PREGAME REPORT

HOUSTON - HBU returns to Southland Conference play, hosting Abilene Christian at 7 p.m. at Husky Stadium Saturday. The game will be televised on Fox College Sports and the Legacy Sports Network audio broadcast will be available on HBUHuskies.com.

HBU (1-1) is coming off a 24-20 victory over crosstown rival Texas Southern at home last Saturday. Junior running back Terrance Peters rushed for a school-record 155 yards on 14 carries with a pair of touchdowns. On the game's opening drive, he went sideline-to-sideline for a 34-yard touchdown, then scored the go-ahead touchdown on a 51-yard rumble with 4:08 left. Peters ranks third in the SLC with 110.0 rushing yards per game. Senior quarterback Tony Dawson completed 19-of-27 passes for 150 yards, while also adding 49 yards rushing on six carries. Junior receiver Isaiah Hall had seven receptions Saturday and now leads the Huskies with 15 for the season. Junior receiver Wesley Lewis caught six passes for 81 yards against the Tigers.

Junior linebacker Garrett Dolan is tied for third nationally and leads the SLC with 12.5 tackles per game and had seven stops and a sack, which forced a fumble and was returned for a touchdown. Senior linebacker Dorrin Turner is second on the team with 18 tackles and also has a sack. The defense has yet to record an interception, but has four sacks and has forced three fumbles.

Junior punter Christian Guzman is averaging 38.5 yards per kick, and sophomore kicker Alec Chadwick is 3-for-6 on field goal attempts and 4-for-4 on extra points to tie for fourth in the league in scoring with 6.5 points per game.

ACU (0-2) lost its opener to FBS foe Air Force, 37-21, then fell to Northern Colorado in a shootout last week, 55-52. Quarterback Dallas Sealey has completed 41-of-71 passes for 572 yards, four touchdowns and no interceptions, while adding 91 yards and four touchdowns on the ground. Saturday against the Bears, he was 25-for-38 with 313 passing yards with a touchdown and rushed for 97 yards and four touchdowns. Adrian Duncan rushed for 101 yards against UNC and is the Wildcats' leading rusher for the season with 125 yards. D.J. Fuller is ACU's leading receiver with 11 receptions for 191 yards, and Justin Miller has made eight catches for 103 yards.

On defense, Sam Denmark has made 22 tackles and has made the Wildcats' lone interception for the year. Byron Gates and Gavin Burford each have 18 tackles, with Burford recording one of the team's two sacks. ACU has forced four fumbles through two games, recovering three of them.

Punter Austin Kilcullen has 12 attempts for 42.9 yards with a long of 65 yards, three of 50-plus yards, and four inside the 20. Nik Grau is 1-for-1 on field goal attempts, while Brendan Conn is 0-for-1, but is 10-for-10 on extra points.

The Huskies will play their third-straight home game next week when they face No. 3 Sam Houston State in SLC action Saturday on Family Weekend at Husky Stadium at 7 p.m. The game will also be televised on Fox College Sports.

SHEALY QUOTES (9/13)

On Texas Southern: "We're excited we found a way to win. I don't think there's a coach, no matter whether you've had great success or are struggling to find it, in the locker room after the game with those kids are good moments. I think we all savor those moments and it's just great to see our kids handle some adversity in the game and come from behind there in the fourth quarter and find a way to win, and I think that's building confidence as we grow our program."

On Abilene Christian: "Ken (Collums) does such a phenomenal job there, and they've played two really good football teams, and I know just in my time as a long-time assistant at Air Force, it's a tough place to play in The (Colorado) Springs, particularly on opening weekend. (ACU) played well defensively, and their toughness, and some of the things that really didn't get decided until late in the second half of that game, in terms of who was going to win that game is a credit to what they did there. Last week, I think they kind of ran into one of those anomalies, where you had a quarterback who had beyond a career-type of day, and I don't know how many opportunities someone has to re-create that. It's obviously a lot of points scored there and I think we all know (ACU) did a great job is very talented and this is an important game going back into conference play after losing, in a big way, to Central Arkansas. It's going to show (UCA) is a really fine team and I think we were all flabbergasted trying to make sense of it, I'm sure Coach (Steve) Campbell has a lot to do with some of the lop-sidedness of that game, but we have to come back and play much better this week."

