NOTES

Last time out - vs Evansville Nov. 29 - W, 72-65 (OT)

The Herd earned its second win of the season in tough battle with the Evansville Purple Aces. Marshall struggled offensively in the first half but trailed by only one, 29-28, at the half. The Herd began the third with a 10-0 run and finished the quarter with a seven-point lead, 50-43. Marshall shot 53.8 percent (7-of-13) in the third. Evansville rallied in the fourth and took back the lead before the Herd fought back and tied the game in the final minute to send it to overtime. Marshall controlled the final five-minute extra period, outscoring Evansville 11-4 and grabbing the win. The Herd won the rebounding battle 63-37 and had three players finish with double-digits boards. Redshirt junior Khadaijia Brooks and sophomore Taylor Pearson recorded double-doubles in the winning effort. Senior Shayna Gore and sophomore Kristen Mayo combined to go 12-of-12 from the free throw line, with all six of Mayo's makes coming in overtime.

Overtime-less Streak Comes to an End

Marshall's 72-65, overtime victory against Evansville ended a long running streak. It had been 131 games - or 1,730 days - since the Herd played an overtime period, and ended the second longest active streak in Division I women's basketball. The Maryland Terrapins are still running strong with 187 consecutive games without needing the extra minutes. Illinois now has the second longest active streak at 122 games, with the Fighting Illini's last overtime contest coming on Nov. 29, 2014. The last time Marshall played an overtime game came on March 5, 2014, on Senior Night against the UTSA Roadrunners in the Cam Henderson Center. The last time Marshall played an overtime game, the Herd's freshmen were in the eighth grade and only redshirt senior Taylor Porter was on a collegiate court during her freshman season at Murray State.

Thieves on the Floor

Through the first six games, Marshall has ripped off 67 steals and lead Conference USA with 11.2 thefts per game. 56.3 percent (67-of-119) of the Herd's opponent's turnovers have come from a steal. Freshman Kia Sivils leads the team with 15 steals and nabbed five at Appalachian State. It marked back-to-back games that Marshall featured a player with five steals in a game as redshirt senior Taylor Porter had five against Bluefield State. Senior Shayna Gore has 12 steals and has recorded at least one theft in each game this season and 17-straight games going back last season. Sivils (sixth - 2.5) and Gore (seventh - 2.0) both rank in the top 10 in C-USA in steals per game. Adding in Porter's numbers (14th - 1.5), Marshall is the only team in the conference with three players ranked in the top 15 in steals per game.

SWAT Party

Marshall leads Conference USA in blocked shots per game through the first six contests. After recording six more in the win over Evansville, the Herd is averaging 4.67 rejections per game and 28 overall. Old Dominion is second with 3.80 per game and UTSA is second in total with 26 in eight games (3.25). Marshall has recorded at least two blocked shots in each game this season with a high of seven versus Indiana State (Nov. 7). The Herd has blocked at least two shots in eight-straight games going back to last season. The last time Marshall did not record at least two blocks was Feb. 22, 2018 at Rice. Since the return of Ashley Saintigene to the lineup, the Herd has recorded 10 blocks over the last two games and Saintigene has four. Khadaijia Brooks currently leads the team with seven.

Welcome Back Part II - Ashley Saintigene - Nov. 25 at Appalachian State

Junior Ashley Saintigene was on the floor at Appalachian State for the first time since Dec. 21, 2017, after suffering a knee injury at Tennessee State. Saintigene played just 10 minutes against the Mountaineers, but she still recorded six points and a block. It was the 65th block of her career, putting her into a tie with Lee Ann Parsley (1986-90) for 11th all-time, and it was sixth-straight game with a block going back to last season. The junior shot-blocker was off to a great start last season with 22 blocks in 12 games. She is a welcome presence back out on the court.

<u>Welcome Back - Khadaijia Brooks & Taylor Porter - Season-Opener</u>

The season-opener against Indiana State saw the return of two players for Marshall who missed the 2017-18 season with medical redshirts. Taylor Porter and Khadaijia Brooks both made their comebacks to the floor on Nov. 7, in the Cam Henderson Center. Brooks led Marshall with 16 points, 11 boards and added two blocks while shooting 7-of-13 from the floor. Porter struggled offensively from the field going 2-of-9 and 1-of-5 from three-point range. However, Porter's energy, intensity and toughness on the floor will be a welcomed sight back for Marshall in her senior season.

500 Field Goals

Senior Shayna Gore finished the 2017-18 season just one bucket short of 500 made for her career. With 2:14 left in the first quarter of the season-opener against Indiana State, Gore hit a three to become the eighth player in program history with 500 made field goals. After hitting two more baskets in the game, Gore moved into seventh all-time passing Sheila Johnson (1987-91). Gore currently has 513 after the BGSU contest. Next up is Marshall Athletics Hall of Famer Sikeetha Shepard-Hall (2002-06) and Karla May (1982-86) tied with 537.

