PREVIEW

HOUSTON - HBU returns home after two weeks on the road to host Stephen F. Austin in Southland Conference football action Saturday at 7 p.m. at Husky Stadium. The FOX Sports Southwest broadcast with Brett Dolan and Jeff Power will be streamed live and shown later on tape delay. The Legacy Sports Network audio broadcast with Lonnie King and Alonzo Williams is available on HBUHuskies.com, beginning with the pregame show at 6:30 p.m.

The Huskies (1-5, 0-3 SLC) are led by redshirt freshman running back B.J. Kelly, who has rushed for 321 yards and a pair of touchdowns. Senior tight end Kenneth Bibbins has 17 catches for 222 yards and three touchdowns, while redshirt freshman wide receiver Wesley Lewis has 17 catches for 170 yards and a touchdown.

Redshirt freshman linebacker Garrett Dolan anchors the HBU defense, ranking fourth in the Southland with 53 tackles and also has 2.5 sacks. Sophomore cornerback Eric Amoako has made 35 tackles and recovered a fumble, while junior defensive end Josh Jones leads the team with 4.0 sacks.

SFA running back Gus Johnson leads the conference and ranks sixth nationally with 853 rushing yards and 13 touchdowns. Quarterback Zach Conque leads the Lumberjacks (4-2, 1-1 SLC), completing 116-of-193 passes for 1,393 yards, five touchdowns and six interceptions, while adding 249 rushing yards and eight rushing scores. Wide receiver Tyler Boyd has caught 36 passes for 377 yards and two touchdowns, while Aaron Thomas has 23 catches for 377 yards.

Linebacker Collin Garrett leads the league with 60 tackles and also has two interceptions for SFA. Justin Owens is the team's second-leading tackler with 33, including 4.0 for losses and a pair of sacks. Ishmiah Miles leads the Lumberjacks with 4.0 sacks, and Keavon Madison is tied with Garrett with two picks.

Last week, HBU suffered a 70-0 loss to Central Arkansas in Conway, Ark. True freshman quarterback Isaiah Hall rushed for 47 yards and led the Huskies on a pair of solid drives. SFA was tied with Nicholls, 7-7, at halftime and led 14-13 midway through the third quarter, but went on to a 42-20 victory over the Colonels in Thibodaux, La. Johnson ran for 202 yards and three touchdowns for the Lumberjacks.

The Huskies play their only back-to-back home games of the season, as they will return to action and host Nicholls for Homecoming next Saturday, Oct. 25, at 7 p.m. at Husky Stadium. Their only remaining home game following Homecoming will be in the season finale against Sam Houston State on Nov. 15 at 3 p.m.

Players are available in the mornings after practice at Husky Stadium and prior to their team meetings in the afternoon at the Bradshaw Fitness Center. Practices are typically held Monday-Thursday from 6:30-8:30 a.m. The best time to shoot video of practice is from 7:45-8:15 a.m. Afternoon interviews are typically conducted at 4 p.m. by request. HBU players will be available for interviews after games in the weight room facility following a brief cooling-off period.

JERRY RICE AWARD WATCH LIST

Redshirt freshman linebacker Garrett Dolan and redshirt freshman punter Christian Guzman were each named to the 21-member watch list for the Jerry Rice Award on Oct. 8. Dolan and Guzman are two of the three representatives from the Southland Conference, with Sam Houston State defensive end P.J. Hall being the other. HBU is one of only two schools to have more than one student-athlete on the list, with Mercer also having two. The Jerry Rice Award is presented by The Sports Network and is given annual to the most outstanding freshman in the Football Championships Subdivision (FCS). The award will be presented Dec. 15 in Philadelphia.

"DOLAN" OUT PUNISHMENT

Redshirt freshman linebacker Garrett Dolan is second in the Southland Conference and among the top 25 nationally with 9.8 tackles per game. He had 14 tackles in the season opener against McMurry, then followed with 16 stops at Northern Colorado, but only played two-and-half quarters of a blowout win over Texas College. He also has 2.5 sacks and had two hurries against the Northern Colorado that led to sacks for teammates. Of his 49 total tackles, 35 have been solo efforts.

FAMILY TIES

HBU has had family ties to its opponent the last two weeks. Central Arkansas quarterback Taylor Reed is the nephew of HBU head men's basketball coach Ron Cottrell. Last week against Incarnate Word, Huskies freshman wide receiver D'Angelo Wallace was pitted against his half-brother, Cardinals' quarterback Breyann McCollum. Redshirt freshman linebacker Garrett Dolan is the fifth player from his family to play football in the Southland.

