#### PREGAME REPORT

HOUSTON - HBU returns to Southland Conference action after a bye week and playing its first-ever FBS opponent two weeks ago when it hosts Nicholls on Homecoming Saturday at 7 p.m. at Husky Stadium. The Legacy Sports Network broadcast will be available on HBUHuskies. com, while the video stream will be available on FOX Sports Go.

The Huskies (2-3, 1-2 SLC) are led by senior quarterback Tony Dawson, who has completed 67-of-133 passes for 776 yards, two touchdowns, no interceptions and has added 162 yards and a score on the ground. Junior running back Terrance Peters has rushed for 372 yards (93.0 yds/game) and four touchdowns. Junior Isaiah Hall is HBU's leading receiver with 21 catches, while junior Wesley Lewis leads in receiving yards, catching 11 passes for 217 yards (19.7 yds/rec) and a touchdown.

breakups, although HBU does not have an interception through the first five games.



Sophomore David Racine and junior H-back Mev Ajdin also have a touchdown reception apiece. Junior linebacker Garrett Dolan ranks fourth in the nation and leads the SLC with 12.0 tackles per game (60 total), has a pair of sacks, a fumble forced and a fumble recovery. Junior safety La'Travien Gee is second on the team with 31 stops, has a sack and has also forced a fumble and recovered one. Junior cornerback Derek Broussard leads the Huskies with four pass

On special teams, junior punter Christian Guzman is averaging 40.7 yards on 43 attempts, while sophomore kicker Alec Chadwick is 7-for-10 on field goals, setting a new HBU single-season record for field goals made, and is 8-for-8 on extra points. Freshman Otis Lanier made his debut as a kick returner two weeks ago at Western Kentucky, getting eight opportunities for 115 yards.

Nicholls (3-2, 2-1) is paced by quarterback Chase Fourcade, who has completed 84-of-152 passes for 993 yards, seven touchdowns and five interceptions. C.J. Okpalobi is the Colonels' leading rusher with 306 yards and three touchdowns, while Dontrell Taylor has 248 rushing yards and three scores. C.J. Bates has made 19 receptions for 240 yards and a touchdown, and Damion Jeanpiere has 14 catches for 228 yards and three touchdowns.

B.T. Sanders leads the Colonels with 36 tackles and has an interception and forced fumble, whereas Hezekiah White has totaled 35 stops and broken up three passes. Sully Laiche has made 32 tackles, leads Nicholls with four sacks and has forced a fumble. Jeff Hall and Christian Boutte each have two interceptions, with Hall making returns of 91 yards and 46 yards.

Tyler St. Germain is averaging 41.1 on 40 punts, while David McKey has made 5-of-7 field goals and 16-of-17 extra points. Stefano Guarisco has averaged 24.1 yards on 18 kickoff returns.

The all-time series between HBU and Nicholls is tied 1-1, with each team holding serve at home. The Huskies recorded their first-ever conference win with a 31-21 victory over the Colonels on Oct. 25, 2014, in Houston. Last season, Nicholls returned the favor, handing HBU a 38-17 defeat on Oct. 17 in Thibodaux.

The Huskies play four of their last five games on the road, including the next three. HBU will travel to face Southeastern Louisiana Oct. 22 in Hammond, followed by Lamar Oct. 29 in Beaumont, then another FBS and Conference USA matchup at UTEP Nov. 5 in El Paso.

#### SHEALY QUOTES (10/11)

"I think getting healthy again had to be a first priority for us as a staff. We had been through a tough month there of the injuries just kind of building on the previous week, so hopefully we'll get most of the kids back and get more healthy and then just go back and fundamentally play better, refine some things and execute better in practice."

"We've got great respect for what Coach (Tim) Rebowe and his staff and the players there at Nicholls have done in two years under his leadership. As a coach, you look at how they play and the way they create opportunities for themselves, fundamentally how sound they are and how hard they play and how tough and physical they are. It's what we all want as coaches, for our kids to look at on tape, it's an impressive bunch and I think when you look at some of the toughness of their schedule, they've had to play some good teams, and they played them well. I think that this is a team that probably everybody in our league doesn't want to play now, because of their ability to win on any given day and to physically beat you up when you play them, so it's going to be a tough game."

