#### READ IT, TWEET IT

.@HerdWBB senior Shayna Gore is now 3rd all-time in scoring at MU with 1,625, passing Sikeetha Shepard-Hall vs. Tennessee State.

Taylor Porter was named @ConferenceUSA Player of the Week on 12/10.

.@HerdWBB leads Conferenece USA in blocked shots per game with 5.30 and in steals per game with 10.10.

.@HerdWBB's starting guard trio of Porter, Gore and Mayo combined for 19 assists and 1 turnover in the win over Cleveland State. .@HerdWBB's 16 made three's vs. Coppin State was a team record. Jovana Vucetic hit the record-breaker.

Kristen Mayo tied a program record hitting 100 percent from three vs. Coppin State, but set a record with the highest perfect score of 6-for-6.

.@HerdWBB's OT win vs. Evansville was MU's first OT game in 131 games. 2nd longest active streak in the country behind Maryland's 187.

The OT win was the first extra-period game for @Herd-WBB since 3/5/14, a home win over UTSA.

#### **UP NEXT**

Marshall returns to the Cam Henderson Center for two final non-conference games against Towson (Dec. 22) and Delaware State (Dec. 29).

#### #11 - Taylor Porter

- Was named Conference USA Player of the Week for first time in career on Dec. 10, 2018.
- Missed all of the 2017-18 season with a medical redshirt.
- Has played 63 games in her Herd career with 50 starts.
- 13th all-time with 87 made three-pointers.
- Scored 13 points, five assists and career-high two blocks vs. Coppin State (12/1).
- Put up 16 points and tied career-best with eight boards at Wisconsin (12/4).
- Season-best 22 points with five assists, three steals, four boards and no turnovers in win over Cleveland State
- Set career-high with six made three-pointers (6-of-9) versus Cleveland State (12/8).
- Has scored at least 16 points in the three-straight contests (Wisconsin-16, Cleveland State-22 & Tennessee State-16).

#### #14 - Shayna Gore

- Third all-time in scoring (1,625). Third all-time in fields goals made (557). Fifth in field goals attempted (1,297). First in three-pointers made (241). First in three-pointers attempted (661). Fifth in three-point FG percentage (36.5%). 14th in steals (157). 15th in assists (251). Tied for seventh in free throws made (270) and 14th in free throws attempted (329).
- In 2018, for the first time in career, did not open the season with at least 20 points.
- Set career-high with 34 points at Bowling Green which also tied the Stroh Center record for most points in a game. Originally set by Presley Hudson of Central Michigan on Jan. 14, 2017.
- Has 34 career games with 20 or more points.
- String of 17-straight games with at least one steal snapped against Coppin State (12/1). Last game without a steal was Jan. 21, 2018 vs. WKU.
- Moved into third place all-time at Marshall in scoring with 24 points against Tennessee State (12/15), moving ahead of Hall of Famer Sikeetha Shepard-Hall (2002-06).

#### #22 - Khadaijia Brooks

- Recorded fourth career double-double in season opener vs. Indiana State (11/7) with 16 points and 11 rebounds.
- Fifth career double-double with 19 pts & 13 boards vs. Evansville (11/29).
- Missed all of 2017-18 season with a medical redshirt.
- Grabbed her 200th career board against Indiana State (11/7).
- Was averaging 6.5 rpg in 2016-17 before missing the final eight games with a knee injury.
- Grabbed 11 boards and recorded two blocks vs. Bluefield State (11/20).
- Recorded at least one block in 8-of-10 games this season.
- String of 41-straight games with at least one rebound. Last game without one board 2/18/16 at Charlotte.

#### #23 - Kristen Mayo

- Has started 35 of 39 career appearances for Marshall.
- Fourth all-time in program history hitting 36.7 percent from three-point range.
- 309 career points & 124 career assists.
- 15 career games with 10 or more points.
- Scored career-high 18 points while hitting 6-of-6 from three in win over Coppin State (12/1).
- Has recorded at least one assist in 31-straight games.
- Hit 100th career field goal against Cleveland State (12/8).
- Career-high eight assists with no turnovers against Cleveland State (12/8). Combined with Porter and Gore to finish with 19 assists and one turnover.
- Back-to-back games with eight assists (Clev. St. & TSU), a combined 16 assists to one turnover in the contests.