MAKING THEM COUNT

Junior defensive end Josh Jones had recorded a team-high 4.0 sacks this season, two of which led directly to points for the Huskies. Against McMurry, he sacked the quarterback in the endzone for a safety, then at Northern Colorado, his sack forced a fumble, which was scooped up by sophomore cornerback Eric Amoako and returned 31 yards for a touchdown. His sack against Texas College resulted in a 25-yard loss that knocked the Steers out of scoring position.

TOPS AMONG TIGHT ENDS

Senior tight end Kenneth Bibbins leads all tight ends in the Southland Conference with 15 receptions for 204 yards and three touchdowns. He had three catches for 81 yards and a pair of scores against Texas College, despite having 36 yards and a touchdown taken off the board due to a penalty. He also had a touchdown taken off the board against Northern Colorado.

NOTHING IS A GIMME

The Huskies blocked two of McMurry's four extra-point attempts in the season opener on Sept. 6. Prince Sam blocked the attempt after the Warhawks' second touchdown with 11:06 left in the second quarter and La'Travian Gee blocked the attempt after the fourth score with 5:39 left in the fourth quarter. At Northern Colorado, sophomore cornerback Eric Amoako blocked a field goal attempt by the Bears.

ONES TO WATCH

HBU had three players named to the College Football Performance Awards preseason watch lists over the summer. Redshirt freshman running back B.J. Kelly was named to the running back list, redshirt freshman safety Taylor Thompson was named to the defensive back list, and senior tight end Kenneth Bibbins was named to the tight end list.

FILLED WITH FRESHMEN

Entering its third year as a startup program, HBU's roster is obviously filled with youth. Since no student-athletes lost a year of eligibility last season, the Huskies have 30 redshirt freshmen and added 27 true freshmen through this year's class.

YOUNG BUT EXPERIENCED

HBU lost only starter from last year's developmental squad. The Huskies return all 11 starters on offense, 10 on defense, and eight special teams players. HBU has 43 freshmen listed on its two-deep chart, including 19 starters.

STORYLINES

NETWORKING

All of HBU's home games will be streamed live by a major network carrier. FOX Sports Southwest is the official broadcaster and will show the games against McMurry (Sept. 6), Abilene Christian (Sept. 27), Stephen F. Austin (Oct. 18), and Sam Houston State (Nov. 15). The game will also be broadcast on tape delay across the network's television stations. As part of the Southland Conference package, the Huskies' home game against Nicholls (Oct. 25) and their road game at Lamar (Nov. 1) will be shown on ESPN3. HBU is the only Southland school to have such a contract in place and will have more games shown live on a major network than any other school in the league.



GRAND OPENING

HBU opened its new on-campus facility, HBU Stadium, in the season opener of its first official season of football and the Southland Conference Saturday, Sept. 6 with a 26-17 loss to McMurry. The surface of the stadium, Dunham Field, has been in place since the summer of 2013, but construction on the rest of the complex has been ongoing since February. The stadium seats 5,000, all on the west side of the facility. In last year's developmental season, the Huskies played three "home" games at Strake Jesuit College Preparatory's Crusader Stadium and one at BBVA Compass Stadium.

BIG-TIME TRANSFERS

HBU has nine Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) transfers on its roster. The Huskies return senior wide receiver Darian Lazard, and senior tight end Kenneth Bibbins, both from the University of Houston, and placekicker Travis Shinn from Louisiana-Lafayette. Over the summer, HBU added senior cornerback Tyler Stephenson (Baylor), sophomore cornerback Eric Amoako (Oregon), senior linebacker Aaron Benson (Texas), sophomore defensive end Rion Gurnell (LSU), safety Deon Hall (Houston), and redshirt freshman safety La'Travien Gee (Oklahoma State).

IT'S OFFICIAL

The Huskies are entering their first official season of Football Championship Series (FCS) and Southland Conference play. Last season, HBU played a seven-game "developmental" season, going 3-4. The results and statistics from that season are unofficial and do not count toward HBU's overall record. Also, no student-athletes lost a year of eligibility, but did have the year count toward their NCAA five-year clock.

McMurry 26, HBU 17

HOUSTON – McMurry wide receiver Jeret Smith caught six passes for 123 yards with two receiving touchdowns and one rushing touchdown as the Warhawks held off HBU, 26-17, in the Huskies first official game and home opener at Husky Stadium Saturday night.