"Garrett (Dolan) we all probably feel like he's been around for a while and feel like he's played a lot of games — and he has. Garrett is a tough, physical, inside guy and with those type linebackers he's really defined by, you want to be able to have a guy that, at the point of attack, is not going to turn out on a block made in the hole, that he's going to stay square and knock the ball-carrier back and he's going to physically set a tempo for who you are as a defense and is going to be relentless to put pressure on the quarterback. Garrett has been a great leader for us also, so we have probably come to expect certain things by Garrett, in terms of the certain number of plays that you can predict he will make, we feel like he's gotten better at tackling in space, has become a better coverage backer and made some improvements that had to be made and has become our "bell cow" on defense."

"Tony Dawson has made more plays off-schedule than you probably would like for all of us to reproduce and recreate offensive execution, but whenever an individual player makes a great play, you are obviously thankful for when those plays are made and Tony has made some things happen just based on his own ability to move his feet. His leadership has been tremendous, his enthusiasm and the confidence he's playing with, we feel like he's gotten better every week. We really feel like his first half against Western Kentucky may have been his single-best half of football, then pretty early on in the third quarter he got hit, so we felt it was in our best interest to keep him healthy for the rest of the season. We feel like he continues to grow. Terrance Peters got hurt against Sam early on in the second half and we kept him out last week just to get him more healthy. He looked really good in practice last week and looked really fast in practice yesterday, so I hope he continues to stay healthy, because if he does, he can be a difference-maker"

#### **STORYLINES**

#### **FIRST FBS FOES**

Now in its third official season, HBU played its first FBS opponent when it traveled to face defending Conference USA champion Western Kentucky Oct. 1 in Bowling Green, Kentucky. The Huskies fell to the Hilltoppers, 50-3. HBU will face another FBS and Conference USA opponent when it squares off against UTEP at the Sun Bowl in El Paso, Texas, on Nov. 5. All 11 of the Huskies' opponents are Division I members, with the other non-conference game at home against Texas Southern on Sept. 10, plus their eight Southland Conference games.

#### **MANY RETURNS**

With its initial class now fourth-year juniors, the Huskies have a junior class of 40 and return 10 starters on offense and nine starters on defense. The lone loss to graduation on the offensive side is tight end Max Brown, while HBU lost defensive end Josh Jones to graduation and cornerback Prince Sam, who transferred to Louisiana Tech.

#### MAN IN THE MIDDLE

Junior linebacker Garrett Dolan has started every game during his HBU career. In the opening week, he recorded the most tackles in the FCS with 18 and added a fumble recovery to be named the HERO of the Week by HERO Sports. In the win over Texas Southern, he had seven tackles and a sack, which forced a fumble the Huskies returned for a touchdown. Against Abilene Christian, Dolan recorded 17 tackles and a sack. He leads the Southland and ranks fourth nationally with 12.0 tackles per game. Last season he totaled 110 tackles in 10 games, ranking 13th nationally and second in the Southland Conference with 11.0 tackles per game. Dolan is a two-time all-SLC honorable mention selection and is a preseason second-team pick this year.

#### **BREAKOUT FOR HALL**

After catching only three passes for 40 yards in all of 2015, junior wide receiver Isaiah Hall, who came to HBU as a quarterback, led the Huskies with eight catches for 90 yards against Central Arkansas, including a 41-yard reception. In the win over Texas Southern, he added seven more receptions and now has a team-leading 21 for the season.

#### **BIG DAY FOR BOWLING**

Sophomore linebacker Kyle Bowling was named the Southland Conference Special Teams Player of the Week on Sept. 19, after blocking Abilene Christian's go-ahead field goal attempt with 58 seconds left in regulation. He saw significant action on defense against the Wildcats, recording a career-high six tackles, and the Huskies went on to win their first-ever overtime game, 27-24. It was the first weekly conference honor in the program's history. Bowling also earned honorable mention for the STATS FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week.

