

Game Notes – UAB at Marshall – November 13, 2021

Following UAB's win, Marshall leads the all-time series, 8-4.

Senior offensive lineman Will Ulmer made his 54th career start, passing Chris Jasperse for No. 3 on Marshall's career starts list.

Marshall's streak of consecutive games without a missed extra point is now 30 games.

The Thundering Herd defense allowed an opposing offense to score points in the third quarter for the first time this season.

Quarterback Grant Wells had two touchdown passes, moving him past Isaiah Green for No. 14 on the school's career passing touchdowns list and tied with Bradley Workman and Bernard Morris for No. 13 on the all-time list with 31 career passing TDs.

Wells also eclipsed 5,000 career passing yards, the 12th QB in Herd history to accomplish the feat.

Wells surpassed 3,000 passing yards this season, the 18th time in Marshall history a QB has passed for as many yards in a season (11th different QB).

Kicker Shane Ciucci has now converted 64 consecutive PATs. Overall, Marshall has made 103 consecutive PATs.

Linebacker Abraham Beauplan led Marshall with 15 tackles, which is also a personal career best for a single game. Beauplan's 2.5 tackles for a loss are also a career high.

Defensive back Brandon Drayton had his first double-digit tackle game since Sept. 28, 2019, and his 14 tackles vs. UAB is a single game career high.

Defensive lineman Owen Porter finished with eight tackles, a career high.

Receiver Corey Gammage scored his first touchdown of the season. Gammage last had a receiving TD nearly one year ago today – Nov. 14, 2020 against Middle Tennessee.

Gammage tied a career high with eight receptions.

Receiver Jayden Harrison scored his second receiving touchdown of the season and his third total touchdown in the last four games.
