ETSU: 6th meeting, Marshall leads 4-1, last meeting Feb. 14, 2015 - MU won 3-0



The East Tennessee State Bucs enter the weekend with a 3-6 record. ETSU got off to a ough start going 0-4 in the season-opening tournament at Georgia Southern. However, the team bounced back in Jacksonville with three wins coming over Alabama A&M (twice) and North Florida before dropping the final two games to Jacksonville. The Bucs have only been outscored by six runs (45-39) to start the year. Three players are batting over 300 with Kelly Warren (.412), Julia Fritz (.367) and Makenna Helton (.333). Warren has collected 14 hits, four runs, one double and is 5-of-7 in stolen base attempts. Fritz leads the team in extra base hits with four doubles and one triple. Lili Bowen has the only home run so far this season in the loss to Rutgers on Feb. 9. Senior thirdbase Nikki Grupp was just named a Senior CLASS Award candidate on Tuesday. Grupp is off to rough start after missing the first weekend as the 2019 All-SoCon performer is batting .091 in four games. In the circle, Kelly Schmidt has the most innings with 19.2 and a 3.56 ERA.Taylor Boling has pitched 15.0 innings and has a 3.73 ERA while MacKenzie Dyson has 13 innings and a 3.23 ERA. Head coach Brad Irwin is in his 10th season and has tallied 167 wins

Kennesaw St: 2nd all-time meeting, KSU leads 1-0, last meeting Feb. 17, 2012 - KSU won 4-3



The host Kennesaw State Owls have an 8-1 record that includes a 4-1 win over Auburn, at Auburn, on Feb. 13. The lone loss was 9-2 at Troy on Friday. The Owls offense has been pouring in the production with a team batting average of .343 and outscoring the opposition 68-21. Seven of the main starters are batting over .300 this season with three hitting over .400 in Brea Dickey (.483), Katie Greep (.444) and Taylor Cates (.429). Dickey has 14 hits, 10 runs scored, two doubles, one triple and is 5-of-6 in steals. The Owls have hit just three home runs in the first nine games but they have been excellent at producing runs with timely hitting and forcing opponents into errors with 17 total. Greep was named Atlantic Sun Player of the Week on Monday after recording eight hits. three runs. three Atlantic Sun Player of the Week on Monday after recording eight hits, three runs, three RBI and a stolen base. Greep had two hits in the win over Auburn and drove in two runs with a double in the Owls' 6-4 win over Southeast Missouri State on Friday. In the circle, KSU has five pitchers that have all thrown at least 7.1 innings so far. Melanie Bennett has the most innings with 14.0 and a 2.00 ERA. Lindsey Kyte has 13.1 innings and a 1.58 ERA. Head coach Tripp MacKay is in his second season with a 34-30 overall record.

Rhode Island: 2nd all-time meeting, MU leads 1-0, last meeting March 2, 2007 - MU won 12-5



The Rhode Island Rams begin the season 3-5 with wins over Seton Hall (2-1), Charlotte (7-2) and North Carolina A&T (7-2). The offense has struggled some out of the gate with (7-2). The offense has struggled some out of the gate with a team batting average of .206 and just two hitters batting over .300. Erika Yeger leads with a .333 average and seven hits. Ari Castillo is also hitting .333 (5 hits) and has one double and one home run. Rachel Zingerman, who was just named Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Week, has two of the team's three home runs. She bat .364 this past week, is hitting .286 for the year, and leads the team with 14 RBI. Pitcher Sarah Gunderson was honored as the Atlantic 10 Pitcher of the Week for the second time and has been the main arm for the Rams. Gunderson has tossed 25 innings, sports a 1.80 ERA, has a 3-0 record and 21 the Kams. Guiderson has cossed 23 minings, spot is a 1.00 EtX, has a 3-0 fecolog and 21 strikeouts. She is holding batters to a .226 average against her. CeCe Sidley is next with 13 innings and a 2.77 ERA. However, opposing teams are hitting .303 against Rhode Island with 25 more hits and 10 more runs. The Rhode Island defense has been solid with just five errors in the first eight games and a team fielding percentage of .977, good for 32nd in the NCAA. Head coach Bridget Hurlman is in her fifth season and has 55 career wins.