Sophomore quarterback Jonathan Fleming was 20-for-39 for 179 yards, a touchdown and two interceptions for HBU (0-1). Redshirt freshman running back B.J. Kelly led the Huskies with 64 rushing yards, and freshman wide receiver D'Angelo Wallace had six catches for 61 yards and a touchdown. Redshirt freshman linebacker Garrett Dolan recorded 14 total tackles and a sack. Junior defensive end Josh Jones made a sack for a safety.

McMurry quarterback Matthew McHugh connected on 14-of-23 passes for a pair of touchdowns and two interceptions. Paxton Grayer caught two passes for 92 yards. Chris Simpson led the Warhawks with 45 rushing yards. Desmond Guy led McMurry with nine tackles.

Smith had a five-yard touchdown run, but the extra point was blocked as the Warhawks took shut the Huskies out in the quarter and took a 13-8 lead into halftime.

Early in the third quarter, Fleming hooked up with Wallace for a 14-yard touchdown, the first in HBU history, but Shinn missed the extra point as HBU regained a 14-13 lead. The Warhawks came back and took a 20-14 lead on a 22-yard touchdown reception by Smith.

With 12:06 to go in the fourth quarter Shinn hit a 20-yard field goal to cut the Warhawks' lead to 20-17, and the Huskies quickly got the ball back after McHugh was sacked and senior linebacker Aaron Benson recovered a fumble. The ensuing drive ended on Shinn's missed 30-yard field goal attempt that would have knotted up the game.

GREELEY, Colo. – HBU took a 20-15 lead into the fourth quarter, but Northern Colorado scored a pair of unanswered touchdowns over the final 10 minutes to pull out a 28-20 victory over the Huskies Saturday afternoon at Nottingham Field.

Sophomore quarterback Jonathan Fleming completed 21-of-35 passes for 159 yards and was intercepted three times for HBU (0-2). Freshman running back B.J. Kelly carried 11 times for 46 yards, while freshman Larry Day had seven carries for 36 yards and a touchdown. GAME 3

HBU 72, Texas College 6 Sept. 20, 2014 ♦ Rose Stadium

TYLER, Texas - HBU could not have been more balanced on offense, getting 217 yards on the ground and 217 yards passing in a 72-6 romp over Texas College for the Huskies' first official victory as an FCS program Saturday afternoon at Trinity Mother Frances Rose Stadium.

Sophomore quarterback Jonathan Fleming completed 12-of-16 passes for 206 yards and five touchdowns. Senior tight end Kenneth Bibbins led the Huskies (1-2) with three catches for 81 yards and a pair of TDs, while sophomore Davis Iheanacho and freshmen Ethan Fry and Wesley Lewis each had a receiving TD. Freshman running back B.J. Kelly rushed 12 times for 69 yards and a TD and freshman Steven Thompson had four carries for 46 yards and a pair of touchdowns.

On defense, HBU held Texas College (0-4) to 135 yards of total offense, with 86 on the ground and only 49 yards passing. Freshman cornerback Jonathan Buffin returned and interception for a TD, and freshman linebacker Victor Martinez led the Huskies with five tackles.

Cory Sherman had 15 carries for 100 yards, which included a 60-yard run in the second quarter, for the Steers. Quarterback Milton Harper was 2-for-17 with a TD and an interception. Ja'Marius Allen made one catch for 33 yards, and Bradford Lewis had a 24-yard reception for Texas College's lone score.

The Huskies struck first quickly as Fleming hit Iheanacho for a 12-yard TD three minutes into the game. Fleming then added a 33-yard strike to Fry and a 13-yard score to Lewis to put HBU ahead 21-0 through the first quarter. In the second quarter, Day and Kelly each capped drives with 1-yard TD runs, then Fleming's 25-yard TD to Bibbins gave the Huskies a 42-0 lead heading into halftime.

The Huskies had 25 first downs to eight for the Steers, while HBU outgained Texas College, 434-135, in total yards.

HOUSTON - Abilene Christian outgained HBU, 659-300, as the Wildcats downed the Huskies, 59-14, in Southland Conference football Saturday night at Husky Stadium. The game was HBU's first SLC contest.