#### **GUZMAN GETTING BACK TO FORM**

Junior punter Christian Guzman missed the final two games of the 2015 season with a knee injury suffered against Lamar. In a Sept. 17 win over Abilene Christian, he launched a 57-yarder and averaged 42.2 yards on 10 attempts. Then against #2 Sam Houston State, he had a season-best 59-yard effort, all through the air. He led the SLC and ranked 10th in the nation with a 43.6 punt average last season. Guzman had 14 punts of 50 yards or more, including a season-long of 63, one of four punts of 60-plus yards in his career. As a freshman, he was a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award, recognizing the nation's top freshman in FCS, and he was named a TonySofli.com Freshman All-America.

#### **STABLE STABLE OF BACKS**

Junior running back Terrance Peters recorded his fifth career 100-plus yard performance in a Sept. 24 loss to #2 Sam Houston State. Against Texas Southern, he totaled a school-record 155 yards on 14 carries and a pair of touchdowns. Peters had a 34-yard sideline-to-sideline touchdown on the game's opening drive, which was the HERO Sports National Play of the Week, then added a 51-yard go-ahead touchdown scamper with 4:08 left. Against Abilene Christian, he rushed for 48 yards and a pair of touchdowns and had a career-high four catches for 49 yards. He led the Huskies with 96 carries for 576 yards and two touchdowns, 82- and 78-yarders, respectively, last season. Peters recorded three 100-yard performances, all in Southland play. Junior running back B.J. Kelly rushed 62 times for 284 yards and led HBU with five touchdowns, giving him eight for his career. Combined Peters and Kelly have recorded all seven of HBU's single-game 100-yard efforts. Kelly (1,117) and Peters (1,111) have each gained more than 1,000 yards for their careers, while , with senior Craig Bell has 362.

#### **HERO HIGHLIGHT**

Junior running back Terrance Peters scored on a 34-yard touchdown run on the opening drive against Texas Southern. He started out on a sweep toward the left sideline, then stopped and completely reversed his field, where he picked up a convoy of Huskies blockers to score just inside the right pylon. The play was voted the HERO National FCS Play of the Week on the HERO Sports poll.

#### **HOME HEAVY TO ROAD READY**

Following the opener at Central Arkansas, HBU played three-straight at home at Husky Stadium, going 2-1. The Huskies hosted crosstown rival Texas Southern Sept. 10 and scored a 24-20 victory, followed by Southland Conference home games against Abilene Christian on Sept. 17, a 27-24 overtime win, and #2 Sam Houston State on Sept. 24, a 52-16 loss. The schedule now flips as HBU will have only one home game in October, followed by three-straight road games, then only one in November, with the home finale against Stephen F. Austin on Nov. 12.

#### Central Arkansas 56, HBU 13 • Sept. 1 • Estes Stadium

CONWAY, Arkansas - Central Arkansas got off to a fast start with 21 points in both the first and second quarters to deal HBU a 56-13 defeat in the season and Southland Conference opener.

Junior linebacker Garrett Dolan led HBU (0-1, 0-1 SLC) picked up where he left off, tying his school record of 18 tackles set against Incarnate Word in last season's finale, then added a fumble recovery late in the game. Senior linebacker Dorrin Turner made 13 stops and junior linebacker Cody Moncure added nine.

Junior wide receiver Isaiah Hall had career highs with eight catches for 90 yards, and sophomore wide receiver David Racine made two catches for 35 yards, including his first career touchdown. Junior running back Terrance Peters rushed 14 times for 65 yards. Senior quarterback Tony Dawson started the game, completing 10-of-27 passes for 127 yards, but was credited for a fumble on a lateral pass, which was returned for a touchdown. Junior quarterback Max Staver finished off the game, completing 8-of-13 passes for 85 yards and a touchdown.

Sophomore kicker Alec Chadwick was 2-for-3 on field goal attempts in his Huskies debut, making from 26 and 32 yards and having a 54-yard attempt blocked. Junior punter Christian Guzman returned from the knee injury that cut short his 2015 season and punted 10 times for a 38.8-yard average.

Hayden Hildebrand completed 17-of-21 passes for 238 yards and a pair of touchdowns and added 52 yards and a touchdown on the ground for UCA (1-0, 1-0). Jatavious Wilson caught six passes for 100 yards, while Desmond Smith caught six for 78 yards and a touchdown. Carlos Blackman carried 15 times for 98 yards and Keshawn Ledet had a rushing touchdown.

