UC-Riverside: MU leads 1-0, last meeting 12-1 (5) Feb. 23, 2008



The Highlanders finished the 2018 season with a 38-24 record as well as a trip to the National Invitational Softball Championship. The squad advanced to the championship game before falling to Loyola Marymount, 5-0. On offense the Highlanders will have to replace the production of its top hitter in Jena Curtan who finished the season batting .379, scored 52 runs, 72 hits, 17 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 24 RBI and nine stolen bases. The top returner is senior Hannah Rodriguez who hit .329 with 53 hits, 29 runs, eight doubles and 26 RBI. UCR will also have to fill in for its top two pitchers from a year ago. Hailey Dolcini (who transferred to Fresno State) pitched 159.2 innings with a record of 15-9, a 1.80 ERA and 117 strikeouts. Departed senior Tayler Misfeldt tossed 189.1 innings, 21-13 record, a 2.51 ERA and 182 strikeouts. Haley Marschall (35.2 IP), Jacy Boles (19.2 IP) and Rebecca Faulkner (3.0 IP) will be joined by freshman Megan Casper and Oklahoma transfer Melanie Olmos.



San Diego: MU leads 1-0, last meeting 6-4 Feb. 23, 2008

The Toreros ended the 2018 season with an overall record of 25-27. USD dropped its final nine games of the year. The squad's top hitter from 2018 was Taylor Spence and she is back for her senior year. Spence ended the season hitting .368, 60 hits, 32 runs, two doubles and 16 steals. USD will have to replace the top power-hitter from last year in Kailey Hill who had 11 doubles, six homers and 34 RBI. Spence and Hill were the only two players to finish hitting over .300 for the year. USD stole a total of 60 bases in 2018 and allowed just 48. All three pitchers who played for the Toreros in 2018 are back. Hannah Boos topped the team with a 3.22 ERA, a 9-9 record in 104.1 innings. Delaney Heller had the most wins with a 10-8 record and 88 strikeouts in 122.1 innings. Halle Kyler tossed 132.1 innings, a 6-10 record and a 3.39 ERA.



Cal Poly: Tied 1-1, last meeting 1-0 (MU), 4-2 (CP) March 15, 2001

The Mustangs ended 2018 with a 38-21 record and a trip to the National Invitational Softball Championship. Cal Poly advanced through the first round before being eliminated by Liberty, 3-0. The top hitter from a year ago, Hailey Martin, is back for her junior year. As a sophomore, Martin hit .315, 45 hits, 11 doubles and 30 RBI. Two of the top three batters in terms of hits are gone as Chelsea Convissar (48) and Stephanie Heyward (44) have graduated. As a team, the Mustangs hit .245 and were outscored 181-145. Cal Poly will look to replace its top pitcher in departed senior Lindsey Chalmers who tossed 177.1 innings, a 2.57 ERA, 19-9 record, 19 complete games and 98 strikeouts. Dakota Casper is the top returner in the circle with 80.2 innings last season, a 2.95 ERA, and a 2-10 record.



Portland State: First ever meeting

The Vikings finished 2018 with a record of 18-34. Portland State had three players bat over .300 last season and only one player is not back for 2019. Darian Lindsey hit .324 with 48 hits, 31 runs, 13 doubles, five home runs and 25 RBI in her final season with the Vikings. Returning is Kaela Morrow, the team's top hitter with an average of .346, 56 hits, 25 runs, 10 doubles, two triples, seven home runs and 31 RBI. Also returning in the lineup is Marissa Bruno who hit .339, 43 hits, 27 runs, six doubles and two triples. All four pitchers for Portland State who threw innings last season are back in the circle. Alyssa Burk threw 166.2 innings with a 3.49 ERA, 13-14 record and 133 strikeouts. Emma Detamore (86.2 IP) finished 4-11. Serafine Parrish (47.0 IP) and Haley Schimmel (31.1.) who had time as well are joined by Katie Schroeder from Utah State.





Started the softball program at Western Carolina and finished with a 41-20 record in the first season (2006) and a 16-4 Southern Conference mark and was named SoCon Coach of the Year. The Catamounts won the regular season title along with 6 players named all-conference (5 1st team), 2 All-Region 2nd team and the 2006 Pitcher of the Year (Mendy McKenzie). Western Carolina broke the conference single season home run record with 81 and were ranked 3rd in he country in home runs per game, 14th in slugging percentage and 19th in scoring.

Spent two seasons as the head coach at Young Harris and had a 79-41 record. Finished as the NICAA Regional Runner-up both years.

Prior to coaching at Kansas, spent three seasons as an assistant at LSU under Yvette Girouard. Tigers won the 2007 SEC Tournament, the Stanford Regional in the NCAA Tournament and finished the year with 55 wins. LSU ended the regular season 3rd in the ESPN/USA Today Poll.

