### READ IT, TWEET IT

In her first game back from injury in over a year, Khadaijia Brooks scored a double-double against Indiana State. The RS-Jr. had 16 points and 11 boards. She added 2 blocks as well.

@HerdWBB senior Shayna Gore has had 2 of the top-10 best single season scoring performances with 526 (10th) in 16-17 & 568 (8th) in 17-18.

Shayna Gore scored 34 at BGSU and passed Tynikki Crook (2007-11) for 4th all-time in scoring.

Shayna Gore tied the Stroh Center single-game points record with a career-high 34 in the loss at Bowling Green.

@HerdWBB currently sports 3 of the best 3-point shooters in program history. Gore is 1st with 215 made, Fraley is 13th with 74 and Porter is tied for 14th with 72.

@HerdWBB freshman G Kia Sivils scored 12 points and had 3 assists and no turnovers in 25 minutes of point guard action at BGSU.

Gore, Mayo and Brooks are a combined 18-for-18 from the free throw line through two games.

#### #11 - Taylor Porter

- Began collegiate career at Murray State in 2013-14 before transferring to Marshall
- Missed all of the 2017-18 season with a medical redshirt.
- Has played 56 games in her Herd career with 43 starts.
- Tied for 14th all-time in program history with 72 made three-pointers.

#### #14 - Shayna Gore

- Can be found all throughout the record book.
- Fourth all-time in scoring with 1,490 points. Seventh all-time in fields goals made with 515. Fifth in field goals attempted with 1,199. First in three-pointers made with 216. First in three-pointers attempted with 605. Sixth in three-point FG percentage 35.7. 15th in steals with 145 and 11th in free throws made with 244.
- In 2018, for the first time in career, did not open the season with at least 20 points.
- Set career-high with 34 points at Bowling Green which also tied the Stroh Center record for most points in a game. Set by Presley Hudson of Central Michigan on Jan. 14, 2017.

#### #20 - Taylor Pearson

- Recorded eight rebounds and led the Herd with five assists in her start against Indiana State (11/7).
- Grabbed her 100th career rebound against Indiana State (11/7).
- Averaged just under 20 minutes a game during freshman season. Played career-high 34 minutes against Indiana State (11/7).
- Had season-high 10 points and added six rebounds at Southern Illinois (11/17).

#### #22 - Khadaijia Brooks

- Recorded fourth career double-double in season opener vs. Indiana State (11/7) with 16 points and 11 rebounds.
- Missed all of 2017-18 season with a medical redshirt.
- Grabbed her 200th career board against Indiana State (11/7).
- Was averaging 6.5 rebounds per contest in 2016-17 before missing the final eight games with a knee injury.

#### #23 - Kristen Mayo

- Has started 28 of 32 career appearances for Marshall.
- 234 career points.
- 95 career assists.
- Tied for team game-high with 10 points and added two steals at SIU (11/17).

## NOTES

### Last time out - at Southern Illinois Nov. 17, 2018 - L, 58-49

Marshall's defense played well against the Salukis but struggled to find its rhythm on offense. The Herd held SIU to shooting just 35.2 percent (19-54) from the floor and 18.8 percent (3-16) from outside. On offense, Marshall hit 33.9 percent (19-56) from the field and 14.3 percent (3-21) from three. The Herd's defense held Southern Illinois without a point for a seven minute span from the end of the first quarter through almost the first six minutes of the second quarter. Sophomores Kristen Mayo and Taylor Pearson led Marshall with 10 points each. Redshirt senior Taylor Porter scored eight points and tied a career-high with eight rebounds. Freshman guard Kia Silvils grabbed a season-best six rebounds with five coming on the offensive end. Senior Shayna Gore (five points) was held under double-digits scoring since putting up nine points on Dec. 10, 2017 at Florida. It stopped a span of 22-straight games.

### Welcome Back

The season-opener against Indiana State saw the return of two players for Marshall who missed the 2017-18 season with medical redshirts. Taylor Porter and Khadaija Brooks both made their comebacks to the floor on Nov. 7, in the Cam Henderson Center. Brooks led Marshall with 16 points, 11 boards and added two blocks while shooting 7-of-13 from the floor. Porter struggled offensively from the field going 2-of-9 and 1-of-5 from three-point range. However, Porter's energy, intensity and toughness on the floor will be a welcomed sight back for Marshall in her senior season.

### 500 Field Goals

Senior Shayna Gore finished the 2017-18 season just one bucket short of 500 made for her career. With 2:14 left in the first quarter of the season-opener against Indiana State, Gore hit a three to become the eighth player in program history with 500 made field goals. After hitting two more baskets in the game, Gore moved into seventh all-time passing Sheila Johnson (1987-91). Gore currently has 513 after the BGSU contest. Next up is Marshall Athletics Hall of Famer Sikeetha Shepard-Hall (2002-06) and Karla May (1982-86) tied with 537.

