## **Head Coach Walt Bell**

Opening Statement:

"First thing, credit to those guys, they are a great football team. We knew that coming into the game. You look for a victory every single chance you get. Obviously not good enough to win a football game."

On game performance without film:

"For a first start, it was a hostile environment. We didn't have any typical issues."

On post-game messages to the team:

"I think for me it's almost the same message, no matter how good or how bad where we have to improve. We are a young team. A big positive is that some of these guys have never really lost before."

On potential opportunities:

"We had some opportunities to capitalize early in the football game. Really for me, it was just starting field position. We're at two games in a row where we are really behind the eight-ball.
