First Time For Everything

- The Thundering Herd and Gators meet on the diamond for the first time in school history to begin the 2020 NCAA Season. Marshall squares off against its first SEC opponent since a mid-week matchup at Tennessee on Wednesday, March 22, 2017. The Volunteers won 7-1. The Gators are ranked as high as No. 4 in the D1Baseball.com preseason Top 25. They are preseason No. 10 in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

Seeking A Big Win

- Marshall seeks its biggest ranked win since defeating Anthony Rendon and Brock Holt's No. 1 Rice Owls, 11-7, on Sunday, April 19, 2009 in Houston. Sophomore Victor Gomez hit a pair of home runs for the The Herd.
 - The Thundering Herd last won a series against a ranked opponent when it took two out of three from then-C-USA foe No. 19 Houston, 2-1 (W, 19-13; W, 4-0; L, 9-1) from April 5-7, 2013 in Charleston, W.Va.
 - At No. 9 Kentucky on March 27, 2013 was the last top-10 team Marshall faced (L, 8-2).

Break Ranks

- Marshall last beat a ranked opponent on April 18, 2019 at No. 21 Louisiana Tech, a win in the series-opener in Ruston, 7-3. Phillip Hoffman earned the win on the mound in relief.
 - The last ranked SEC opponent Marshall faced was No. 14 Mississippi State in February 2015, a two-game set in which the Bulldogs won 6-2 and 7-4.
 - When Marshall faces No. 4 Florida, it will be the highest-ranked opponent it has faced since the Herd lost 6-3 to No. 1 ranked Virginia in Charlottesville on March 23, 2010.

Looking For A Quick Start

- The Herd has won just two of its previous six season-openers, and two of its previous five season-opening series. Marshall in 2018 defeated Florida A&M, 17-5, to begin the season in Tallahassee. Jeff Waggoner's team took two out of three over the Rattlers in that series.
 - Last year, Marshall opened the year in Kissimmee at the Diamond 9 Sunshine State Classic Series, and lost the opener to Milwaukee, 5-3.

New Kids On The Block

- The Herd returns just three positional players who made 30 or more starts in 2019 (Geordon Blanton (57), Zach Inskeep (53), Luke Edwards (32)). The team does however return 12 pitchers and a total of 19 letter-winners.

- The 6-2 Redshirt Senior is a native of Wheelersburg, Ohio and Wheelersburg High School, approximately 45 minutes from Huntington
- In 2018, gained a redshirt after suffering a season-ending UCL tear in game against UAB, forcing surgery. In that contest he had pitched 8 strikeouts in 4.2 innings prior to exiting. Had a 3.55 ERA in 25.1 innings pitched in the five games he appeared in in 2019.
- Last season pitched a season-high 4.0 innings twice against UTSA (May 4) and Rice (May 17), including a season-high six strikeouts in the contest against UTSA.
- 2017 (Sophomore) Was named to the All-Conference USA Second Team and C-USA All-Academic Team. He started in all 14 games that he appeared in on the mound, holding a 3-4 record with a 4.24 ERA and tossed a team-high 78 innings pitched, striking out a team-high 77 batters, good for 11th in Conference USA ... led C-USA in batters struck out looking with 32.
- Ranked in the top 10 of four different categories in C-USA games only – batters struck out looking (1st, 21), innings pitched (1st, 68.1), strikeouts (5th, 56) and opposing batting average (7th, .237) .
- He has been named to the Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll and recipient of the C-USA Academic Medal all four years thus far (GPA of 3.75 or higher).
- Born on April 9, 1996 ... son of Tom and Mindy Martin ... father played football at Ohio Wesleyan University

New 2021 Stadium

On September 11, 2019, Marshall University purchased the Flint Group pigments property in Huntington from the Huntington Municipal Development Authority (HUMDA). The land will be used to construct the Thundering Herd's long-awaited on-campus new baseball stadium, which is set to open in Huntington in March of 2021. On Saturday, October 25, 2019, ground ceremoniously broke for the start of construction on the field.

In 13 seasons, 36 Marshall players/signees have been given a chance to play at the professional level under Head Coach Waggoner, including major leaguers Dan Straily (2009, 24th round – Oakland A's), Kevin Shackelford (2010, 21st round – Milwaukee Brewers), Aaron Blair (2013, first supplemental round – 36th overall – Arizona Diamondbacks) and JD Hammer (2016, 24th Round – Colorado Rockies).