#### #34 - Lorelei Roper

- Received first career start vs. Tennessee State (12/15). Scored three points and one rebound in 13 minutes.
- Has appeared in all 10 games with season-high 22 minutes at Appalachian State (11/25). Scored season-best nine points and grabbed six rebounds.
- Season-high four blocked shots in win over Cleveland State (12/8).
- Has grabbed at least one rebound in every game except one at Bowling Green (11/13), second career appearance.

#### NOTES

#### Last time out - vs. Tennessee State Dec. 15 - W, 80-59

The Herd's offense started slowly as Tennessee State built out a 6-0 lead through the first three minute and 20 seconds before senior **Shayna Gore** hit a layup. Marshall proceeded to go on a 17-3 run to finish the first quarter with an 8-point lead. The Herd owned just a 7-point advantage at the end of the half, but Marshall exploded for 27 points in the third quarter to increase the lead to double-digits. Gore led the Herd with 24 points with 18 coming in the second half. The senior passed **Sikeetha Shepard-Hall** (2002-06) for third all-time at Marshall in scoring with a three-pointer in the third quarter. Redshirt senior **Taylor Porter** scored 16 points, giving her three-straight games with at least 16. Sophomore **Kristen Mayo** recorded eight assists for the second consecutive game. Marshall has won five-straight games at home and four of the last five contests. The starting guard trio of Porter, Gore and Mayo all recorded four steals each and 12 of the Herd's 16.

#### **Dishing Out the Ball**

Marshall is currently 65th in the nation in assist to turnover ratio with 161 assists and 155 turnovers (1.04) and is one of just 83 programs out of 349 Division I programs with a positive assist to turnover ratio. The Herd over the last two games is a combined 48 assists to 24 turnovers (2-to-1), led by sophomore **Kristen Mayo** who has combined for 16 assists and just one turnover. The last time Marshall finished a season with a positive assist to turnover ratio was the 1984-85 season. The Herd finished the year 19-10 overall and Co-Southern Conference Regular Season Champions with a 9-1 SoCon record. Marshall lost to Chattanooga in the second round of the SoCon Tournament.

#### **Conference USA Player of the Week**

**Taylor Porter** was honored with the weekly award for the first time in her career with a couple of great performances. In the loss at Wisconsin, Porter scored a season-high 16 points and tied her career-high with eight boards. Back at home in the win over Cleveland State, the redshirt senior set a new season-high with 22 points, established a career-best with six made three-pointers, contributed five assists and three steals.

#### **Let it Fly From Outside**

Marshall's 16 made three-pointers against Coppin State was a program record. The previous high was 15 versus Maine Fort Kent on Dec. 20, 2016. In the win over Coppin State, **Kristen Mayo** set a career-high going 6-for-6 and establishing a new mark for the highest perfect score from beyond the arc in program history. **Tamira Higgins** went 5-for-5 against Chattanooga on Jan. 17, 1994. **Shayna Gore** hit five three's and six different players hit one from outside. **Jovana Vucetic** hit the record-breaker, sinking the Herd's final three of the day with 1:23 remaining in the game.

#### **Overtime-less Streak Comes to an End**

Marshall's 72-65, overtime victory against Evansville ended a long running streak. It had been 131 games - or 1,730 days - since the Herd played an overtime period, and ended the second longest active streak in Division I women's basketball. The Maryland Terrapins are still running strong with 187 consecutive games without needing the extra minutes. Illinois now has the second longest active streak at 122 games, with the Fighting Illini's last overtime contest coming on Nov. 29, 2014. The last time Marshall played an overtime game came on March 5, 2014, on Senior Night against the UTSA Roadrunners in the Cam Henderson Center. The last time Marshall played an overtime game, the Herd's freshmen were in the eighth grade and only **Taylor Porter** was on a collegiate court during her freshman season at Murray State.