Roy Sutton led the Bears with seven tackles and George Odum made six tackles.

The Bears outgained the Huskies, 283-30, on the ground, and 271-212 through the air. HBU could not take advantage of its plus-one differential in takeaways. UCA had 28 first downs to HBU's 17 and it was a relatively clean game with the two teams combining for only nine penalties for 86 yards.

#### HBU 24, Texas Southern 21 • Sept. 10 • Husky Stadium

HOUSTON — HBU relinquished the lead for the first time on a Texas Southern punt return for a touchdown with just under six minutes to go, but junior running back Terrance Peters broke off a 51-yard touchdown run with 4:08 remaining and the Huskies held off the Tigers for a 24-20 victory in non-conference FCS football Saturday night at Husky Stadium.

Peters rushed 14 times for a school-record 155 yards and two touchdowns for the Huskies (1-1), while junior H-back Mev Ajdin rushed 12 times for 55 yards, most coming on HBU's final drive to run out the clock. Senior quarterback Tony Dawson completed 19-of-27 passes for 150 yards and rushed six times for 46 yards. Junior receiver Wesley Lewis caught six of those passes for 81 yards, and junior receiver Isaiah Hall made seven receptions for 24 yards.

Junior linebacker Garrett Dolan made seven tackles and a sack, which resulted in a fumble senior linebacker Terrance Manderville scooped up and returned 12 yards for a touchdown. Senior linebacker Dorrin Turner made five tackles and recorded a sack, and junior linebacker Cody Moncure also made five stops.

Averion Hurts completed 14-of-33 passes for 143 yards and a touchdown. Tylor Cook rushed 11 times for 17 yards and a TD, while also catching three passes for 42 yards. Tracy Johnson led the Tigers (0-2) with seven catches for 50 yards, and Austin Watts made three catches for 30 yards and a touchdown, then returned a punt 93 yards for a score.

Demetrius Johns and Jamal Lucas each had 14 tackles for TSU, while Zack Bamijko had 10 and Caleb Jenkins added nine.

The Huskies had 465 yards of total offense, while holding the Tigers to 123. HBU rushed for 315 and held the Tigers to minus-20 yards on the ground. Each team fumbled twice and lost one and there were no interceptions.

#### HBU 27, Abilene Christian 24 (OT) + Sept. 17 + Husky Stadium

HOUSTON — HBU wide receiver Wesley Lewis hauled in a 25-yard touchdown pass from senior quarterback Tony Dawson on the Huskies' first play in overtime to stun Abilene Christian, 27-24, in Southland Conference football at Husky Stadium.

Dawson completed 13-of-25 passes for 239 yards and the overtime touchdown, while also rushing 12 times for 70 yards and a score for the Huskies (2-1, 1-1 SLC). Lewis made two catches for 94 yards, while junior running back Terrance Peters carried 15 times for 48 yards and two touchdowns, also adding four catches for 49 yards.

Junior linebacker Garrett Dolan racked up 17 tackles, one shy of his school record, including a sack. Junior safety Taylor Thompson had a career-high 14 tackles and a pass breakup, while senior defensive end Terrance Manderville also had a career-high with 11. Junior linebacker Taylor Holmes added eight stops and junior cornerback Derek Broussard had eight tackles.

Dallas Sealey completed 32-of-45 passes for 345 yards and a touchdown, while rushing 14 times for 72 yards and a touchdown for the Wildcats (0-3, 0-1 SLC). Adrian Duncan carried 23 times for 88 yards, while Troy Grant caught seven passes for 87 yards and Josh Fink made five receptions for 72 yards.

Sam Denmark led ACU with nine tackles, while Bryson Gates and Richard Griffin III had six each.

ACU had 515 yards of total offense, compared to HBU's 389 and neither team turned the ball over. The Wildcats were plagued by 13 penalties for 90 yards.

The Wildcats' Nik Grau made his third field goal of the night, a 38-yarder, on the opening possession of overtime. HBU wasted no time answering as Lewis separated from his defender on the right side of the endzone and Dawson hit him with a strike to send the Huskies' sideline streaming to the corner in celebration.

