season after booting a 24-yard field goal as time expired in a 20-17 win over New Mexico State.
- ▶ WR **Steven McBride** finished the season with a team-best 1,024 receiving yards which marked the 24th 1,000-yard season in UH history and the first by a Rainbow Warrior since 2019.
- ▶ Former UH receiver **Chad Owens** was among the Class of 2024 of the Canadian Football League Hall of Fame. Owens is the third former Rainbow Warrior in the CFL Hall of Fame joining offensive lineman Jim Mills (2009) and linebacker Solomon Elimimian (2023).

TEAM NOTES

MOUNTAIN WEST'S BESTS

- ▶ UH placed six members on the Mountain West's all-conference teams, including WR **Steven McBride**, who was named to the second team.
- ▶ WR **Pofele Ashlock**, DB **Peter Manuma**, QB **Brayden Schager**, PK **Matthew Shipley**, and DB **Cam Stone** earned honorable mention.

ACADEMIC HONOREES

- ▶ OL **Eliki Tanuvasa** was selected to the College Sports Communicators Academic All-District Team for the third time in his career.
- ▶ UH placed 19 on the MW academic all-conference team including fourth-year honorees **Jonah Kahahawai-Welch**, **Tamatoa Mokiao-Atimalala**, **Fo'i Sila**, and **Eliki Tanuvasa**. Second-year honorees include **Noah Kema**, **Koali Nishigaya**, **Karsyn Pupunu**, **Brayden Schager**, and **Landon Sims**. First-year honorees were **Dean Briski**, **Ethan Spencer**, **Jamih Otis**, **Ka'ena Decambra**, **Luke Felix-Fualalo**, **Kuao Peihopa**, **Makana Meyer**, **Anthony Sagapolutele**, **John Tuitupou**, and **Dalen Morris**.

TROPHY GAMES

- ▶ UH played all four of its rivalry trophy games in 2023—Island Showdown (at UNLV), Dick Tomey Legacy (vs. San José State, Oct. 28), Kuter (vs. Air Force, Nov. 11), and Paniolo (at Wyoming, Nov. 18) — marking the first time in program history the team played all four in the same season.
- ▶ UH regained possession of the **Kuter Trophy** for the first time since 2016 following a 27-13 win over Air Force, Nov. 11.
- ▶ UH's opponents currently hold possession of its remaining three rivalry trophies.

SLOW STARTS

- ▶ UH was out-scored 244-122 in the first half this season, including 118-38 in the first quarter. UH was held scoreless in the first quarter in eight of 13 games.
- ▶ Of UH's 13 opening drives, the Warriors punted 10 times, had one punt blocked, scored a TD and converted one field goal.
- ▶ The Warriors found the end zone on their opening drive only once this season against Air Force when they marched 75 yards in 12 plays to take a 7-0 lead.

BALL SECURITY

- ▶ UH has won the turnover battle in three of its last four games with a +5 margin. Hawai'i had lost the turnover battle in seven of its first nine games.
- ▶ The Warriors tied for No. 124 nationally in turnover margin (13 gained, 23 lost).
- ▶ UH has only turned the ball over five times in its five wins with the remaining 18 giveaways coming in the eight losses.

HAWAII IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

- ▶ Hawai'i completed its 12th season in the Mountain West in 2023.

- ▶ UH is 31-65 (.323) all-time in the MW — 18-31 (.367) at home and 13-34 (.277) on the road—and have appeared in one Mountain West Championship game during the 2019 season.

ROAD WARRIORS

- ▶ UH made six road trips in 2023, which included a 8,680-mile trek to Nashville, Tenn, for its season-opener at Vanderbilt.
- ▶ The six trips totaled 37,720 air miles.
- ▶ Over the last decade (not including 2020 COVID season), UH played no less than six road games each year, including a program-high seven in 2021. The most miles UH travelled in a season was 46,568 in 2016, that included trips to Sydney, Australia (vs. California) and Ann Arbor, Mich., in back-to-back weeks.

A BIGGER HOME

- ▶ The 2023 season marks UH's third home season at the Clarence T.C. Ching Complex.
- ▶ During the off-season, Phase 2 of renovations increased the seating capacity by roughly 6,000 to an official capacity of 15,194 and included the installation of Aloha Stadium's 75-foot scoreboard.
- ▶ UH has a 11-9 (.550) all-time record in Ching Complex. Hawai'i went 4-2 in its inaugural season of 2021; finished with a 3-4 mark last year; and were 4-3 this season.

