

PREGAME REPORT





Sophomore quarterback Justin Fomby has completed 121-of-194 passes for 1,267 yards, 11 touchdowns and four interceptions for the Huskies (2-3, 1-1 SLC). Junior wide receiver Karl Reynolds has 26 catches for 412 yards and five touchdowns, while junior Vernon Harrell has 15 catches for 188 yards and junior Deon Cormier has 19 catches for 118 yards and a touchdown. HCU freshman running back Ismail Mahdi has rushed for 263 yards and a touchdown and made seven catches for 149 yards and two touchdowns, but has missed the last three games.

Sophomore linebacker Rodney Dansby leads the Southland and ranks third nationally with 11.8 tackles per game, while senior linebacker Brennan Young ranks third in the league and is tied for fifth nationally at 10.6. Junior linebacker Jalyx Hunt ranks fifth in the league with 47 tackles, ranks second with 5.0 sacks, has forced two fumbles and has seven quarterback hurries. The Huskies are tied for the national lead with nine fumble recoveries, but Elon has played one more game.

Zachary Clement has completed 106-of-194 passes for 1,250 yards, nine touchdowns and four interceptions and added 136 rushing yards and two touchdowns for NSU (2-4, 2-0). Javon Antonio has 40 catches for 438 yards and four touchdowns, while Zach Patterson has 40 catches for 385 yards and three scores. Kenneth Lacy has rushed for 152 yards and a touchdown.

Race Moser and Jared Pedraza each have 41 tackles for the Demons. NSU has six sacks on the year with three interceptions and a fumble recovery.

NSU leads the all-time series against HCU, 4-1, including sweeping a pair of four-point decisions in last year's home-and-home series.

HCU alternates road and home games for the rest of the season, beginning with a trip to new Southland rival Texas A&M-Commerce Saturday, Oct. 22 in Commerce.

STORYLINES

SCORING DEFENSE

HCU has returned three fumbles for touchdowns this season. Holding a 39-34 lead and Northern Colorado driving in the final minute, freshman Jacoby Brass forced a fumble on sack and junior linebacker Jalyx Hunt returned it 52 yards for the game-sealing touchdown. In a 37-34 victory over Lamar, the Huskies scored on back-to-back fumble returns for touchdowns. After a scoreless first quarter, redshirt freshman linebacker Zavion Evans forced a fumble and sophomore linebacker Rodney Dansby returned it 18 yards for a touchdown for the first score of the game early in the second quarter. On the Cardinals' next possession, Evans struck again, forcing another fumble, which was picked up by senior Coi Miller, who returned it 40 yards for a score. The Huskies are tied for the national lead with nine fumble recoverie, but Elon has played one more game.

HUNT-ING FOR THE BALL

Junior linebacker Jalyx Hunt was named the Southland Conference Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 5. He filled up the stat sheet with eight tackles, 1.5 for loss, a sack, a quarterback hurry, a pass breakup, a forced fumble and returned a fumble for a touchdown in the 46-34 victory over Northern Colorado. With the Huskies clinging to a 39-34 lead and the Bears driving into HCU territory with less than a minute remaining, freshman defensive end Jacoby Brass came up with a sack, forcing a fumble, then Hunt scooped it up and returned it 52 yards for the game-sealing touchdown. Hunt ranks second in the conference with 5.0 sacks, which included a forced fumble on a sack in the fourth quarter at Lamar, and has seven quarterback hurries. He also ranks fifth in the league with 47 tackles and leads the conference with nine tackles for loss.

HOME RUN HITTERS

HCU recorded three of the longest scoring plays in HBU history all in the same game in the opener against Northern Colorado. Freshman running back Ismail Mahdi's 78-yard touchdown run is tied for the fourth-longest play from scrimmage and his 74-yard touchdown reception ranks ninth. Junior wide receiver Karl Reynolds' 66-yard touchdown ranked 11th at the time, but was knocked down to 13th by the end of the game.