### Moving on up the ranks

Shayna Gore put up a career-best performance with 34 points against Bowling Green and moved into fourth place all-time in Marshall scoring history. Gore surpassed former Herd great Tynikki Crook (2007-11) in the third quarter and finished the game at 1,485 career points. Gore buried six three's, third time in her career with six or more, in helping to move ahead of Crook. Next up is recent Marshall Athletics Hall of Fame inductee Sikeetha Shepard-Hall (2002-06) for third all-time with 1,609.

## THE OPPONENT - BLUEFIELD STATE

### Scouting the Big Blues

Bluefield State is 3-2 to begin the 2018-19 season with wins over Alfred State (81-52), Campbellsville University-Harrodsburg (79-71) and Kentucky Christian (80-60). The Big Blues are coming off a 90-70 loss at Rio Grande. The Red Storm shot 48.5 percent (33-68) from the floor and hit seven three-pointers and forced 21 Bluefield State turnovers. Head coach Ryan Bailey is in his second season at the helm and already has as many wins as last season. Bluefield State finished the 2017-18 season with a record of 3-23. Freshman forward Kylah Webb leads the team in scoring with 10.5 points per game. Webb had a season-high 16 points and grabbed nine boards in the win over KCU and followed up with 12 at Rio Grande. Senior Lyndsay Hatfield leads the squad with 7.5 rebounds per contest and recorded a season-best 11 against Alfred State and has 500 total boards in her career.

## HEAD COACH TONY KEMPER

### Fort Hays State '01

Marshall Director of Athletics Mike Hamrick has elevated associate head coach Tony Kemper to head women's basketball coach, the department announced Friday, March 17, 2017.

Kemper has been with the Thundering Herd for seven seasons and now second as the head coach and his record coming into 2018-19 is 9-20.

During his time at Marshall, Kemper has assisted in rebuilding a program that progressively increased its win total over the first four seasons - from 9 to 11 to 17 to 21 wins in the 2015-16 season. That 2015-16 win total was the most for Thundering Herd Women's Basketball in 29 seasons and, for the first time in school history, yielded a first-team All-Conference USA student-athlete for Marshall in Leah Scott.

He helped lead Marshall to two of only three postseason berths in the program's NCAA history, including its first postseason win in 2014-15 (WBI) and WNIT berth in 2015-16.

Kemper has also been heavily involved in the Thundering Herd's recruiting and academic success, helping sign the 34th-ranked class in 2017 and its group in 2015, which came in 52nd.

In the classroom, the program has placed 28 members on the Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll (3.0 cumulative GPA or better) and three more were given the Commissioner's Academic Medal (3.75).

Kemper came to Marshall from Central Arkansas, where he coached with now-former Marshall head coach Matt Daniel for three seasons.

"I am very appreciative and excited for the opportunity to lead the women's basketball program at Marshall," said Kemper. "I want to thank our President, Dr. Jerry Gilbert, Mike Hamrick and (Senior Women's Administrator) Beatrice Crane Banford for trusting in my ability to continue the progress our program made under Coach Daniel."

"It is such a privilege to continue working with student-athletes who I have had a hand in recruiting to Huntington, a community that my family values greatly. There are many good people and players here now, and also on the way, who can help make us a consistent winner."

At UCA, Kemper helped the Sugar Bears to their first Division I conference title and three seasons of at least 21 wins.

His tutelage of inside players helped gain two Southland Player of the Year honors and a Defensive Player of the Year.

Before joining the women's staff, Kemper served as an assistant coach for the Central Arkansas men's basketball program for four years.

Two professional players emerged from UCA during those seasons -- the leading scorer in Portugal's Proliga pro league in 2011, Nate Bowie, and professional center Durell Nevels.

Prior to UCA, Kemper was an assistant coach at Hutchinson (Kansas) Community College - one of the nation's most successful junior college programs.

At Hutchinson, he oversaw day-to-day operations and directed the Blue Dragons' strength and conditioning efforts while also serving as a mathematics and physical education instructor.

The Logan, Kansas, native also held the head coaching spot at Quivira Heights High School in Bushton in 2003-04, guiding QHHS to a No. 1 seed to the regional tournament.

His coaching career began in 2002-03 as an assistant at Hill City (Kansas) High School.

"The best person for this job is Tony Kemper," said Hamrick. "He is a man of character who has been instrumental in the program's growth over the past five seasons. Marshall Women's Basketball will be in good hands under his leadership."

Kemper received a bachelor's degree in finance from Fort Hays State University in 2001 and a BBA in Business Education in 2003. He also earned a master's degree in organizational leadership from Fort Hays in 2008.

Kemper and his wife Sandra, a professor at Marshall in the Communications Disorders Department, live in Huntington with sons Brayden and Landry and daughter Jolie.

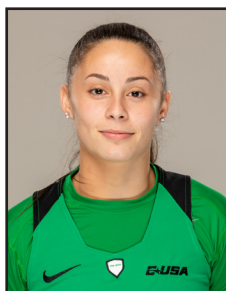

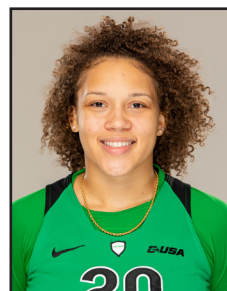