Warhawks totaled 111 wins including two 30+ win seasons.

During tenure had 10 players named to the All-Sun Belt Conference teams, two NFCA All-Region selections and six players chosen by the Louisiana Sports Vriters Association for All-Louisiana recognition.

Team earned the Sun Belt Conference Team GPA Award in 2015 & 2016.

Broke several school offensive records including team batting average, RBI in a season, runs scored in a season, hit by pitches in a season, team slugging perentage, on base percentage and most runs scored in a game.

Finished 2018 season in the top 30 in the nation in batting average, scoring and stolen bases.

In 2015, UL-Monroe finished second in the country with 143 stolen bases. Just 10 steals behind Marshall for the top spot.

Also coached at Southern Arkansas University (2011-14) and led program to its first winning season in 9 years. His 90 wins in 3 years was the most in program history over a 3-year span. The Lady Muleriders set 31 school records and won the 2014 Great American Conference Tournament to qualify for the 1st Division II NCAA Tournament in program history.

Assistant Coach Maddie Holub, 1st Season

Hired on Aug. 22, 2018

Spent the past four seasons as the pitching coach at Saint Leo University (Saint Leo, Fla.).

Helped the Lions to back-to-back NCAA Division II postseason appearances and reached the World Series in 2018.

Saint Leo never won fewer than 37 games during her tenure.

Coached Stephanie Adkins who won back-to-back Sunshine State Conference Pitcher of the Year honors.

Team also featured five pitchers in a three-year span named all-conference.

Her pitching staff ERAs stayed below 2.04 during all four years. Highlighted by a 0.93 staff ERA in 2016 that garnered the National Statistical Championship.

Team averaged 16 shutouts per season.

Prior to Saint Leo, Maddie coached at Fort Hays State, her alma mater. The Tigers were ranked as high as No. 13 in the country during time on staff.

Also coached overseas in Collecchio, Italy with the Collecchio Softball 17U and 10U squads.

Still holds career records at Fort Hays State as a pitcher and hitter with hits (255), runs scored (183), RBI (160), home runs (46), wins (77) and strikeouts 974). Her name also appears in many other top-10 categories.

Had a career-best 6-game hitting streak (Feb. 28-March 4, 2018) and bat .500 during that span.

Hit three doubles during the Carolina Classic in 2018.

Brand New Coaching Staff

Marshall softball marches into the 2019 season with its second new coaching staff in as many years. Megan Smith takes over the program after spending the past nine years as the head coach at Kansas University. Smith led the Jayhawks to six-consecutive 30 win seasons as well as back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 2014 and 2015. Marshall's fourth head coach in program history has had head coaching stops at Young Harris (JUCO) in 2001-02 and started the Western Carolina program in 2005. The Catamounts first season of play in 2006 resulted in a 41-20 record, the Southern Conference Regular Season Title, the SoCon Pitcher of the Year, Freshman of the Year and Smith was named Coach of the Year. After leaving Western Carolina, Smith was an assistant for three years at LSU that included an SEC title and a trip to the World Series.

Joining Coach Smith are assistants **Corey Lyon** and **Maddie Holub**. Former Herd player and Warrior Award winner **Madi Marshall** joins the staff as the Director of Operations.

Coach Lyon comes to Huntington after four seasons as the head coach at UL-Monroe where he won III games. The Warhawks had two 30+ win seasons during his tenure and finished second in the nation in stolen bases in 2015 with 143, ten thefts behind Marshall.

Coach Holub joins the Marshall staff after four seasons as the pitching coach at Saint Leo University (Division II) in Florida. Holub worked her pitching staffs into some of the best in Division II as Saint Leo never won fewer than 37 games during her time. Her pitching staff never had a group ERA higher than 2.04 and won the National Statistical championship in 2016 with a team ERA of a mere 0.93.

Sophomore Aly Harrell Named Preseason All-Conference
The reigning Conference USA Freshman of the Year, Aly Harrell, was the only Herd player named to the Preseason All-Conference squad. Harrell smashed a program rookie record of 11 home runs last season and added 10 doubles. She led the team with 41 RBI, the fourth most by a freshman in program history, and tied for the team lead with a .350 average. While able to bash the ball, Harrell showed a lot of patience as a freshman hitter with 23 walks, seven hit-by-pitches and struck out just nine times in 152 plate appearances. Harrell even set a Marshall record by drawing a walk in eight-straight games, breaking the old mark of seven set by four-time All-American Rachel Folden in 2008. The now sophomore is also an excellent fielder as she sported a .986 percentage in 21 games as the starter at first base. She had just two errors in 144 chances.

