READ IT, TWEET IT

@HerdWBB redshirt junior Khadaijia Brooks has recorded at least one block in each game this season.

@HerdWBB senior Shayna Gore has had 2 of the top-10 best single season scoring performances with 526 (10th) in 16-17 & 568 (8th) in 17-18.

Shayna Gore scored 34 at BGSU and passed Tynikki Crook (2007-11) for 4th all-time in scoring.

@HerdWBB senior Shayna Gore surpassed the 1,500 point plateau in the first half against Bluefield State.

Shayna Gore tied the Stroh Center single-game points record with a career-high 34 in the loss at Bowling Green.

@HerdWBB currently sports 3 of the best 3-point shooters in program history. Gore is 1st with 219 made, Fraley and Porter are tied for 13th with 74..

@HerdWBB freshman G Kia Sivils scored 12 points and had 3 assists and no turnovers in 25 minutes of point guard action at BGSU.

Gore and Mayo are a combined 24-for-24 from the free throw line through four games.

UP NEXT

Marshall returns to the Cam Henderson Center for back-to-back home games. The Herd takes on Evansville (Nov. 29) and Coppin State (Dec. 1).

STARTING FIVE SUMMARY

#11 - Taylor Porter

- Began collegiate career at Murray State in 2013-14 before transferring to Marshall
- Missed all of the 2017-18 season with a medical redshirt.
- Has played 57 games in her Herd career with 44 starts.
- Tied for 13th all-time in program history with 74 made three-pointers, she is tied with current teammate Logan Faley.
- Season-high of 12 points and career-best five steals vs. Bluefield State (11/20).

#14 - Shayna Gore

- Fourth all-time in scoring with 1,512 points. Seventh all-time in fields goals made with 522. Fifth in field goals attempted with 1,210. First in three-pointers made with 219. First in three-pointers attempted with 611. Tied for fifth in three-point FG percentage 35.8. 15th in steals with 147 and 11th in free throws made with 249.
- In 2018, for the first time in career, did not open the season with at least 20 points.
- Set career-high with 34 points at Bowling Green which also tied the Stroh Center record for most points in a game. Set by Presley Hudson of Central Michigan on Jan. 14, 2017.
- Has 31 career games with 20 or more points.

#20 - Taylor Pearson

- Recorded eight rebounds and led the Herd with five assists in her start against Indiana State (11/7).
- Grabbed her 100th career rebound against Indiana State (11/7).
- Averaged just under 20 minutes a game during freshman season. Played career-high 34 minutes against Indiana State (11/7).
- Had season-high 10 points and added six rebounds at Southern Illinois (11/17).

#22 - Khadajia Brooks

- Recorded fourth career double-double in season opener vs. Indiana State (11/7) with 16 points and 11 rebounds.
- Missed all of 2017-18 season with a medical redshirt.
- Grabbed her 200th career board against Indiana State (11/7).
- Was averaging 6.5 rpg in 2016-17 before missing the final eight games with a knee injury.
- Grabbed 11 boards and recorded two blocks vs. Bluefield State (11/20).
- Has recorded at least one block in all four games this season.

#23 - Kristen Mayo

- Has started 29 of 33 career appearances for Marshall.
- 246 career points.
- 97 career assists.
- Tied for team game-high with 10 points and added two steals at SIU (11/17).
- Scored season-best 13 points in win over Bluefield State (11/20).

Last time out - vs. Bluefield State Nov. 20, 2018 - W, 82-29

Marshall dominated at home in a 53-point win over Bluefield State. The Herd defense stifled the Blig Blues scoring just seven points in the second quarter, four in the third and six in the fourth. Marshall grabbed 64 total rebounds as redshirt junior Khadaijia Brooks led the way with 11. Junior Princess Clemons and freshman Lorelei Roper set career-highs with eight boards each. Senior Shayna Gore led in scoring with 22, her 31st career game with 20 or more points. Gore also surpassed 1,500 points for her career. Redshirt senior Taylor Porter was all over the court with 12 points, five rebounds and a career-high five steals. Sophomore Brianna Toney set a career-high with two blocks.

Welcome Back

The season-opener against Indiana State saw the return of two players for Marshall who missed the 2017-18 season with medical redshirts. Taylor Porter and Khadaijia Brooks both made their comebacks to the floor on Nov. 7, in the Cam Henderson Center. Brooks led Marshall with 16 points, 11 boards and added two blocks while shooting 7-of-13 from the floor. Porter struggled offensively from the field going 2-of-9 and 1-of-5 from three-point range. However, Porter's energy, intensity and toughness on the floor will be a welcomed sight back for Marshall in her senior season.

500 Field Goals

Senior Shayna Gore finished the 2017-18 season just one bucket short of 500 made for her career. With 2:14 left in the first quarter of the season-opener against Indiana State, Gore hit a three to become the eighth player in program history with 500 made field goals. After hitting two more baskets in the game, Gore moved into seventh all-time passing Sheila Johnson (1987-91). Gore currently has 513 after the BGSU contest. Next up is Marshall Athletics Hall of Famer Sikeetha Shepard-Hall (2002-06) and Karla May (1982-86) tied with 537.