OTHER TEAM NOTES

- ▶ UH snapped a 10-game road losing streak with a 27-14 win over Nevada. It was the first road win since a 38-14 victory at Wyoming in the 2021 regular-season finale.
- ▶ UH's 35-0 home loss to San Jose State was its first shutout loss since falling 38-0 at Utah State in 2017. It also marked UH's first shutout at home since a 28-0 loss to SMU in 1998.

OFFENSE NOTES

- ▶ Hawai'i ranked No. 26 nationally in passing offense, averaging 276.4 yards per game. The Warriors also tied for No. 7 in FBS with 337 completions.

TEXAS GUNSLINGER

- ▶ In his first season running the Run-and-Shoot offense, QB **Brayden Schager** led the Mountain West in passing yards (3,542), passing touchdowns (26), and points responsible for (168) and ranked No. 2 in total offense (277.3 ypg).
- ▶ Schager, who finished with six 300+ yard passing games, moved up the program's all-time list to No. 5 in passing yards (6,505), No. 6 in total offense (6,565), and No. 7 in passing TDs (41).
- ▶ Schager tied for second among all FBS quarter-

- ▶ Has a 9-16 career record (.360) as a starting QB which includes a win in his starting debut over nationally ranked Fresno State in 2021.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW

- ▶ WR **Pofele Ashlock** was named to the Football Writers Association of America Freshman All-America team as well as to *The Athletic's* Freshman All-America second-team.

- ▶ Ashlock led all FBS freshmen in receptions (83), was No. 2 in receiving yards (832), and No. 3 in TD receptions (9) and receiving yards per game (64.0).

- ▶ He was the first UH freshman in the school's Division I era to start a career with back-to-back 100-yard receiving games, earning Mountain West Freshman of the Week honors in each of those weeks.

- ▶ After redshirting last season, Ashlock was the team leader in receptions and receiving TDs and was second in receiving yards and 20+ yard catches (11).

NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE

- ▶ WR **Steven McBride** finished the season with a team-best 1,024 receiving yards which marked the 24th 1,000-yard season in UH history and the first by a Rainbow Warrior since 2019.

- ▶ The team's deep ball threat tied for No. 3 in FBS lead with six 50+ yard catches on the season, including a season-long 65-yard reception against San Diego State, which was one of two 60+ yard catches against the Aztecs.

- ▶ The Napoleonville, La., native had only 21 receptions for 128 yards in 24 career games at Kansas prior to transferring to Hawai'i.

- ▶ McBride scored in six of 13 games this season and scored multiple TDs three times versus Vanderbilt, Albany, and New Mexico.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

- ▶ At least eight different players caught a pass in 10 of UH's 13 games this season.

- ▶ WR **Pofele Ashlock** (83) and WR **Steven McBride** (63) combined for 146 of the team's 337 receptions (43.3%) and 18 of the team's 27 receiving touchdowns (66.7%).

- ▶ UH had two 100-yard receivers versus San Diego State — Steven McBride (157) and Nick Cenacle (100) — marking the first time since 2021 that multiple receivers eclipsed the 100-yard mark.

RISK TAKERS

- ▶ The Warriors were 16-of-32 (50%) on fourth-down plays this season. Last season, UH converted 18-of-34 (52.9%).

- ▶ In two seasons under head coach Timmy Chang, UH is 34-of-65 (52.3%) in 4th down conversion.

DEFENSE NOTES

- ▶ Despite allowing an average of 32.2 points per game, UH's defense played big at times especially in the last three victories.

- ▶ After forcing just five turnovers in the first nine games, the Warriors had eight takeaways in the last four games, coming away with five INTs and three fumbles over that stretch.

- ▶ The Warriors forced four turnovers in the fourth quarter to seal a win over Air Force, returning a fumble for a TD before ending the Falcons' last three drives with an interception.

- ▶ UH's 17-0 halftime lead over Nevada on Nov. 4 marked the first time UH shutout an opponent in the first half since the 2020 New Mexico Bowl when it out-scored Houston 21-0

COMEBACK SEASON

- ▶ LB **Isaiah Tufaga** had a solid 2023 season in his return to the line-up after missing the final six games of last season.