2016 was a record season for Marshall under the instruction of Coach Waggoner. The Herd won a program record 34 wins, including a win over 17th-ranked Florida Atlantic. Marshall also set a program record 21 wins in Conference USA play. Marshall boasted its highest RPI of 60. Coach Waggoner received the Keith LeClair Coach of the Year award from C-USA. The Thundering Herd lineup featured three C-USA All-Conference first team players (Chase Boster, DJ Gee, Tommy Lane), one C-USA All-Conference second team player (Corey Bird) and a member to the All-Freshman team (Joshua Shapiro). Lane was selected as the Newcomer of the Year for Marshall. The Herd also found success in the classroom with a 3.01 GPA during the fall semester.

The 2016 MLB amateur draft featured four players from the Herd, second most in a single draft. Corey Bird was drafted by the Miami Marlins in the seventh round with the 203rd overall pick. Burris Warner was the second player drafted in the 22nd round to the Detroit Tigers. JD Hammer followed in the 24th round to the Colorado Rockies. Parker Danciu rounded out the group in the 39th round to the Atlanta Braves.

Waggoner's 2014 and 2015 seasons produced All-Conference performers, with Boster earning All-Conference USA second team honors in 2015. Bird was chosen to the All-Freshman team in 2014.

After the 2013 season, Waggoner saw two Thundering Herd players selected in the Major League Baseball Draft. A total of 12 players were selected over the last three seasons, while 26 of his student-athletes have received an opportunity to play professional baseball under his tutelage. Aaron Blair (first supplemental round - 36th overall - to the Arizona Diamondbacks) and Isaac Ballou (15th round to the Washington Nationals), the 2013 draftees, became the 14th and 15th members of the Herd to be selected after serving on one of Waggoner's teams.

One year prior, pitchers Joe Church (17th round to the San Diego Padres) and Mike Mason (24th round to the Colorado Rockies) were selected.

Waggoner's last three teams have produced All-Conference performers, with Blair and Ballou garnering All-Conference USA first team honors in 2013 after Blair and Sergio Leon were named All-Freshmen in 2011 and 2012, respectively.

The 2011 season featured eight players who would go on to be drafted by MLB teams and two players who were signed as free agents. Greg Williams (Texas Rangers), Mike Mason (Texas Rangers), Joe Church (Los Angeles Angels), Isaac Ballou (Pittsburgh Pirates), Kenny Socorro (Chicago Cubs), Arik Sikula (Toronto Blue Jays), Shane Farell (Toronto Blue Jays), Rhett Stafford (Oakland Athletics) were each drafted in the 2011 MLB, marking the most drafted players in a season in Marshall baseball history. Victor Gomez (Atlanta Braves) and Ian Kadish (Toronto Blue Jays) were also picked up by big league teams as free agents.

Along with the most drafted players in a season, Waggoner's club had four players earn Conference USA honors. Kenny Socorro was selected to the All-Conference USA team as an infielder and freshman, Aaron Blair, was named to the Conference USA All-Freshman team. Kyle Blank and Arik Sikula both earned academic recognition through the conference, after being picked to the Conference USA All-Academic team.

In the 2010 Major League Baseball Amateur Draft, Kevin Shackelford, Ryan Kiel and Aaron Blair were selected. Other notable players drafted include Steven Blevins, Tommy Johnson and Nate Lape in 2008, while Eddie Rush and Dan Straily were picked in 2009.

In 2008, during his second season at Marshall, Waggoner led the Herd to 30 wins, the second most in program history. The Herd notched a 30-30-1 overall record and finished sixth in C-USA, with a berth in the 2008 Entergy C-USA Baseball Championship tournament hosted by Tulane.

Prior to the 2010 campaign, the Herd placed three players (Blevins, Lape and Gomez) on All-C-USA teams, while two (Lape and Gomez) were named to all All-Mideast Region squads. Adam Yeager, Gomez and Lape all played summer ball in the prestigious Cape Cod Baseball League.

In his first season with the Herd, Waggoner led the squad to a 21 wins that included 15 victories at home. The Alliance, Ohio, native helped lead Marshall to series wins against both Memphis and Houston.

Waggoner lettered two years as a catcher at Cleveland State University, and graduated with a sport management degree in 1998. He played two years at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo., prior to transferring to Cleveland State. Waggoner received his master's degree in Educational Psychology from the College of Saint Rose in 2001.