HBU sophomore quarterback Jonathan Fleming went 4-for-8 for 50 yards and a touchdown, but left the game with a first-half injury. Redshirt freshman quarterback Ka'Darius Baker went 8-for-17 for 162 yards and a TD in relief. Redshirt freshman running back B.J. Kelly led the Huskies (1-3, 0-1 SLC) with 52 rushing yards. Senior wide receiver Darian Lazard had three catches for 87 yards and a TD, and senior tight end Kenneth Bibbins made two catches for 48 yards and a score. Senior cornerback Eric Amoako and redshirt freshman linebacker Garrett Dolan led HBU with eight tackles each.

ACU quarterback Parker McKenzie completed 21-of-31 passes for 385 yards and four touchdowns. Herschel Sims rushed 15 times for 128 yards, caught four passes for 92 yards and scored three touchdowns, while Cade Stone made seven catches for 121 yards and a pair of TDs for the Wildcats (3-2, 2-0). Cedric Gilbert also caught two TDs. Sam Denmark, Justin Stewart, Angel Lopez and Grady Lynn led ACU defensively with seven tackles apiece.

SAN ANTONIO - Incarnate Word controlled the clock for 37:41, using a balanced attack, for a 31-8 victory over HBU in Southland Conference football Saturday night at Benson Stadium.

Redshirt freshman running back B.J. Kelly rushed 12 times for 64 yards and a touchdown for the Huskies (1-4, 0-2 SLC). Redshirt freshman quarterback Ka'Darius Baker completed 6-of-18 passes for 63 yards, with one of those going to sophomore tight end Maxwell Brown for 52 yards. Redshirt freshman cornerback La'Travien Gee led the Huskies with 11 tackles, while sophomore cornerback Eric Amoako had 10 and redshirt freshman linebacker Garrett Dolan made eight.

UIW quarterback Breyllann McCollum, the half-brother of HBU wide receiver D'Angelo Wallace, went 16-for-22 for 162 yards and a touchdown and also added 33 rushing yards. Junior Sessions picked up 118 yards on 22 carries and scored a pair of touchdowns for the Cardinals (1-5, 1-2). Casey Jennings made five catches for 72 yards and a touchdown. Josh Zellars and Adrian Norwood had eight tackles apiece for UIW.

The Cardinals outgained the Huskies, 357-217. UIW had 179 yards passing and 178 yards rushing, while HBU had 146 yards on the ground and 71 through the air. UIW picked up 27 first downs to 13 for HBU.

In the fourth quarter, Dunkin hit Dolan for an eight-yard pass on a fake punt to keep the Huskies' scoring drive alive, and Kelly scored on a 16-yard touchdown run off the option. Baker then connected with senior tight end Kenneth Bibbins on the two-point conversion to make it a two-score game, 24-8. HBU went 78 yards on 16 plays in 7:56 on the drive.

Central Arkansas 70, HBU 0

CONWAY, Ark. - Central Arkansas rolled up 467 yards of total offense and eight touchdowns in the first half, and went on to a 70-0 victory over HBU in Southland Conference football Saturday night at Estes Stadium.

True freshman quarterback Isaiah Hall rushed 11 times for 47 for HBU (1-5, 0-3 SLC) and threw a pair of interceptions, while redshirt freshman quarterback Ka'Darius Baker was 6-for-18 for 50 yards and three interceptions. Sophomore running back Jackie Robinson had 32 yards on just five carries, and redshirt freshman wide receiver Wesley Lewis made two catches for 23 yards. Redshirt freshman safety Taylor Thompson led the Huskies with 10 tackles, forced a fumble and recovered a muffed punt. True freshman D'Angelo Wallace returned eight kickoffs for 140 yards.

UCA's quarterbacks combined to complete 15-of-17 passes for 287 yards and four touchdowns. Taylor Reed was 5-for-5 for 106 yards and two touchdowns, while rushing four times for 37 yards and a score. Ryan Howard was 7-for-8 for 110 yards and a touchdown, while Hayden Hildebrand was 3-for-4 for 71 yards and a touchdown for the Bears (4-3, 3-0). Dominique Thomas led UCA with 89 rushing yards and two touchdowns, while Darrien Daniels had 83 yards and a touchdown. Desmond Smith made five catches for 63 yards and a touchdown, Justin Dickey made two catches for 82 yards and a touchdown, and Courtney Whitehead had a 60-yard touchdown reception.

UCA totaled 545 yards of offense, with 258 rushing and 287 passing, while HBU gained 131 yards - 79 on the ground and 52 through the air. The Bears converted 21 first downs and the Huskies made 13.