Head Coach Megan Smith, 2nd Season, Overall Divison I record: 361-249/Overall Collegiate Record: 440-290

Entering second season with Marshall after being hired in July of 2018 as the fourth head coach in Marshall softball history.

Won 1st game with the Herd in MU debut vs. UC-Riverside, 5-2 win (Feb. 8). Went 4-1 during the first tournament at the helm for Marshall.

Earned 400th career coaching win Feb. 16, 2019 with 10-1 victory over Presbyterian. Herd also tied single-game, program record with 5 HRs in the win. Spent the past nine seasons as the head coach at Kansas University. Recorded six 30+ win seasons including a 40-15 mark in 2015. Finished with 273 wins.

Took the Jayhawks to NCAA Regionals in 2014 & 2015. In 2015 the team spent 7-consecutive weeks ranked in the top 25.

Kansas led the Big 12 and the nation with a conference record .345 batting average. Also set team records with a .979 fielding percentage in 2014 (2nd ighest nationally), and 60 home runs in 2011.

Team sported a 20-game winning streak in 2012.

Boasted an II.5 game won-loss record improvement in 2011 from the year before, the 16th-best turnaround in NCAA history. Kansas opened the season vith a 26-3 record, the best start in program history.

While at Kansas, the Jayhawks had one All-American, one Academic All-American, 20 All-Big 12 selections, 20 NFCA All-Region selections, 50 All-Big 12 Academic Team honorees, three Big 12 Scholar Athletes of the Year and three players taken in the NPF Draft.

Marshall got out to a rough start on Friday with losses to Lipscomb (14-6) and Chattanooga (10-8), struggling in the circle and defensively. The Herd bounced back with three wins to end the weekend with a winning record.

Marshall got out to an early 4-1 lead over Ohio before the Bobcats fought back and took a one-run lead, 5-4 Junior Armani Brown reached on a bunt-single to begin the bottom of the sixth and then sophomore Grace Chelemen followed up reaching on a bunt-single as well. Junior Aly Harrell came up next, already with two RBI in the game, and hit a double off the wall in right-center scoring both Brown and Chelemen to take the lead. Marshall held on in the top of the seventh as junior Laney Jones picked up her first save in a Herd uniform.

In the nightcap against Tennessee Tech, Harrell provided the big bat again with a grand slam in the bottom of the sixth to put the Herd up by five going into the seventh. Jones finished the night with the complete game victory.

Marshall came out rolling on Sunday in a 9-1 win over Indiana State. The Herd tallied 15 hits in the victory as every batter reached base safely at least once and six hitters recorded at least two hits. Armani Brown was perfect at the plate going 3-for-3. Sophomore Mya Stevenson hit her fourth home run of the season in the second inning to put Marshall up 8-1, and then senior Blakely Burch finished the scoring with a solo homer to right. The Herd defense held the Sycamores off the scoreboard in the top of the fifth to finish with the run-rule win.

Aly Harrell Named Conference USA Player of the Week: February 17 Junior Aly Harrell dominated the weekend at the Chattanooga Challenge. The slugger produced a .714 batting average, slugged 1.500, an on base percentage of .778, 10 hits, 11 RBI, two doubles, three home runs, three walks and one hit-by-pitch to help lead the Herd to a 3-2 record. She hit her first home run of the weekend, and of the 2020 season, with a three-run shot in the loss to Lipscomb. She then reached base twice against Chattanooga with a hit and a walk and a walk.

On Saturday, Harrell really took off combining to go 6-of-7 with eight RBI in the two games against Ohio and Tennessee Tech. Versus the Bobcats, Harrell started the game with a solo home run in the first inning. Her next plate appearance she was plunked on the first pitch with bases loaded to drive in another run. In the bottom of the sixth, Harrell came through with a two-run double to put Marshall back on top by one, 6-5. She also caught the final out in the top of the seventh. Harrell tied her career-high with four RBI in the win. Then against Tennessee Tech, Harrell set a career-high with four hits as she was a perfect 4-for-4 at the plate and then drove in four runs for a second time with a grand slam in the bottom of the sixth. Her third homer of the weekend put Marshall up by five and then went on to win 6-1.