Coming Up Clutch
Another 2018 freshman who may have started to earn the nickname "Miss Clutch" is current sophomore outfielder Rachel Rousseau. In limited time as a rookie, Rousseau recorded five hits and four went for doubles. She also drove in five runs, scored eight times and stole five bases. Her first three appearances as a pinch hitter (at Furman and vs. Southern Miss games one and two), "Rou" got on base each time with two walks and an RBI single that gave Marshall a 4-1 lead in game one against Southern Miss. The freshman hit her second double of the season the next day in game three. In game two at WKU on April 22, Rousseau was brought in to pinch hit in the top of the seventh with one out, one on base and the game tied at 5-5. On the seventh pitch of the at-bat, the freshman right-hander ripped a double to center that scored the run and gave Marshall the lead. Two batters later Rousseau scored to give the Herd a 2-run lead and the eventual 7-5 win.

Finally, in the regular season finale against Middle Tennessee on senior day, Rou stepped up for a pinch hit in the bottom of the seventh with two on base, one out and trailing I-0. On the second pitch, she ripped a shot into the left-center gap scoring both runners and giving Marshall a double-header sweep of the eventual Conference USA Tournament champion Blue Raiders. On the defensive side, Rousseau caught one at the wall at FAU in game three, taking away a sure extra base hit as the Owls had two runners on base. The catch at the top of the fence ended the inning.

Abigail Tolbert Steps into the Circle

After pitching just one inning in two seasons, **Abigail Tolbert** took a chance to step into the pitching circle and take charge for a team that had lost 2017 Conference USA Pitcher of the Year Jordan Dixon to graduation. Tolbert ended up leading the Herd with 160.2 innings pitched, a 3.49 ERA, 12-11 record, 10 complete games, five shutouts and 86 strikeouts. She earned her first career start against 13th ranked Auburn in the season-opener. She tossed back-to-back-to-back complete game shutouts against Presbyterian (Feb. 24), Winthrop (Feb. 25) and George Washington (March 2). Tolbert may have had her best performance of the season during an ESPN 3 broadcast against the James Madison Dukes, a team just outside of the top 25. The junior right-hander pitched a complete game, three-hit shutout and struck out a career-high seven batters. The Dukes had come in with a powerful offense that was punching out extra base hits all over the field.

The Class of 2018 for the Herd saw another group come through with record setters and major contributors that Marshall will look to replace. **Elicia D'Orazio** left with her name throughout the record book including Marshall and Conference USA's all-time leader in stolen bases with 166. Taylor "The Sniper" McCord was a leader on and off the field and closed out her time as the program's all-time leader in run-McCord was a leader on and off the field and closed out her time as the program's all-time leader in runners caught stealing (57), second all-time in pickoffs (27) and the most runners combined thrown out with an astounding 84. Eloise "Weezy" Tribolet was an exciting outfielder who spent her final two collegiate seasons with the Green and White. In Tribolet's final game for Marshall she went 3-for-3 against WKU in the C-USA Tournament and robbed her second home run of the year. Jordan Colliflower worked her way from a walk-on who saw limited time on the field to a regular starter who had a 23-game hitting streak during her senior season, the second longest streak in program history, and was named an All-Conference USA performer. Madi Marshall was the 2018 Warrior Award winner named in honor of Emileigh Cooper, and set a team pinch-running record in 2017 scoring a run in 10-straight games.

Herd Welcomes Eight Newcomers



All five received numerous accolades during their prep careers and even walking away with school records.











Megan Smith

Head Coach 1st Season North Carolina '99



On Wednesday July 25, 2017, Megan Smith was named the four head coach in Marshall softball history.

Smith, who sports a career record of 393-265, led the Kansas Jayhawks to six consecutive 30-win seasons and back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 2014 and 2015. The 2015 campaign yielded the first 40-win season for the program in 23 years, the best start in school history for the second time in her tenure (12-0) and seven consecutive weeks in the top 25. Her 2013 team recorded the program's highest winning percentage (.680) in 21 years, broke the Big 12 record for batting average (.345), the highest mark in the NCAA that season. In 2012, Kansas had a 20-game win streak and, the year before, boasted an 11.5 game won-loss record improvement, the 16th-best turnaround in NCAA history. The 26-3 mark to open the 2011 season was also the best start in the program's history.

"I am extremely honored and excited to be a part of the Marshall family," said Smith. "There is such a strong history and tradition of success within the softball program and I am humbled to now be a part of that. I want to thank Mike Hamrick for this incredible opportunity for me and my son Cooper. I am eager to get to know the players and to get started this fall!"