- ▶ The Laie, O'ahu native finished second on the team with 79 tackles while recording 5.5 tackles for loss and 2.5 sacks.

- ▶ Posted a career-high 12 tackles at New Mexico and forced a fumble in back-to-back games against San Jose State and Nevada. Both of his sacks occurred in the season-opener against Vanderbilt in which he also led the team with eight tackles.

- ▶ Has 23 starts in 42 career games for the Rainbow Warriors after transferring from Oregon State in 2020.

ROTATING LINEBACKERS

- ▶ UH's other inside linebacker position rotated among several players after the season-ending injury to starter **Logan Taylor**.

- ▶ Taylor started the first three games before suffering the injury against UAlbany. The Harbor City, Calif., native totaled 21 tackles, including four for loss prior to the injury.

- ▶ **Nalu Emerson** started two games before suffering an injury in the New Mexico State game. The Kahuku, O'ahu native recorded 10 tackles and forced a fumble against Oregon and NMSU.

- ▶ **Jalen Smith** started the last eight games and recorded 67 tackles, 9.0 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks and a forced fumble over that stretch. He made a career-high 10 tackles at UNLV and a career-best three TFLs vs. San Jose State.

PASS THE SAUCE

- ▶ With perhaps the biggest defensive play of the season, **Daniel "Sauce" Williams** stripped and returned a New Mexico State fumble 41 yards in the second quarter that set up a UH field goal.

- ▶ According to Pro Football Focus, was the top-graded defensive player nationally in Week 4 against New Mexico State with a 97.4 rating.

- ▶ Ranked the No. 2 interior defensive lineman in the Mountain West in rush defense with a 79.9 rating by PFF.

SET IN STONE

- ▶ Perhaps the biggest acquisition during the off-season for the Hawai'i was Wyoming transfer cornerback **Cam Stone**.

- ▶ Started the year wearing #0 but switched to #4.

► First interception as a Rainbow Warrior sealed the win over Air Force.

► Served as the team's primary kickoff return specialist with an average of 20.7 yards on 16 returns.

► The Angleton, Texas native appeared in 28 games over three seasons for Wyoming and was an honorable mention all-Mountain West pick in 2022 after recording 10 PBUs and two interceptions.

MANUMA MAGIC

► Safety **Peter Manuma** made 21 consecutive starts at safety since entering the lineup in the fifth game of last season.

► The 'Ewa Beach, O'ahu native led the team with 87 tackles including 5.5 for loss along with three interceptions.

► Named the Mountain West Defensive Player of the Week after leading the team with 12 tackles while picking off his third pass of the season and sixth of his career in a win over Air Force.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

► UH recovered an onside kick in the third quarter against New Mexico State, marking its first successful recovery since 2019 (Nov. 2 vs. Fresno State). UH is 1-of-4 on onside kicks this season.

ROCKET SHIP

► PK **Matthew Shipley** completed his fourth season as the team's starting placekicker and was 14-of-18 in field goal attempts.

► Over his career, was 56-of-73 (76.7%) in field goal attempts and 125-of-127 in PAT attempts. His 76.7% career clip is second behind Jason Elam's all-time mark of 79.0%.

► The Liberty Hill, Texas native kicked two game-winning field goals as time expired — a 24-yarder against New Mexico State and 51-yarder versus Colorado State. It marked UH's first walk-off win at the end of regulation since Marcus Kemp's TD against UNLV on Nov. 22, 2014.

► Converted two 50-yard field goals in a win at Nevada to become the first UH player to nail multiple 50-yard field goals in a game.

► Named a semifinalist for the Lou Groza Award for the second time in his career after making the list in 2021.

► He was one of five MW kickers since 1996 to make multiple 50-yard FGs in a game.

► Team's starting punter for the third straight season and averaged 39.5 yards per punt. Ranked fourth in program history with 178 punts.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

OH, CAPTAIN

► UH's captains this season were DB **Virdel Edwards II**, RB **Tylan Hines**, DL **Jonah Kahahawai-Welch**, OL **Eliki Tanuvasa**, and LB **Logan Taylor**. Taylor suffered a season-ending injury against UAlbany.

WALK-ON U.