### **Thieves on the Floor**

Marshall has ripped off 101 steals and leads Conference USA with 10.1 thefts per game. 54 percent (101-of-187) of the opposition's turnovers have come from a steal. **Shayna Gore** leads the team with 18 steals and has recorded at least one in 8-of-10 games. **Kia Sivils** is next with 17 steals and nabbed five at Appalachian State. It marked back-to-back games that Marshall featured a player with five steals in a game as **Taylor Porter** had five against Bluefield State. Gore (7th - 1.8) and Sivils (9th - 1.7) both rank in the top 10 in C-USA in steals per game. Add in Porter and **Kristen Mayo** (tied for 10th - 1.6) and Marshall has more players in the top-15 than any other team in conference.

#### **SWAT Party**

Marshall leads Conference USA in blocked shots per game, averaging 5.3 rejections and 53 overall. UTSA is second with 3.6 per game. The Herd blocked at least seven shots in three-straight games (Dec. 1-8) and has recorded at least two blocked shots in each game this season. Marshall's string of at least two blocked shots is 12-straight games going back to last season. The last time Marshall did not record at least two blocks was Feb. 22, 2018 at Rice.

#### Welcome Back Part II - Ashley Saintigene - Nov. 25 at Appalachian State

Junior **Ashley Saintigene** was on the floor at Appalachian State for the first time since Dec. 21, 2017, after suffering a knee injury at Tennessee State. Saintigene played just 10 minutes against the Mountaineers, but she still recorded six points and a block. It was the 65th block of her career, putting her into a tie with **Lee Ann Parsley** (1986-90) for 11th all-time, and it was sixth-straight game with a block going back to last season. The junior shot-blocker was off to a great start last season with 22 blocks in 12 games. She is a welcome presence back out on the court.

### Welcome Back - Khadaijia Brooks & Taylor Porter - Season-Opener

The season-opener against Indiana State saw the return of two players for Marshall who missed the 2017-18 season with medical redshirts. **Taylor Porter** and **Khadaijia Brooks** both made their comebacks to the floor on Nov. 7, in the Cam Henderson Center. Brooks led Marshall with 16 points, 11 boards and added two blocks while shooting 7-of-13 from the floor. Porter struggled offensively from the field going 2-of-9 and 1-of-5 from three-point range. However, Porter's energy, intensity and toughness on the floor will be a welcomed sight back for Marshall in her senior season.

#### **500 Field Goals**

Senior **Shayna Gore** finished the 2017-18 season just one bucket short of 500 made for her career. With 2:14 left in the first quarter of the season-opener against Indiana State, Gore hit a three to become the eighth player in program history with 500 made field goals. After hitting two more baskets in the game, Gore moved into seventh all-time passing **Sheila Johnson** (1987-91). Gore is now third with 548 after the Cleveland State contest, passing **Tammy Wiggins** (1983-87 with 545) and **Tynikki Crook** (2007-11 with 546) in the win. The senior from Logan, W.Va., has quite a way to go before possibly reaching second all-time as Marshall Athletics Hall of Famer **Kristina Behnfeldt** (1995-99) has 664. Fellow hall of famer **Karen Pelphrey** (1982-86) is the program's all-time leader with 1,175.

#### Moving on up the ranks

**Shayna Gore** put up a career-best performance with 34 points against Bowling Green and moved into fourth place all-time in Marshall scoring history. Gore surpassed former Herd great **Tynikki Crook** (2007-11) in the third quarter and finished the game at 1,485 career points. Gore buried six three's, third time in her career with six or more, in helping to move ahead of Crook.

Gore continued her move up the scoring column with 24 points in the win over Tennessee State (12/15) to move into third place all-time, passing **Sikeetha Shepard-Hall** (2002-06). Gore moved into the third slot with a three-pointer in the third quarter and finished the day with 1,625 for her career. Next up in second place is another Herd Hall of Famer in **Kristina Behnfeldt** (1995-99) with 2,117, and whose number hangs in the rafters in the Cam Henderson Center.