With the game tied, 21-21, ACU had a chance to take the lead in regulation, but Grau's 37-yard field goal was blocked by sophomore linebacker Kyle Bowling with 58 seconds left.

#### #2 Sam Houston State 52, HBU 16 • Sept. 24 • Husky Stadium

HOUSTON — HBU opened the second half with a field goal and a touchdown, but second-ranked Sam Houston State responded with three unanswered touchdowns to claim a 52-16 victory in Southland Conference play.

Junior running back Terrance Peters rushed 18 times for 104 yards for the Huskies (2-2, 1-2 SLC), his second-straight 100-plus yard performance against the Bearkats (3-0, 2-0). Senior quarter-back Tony Dawson completed 15-of-34 passes for 153 yards and a touchdown, while also rushing 12 times for 53 yards. Senior wide receiver Ricardo Barnett made five catches for 60 yards, junior Isaiah Hall had four for 40 yards, and junior H-back Mev Ajdin had three catches for 36 yards and a touchdown.

Junior linebackers Garrett Dolan and Taylor Holmes had 10 tackles each to lead HBU defensively. In addition to his career-high in stops, Holmes added a forced fumble. Junior safety La'Travien Gee and freshman defensive end Andre Walker made eight tackles apiece. Sophomore kicker Alec Chadwick was 3-for-3 on field goal attempts, including an HBU school-record 46-yarder. Junior punter Christian Guzman punted 10 times for a 41.7-yard average and boomed a kick that traveled a season-long 59 yards, all in the air.

Jeremiah Briscoe completed 26-of-47 passes for 369 yards and three touchdowns for SHSU. Remus Bulmer rushed 19 times for 124 yards and a pair of touchdowns, while Javin Webb rushed for 48 yards and a pair of scores. Yedidiah Louis made six catches for 111 yards and a touchdown, Tyler Scott had three receptions for 73 yards and Davion Davis made three catches for 60 yards and a TD. Mouf Abedo led the Bearkats with eight tackles, while P.J. Hall had seven tackles and 2.5 of SHSU's five sacks. Hunter Brown also was in on seven stops for SHSU.

SHSU totaled 632 yards of offense to HBU's 370. The rushing yards were nearly even as the Bearkats edged the Huskies, 219-217, but SHSU had 260 more passing yards. Neither team threw an interception and each team lost a fumble, oddly enough, on the same play.

#### Western Kentucky 50, HBU 3 • Oct. 1 • Houchins-Smith Stadium

BOWLING GREEN, Kentucky — Western Kentucky rolled up 535 yards of total offense to down HBU, 50-3, in the Huskies' first-ever matchup against an FBS opponent Saturday night at Houchens-Smith Stadium.

Senior quarterback Tony Dawson completed 10-of-20 passes for 107 yards and added 24 rushing yards, while senior running back Craig Bell led the Huskies (2-3) with 43 yards on 15 carries. Junior wide receiver Ethan Fry caught a season-high five passes for 70 yards.

Junior linebacker Garrett Dolan made eight tackles, while freshman safety Nicholas Smith made seven. Junior linebacker Cody Moncure, freshman defensive end Andre Walker and junior safety La'Travien Gee each had a sack, with Gee's forcing a fumble. Sophomore kick Alec Chadwick provided HBU's only score with a field goal, while junior punter Chrisitian Guzman averaged 42.1 yards on seven attempts.

Mike White completed 11-of-13 passes for 225 yards and three touchdowns for WKU (3-2), while Anthony Wales rushed seven times for 87 yards and a score. Nicholas Norris's only carry netted an 85-yard touchdown and he made two catches for 53 yards and Quinton Baker rushed 10 times for 71 yards. Taywan Taylor caught seven passes for 146 yards and a touchdown.

Keith Brown led the Hilltoppers with 10 tackles, and Masai Whyte chipped in with eight. Drew Davis added an interception, the first thrown by HBU this season.

WKU had 283 passing yards and 252 rushing yards, while HBU gained 138 passing yards and 86 on the ground. The Huskies' interception was the only turnover of the game and the two teams combined for only eight penalties for 63 yards.