► Former walk-ons who have made starts at UH include DL **Andrew Choi**, OL **Eliki Tanuvasa**, DL **John Tuitupou**, WR **Koali Nishigaya**, and DB **Meki Pei**.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

► The 2023 squad featured seven second-generation Warriors—**Wynden Ho'ohuli** (Watson, 2000-05), **Kila & Kalani Kamakawiwo'ole** (Kila, 2002-05); **Landon Sims** (Travis, 1989-92), **Ethan Spencer** (Sean), **Matagi Thompson** (Afatia, 1998-2000), and **Chad Owens, Jr.** (Chad, 2001-04).

► Two sets of brothers on the 2023 squad include **Kila & Kalani Kamakawiwo'ole** and **Anthony & Josh Sagapolutele**.

► Two others have older brothers who once suited up for UH—**Andrew Choi** (Zeno), **Sergio Mui-sau** (Darius), and **Maurice Ta'ala** (Blessman).

SPANNING THE GLOBE

► UH's roster featured players from eight countries—United States (99), American Samoa (6), Australia (1), Canada (1), England (1), Japan (1), New Zealand (1), and Samoa (1).

► UH ranked second nationally for most countries represented to Temple's 10.

► 48 of the 111-man roster hails from the state of Hawai'i while California (18) and Texas (10) combine to make up more than a quarter of the roster.

► UH also has players from 15 states, encompassing five time zones.

WE ARE THE "BRADDAHOOD"

► Following the 2021 season, the "Braddahood" movement began as an organic, team-unifying slogan created by the players to show solidarity amid an offseason of controversy.

► WR **Jonah Panoke** was one of the leaders of the movement which has since taken over as the team's motto and endorsed by head coach **Timmy Chang**, whose alma mater Saint Louis School, uses the term "The Brotherhood." Panoke is also a Saint Louis School alum.

BROTHERHOOD TO BRADDAHOOD

► Honolulu prep football powerhouse Saint Louis School has the most players of any Hawai'i high school on the current Rainbow Warrior roster.

► Fifteen Warriors are former Crusaders including **Kamalu DeBlake**, **Ka'ena Decambra**, **Nick Delgadillo**, **Kila Kamakawiwo'ole**, **Kona Moore**, **Arasi Mose**, **Koali Nishigaya**, **Jonah Panoke**, **Anthony Sagapolutele**, **Josh Sagapolutele**, **Ethan Spencer**, **Tasi Tadio**, **Eliki Tanuvasa**, **Devon Tauaefa**, and **Isaiah Tufaga**.

► Head coach **Timmy Chang** and defensive coordinator **Jacob Yoro** also prepped at Saint Louis.

'BOWS IN THE PROS

► Four former Warriors made NFL 53-man rosters, seven-year veteran P **Rigoberto Sanchez** (Indianapolis), fifth-year LB **Jahlani Tavai** (New England) and first-year free agent OL **Iim Manning** (Arizona).

'BOW BITES

- ▶ WR **Karsyn Pupunu** of Lahaina, Maui lost four members of his family (uncle, aunt, two cousins) in the Maui wildfires. DB **Kimo Holo Holt-Mossman** of Kula, Maui, lost his childhood home in the fires.
- ▶ QB **Brayden Schager** and his family founded the HP Buddy Bowl, an annual football event in Texas for special-needs youth. As a 10-year-old, he had the top bracket out of 8.5 million entries in ESPN's 2013 NCAA Tournament basketball pool.
- ▶ DB Eli **Matagi Thompson** was named after his uncle Eli Thompson who was committed to UH but passed away his senior year of HS. Fire knife dances for his father's luau company "Tihati Productions."
- ▶ PK **Matthew Shipley** has a twin brother (Mason) who kicks for Texas State. Older brother Michael kicked at West Texas A&M.
- ▶ QB **Dalen Morris** joined the team as a walk-on this past spring after being stationed at Pearl Harbor on O'ahu. The Navy graduate last played college football in 2020 and was the team's starting quarterback in that season's opener versus BYU.
- ▶ WR **Jonah Panoke** and DL **John Tuitupou** each have three children while LB **Logan Taylor** has two children.
- ▶ OL **Fred Pelling** is the tallest Warrior at 6-9 while RB **Tylan Hines** and WR **Koali Nishigaya** are the shortest at 5-7.
- ▶ WR **Tamatoa Mokiao-Atimalala's** brother Titus played at UCF and now plays for UCLA.
- ▶ LS **Solomon Landrum's** father Mike played tight end for the Atlanta Falcons.
- ▶ DL **Fo'i Sila** changed his last name in the off-season. He was previously Fo'i Shaw in his first five seasons as a Rainbow Warrior.
- ▶ WR **Eddie Osei-Nketia** is a world-class sprinter, having competed in international competition for both Australia and New Zealand. He is the current New Zealand 100m record holder.
- ▶ WR **Chuuky Hines'** mother is from Hawai'i and is of Micronesian and Hawaiian descent. His first name Chuuky translates to "mountain" in the Micronesian language of Chuukese.
- ▶ RB **Landon Sims** dons the same jersey number (#30) as his famous UH football father, Travis Sims, who was a member of the 1992 Holiday Bowl champion squad.
- ▶ WR **Maclane Watkins** older sister Avery is a member of the UH women's basketball team.
- ▶ DL **All Jarvis** is an amateur boxer who created a successful moving company as a HS sophomore. Studied Chinese for five years.
- ▶ DB **Elijah Palmer** was raised by his grandparents.
- ▶ WR **Carlito Capanang, Jr.** is the youngest of 12 children.
- ▶ DB **Brandon Shah** can play the piano by ear.
- ▶ LB **Jamih Otis** is a barber.