Moving on up the ranks

Shayna Gore put up a career-best performance with 34 points against Bowling Green and moved into fourth place all-time in Marshall scoring history. Gore surpassed former Herd great Tynikki Crook (2007-11) in the third quarter and finished the game at 1,485 career points. Gore buried six three's, third time in her career with six or more, in helping to move ahead of Crook. Next up is recent Marshall Athletics Hall of Fame inductee Sikeetha Shepard-Hall (2002-06) for third all-time with 1,609.

Scouting the Eagles

Coppin State comes in at 0-4, however the Eagles have played four top-25 teams. Coppin State opened the season with a 78-37 loss at No. 25 WVU, then a 93-36 loss at No. 9 Maryland, and a 110-38 loss at No. 6 Mississippi State. The Eagles lone game against unranked competition was a 57-52 loss to UMBC at home. The UMBC game is the only home contest for Coppin State until conference play in MEAC against Savannah State on Jan. 5. Chance Graham leads the Eagles in scoring (14.8 ppg), rebounds (12.0 rpg), blocks 10 and steals nine. The Eagles have been outrebounded by 17 boards per game and have committed 35 more turnovers then the competition. Following the contest at Marshall, Coppin State stays on the road with games at Virginia (Dec. 2), Ohio (Dec. 8), No. 20 Minnesota (Dec. 12), Niagara (Dec. 15), Florida Gulf Coast (Dec. 19), UAB (Dec. 20) and Old Dominion (Dec. 29) before heading home to begin conference play.

Marshall Director of Athletics Mike Hamrick has elevated associate head coach Tony Kemper to head women's basketball coach, the department announced Friday, March 17, 2017.

Kemper has been with the Thundering Herd for seven seasons and now second as the head coach and his record coming into 2018-19 is 9-20.

During his time at Marshall, Kemper has assisted in rebuilding a program that progressively increased its win total over the first four seasons - from 9 to 11 to 17 to 21 wins in the 2015-16 season. That 2015-16 win total was the most for Thundering Herd Women's Basketball in 29 seasons and, for the first time in school history, yielded a first-team All-Conference USA student-athlete for Marshall in Leah Scott.

He helped lead Marshall to two of only three postseason berths in the program's NCAA history, including its first postseason win in 2014-15 (WBI) and WNIT berth in 2015-16.

Kemper has also been heavily involved in the Thundering Herd's recruiting and academic success, helping sign the 34th-ranked class in 2017 and its group in 2015, which came in 52nd.

In the classroom, the program has placed 28 members on the Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll (3.0 cumulative GPA or better) and three more were given the Commissioner's Academic Medal (3.75).

Kemper came to Marshall from Central Arkansas, where he coached with now-former Marshall head coach Matt Daniel for three seasons.

"I am very appreciative and excited for the opportunity to lead the women's basketball program at Marshall," said Kemper. "I want to thank our President, Dr. Jerry Gilbert, Mike Hamrick and (Senior Women's Administrator) Beatrice Crane Banford for trusting in my ability to continue the progress our program made under Coach Daniel."

"It is such a privilege to continue working with student-athletes who I have had a hand in recruiting to Huntington, a community that my family values greatly. There are many good people and players here now, and also on the way, who can help make us a consistent winner."

At UCA, Kemper helped the Sugar Bears to their first Division I conference title and three seasons of at least 21 wins.

His tutelage of inside players helped gain two Southland Player of the Year honors and a Defensive Player of the Year.

Before joining the women's staff, Kemper served as an assistant coach for the Central Arkansas men's basketball program for four years.

Two professional players emerged from UCA during those seasons -- the leading scorer in Portugal's Proliga pro league in 2011, Nate Bowie, and professional center Durell Nevels.

Prior to UCA, Kemper was an assistant coach at Hutchinson (Kansas) Community College - one of the nation's most successful junior college programs.

At Hutchinson, he oversaw day-to-day operations and directed the Blue Dragons' strength and conditioning efforts while also serving as a mathematics and physical education instructor.

The Logan, Kansas, native also held the head coaching spot at Quivira Heights High School in Bushton in 2003-04, guiding QHHS to a No. 1 seed to the regional tournament.

His coaching career began in 2002-03 as an assistant at Hill City (Kansas) High School.

"The best person for this job is Tony Kemper," said Hamrick. "He is a man of character who has been instrumental in the program's growth over the past five seasons. Marshall Women's Basketball will be in good hands under his leadership."

Kemper received a bachelor's degree in finance from Fort Hays State University in 2001 and a BBA in Business Education in 2003. He also earned a master's degree in organizational leadership from Fort Hays in 2008.

Kemper and his wife Sandra, a professor at Marshall in the Communications Disorders Department, live in Huntington with sons Brayden and Landry and daughter Jolie.