#### **Scouting the Tigers**

Clemson comes in after a 90-80 loss to Davidson, following a 5-game winning streak. During the victorious stretch the Tigers defeated Oklahoma (74-62), Illinois (69-67 OT), Belmont (65-62), High Point (83-64) and Rhode Island (80-67). Clemson is averaging just over 71 points per game on 42.7 percent shooting from the field and 25 percent from three. The Tigers are giving up 67.1 points per game on 39.5 percent shooting and 29.8 percent from three-point range. Clemson also sports a plus-6.5 rebounding margin. Kobi Thornton leads the team in scoring with 16.8 points per game, on the glass with 8.3 rebounds per contest and is tied for the lead in blocks with 12. Simone Westbrook is second in points with 15.1 per game and Danielle Edwards adds 13.4 points per game and leads with 38 assists and 36 steals. Aliyah Collier was among the team leaders in boards with 7.8 per game but has not played since Nov. 19 at Alabama. Tylar Bennett is averaging 7.5 per game and had a three-game stretch (Nov. 28-Dec. 5) where she nabbed a combined 40 boards. Clemson is averaging 21.1 turnovers per contest.



# Head Coach Tony Kemper 2nd season • @CoachTonyKemper



### Fort Hays State '01

Marshall Director of Athletics Mike Hamrick has elevated associate head coach Tony Kemper to head women's basketball coach, the department announced Friday, March 17, 2017.

Kemper has been with the Thundering Herd for seven seasons and now second as the head coach

and his record coming into 2018-19 is 9-20.

During his time at Marshall, Kemper has assisted in rebuilding a program that progressively increased its win total over the first four seasons - from 9 to 11 to 17 to 21 wins in the 2015-16 season. That 2015-16 win total was the most for Thundering Herd Women's Basketball in 29 seasons and, for the first time in school history, yielded a first-team All-Conference USA student-athlete for Marshall in Leah Scott.

He helped lead Marshall to two of only three postseason berths in the program's NCAA history, including its first postseason win in 2014-15 (WBI) and WNIT berth in 2015-16.

Kemper has also been heavily involved in the Thundering Herd's recruiting and academic success, helping sign the 34th-ranked class in 2017 and its group in 2015, which came in 52nd.

In the classroom, the program has placed 28 members on the Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll (3.0 cumulative GPA or better) and three more were given the Commissioner's Academic Medal (3.75).

Kemper came to Marshall from Central Arkansas, where he coached with now-former Marshall head coach Matt Daniel for three seasons.

"I am very appreciative and excited for the opportunity to lead the women's basketball program at Marshall," said Kemper. "I want to thank our President, Dr. Jerry Gilbert, Mike Hamrick and (Senior Women's Administrator) Beatrice Crane Banford for trusting in my ability to continue the progress our program made under Coach Daniel."

"It is such a privilege to continue working with student-athletes who I have had a hand in recruiting to Huntington, a community that my family values greatly. There are many good people and players here now, and also on the way, who can help make us a consistent winner."

At UCA, Kemper helped the Sugar Bears to their first Division I conference title and three seasons of at least 21 wins.

His tutelage of inside players helped gain two Southland Player of the Year honors and a Defensive Player of the Year.

Before joining the women's staff, Kemper served as an assistant coach for the Central Arkansas men's basketball program for four years.

Two professional players emerged from UCA during those seasons -- the leading scorer in Portugal's Proliga pro league in 2011, Nate Bowie, and professional center Durell Nevels.

Prior to UCA, Kemper was an assistant coach at Hutchinson (Kansas) Community College - one of the nation's most successful junior college programs.

At Hutchinson, he oversaw day-to-day operations and directed the Blue Dragons' strength and conditioning efforts while also serving as a mathematics and physical education instructor.

The Logan, Kansas, native also held the head coaching spot at Quivira Heights High School in Bushton in 2003-04, guiding QHHS to a No. 1 seed to the regional tournament.

His coaching career began in 2002-03 as an assistant at Hill City (Kansas) High School.

"The best person for this job is Tony Kemper," said Hamrick. "He is a man of character who has been instrumental in the program's growth over the past five seasons. Marshall Women's Basketball will be in good hands under his leadership."

Kemper received a bachelor's degree in finance from Fort Hays State University in 2001 and a BBA in Business Education in 2003. He also earned a master's degree in organizational leadership from Fort Hays in 2008.

Kemper and his wife Sandra, a professor at Marshall in the Communications Disorders Department, live in Huntington with sons Brayden and Landry and daughter Jolie.