THE RUN-AND-SHOOT

- ▶ The most productive offensive scheme in program history is the **Run-and-Shoot**, which Hawai'i used for 15 seasons since 1999.
- ▶ UH ran the offense for 13 consecutive seasons under coaches June Jones (1999-2007) and Greg McMackin (2008-11) until Nick Rolovich brought it back for the 2018 & '19 seasons.
- ▶ UH finished in the Top 10 nationally in passing in 13 of 15 seasons and led the country in 2002, '06 & '10. UH also led the nation in scoring in 2006 and '07.
- ▶ UH is the only school to feature three 1,000-yard receivers in the same season twice – 2018 (JoJo Ward, Jared Smart, Cedric Byrd II) and 2007 (Ryan Grice-Mullen, Davone Bess, Jason Rivers).

Former record setting quarterback Timmy Chang is the sixth former Rainbow Warrior to head the program, joining Tom Kaulukukui (1946-50),

Jim Asato (1962-64), Larry Price (1974-76), June Jones (1999-2007), and Nick Rolovich (2016-19).

Chang was hired as UH's 25th head coach in program history on Jan. 22, 2022. He completed his first season with a 3-10 record which included career win No. 1 against Duquesne.

Chang spent the previous five seasons as the wide receivers and tight ends coach at Nevada, under coach Jay Norvell. He helped direct one of the most potent offensive attacks on the West Coast while the Wolf Pack earned a bowl bid in each of the last four seasons.

Prior to his time at Nevada, Chang had two stints as an offensive coordinator. In 2016, he served as the offensive coordinator at Emory & Henry College in Virginia and also spent two seasons at Jackson State in Mississippi from 2014-15.

Chang first got his coaching start as an offensive assistant at SMU under his collegiate head coach, June Jones, for two seasons assisting with the quarterbacks.

A four-year starter for Hawai'i from 2000-04, Chang set the NCAA's all-time passing (17,072) and total offense (16,910) records. The Honolulu native finished his career with 117 total touchdowns, which ranked third at the time. A two-time Hawai'i Bowl Most Outstanding Player, Chang led UH to three bowl appearances and a program-record 29 wins at quarterback. In his final season as a Warrior, he was a finalist for the Johnny Unitas Award, given to the nation's top senior quarterback.

Following his collegiate career, Chang played professionally in the NFL, CFL, and NFL Europe for four seasons. He retired from pro football in 2009 and returned to Hawai'i to complete his bachelor's degree.