On areas of improvement: "We got in the low red (zone) several times and didn't -- offensively -- finish drives off, and you do those things early, then we had a punt return there that, as a coach, is probably one of the most difficult plays to see how it happen for a touchdown to let Texas Southern take the lead. There's some areas there in the red zone we have to improve and just consistency defensively. We gave up a deep ball, then had a couple of penalties that aided on that particular scoring drive, so I think it's just a matter of playing cleaner. We're all trying to build those consistencies and predictability, so it's just the normal grind to improve each week."

FIRST FBS FOES

Now in its third official season, HBU will play its first Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponents when they travel to defending Conference USA champion Western Kentucky Oct. 1 in Bowling Green, Kentucky, and UTEP at the Sun Bowl in El Paso, Texas, on Nov. 5. All 11 of the Huskies' opponents are Division I members, with the other non-conference game at home against Texas Southern on Sept. 10, plus their eight Southland Conference games.

MANY RETURNS

With its initial class now fourth-year juniors, the Huskies have a junior class of 40 and return 10 starters on offense and nine starters on defense. The lone loss to graduation on the offensive side is tight end Max Brown, while HBU lost defensive end Josh Jones to graduation and cornerback Prince Sam, who transferred to Louisiana Tech.

MAN IN THE MIDDLE

Junior linebacker Garrett Dolan has started every game during his HBU career. In the opening week, he recorded the most tackles in the FCS with 18 and added a fumble recovery to be named the HERO of the Week by HERO Sports. In Saturday's win over Texas Southern, he had seven tackles and a sack, which forced a fumble the Huskies returned for a touchdown. He is tied for third nationally with 12.5 tackles per game. Last season he totaled 110 tackles in 10 games, ranking 13th nationally and second in the Southland Conference with 11.0 tackles per game. His redshirt freshman season, Dolan led the Huskies with 82 tackles in 11 games. Dolan is a two-time all-SLC honorable mention selection and is a preseason second-team pick this year.

BREAKOUT FOR HALL

After catching only three passes for 40 yards in all of 2015, junior wide receiver Isaiah Hall, who came to HBU as a quarterback, led the Huskies with eight catches for 90 yards against Central Arkansas, including a 41-yard reception. In Saturday's win over Texas Southern, he added seven more receptions to rank in a tie for seventh nationally and tying for the league lead with 7.5 receptions per game.

GUZMAN BACK FROM INJURY

Junior punter Christian Guzman missed the final two games of the 2015 season with a knee injury suffered against Lamar. He led the SLC and ranked 10th in the nation with a 43.6 punt average. Guzman had 14 punts of 50 yards or more, including a season-long of 63, one of four punts of 60-plus yards in his career. As a freshman, he was a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award, recognizing the nation's top freshman in FCS, and he was named a TonySofli.com Freshman All-America.

STABLE STABLE OF BACKS

Junior running back Terrance Peters recorded his fourth career 100-plus yard performance with a school-record 155 yards on 14 carries and a pair of touchdowns in Saturday's win over Texas Southern. He had a 34-yard sideline-to-sideline touchdown on the game's opening drive, which was a finalist for HERO Sports National Play of the Week, then added a 51-yard go-ahead touchdown scamper with 4:08 left. led the Huskies with 96 carries for 576 yards and two touchdowns, 82- and 78-yarders, respectively, last season. Peters recorded three 100-yard performances, all in Southland play. Junior running back B.J. Kelly rushed 62 times for 284 yards and led HBU with five touchdowns, giving him eight for his career. Combined Peters and Kelly have recorded all six of HBU's single-game 100-yard efforts. Kelly has 1,037 career rushing yards, followed by Peters with 955 and senior Craig Bell at 285.

DAWSON, STAVER BATTLE TO THE END

Senior quarterback Tony Dawson and junior quarterback Max Staver have competed for the starting position since spring camp in March, with both showing improvement and success with the offense. Dawson was tabbed the starter last week at Central Arkansas and completed 10-of-27 passes for 127 yards, while Staver completed 8-of-13 for 85 yards and a 31-yard touchdown to David Racine. Dawson played the entire game against Texas Southern, completing 19-of-27 passes for 150 yards and adding 46 yards on six carries on the ground. Staver started nine games last season, completing 80-of-187 passes for 1,010 yards and five touchdowns and Dawson starting one game, completing 34-of-68 passes for 360 yards, one touchdown and gaining another 111 yards on the ground.