BUELL ON FCS PUNTER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Senior punter Brady Buell was a semifinalist for the FCS Punter of the Year in 2021 and is on the preseason watch list for the award again in 2022. He was a first-team all-conference selection a year ago, averaging 42.0 yards per attempt.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

HCU had five players selected to the Preseason All-Southland Teams, inculding first-team selections in sophomore linebacker Rodney Dansby and senior punter Brady Buell. Senior linebacker Brennan Young, senior safety Coi Miller and sophomore safety Isaiah Cash made the second team.

LINEBACKER U

An HCU linebacker has led the Southland Conference and ranked among the top five in the FCS each of the last six seasons. Freshman linebacker Rodney Dansby led the league and ranked second nationally as a true freshman with 11.3 tackles per game in 2021. Caleb Johnson led the league and ranked fourth nationally with 12.2 tackles per game in 2020. Brennan Young led the league and ranked fifth in the FCS with 11.3 tackles per game in 2019. In 2018, Langston Tunson led the conference and ranked fourth in the nation and in both 2016 and 2017, Garrett Dolan led the conference and ranked second in the nation to earn back-to-back All-America honors. Dansby currently leads the league and ranks third nationally, while Young ranks third in the league and is tied for fifth nationally.

MAHDI SHINES IN OPENER

Freshman running back Ismail Mahdi was named the Stats Perform FedEx

Ground National Freshman Player of the Week as well as the Southland Conference Offensive Player of the Week. He rushed 25 times for 184 yards, the third most in school history and the most by a running back, including a 78-yard touchdown. He also caught two passes for 83 yards, including a 74-yard touchdown. Mahdi has missed the last three games with a foot injury.

YOUNG A SEMIFINALIST FOR CAMPBELL TROPHY

Senior linebacker Brennan Young was named one of 156 semifinalists Wednesday for the National Football Foundation's Campbell Trophy, the "academic Heisman" of college football. Young graduated from HCU in December of 2021 with a 3.72 GPA in marketing and is now pursuing a Master of Business Administration. He is a two-time member of the FCS Athletic Directors Association Academic All-Star Team and made the Southland Conference All-Academic Team.

HUSKIES IN THE NFL

Undrafted free agent linebacker Caleb Johnson became the first HCU football player to make an NFL 53-man roster with the Chicago Bears in 2021 and made his debut against the eventual Super Bowl champion Los Angeles Rams on Sept. 12, 2021. Johnson was released by the Bears prior to the 2022 season, but was immediately picked up by the Jacksonville Jaguars and has made four tackles this year. Quarterback Bailey Zappe became the first Husky to be drafted when he was selected in the fourth round with the 137th pick by the New England Patriots in the 2022 NFL Draft. Zappe made his NFL debut this past Sunday against the Green Bay Packers and became the first player to throw a touchdown pass when making his debut at Lambeau Field. He then made his first start against the Detroit Lions on Oct. 9, leading the Patriots to a 29-0 victory.

FAMILY TIES

Offensive coordinator/wide receivers coach Cedric Comier is coaching a very familiar face, as his son, wide receiver Deon Cormier, transferred to HBU from McNeese. Desmond and Deandre Malone are the only set of siblings on the Huskies' roster this year. Freshman linebacker Kalim Mikhail is the son of Karim Mikhail, who was a member of Head Coach Vic Shealy's 1998 NAIA National Championship team at Azusa Pacific.

SCHEDULE QUIRK

After previously not playing more than two non-conference FCS opponents in the same season, HCU will play four this season for the first time in program history. Northern Colorado was the second leg of a home-and-home series, Lindenwood was a Division II program when the game was originally scheduled, UT Martin is part of the scheduling cohort with the Ohio Valley Conference and Tarleton was added before UIW announced it was remaining in the Southland Conference.

HCU jumped out to a 30-point lead sparked by a pair of defensive scores, before Lamar roared back, but the Huskies escaped with a 37-34 victory in the Southland Conference opener Saturday afternoon at Provost Umphrey Stadium.

Michael Chandler completed 11-of-27 passes for 239 yards and two touchdowns and rushed 13 times for 45 yards and two more scores for the Cardinals (0-5, 0-2). Kyndon Fuselier had three catches for 104 yards and Devyn Gibbs made four catches for 35 yards and two touchdowns.