- ▶ **Timmy Chang** is one of two Polynesian head coaches (Kalani Sitake-BYU) in FBS.
- ▶ **Chang** is also one of 17 head coaches who is coaching at his alma mater, including one of three in the Mountain West (Troy Calhoun–Air Force, and Danny Gonzales–New Mexico).
- ▶ In addition to **Chang** (2000-04), three other former Warriors are on the full-time coaching staff: LB coach **Chris Brown** (1998-2002), RB coach **Keiki Misipeka** (2001), and DT coach **Jordan Pu'u-Robinson** (2012-14).
- ▶ Among the full-time staff, Chang has previous coaching ties with only **Thomas Sheffield** at Nevada. In addition, **Silas Clapham** (Dir. of Player Personnel) and **Cade Socha** (Analyst) also were on the same staff at Nevada.
- ▶ Defensive coordinator **Jacob Yoro**, who joined the program in 2017, spent one season as co-coordinator in 2020. Yoro, who prepped at powerhouse Saint Louis School under legendary coach and former UH assistant Cal Lee, previously served as DC at Pacific University (Ore.) from 2010-14.
- ▶ WR coach **Jared Ursua** is the older brother of former UH receiver John Ursua.
- ▶ Co-OC/TE coach **Ian Shoemaker** and co-DC/DL coach **Eti Ena** both coached at Eastern Washigton in 2021. Prior to EWU, Shoemaker was head coach at Central Washington from 2014-19 while accumulating a win percentage of .704. In addition to Shoemaker, Ena coached alongside Yoro at Cal Poly.
- ▶ Co-OC/OL coach **Roman Sapolu's** father is former UH All-American Jesse Sapolu, who earned four Super Bowl rings with the San Francisco 49ers. Brother Landon also suited up for the Rainbow Warriors.
- ▶ LB coach **Chris Brown** still owns two UH weightlifting records—bench press (500lbs) and squat (605lbs).
- ▶ New to the full-time staff this season are DT coach **Jordan Pu'u-Robinson** and CB coach **Steve Irvin**. Pu'u-Robinson, a Maui native, spent the 2021 and '22 seasons as a graduate assistant and quality control coach, respectively, before briefly taking a full-time job at The Citadel in the spring. He returned to UH in the summer. Irvin has 25 years of coaching experience at eight different schools, including 10 years at the University of San Diego, where he was defensive coordinator from 2013-17.
- ▶ The 11 full-time coaches have a combined 33 children. RB coach **Keiki Misipeka** has eight children, all of whom begin with the letter K and have Hawaiian first names.

GAME NOTES

- ▶ The game was delayed 101 minutes due to inclement weather. Originally scheduled to kickoff at 6:30 p.m. CT, the game started at 8:11 p.m. CT.
- ▶ Hawai'i dropped to 3-11-1 all-time against current members of the Southeastern Conference including 0-5 on the road.
- ▶ UH dropped its seventh consecutive road game dating back to last season. It has lost 16 straight road games (including neutral sites) against Power 5 teams.
- ▶ After surrendering 404 yards rushing to Vanderbilt in the 2022 meeting, UH allowed a measly 39 yards in this year's match-up.
- ▶ The two teams failed to rush for 100 yards marking the first UH game since 2013 that neither the Warriors or their opponent broke the century mark. (UH-40, Vandy-39). The last time that occurred was UH's game at Oregon State, Sept. 7, 2013.
- ▶ Brayden Schager completed his first eight passes of the game and finished 27-of-35 for a career-high 351 yards, three touchdowns and two interceptions.
- ▶ Pofele Ashlock caught seven passes in his collegiate debut for a team-high 127 yards and scored his first career touchdown with a 3-yard reception in the 4Q.
- ▶ Isaiah Tufaga led the UH defense and tied his career-high with eight tackles, including three for loss and two sacks.
- ▶ Andrew Choi set a new career-high with seven tackles, including a sack.

- ▶ UH won the first-ever meeting between the teams and has now won its last 20 games against FCS teams dating back to the 2001 season.
- ▶ Hawai'i snapped a three-game losing streak dating back to last season and started the season 1-2 for the second time in the last three years (also 2021).

- ▶ Running backs Jordan Johnson and Naszjze Bryant-Lelei each saw their first action of the season and combined for 19 carries for 111 yards. Johnson led the way with 11 carries for 76 yards.
- ▶ Noah Kema made his first start of the season and made a key fourth-quarter fumble recovery that he returned 41 yards to set up UH's game-sealing touchdown.

- ▶ Oregon scored 24 first-quarter points and all six of its first-half drives to take a commanding 34-3 lead at halftime.
- ▶ Bo Nix led to the Ducks to a score in all seven drives he directed as the Ducks ended a three-game series skid against UH in the first meeting in nearly 30 years.

