PREGAME REPORT

NATCHITOCHES, La. – The HBU football team is set for its final road game of the 2021 season this Saturday when the Huskies face Southland Conference foe Northwestern State at Turpin Stadium at 3:00 p.m. The game will be aired on ESPN+ while the Husky Sports Network audio broadcast with Garrett Jones handling play-by-play will be available at HBUHuskies. com.



Orion Olivas, HBU's true freshman quarterback, is coming off a game in which he set new career highs for completions (38), completion percentage (77.6) and yards (274). He has completed 57.9 percent (99-of-171) this season for 848 yards.

Sophomore Tyson Thompson leads the Huskies (0-8, 0-5 SLC) with 47 receptions for 443 yards with a pair of touchdowns and posted his first career 100-yard receiving game last weekend at UIW. Thompson also continues to lead the FCS in combined kick return yardage with 800 combined yards between punt and kickoff returns.

Defensively, linebackers Rodney Dansby and Brennan Young continue to rack up the tackles. Dansby, a freshman, ranks sixth in the nation with 10.9 tackles per game with Young, a senior, not far behind at 23rd with 9.4 tackles per game. Junior Kyler Baugh leads the team with 3.5 sacks, picking up a solo sack in the team's last game at UIW.

Northwestern State (1-7, 1-4 SLC) freshman quarterback Zachary Clement is 52-of-98 for 636 yards this season with two touchdowns and three interceptions. Clement also has 231 yards on the ground and seven rushing touchdowns. Sophomore running back Curtis Williams has gained 246 yards on the ground on 48 carries and Jay Griffin leads the receivers with three touchdowns, 35 receptions and 433 yards.

Junior linebacker Jomard Valsin leads the Demons defensively with 50 tackles while junior defensive end Isaiah Longino is second in the conference with 5.5 sacks this year.

The two teams met in Houston on Oct. 9 with the Demons escaping with a 21-17 win over the Huskies.

The Huskies will be at home for their final two games of the 2021 season, first hosting McNeese on Saturday, Nov. 13, at 2:00 p.m. for Homecoming.

STORYLINES

UPDATE ON QB BLAISE BENTSEN

Sophomore quarterback Blaise Bentsen suffered a head injury at Prairie View A&M on Sept. 18 and announced via Instagram on Oct. 14 that he will not return to football. After leading HBU to a go-ahead score at the end of the second quarter, he was care-flighted at halftime to Memorial Hermann-Texas Medical Center, where he underwent surgery late that evening. The procedure was deemed successful and the prognosis has been encouraging as Bentsen has been recovering at home in Sherman.

HONORING #40

At the home opener on Sept. 11, HBU football unveiled its first Honored Number -- #40 worn by linebacker Garrett Dolan. Dolan was the Huskies' first All-American, earning the honors twice in 2016 and 2017, and finished his career ranked seventh all-time in FCS history in tackles. He tragically passed away at the end of his senior year in May 2018.

DANSBY NAMED TO JERRY RICE AWARD WATCH LIST

Freshman linebacker Rodney Dansby has been named to the 2021 Stats Perform FCS Jerry Rice Award Watch List. Dansby is averaging 10.9 tackles per game for the season and 14 per game in SLC play.

THOMPSON ELECTRIC ON RETURNS

Sophomore Tyson Thompson leads all FCS players in combined return yards this season with 800 yards on punt and kickoff returns. With a punt return TD already to his name in the season opener at New Mexico, Thompson took a kickoff 89 yards to the house two weeks ago against Nicholls. His 27.2 yards per kickoff return ranks 13th nationally. On top of that, Thompson's all-purpose yardage average of 155.25 is second-best in the country.

BALL HAWKS ON D

The HBU defensive unit ranks 3rd in the nation in fumbles recovered, totaling 11 through 8 games this season. 10 different players have recovered fumbles while freshman safety Xavier Toliver has forced 3.

TOUCHDOWN KING

Receiver Charles King set HBU's freshman record for touchdown receptions with his fifth of the season at No. 11 Southeastern on Oct. 16. Jerreth Sterns had four in 2018 and Josh Sterns also had four in 2020. King caught a touchdown pass in each of his first four career games.

GARCIA MOVES UP CHARTS

Junior kicker Gino Garcia made the second-longest field goal in school history with his 59-yarder at Southeastern on Oct. 16. Alec Chadwick made a 60-yard field goal at UIW in 2016. Garcia has made 7-of-8 field goals this season, tying for 9th nationally in field goal percentage and moving ahead of Chadwick for the most career made field goals in school history with 30.

BUELL BOOMS

Senior punter Brady Buell was named Southland Conference Special Teams Player of the Week on Sept. 6, setting a single-game school record with a 50.9-yard average on nine attempts. His 59-yard punt that went out of bounds inside the New Mexico 1-yard line at the end of the first quarter, set up sophomore wide receiver Tyson Thompson's 44-yard punt return for a touchdown. Also this season, Buell had the second-longest punt in school history, a 79-yarder, go out of bounds at the one against Northern Colorado. He earned Player of the Week again on Oct. 4, after averaging 47.8 yards on 10 punts and holding Nicholls to minus-four yards of punt return yardage.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

HBU had six selection to the Preseason All-Southland Conference Teams. Junior center Christian Hood and senior safety Patrick Wolfe were auto-

matic selections as first-team all-conference honorees last season and were joined by senior running back Dreshawn Minnieweather, senior defensive lineman Segun Ijiyera, junior defensive lineman Philip Ossai and senior linebacker Brennan Young.