She finished the weekend going 2-of-3 at the plate and scoring another run, her fifth of the weekend, in the victory over Indiana State. After her monster performance, Harrell increased her season batting average to .650, is slugging 1.250 and has a .774 on base percentage.

Senior Kailee Williamson, junior Aly Harrell and sophomore Mya Stevenson were named to the Preseason All-Conference USA team, as voted on by the league coaches. As a senior in 2015, players were told to pick one word that would be significant and have meaning to them. Cooper chose "Warrior" and her identity statement that season was, "I am a confident Warrior. I am the fire in C-USA that will always keep burning." At home against WKU on March 13, 2015, the Herd and Hilltoppers were locked in a scoreless battle that went into the 10th inning. Cooper came up to the plate, after **Rebecca Myslenski** was walked, and got to see one pitch before the game was called because of rain. The teams came back the following morning and picked up right from there. As Cooper prepared to go to the plate she looked at freshman **Elicia D'Orazio** who was batting behind her and warming up and said "Don't worry about getting ready. I'm going to end this now." Cooper saw two more pitches before blasting a home run off 2015 C-USA Pitcher of the Year Miranda Kramer for the walk-off win.

The 2019 Warrior Award, our recipient (**Hayden Ellis**) has earned the title. She has battled through adversity on an off the field. Not only has she fought through three seasons of trying to see more playing time on the field, behind one of the greatest catchers in Herd history, she made a great comeback from a shoulder injury that took away almost her entire junior season. She has fought through personal tragedy in losing a close friend and has also seen her father fight cancer, and who we are now glad to say is cancer free. Our 2019 Warrior Award winner has had a career year in 2019 with 40 games played, 36 starts, 19 hits, 12 runs, seven doubles, one triple, one home run, 13 RBI and 21 walks. She has come through in clutch situations and over a nine-game stretch in March, hit .474 with an on-base percentage of .643. She has thrown out two runners in a game twice adding her name to the list of catcher greats in program history that have completed the for catcher greats in program history that have completed the feat.

Its a weekend of games against teams that Marshall has not played too often throughout the history of the program.The Herd has faced all three teams combined just seven times with five against East Tennessee State as the most.

Marshall has not played ETSU since a 3-0 victory in 2015. Morgan Zerkle had two hits, scored twice and stole three bases. Brittanie Fowler was brought in to the circle in relief in the first inning and pitched 5.2 innings to earn her first win of the season. Fowler allowed just two hits, walked two and struck out two in the victory. Jordan Dixon came in for the final inning and earned her first save of the year. Marshall and the Bucs first met in 2002 as the Herd won as the teams split while playing at the Georgia Bulldog Classic. The teams met again in 2004 and in 2006, both Herd wins, before going nine years to the last meeting in 2015.

It has been eight years since the last time that Marshall and Kennesaw State met on the field. The Owls got out to the early lead in the nightcap of a Friday doubleheader at the College of Charleston. The Herd tied the game in the second as Samantha Spurlock drove in Taylor Thompson. However, KSU scored three runs in the third to take a 4-1 lead. Bri Anna Hope had her first two double game of her career and drove in a run as Marshall could not complete the comeback.

And it has been 13 years since Marshall and Rhode Island met on the field at a tournament hosted by Herd head coach Megan Smith's alma mater, the UNC Tar Heels in 2007. Rachel Schmidt was 3-for-3 at the plate and hit her first career home run as Marshall went on to win 12-5. The Herd totaled 13 hits as Christina Guillen also had three, and Joscelyn Bitner, Caitlyn Jackson and Gina Guzzo all had two each. Five players scored twice for Marshall. Abigail Harter - now the head coach at Abilene Christian - earned her fifth win of the year going six innings and scattering five hits. Amanda Luers finished the game pitching in the seventh and did not allow a player on base.