At Kansas, she coached one All-American, one academic All-American, 20 All-Big 12 selections, 20 NFCA (National Fastpitch Coaches Association) All-Region selections, 50 All-Big 12 Academic Team honorees, three Big 12 Scholar Athletes of the Year and three student-athletes taken in the NPF (National Pro Fastpitch) Draft. The program also set single-season fielding percentage (2014, .979-second-highest nationally) and home run records during her time as head coach (60, 2011).

Prior to her time in Lawrence, Smith was an assistant for LSU for three seasons, where she helped the Tigers in winning the 2007 SEC Tournament and the Stanford Regional in the NCAA Tournament en route to 55 wins. LSU finished the regular season ranked third in the ESPN/USA Today poll. The following season, the Tigers picked up 44 wins on their way to a #9 national seed in the NCAA Tournament. During her tenure, she mentored two All-Americans and five NFCA All-South Region honorees.

Smith started the softball program at Western Carolina and posted a 41-20 record in WCU's inaugural season, earning 2006 Southern Conference Coach of the Year honors, while leading the Catamounts to the league's regular season title. That season, five student-athletes garnered first-team all-league acclaim, with another on the second team and two more were tabbed on the NFCA Southeast All-Region second team. She also coached the conference's 2006 Pitcher of the Year and Freshman of the Year. WCU broke the league's single-season home run record (81) that year, part of an explosive offensive season for the program (third in the nation in home runs per game, 14th in slugging percentage, 19th in scoring).

She also had assistant coaching stops at her alma mater North Carolina (2004), where she helped the Tar Heels reach the NCAA Tournament, and at Charlotte in 2003.

Her first head coaching position came at Young Harris College in Georgia, where she put up a 79-41 record over two seasons.

"We are very much looking forward to Megan leading our softball program," said Marshall Director of Athletics Mike Hamrick. "She is a proven winner and has a reputation for helping mold top-quality student-athletes. Our program is eager for her arrival in Huntington."

Smith, who is an NCAA Division I Softball Committee member, graduated from North Carolina in May 1999 with a Bachelor of Arts in Physical Education and Recreation Studies. She received her Master of Science in Human Performance and Sport Studies from Tennessee in August of 2000.

A Walkertown, N.C. native, Smith and the late Paul Buske have one son, Cooper.

Grand Larceny on the Bases

Marshall has recorded 2,276 total stolen bases in program history going back to 1994 averaging 91.04 per season (through end of 2018).

Marshall has been ranked more times in the Top 10 in the country than any other school since 2000 and has been in the Top

10 every year since 2009. 1. Marshall – 11 (3 times led the country) 2. Alabama – 7

T3. Miss. Valley State, Baylor, Prairie View & Akron – 6 T5. Southern U. & Jackson State – 5 T9. Alcorn & Loyola-Chicago – 4

Marshall has led the country in stolen bases per game three times -2011,2015 & 2017 (the only program to do so since 2000) and finished second in 2012 & 2013. Only Alabama (2007 & 2009) and Prairie View A&M (2001 & 2003) have led the country twice since 2000. Marshall set the team mark in 2017 with 162.

Morgan Zerkle (2015) and Elicia D'Orazio (2017) both won the Golden Shoe Award which is given annually to the nation's leader in stolen bases. Zerkle led the country with .94 per game and D'Orazio racked up 1.09 per game.

Marshall shattered the program record for steals in a game with 16 against Delaware State on March 5, 2017. The old mark was 11 steals at Middle Tennessee State April 10, 2015. Thieves in the game: Morgan Zerkle (5), Shaelynn Braxton (4), Eloise Tribolet (2), Abigail Estrada (2), Elicia D'Orazio (2) and Hayden Ellis (1).

Marshall has reached double-digits for steals in a single game five times in program history. One game in each season since 2014: 10 at UNC Wilmington (3/20/14), 11 at Middle Tennessee (4/10/15), 10 vs. Toledo (3/15/16), 16 vs. Delaware State (3/5/17), 11 vs. UMass-Lowell (2/17/18).

Prior to the 2018 season, Marshall was the only team in Conference USA to have more than one player with 100 or more

career steals. After the 2018 season Florida Atlantic now has two players over the century mark.

Sierra Davenport is still the Mid-American Conference's all-time leader in career stolen bases.

In 2017, D'Orazio shattered the Herd's single season mark of 51 steals with 59. The junior base-stealer also broke the 17-year old Conference USA record of 57 set by Chrystal Stevens of Southern Miss. Stevens set the record in 76 games back in 2000. D'Orazio broke the record in just 53 games.

Marshall has recorded over 100 steals in a season 12 times and following 2018, now 10 seasons in a row.

In Marshall's record-breaking season of 2017, six players combined for 40 Multi-SB games: Elicia D'Orazio 17, Morgan Zerkle 13, Eloise Tribolet 3, Abigail Estrada 3, Taylor McCord 3 & Shaelynn Braxton 1