JOHNSON MAKES BEARS 53-MAN ROSTER

Linebacker Caleb Johnson became the first HBU football player to make an NFL 53-man roster when the Chicago Bears made their final cut. The undrafted free agent turned heads in the preseason, making 17 tackles and two fumble recoveries in the Bears' three preseason contests, and made his debut on special teams at the Los Angeles Rams on Sept. 12. He made his first career tackle on Sept. 26 against the Cleveland Browns.

LINEBACKER U

Freshman linebacker Rodney Dansby leads the league and is 6th nationally with 10.9 tackles per game, while senior linebacker Brennan Young ranks fourth in the league and 23rd in the nation with 9.4 tackles per game. HBU has produced the leading tackler in the Southland Conference each of the last five seasons, including the top two leading tacklers in 2019, and a top-five tackler nationally each of those seasons. Caleb Johnson led the league and ranked fourth nationally with 12.2 tackles per game in 2020. Young led the league and ranked fifth in the FCS with 11.3 tackles per game, while Johnson ranked second in the Southland and 10th nationally with 10.4 tackles per game in 2019. In 2018, Langston Tunson led the conference and ranked fourth in the nation and in both 2016 and 2017, Garrett Dolan led the conference and ranked second in the nation. In 2015, Dolan was second in the league and 13th nationally as a sophomore.

DANSBY JOINS 19-TACKLE CLUB

Freshman linebacker Rodney Dansby tied the single-game school record with 19 tackles at No. 11 Southeastern on Oct. 16. The feat has now been accomplished five times as he joins Garrett Dolan (twice), Langston Tunson and Brennan Young.

Junior defensive lineman Philip Ossai's brother, Joseph, was drafted out of the University of Texas by the Cincinnati Bengals in the third round of the 2021 NFL Draft. Sophomore safety Isaiah Cash's father, Kerry, and his uncle, Keith, each played football at the University of Texas, and his mother, Kim, played soccer for the Longhorns. This year will be the first season senior running back Ean Beek is not playing at HBU with his brother, Ethan, who graduated. Their mother, Karla, played volleyball for the Huskies. Senior wide receiver Jaylon Johnson's brother, Cameron, is a wide receiver at Rice. Senior tight end Coleman Robinson's father, Rusty, was a defensive back at Texas Tech. Junior long snapper Garrett Scott's brother, Joel, played football at Arkansas. Isaiah Williams' father, Terrence, was an NCAA champion in the 4x400-meter relay. After having multiple sets of brothers on the team for the last few years, the Huskies have only one set on this year's squad, Deandre and Desmond Malone.

FORMER HUSKIES IN THE FBS

HBU lost seven players to the FBS ranks following the 2020 season. Quarterback Bailey Zappe and wide receivers Jerreth and Josh Sterns and Ben Ratzlaff are all at Western Kentucky. Safety Tra Fluellen is at Middle Tennesee, offensive lineman Reynard Burnett is at Florida International and offensive lineman Doro Omerhi is at New Mexico State.

Tyreke Boyd led the Colonels with six tackles and made two interceptions, returning one for a touchdown. Perry Ganci added 1.5 sacks, while Jamiran James and Johnel Jollla Jr. each had a sack.

Nicholls had 30 first downs to HBU's 15 and each team turned the ball over twice – all in the first quarter.

SAN ANTONIO, Texas – Despite the team's best offensive output of the season, HBU dropped a Southland Conference matchup to 22nd-ranked UIW, 49-21, on Saturday afternoon at Benson Stadium.

The Huskies (0-8, 0-5 SLC) finished the game with 364 yards of offense, the team's highest total of the season, with freshman quarterback Orion Olivas completing 38-of-49 passes for 274 yards and a touchdown with one interception.

Sophomore receiver Tyson Thompson eclipsed the 100-yard mark for the first time in his career, finishing with 103 yards on 16 catches with a touchdown. Thompson also added 74 yards on three kickoff returns for 177 all-purpose yards. Vernon Harrell, meanwhile, returned to the lineup and totaled eight catches for 91 yards. Xzavier Ford ended the day with 62 yards rushing on 13 carries with Ean Beek adding 46 yards on the ground on eight carries.

Freshman linebacker Rodney Dansby continues to pile up the tackles, finishing with 17 stops with one tackle for a loss. Over the last three games, he is averaging 16.7 tackles per game. Senior linebacker Brennan Young added 11 tackles with one for a loss. Punter Brady Buell averaged 42.7 yards on three punts with a long of 52, placing two inside the UIW 20.

UIW (6-2, 4-1 SLC) was led by sophomore quarterback Cameron Ward who finished 34-of-46 passing for 328 yards and four touchdowns. Robert Ferrel had 10 catches for 102 yards and two scores while Marcus Cooper had two rushing touchdowns and 104 yards on the ground.