Moving on up the ranks

Shayna Gore put up a career-best performance with 34 points against Bowling Green and moved into fourth place all-time in Marshall scoring history. Gore surpassed former Herd great Tynikki Crook (2007-11) in the third quarter and finished the game at 1,485 career points. Gore buried six three's, third time in her career with six or more, in helping to move ahead of Crook. Next up is recent Marshall Athletics Hall of Fame inductee Sikeetha Shepard-Hall (2002-06) for third all-time with 1,609.

THE OPPONENT - APPALACHIAN STATE

Scouting the Mountaineers

Appalachian State comes in at 3-2 overall and winners of three-straight. After beginning the season with back-to-back losses at UAB (80-61) and at Georgia Tech (71-53) the Mountaineers have rattled off wins over UNC-Greensboro (68-65), at Davidson (81-78) and Elon (65-62). All three wins came by a margin of just three points. Against Elon, Appalachian State entered the fourth quarter trailing 55-48 but then outscored the Phoenix 17-7 to get the win. The Mountaineers held Elon to shooting just 30 percent (3-15) from the floor in the fourth and 0-for-4 from three. Appalachian State sports two players averaging double-digit scoring with Tierra Wilson (11.0 ppg) and Pre Stanley (10.5 ppg). Bayley Plummer continues to clean the glass with 8.8 boards per game but is scoring just 4.6 ppg. Ashley Polacek leads the team with 27 assists. Appalachian State is shooting 37.7 percent from the field while opponents are hitting 42.9 percent. From outside, the Mountaineers are hitting just 25.0 percent from three while the competition has hit 35.1 percent. Appalachian State has outrebounded its opponents 42.4 to 37.0 per game and has committed 13 more turnovers (89-76).

Marshall Director of Athletics Mike Hamrick has elevated associate head coach Tony Kemper to head women's basketball coach, the department announced Friday, March 17, 2017.

Kemper has been with the Thundering Herd for seven seasons and now second as the head coach and his record coming into 2018-19 is 9-20.

During his time at Marshall, Kemper has assisted in rebuilding a program that progressively increased its win total over the first four seasons - from 9 to 11 to 17 to 21 wins in the 2015-16 season. That 2015-16 win total was the most for Thundering Herd Women's Basketball in 29 seasons and, for the first time in school history, yielded a first-team All-Conference USA student-athlete for Marshall in Leah Scott.

He helped lead Marshall to two of only three postseason berths in the program's NCAA history, including its first postseason win in 2014-15 (WBI) and WNit berth in 2015-16.

Kemper has also been heavily involved in the Thundering Herd's recruiting and academic success, helping sign the 34th-ranked class in 2017 and its group in 2015, which came in 52nd.

In the classroom, the program has placed 28 members on the Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll (3.0 cumulative GPA or better) and three more were given the Commissioner's Academic Medal (3.75).

Kemper came to Marshall from Central Arkansas, where he coached with now-former Marshall head coach Matt Daniel for three seasons.

"I am very appreciative and excited for the opportunity to lead the women's basketball program at Marshall," said Kemper. "I want to thank our President, Dr. Jerry Gilbert, Mike Hamrick and (Senior Women's Administrator) Beatrice Crane Banford for trusting in my ability to continue the progress our program made under Coach Daniel."

"It is such a privilege to continue working with student-athletes who I have had a hand in recruiting to Huntington, a community that my family values greatly. There are many good people and players here now, and also on the way, who can help make us a consistent winner."

At UCA, Kemper helped the Sugar Bears to their first Division I conference title and three seasons of at least 21 wins.

His tutelage of inside players helped gain two Southland Player of the Year honors and a Defensive Player of the Year.

Before joining the women's staff, Kemper served as an assistant coach for the Central Arkansas men's basketball program for four years.

Two professional players emerged from UCA during those seasons -- the leading scorer in Portugal's Proliga pro league in 2011, Nate Bowie, and professional center Durell Nevels.

Prior to UCA, Kemper was an assistant coach at Hutchinson (Kansas) Community College - one of the nation's most successful junior college programs.

At Hutchinson, he oversaw day-to-day operations and directed the Blue Dragons' strength and conditioning efforts while also serving as a mathematics and physical education instructor.

The Logan, Kansas, native also held the head coaching spot at Quivira Heights High School in Bushton in 2003-04, guiding QHHS to a No. 1 seed to the regional tournament.

His coaching career began in 2002-03 as an assistant at Hill City (Kansas) High School.

"The best person for this job is Tony Kemper," said Hamrick. "He is a man of character who has been instrumental in the program's growth over the past five seasons. Marshall Women's Basketball will be in good hands under his leadership."

Kemper received a bachelor's degree in finance from Fort Hays State University in 2001 and a BBA in Business Education in 2003. He also earned a master's degree in organizational leadership from Fort Hays in 2008.

Kemper and his wife Sandra, a professor at Marshall in the Communications Disorders Department, live in Huntington with sons Brayden and Landry and daughter Jolie.


