.@HerdWBB's 16 made three's vs. Coppin State was its highest total over the last 7 years.

Kristen Mayo tied a program record hitting 100 percent from three vs. Coppin State, but set a record with the highest perfect score of 6-for-6.

.@HerdWBB's OT win vs. Evansville was MU's first OT game in 131 games. 2nd longest active streak in the country behind Maryland's 187.

The OT win was the first extra-period game for @Herd-WBB since 3/5/14, a home win over UTSA.

.@HerdWBB junior Ashley Saintigene had 3 blocks at Wisconsin & passed Tammy Simms (1986-87) for 9th all-time with 73 career swats.

.@HerdWBB senior Shayna Gore surpassed the 1,500 point plateau in the first half against Bluefield State.

.@HerdWBB currently sports 3 of the best 3-point shooters in program history. Gore is 1st with 233 made, Porter is 13th with 79 & Fraley is 14th with 74.

#### NOTES

#### Last time out - at Wisconsin Dec. 4 - L, 67-49

The Herd fought hard but in the end it wasn't enough in its first-ever meeting with the Wisconsin Badgers. Marshall's defense played well stopping Wisconsin on the majority of its first shot of a possession. However, the Badgers size eventually wore down the Herd as the home team grabbed 31 of its 68 rebounds on the offensive glass to help lead to the win. Wisconsin scored 21 second chance points. Redshirt senior Taylor Porter scored a season-high 16 points and tied a career-best with eight boards in the loss. Senior Shayna Gore scored 16 points as well and added two steals. Junior Ashley Saintigene swatted three shots and grabbed six rebounds. The game was tied 13-13 at the end of the first, but then Wisconsin outscored Marshall 21-10 in the second quarter to move ahead for good.

#### **Let it Fly From Outside**

Marshall's 16 made three-pointers against Coppin State were the most for the women's program since head coach Tony Kemper came to Marshall as an assistant coach for the 2012-13 season. The previous high over that span was 15 versus Maine Fort Kent on Dec. 20, 2016. In the win over Coppin State, Kristen Mayo set a career-high going 6-for-6 and establishing a new mark for the highest perfect score from beyond the arc in program history. Tamira Higgins went 5-for-5 against Chattanooga on Jan. 17, 1994. Shayna Gore hit five three's and six different players hit one from outside. Jovana Vucetic hit the Herd's final three of the day with 1:23 remaining in the game.

#### **Overtime-less Streak Comes to an End**

Marshall's 72-65, overtime victory against Evansville ended a long running streak. It had been 131 games - or 1,730 days - since the Herd played an overtime period, and ended the second longest active streak in Division I women's basketball. The Maryland Terrapins are still running strong with 187 consecutive games without needing the extra minutes. Illinois now has the second longest active streak at 122 games, with the Fighting Illini's last overtime contest coming on Nov. 29, 2014. The last time Marshall played an overtime game came on March 5, 2014, on Senior Night against the UTSA Roadrunners in the Cam Henderson Center. The last time Marshall played an overtime game, the Herd's freshmen were in the eighth grade and only Taylor Porter was on a collegiate court during her freshman season at Murray State.

#### **Thieves on the Floor**

Marshall has ripped off 78 steals and lead Conference USA with 9.75 thefts per game. 52.7 percent (78-of-148) of the Herd's opponent's turnovers have come from a steal. Kia Sivils leads the team with 15 steals and nabbed five at Appalachian State. It marked back-to-back games that Marshall featured a player with five steals in a game as **Taylor** Porter had five against Bluefield State. Shayna Gore has 14 steals, has recorded at least one theft in 7-of-8 games this season and had a 17-straight game streak going back last season snapped versus Coppin State. Sivils (7th - 1.9) and Gore (9th - 1.8) both rank in the top 10 in C-USA in steals per game. The Herd features three players ranked in the top 20 in C-USA. Along with Sivils and Gore, Kristen Mayo 17th with 1.4 per game.

#### **SWAT Party**

Marshall leads Conference USA in blocked shots per game, averaging 5.25 rejections and 42 overall. UAB is second with 3.88 per game and UTSA is second in total with 33 in nine games (3.67). The Herd blocked seven shots in each of the past two games and has recorded at least two blocked shots in each game this season. Marshall's string of at least two blocked shots is ten-straight games going back to last season. The last time Marshall did not record at least two blocks was Feb. 22, 2018 at Rice. Since the return of **Ashley** Saintigene to the lineup, the Herd has recorded 24 blocks over the last four games.

#### Welcome Back Part II - Ashley Saintigene - Nov. 25 at Appalachian State

Junior **Ashley Saintigene** was on the floor at Appalachian State for the first time since Dec. 21, 2017, after suffering a knee injury at Tennessee State. Saintigene played just 10 minutes against the Mountaineers, but she still recorded six points and a block. It was the 65th block of her career, putting her into a tie with **Lee Ann Parsley** (1986-90) for 11th all-time, and it was sixth-straight game with a block going back to last season. The junior shot-blocker was off to a great start last season with 22 blocks in 12 games. She is a welcome presence back out on the court.

#### Welcome Back - Khadaijia Brooks & Taylor Porter - Season-Opener

The season-opener against Indiana State saw the return of two players for Marshall who missed the 2017-18 season with medical redshirts. **Taylor Porter** and **Khadaijia Brooks** both made their comebacks to the floor on Nov. 7, in the Cam Henderson Center. Brooks led Marshall with 16 points, 11 boards and added two blocks while shooting 7-of-13 from the floor. Porter struggled offensively from the field going 2-of-9 and 1-of-5 from three-point range. However, Porter's energy, intensity and toughness on the floor will be a welcomed sight back for Marshall in her senior season.