- ▶ Caleb Brown (CB), Wynden Ho'ohuli (LB), Nalu Emerson (LB) and Devon Tauaefa (TE) all made their first career starts for UH.

- ▶ UNLV won the Mountain West opener for both teams and regained possession of the Island Showdown Trophy.
- ▶ UNLV's win was its seventh in the last eight meetings between the teams in Las Vegas. The home team has now won 13 of the last 15 matchups in the series.
- ▶ A lackluster first half doomed the Warriors who surrendered the first 10 points of the game and trailed by 17 at the break.

- ▶ The Rainbow Warriors erased a 17-point first half deficit and took a 24-20 lead in the third quarter, but could not complete the comeback.

GAME NOTES

- ▶ The Rainbow Warriors end a four-game slide and a 10-game road losing streak, while picking up its first Mountain West win of the year.
- ▶ UH also handed head coach Timmy Chang his first career road win at the place where he served as an assistant coach for five previous seasons.
- ▶ UH picked up just its third win in 12 all-time trips to Reno (also in 2007, '19). Two of those wins have come in the last three visits.
- ▶ UH won the turnover battle (2-1) for the first time this season. Two of the turnovers (one fumble, one interception) led to 10 UH points.
- ▶ With a 17-0 lead, UH shutout an opponent in the first half for the first time since the 2020 New Mexico Bowl vs. Houston (21-0). It was also the team's largest half-time lead since the 2021 regular-season finale at Wyoming (31-7).
- ▶ The Rainbow Warriors racked up a season-high six sacks. The last time UH had that many sacks was Oct. 8, 2016 at San Jose State.
- ▶ UH held Nevada to opponent season-lows in points (14), total offense (236), pass completions and yards (6, 112), and first downs (14).
- ▶ Matthew Shipley became the first UH player to nail multiple 50-yard field goals in a game. The career-long 50 yarders came in the 2nd and 4th quarters.

GAME NOTES

- ▶ Hawai'i reclaimed possession of the Kuter Trophy with its first win over Air Force since its 2016 victory in Colorado Springs.
- ▶ Air Force's 13 points was a season-low for a UH opponent as the Warriors forced a season-high four turnovers, all of them coming in the fourth quarter.
- ▶ UH safety Peter Manuma made a career-high 12 tackles, seven unassisted, and came up with the second of UH's three interceptions in the fourth quarter.
- ▶ Linebacker Jalen Smith finished with eight stops and forced a fumble that safety Meki Pei returned 32 yards for a TD to give UH a 27-10 lead with 11:09 left.
- ▶ UH won back-to-back games for the first time since the final two weeks of the 2021 season and the first time in the Timmy Chang era.
- ▶ Air Force had outscored UH 114-33 in its last two visits to Honolulu (58-7 in 2015 and 56-26 in 2019), but the Warriors held the Falcons to their lowest point total in the series since a 6-3 win in 1992 in Colorado Springs.
- ▶ Air Force entered the game leading the nation in rushing with 284.2 yards per game but was held to 201.
- ▶ UH scored on its opening drive for the first time this season to set the tone.
- ▶ Pofele Ashlock snagged a career-high 12 catches and found the end zone twice for his third multi-score this game this season.

GAME NOTES

- ▶ Wyoming retained possession of the Paniolo Trophy with its second straight win over UH and its third in the last four meetings.
- ▶ Wyoming's first four touchdowns went for 44, 89, 28 and 40 yards, respectively, and the Cowboys averaged 9.4 yards per play, the highest average by a UH opponent this year.
- ▶ Wyoming, which did not commit a single penalty all game, racked up 345 yards in the decisive first half as UH trailed 35-0 at the break.
- ▶ UH's 35-point halftime deficit was its largest since being down 42-0 in last season's loss at nationally-ranked Michigan.
- ▶ UH has dropped 11 of its last 12 road games dating back to last season.
- ▶ After finishing with 278 passing yards Brayden Schager became the seventh UH quarterback to reach 6,000 career passing yards and moved into fifth in the all-time passing charts with 6,185 yards.
- ▶ Sophomore receiver Chuuky Hines scored his first career touchdown on a 19-yard catch in the third quarter and finished with a career-high 49 receiving yards.
- ▶ Justin Sinclair had his first career forced and recovered fumble in the third quarter. That turnover helped set up UH's first score of the game.