SEPTEMBER HOMESTAND

Following the opener at Central Arkansas, HBU will play three-straight at home at Husky Stadium. The Huskies host crosstown rival Texas Southern Sept. 10, followed by Southland Conference home games against Abilene Christian on Sept. 17 and Sam Houston State on Sept. 24. The schedule then flips as HBU will have only one home game in October and one in November.

RECAPS - GAME 1

Central Arkansas 56, HBU 13 • Sept. 1 • Conway, Arkansas

CONWAY, Arkansas - Central Arkansas got off to a fast start with 21 points in both the first and second quarters to deal HBU a 56-13 defeat in the season and Southland Conference opener.

Junior linebacker Garrett Dolan led HBU (0-1, 0-1 SLC) picked up where he left off, tying his school record of 18 tackles set against Incarnate Word in last season's finale, then added a fumble recovery late in the game. Senior linebacker Dorrin Turner made 13 stops and junior linebacker Cody Moncure added nine.

Junior wide receiver Isaiah Hall had career highs with eight catches for 90 yards, and sophomore wide receiver David Racine made two catches for 35 yards, including his first career touchdown. Junior running back Terrance Peters rushed 14 times for 65 yards. Senior quarterback Tony Dawson started the game, completing 10-of-27 passes for 127 yards, but was credited for a fumble on a lateral pass, which was returned for a touchdown. Junior quarterback Max Staver finished off the game, completing 8-of-13 passes for 85 yards and a touchdown.

Sophomore kicker Alec Chadwick was 2-for-3 on field goal attempts in his Huskies debut, making from 26 and 32 yards and having a 54-yard attempt blocked. Junior punter Christian Guzman returned from the knee injury that cut short his 2015 season and punted 10 times for a 38.8-yard average.

Hayden Hildebrand completed 17-of-21 passes for 238 yards and a pair of touchdowns and added 52 yards and a touchdown on the ground for UCA (1-0, 1-0). Jatavious Wilson caught six passes for 100 yards, while Desmond Smith caught six for 78 yards and a touchdown. Carlos Blackman carried 15 times for 98 yards and Keshawn Ledet had a rushing touchdown.

Roy Sutton led the Bears with seven tackles and George Odum made six tackles.

The Bears outgained the Huskies, 283-30, on the ground, and 271-212 through the air. HBU could not take advantage of its plus-one differential in takeaways. UCA had 28 first downs to HBU's 17 and it was a relatively clean game with the two teams combining for only nine penalties for 86 yards.

HBU 24, Texas Southern ♦ Sept. 10 ♦ Husky Stadium

HOUSTON – HBU relinquished the lead for the first time on a Texas Southern punt return for a touchdown with just under six minutes to go, but junior running back Terrance Peters broke off a 51-yard touchdown run with 4:08 remaining and the Huskies held off the Tigers for a 24-20 victory in non-conference FCS football Saturday night at Husky Stadium.

Peters rushed 14 times for a school-record 155 yards and two touchdowns for the Huskies (1-1), while junior H-back Mev Ajdin rushed 12 times for 55 yards, most coming on HBU's final drive to run out the clock. Senior quarterback Tony Dawson completed 19-of-27 passes for 150 yards and rushed six times for 46 yards. Junior receiver Wesley Lewis caught six of those passes for 81 yards, and junior receiver Isaiah Hall made seven receptions for 24 yards.

Junior linebacker Garrett Dolan made seven tackles and a sack, which resulted in a fumble senior linebacker Terrance Manderville scooped up and returned 12 yards for a touchdown. Senior linebacker Dorrin Turner made five tackles and recorded a sack, and junior linebacker Cody Moncure also made five stops.

Averion Hurts completed 14-of-33 passes for 143 yards and a touchdown. Tylor Cook rushed 11 times for 17 yards and a TD, while also catching three passes for 42 yards. Tracy Johnson led the Tigers (0-2) with seven catches for 50 yards, and Austin Watts made three catches for 30 yards and a touchdown, then returned a punt 93 yards for a score.

Demetrius Johns and Jamal Lucas each had 14 tackles for TSU, while Zack Bamijko had 10 and Caleb Jenkins added nine.

The Huskies had 465 yards of total offense, while holding the Tigers to 123. HBU rushed for 315 and held the Tigers to minus-20 yards on the ground. Each team fumbled twice and lost one and there were no interceptions.