#### **500 Field Goals**

Senior **Shayna Gore** finished the 2017-18 season just one bucket short of 500 made for her career. With 2:14 left in the first quarter of the season-opener against Indiana State, Gore hit a three to become the eighth player in program history with 500 made field goals. After hitting two more baskets in the game, Gore moved into seventh all-time passing **Sheila Johnson** (1987-91). Gore is now fifth with 541 after the Wisconsin contest and moved ahead of Marshall Athletics Hall of Famer Sikeetha Shepard-Hall (2002-06) and Karla May (1982-86) tied with 537. Tammy Wiggins (1983-87) with 545 and Tynikki Crook (2007-11) with 546 are up next in front of the senior.

#### Moving on up the ranks

Shayna Gore put up a career-best performance with 34 points against Bowling Green and moved into fourth place all-time in Marshall scoring history. Gore surpassed former Herd great Tynikki Crook (2007-11) in the third quarter and finished the game at 1,485 career points. Gore buried six three's, third time in her career with six or more, in helping to move ahead of Crook. Next up is recent Marshall Athletics Hall of Fame inductee Sikeetha Shepard-Hall (2002-06) for third all-time with 1,609.

#### **Scouting the Vikings**

Cleveland State has started off the season with a 3-6 record in head coach Chris Kielsmeier's first season. Kielsmeier spent eight seasons at Howard Payne (DIII) and then 10 years at Wayne State (DII) and amassed over 400 wins combined in turning both schools into perennial contenders. However, in 2018 Cleveland State has dropped its last six games including a 65-60 loss to Toledo in the Vikings last outing. Cleveland State shot 34.4 percent in the loss as the Rockets hit 43.5 percent from the floor. Savanna Crockett scored 18 points and grabbed eight rebounds. Mariah White scored 14 points, dished out four assists, but committed 11 turnovers. Freshman Isabelle Gradwell had a career game with 15 points and hit 4-of-8 from three-point range. Mariah Miller leads the Vikings in scoring with 16.4 points per game and Jade Ely is right behind with 15.9 per contest. Crockett is third in scoring (11.3), leads in rebounding with 9.6 boards a game and 13 blocks. Cleveland State is shooting 45.0 percent from the field this season and 31.1 percent from three. The Vikings hold a slim rebounding margin over its opponents this season of 1.2 (40.0 - 38.8).

# Head Coach Tony Kemper 2nd season • @CoachTonyKemper



#### Fort Hays State '01

Marshall Director of Athletics Mike Hamrick has elevated associate head coach Tony Kemper to head women's basketball coach, the department announced Friday, March 17, 2017.

Kemper has been with the Thundering Herd for seven seasons and now second as the head coach

and his record coming into 2018-19 is 9-20.

During his time at Marshall, Kemper has assisted in rebuilding a program that progressively increased its win total over the first four seasons - from 9 to 11 to 17 to 21 wins in the 2015-16 season. That 2015-16 win total was the most for Thundering Herd Women's Basketball in 29 seasons and, for the first time in school history, yielded a first-team All-Conference USA student-athlete for Marshall in Leah Scott.

He helped lead Marshall to two of only three postseason berths in the program's NCAA history, including its first postseason win in 2014-15 (WBI) and WNIT berth in 2015-16.

Kemper has also been heavily involved in the Thundering Herd's recruiting and academic success, helping sign the 34th-ranked class in 2017 and its group in 2015, which came in 52nd.

In the classroom, the program has placed 28 members on the Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll (3.0 cumulative GPA or better) and three more were given the Commissioner's Academic Medal (3.75).

Kemper came to Marshall from Central Arkansas, where he coached with now-former Marshall head coach Matt Daniel for three seasons.

"I am very appreciative and excited for the opportunity to lead the women's basketball program at Marshall," said Kemper. "I want to thank our President, Dr. Jerry Gilbert, Mike Hamrick and (Senior Women's Administrator) Beatrice Crane Banford for trusting in my ability to continue the progress our program made under Coach Daniel."

"It is such a privilege to continue working with student-athletes who I have had a hand in recruiting to Huntington, a community that my family values greatly. There are many good people and players here now, and also on the way, who can help make us a consistent winner."

At UCA, Kemper helped the Sugar Bears to their first Division I conference title and three seasons of at least 21 wins.

His tutelage of inside players helped gain two Southland Player of the Year honors and a Defensive Player of the Year.

Before joining the women's staff, Kemper served as an assistant coach for the Central Arkansas men's basketball program for four years.

Two professional players emerged from UCA during those seasons -- the leading scorer in Portugal's Proliga pro league in 2011, Nate Bowie, and professional center Durell Nevels.

Prior to UCA, Kemper was an assistant coach at Hutchinson (Kansas) Community College - one of the nation's most successful junior college programs.

At Hutchinson, he oversaw day-to-day operations and directed the Blue Dragons' strength and conditioning efforts while also serving as a mathematics and physical education instructor.

The Logan, Kansas, native also held the head coaching spot at Quivira Heights High School in Bushton in 2003-04, guiding QHHS to a No. 1 seed to the regional tournament.

His coaching career began in 2002-03 as an assistant at Hill City (Kansas) High School.

"The best person for this job is Tony Kemper," said Hamrick. "He is a man of character who has been instrumental in the program's growth over the past five seasons. Marshall Women's Basketball will be in good hands under his leadership."

Kemper received a bachelor's degree in finance from Fort Hays State University in 2001 and a BBA in Business Education in 2003. He also earned a master's degree in organizational leadership from Fort Hays in 2008.

Kemper and his wife Sandra, a professor at Marshall in the Communications Disorders Department, live in Huntington with sons Brayden and Landry and daughter Jolie.