Head Coach 2nd Season North Carolina '99

Coach Smith led a big turnaround for the Herd with a 17-win improvement (tied for second-best in program history) at 42-22. Her career record is 440-290 (13 years).

Her first season with the Herd was a record-breaking one along with leading the team to the Conference USA Championship game for the first time since 2014 as the No. 4 seed in the tournament. Following the 3-1 championship game loss to No. 2 seed Louisiana Tech, Marshall received an invite to the National Invitational Softball Championship and played in the Lynchburg, Va., Regional. Again Marshall fought its way into the regional championship game before falling to the host Liberty Flames. The Herd ended the season tying the record for most wins in a season with 42.

Coach Smith won her debut game for the Green and White with a 5-2 victory over UC-Riverside (Feb. 8) in San Diego, Calif. She earned her 400th career coaching victory with a 10-1 win against Presbyterian (Feb. 16). The Herd finished the early part of the season with a 17-6 record before diving into Conference USA action. Marshall was predicted to finish eighth in the preseason coaches' poll but battled through to a 17-7 record with the series win in 7-of-8 conference matchups. The Herd played well at home with a 13-6 record including two walk-off victories at the Dot in conference action against WKU and Louisiana Tech.

During the season, the team as well as individual players were ranked nationally in many statistical categories. By the end of the season Marshall was ranked in the top 100 in home runs (19th), shutouts (tied for 21st), slugging percentage (27th), on base percentage (40th), runs per game (45th), winning percentage (51st) and fielding percentage (97th). Individually Aly Harrell led the country in total walks (68) and combined free passes with 85 (68 walks and 17 hit-by-pitches). Sierra Huerta led the nation in hit-by-pitches with 30 which was also good for 12th most all-time in NCAA history. Freshman Mya Stevenson led all freshman across Division I with 20 homers. Marshall players in total ranked in the top 50 in the country 17 times by the end of the 2019 season.

The 2019 Marshall softball team broke or tied 15 team records and 15 individual records.

Smith, who sported a career record of 393-265 prior to coming to Marshall, led the Kansas Jayhawks to six consecutive 30-win seasons and back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 2014 and 2015 during her nine seasons at the helm. The 2015 campaign yielded the first 40-win season for the program in 23 years, the best start in school history for the second time in her tenure (12-0) and seven consecutive weeks in the top 25. Her 2013 team recorded the program's highest winning percentage (.680) in 21 years, broke the Big 12 record for batting average (.345), the highest mark in the NCAA that season. In 2012, Kansas had a 20-game win streak and, the year before, boasted an 11.5 game won-loss record improvement, the 16th-best turnaround in NCAA history. The 26-3 mark to open the 2011 season was also the best start in the program's history.

"I am extremely honored and excited to be a part of the Marshall family," said Smith. "There is such a strong history and tradition of success within the softball program and I am humbled to now be a part of that. I want to thank Mike Hamrick for this incredible opportunity for me and my son Cooper. I am eager to get to know the players and to get started this fall!"

At Kansas, she coached one All-American, one academic All-American, 20 All-Big 12 selections, 20 NFCA (National Fastpitch Coaches Association) All-Region selections, 50 All-Big 12 Academic Team honorees, three Big 12 Scholar Athletes of the Year and three student-athletes taken in the NPF (National Pro Fastpitch) Draft. The program also set single-season fielding percentage (2014, .979-second-highest nationally) and home run records during her time as head coach (60, 2011).

Prior to her time in Lawrence, Smith was an assistant for LSU for three seasons, where she helped the Tigers in winning the 2007 SEC Tournament and the Stanford Regional in the NCAA Tournament en route to 55 wins. LSU finished the regular season ranked third in the ESPN/USA Today poll. The following season, the Tigers picked up 44 wins on their way to a #9 national seed in the NCAA Tournament. During her tenure, she mentored two All-Americans and five NFCA All-South Region honorees.

Smith started the softball program at Western Carolina and posted a 41-20 record in WCU's inaugural season, earning 2006 Southern Conference Coach of the Year honors, while leading the Catamounts to the league's regular season title. That season, five student-athletes garnered first-team all-league acclaim, with another on the second team and two more were tabbed on the NFCA Southeast All-Region second team. She also coached the conference's 2006 Pitcher of the Year and Freshman of the Year. WCU broke the league's single-season home run record (81) that year, part of an explosive offensive season for the program (third in the nation in home runs per game, 14th in slugging percentage, 19th in scoring).

She also had assistant coaching stops at her alma mater North Carolina (2004), where she helped the Tar Heels reach the NCAA Tournament, and at Charlotte in 2003.

Her first head coaching position came at Young Harris College in Georgia, where she put up a 79-41 record over two seasons.

"We are very much looking forward to Megan leading our softball program," said Marshall Director of Athletics Mike Hamrick. "She is a proven winner and has a reputation for helping mold top-quality student-athletes. Our program is eager for her arrival in Huntington."

Smith, who is an NCAA Division I Softball Committee member, graduated from North Carolina in May 1999 with a Bachelor of Arts in Physical Education and Recreation Studies. She received her Master of Science in Human Performance and Sport Studies from Tennessee in August of 2000.

A Walkertown, N.C. native, Smith and the late Paul Buske have one son, Cooper.

Marshall has recorded 2,340 total stolen bases in program history going back to 1994 averaging 90.0 per season (through end of 2019).

Marshall has been ranked more times in the Top 10 in the country than any other school since 2000 and was in the Top 10 every year from 2009 through 2017. I. Marshall $-\frac{1}{2}I$ (3 times led the country)

Marshall has led the country in stolen bases per game three times -2011,2015 & 2017 (the only program to do so since 2000) and finished second in 2012 & 2013. Only Alabama (2007 & 2009) and Prairie View A&M (2001 & 2003) have led the country twice since 2000. Marshall set the team mark in 2017 with 162.

Morgan Zerkle (2015) and Elicia D'Orazio (2017) both won the Golden Shoe Award which is given annually to the nation's leader in stolen bases. Zerkle led the country with .94 per game and D'Orazio racked up 1.09 per game.

Marshall shattered the program record for steals in a game with 16 against Delaware State on March 5, 2017. The old mark was 11 steals at Middle Tennessee State April 10, 2015. Thieves in the game: Morgan Zerkle (5), Shaelynn Braxton (4), Eloise Tribolet (2), Abigail Estrada (2), Elicia D'Orazio (2) and Hayden Ellis (1).

Marshall has reached double-digits for steals in a single game five times in program history. One game in each season since 2014: 10 at UNC Wilmington (3/20/14), 11 at Middle Tennessee (4/10/15), 10 vs. Toledo (3/15/16), 16 vs. Delaware State (3/5/17), 11 vs. UMass-Lowell (2/17/18).

Prior to the 2018 season, Marshall was the only team in Conference USA to have more than one player with 100 or more

career steals. After the 2018 season Florida Atlantic now has two players over the century mark.

Morgan Zerkle (2014-17) - 162 3rd all-time in C-USA

Kaelynn Greene (2013-16) - 141 4th all-time in C-USA

Sierra Davenport is still the Mid-American Conference's all-time leader in career stolen bases.

In 2017, D'Orazio shattered the Herd's single season mark of 51 steals with 59. The junior base-stealer also broke the 17-year old Conference USA record of 57 set by Chrystal Stevens of Southern Miss. Stevens set the record in 76 games back in 2000. D'Orazio broke the record in just 53 games.

Marshall has recorded over 100 steals in a season 12 times and following 2018, now 10 seasons in a row.

In Marshall's record-breaking season of 2017, six players combined for 40 Multi-SB games: Elicia D'Orazio 17, Morgan Zerkle 13, Eloise Tribolet 3, Abigail Estrada 3, Taylor McCord 3 & Shaelynn Braxton I
