The Florida Atlantic Owls are 8-23 this season and have started 3-5 in Conference USA play. The Owls opened C-USA action splitting with FIU. Both teams grabbed an 8-0 victory from the first two games. FAU then won 7-3 before falling 7-4 in game four. The Owls then dropped three-of-four to Charlotte at home, getting outscored 19-10. FAU won game three 5-4 with a walkoff, after the contest was suspended in the bottom of the sixth due to bad weather Saturday night. The teams resumed the game Sunday morning and Florida Atlantic started the bottom of the seventh with a double from Fayth Davis. Gretchen Ebert then reached first on a throwing error from third that allowed Davis to score for the walkoff victory. FAU's offense is batting .242 and has been outscored 156-91. The team leads the conference in triples with 10, 27th in the NCAA in triples per game (.32), and freshman Kaitlyn Cunningham is tied for the second-most triples in the country with five. Cunningham is also the only batter hitting over .300 (.301) this season, and has 28 hits with 12 runs scored. Sara Bertiaume is second in batting average (.284), triples (3) and runs scored (10). Fifth-year senior Kaitlyn Burke leads the Owls with three home runs and 12 RBI and is second with 24 hits. FAU has used four pitchers in 2021 that have a combined ERA of 4.63 with opponents batting .290 against them. Lynn Gardner has been the main arm with 100.2 innings pitched, a 3.96 ERA, 5-10 record and 58 strikeouts. Donnie Gobourne has tossed 49.2 innings, has a 4.65 ERA, a 2-8 record and 33 strikeouts. Abigail Morgan has 37.1 innings and a 7.13 ERA. Kara Lokeinsky has thrown 118.1 innings with a 3.24 EPA. 19.1 innings with a 3.26 ERA.



Head Coach Megan Smith Lyon, 3rd Season, Overall Divison I record: 386-260/Overall Collegiate Record: 465

Third season with Marshall after being hired in July of 2018 as the fourth head coach in Marshall softball history.

Marshall record is 72-36. Has quickly established Marshall as a powerful offensive threat. After setting program record with 79 home runs in 2019, then in 2020 Herd led NCAA in home runs per game with 1.92 (48 total) and was on pace for over 100 before remainder of year was canceled due to COVID-19 pandemic.

Herd bats hit 150th home run during coach Smith Lyon's tenure in game two vs. Bellarmine on March 27. It was just the 103 game of her time at Marshall.

Became the fastest coach in program history to reach 50 wins (76 games) with 8-0 victory over Rhode Island on Feb. 23, 2020.

Won 1st game with the Herd in MU debut vs. UC-Riverside, 5-2 win (Feb. 8). Went 4-1 during the first tournament at the helm for Marshall.

Earned 400th career coaching win Feb. 16, 2019 with 10-1 victory over Presbyterian. Herd also tied single-game, program record with 5 HRs in the win.

Spent the past nine seasons as the head coach at Kansas University. Recorded six 30+ win seasons including a 40-15 mark in 2015. Finished with 273 wins.

Took the Jayhawks to NCAA Regionals in 2014 & 2015. In 2015 the team spent 7-consecutive weeks ranked in the top 25.

Kansas led the Big 12 and the nation with a conference record .345 batting average. Also set team records with a .979 fielding percentage in 2014 (2nd highest nationaly), and 60 home runs in 2011.

Team sported a 20-game winning streak in 2012.

Boasted an 11.5 game won-loss record improvement in 2011 from the year before, the 16th-best turnaround in NCAA history. Kansas opened the season with a 26-3 record, the best start in program history.

While at Kansas, the Jayhawks had one All-American, one Academic All-American, 20 All-Big 12 selections, 20 NFCA All-Region selections, 50 All-Big 12 Academic Team honorees, three Big 12 Scholar Athletes of the Year and three players taken in the NPF Draft.

Actually coached against Marshall in her first season at Kansas, during the Florida Lipton Invitational hosted by the Florida Gators. Marshall won the first matchup 7-3 on Feb. 19 and then the Jayhawks won the second contest, also by a score of 7-3, on Feb. 21.

Started the softball program at Western Carolina and finished with a 41-20 record in the first season (2006) and a 16-4 Southern Conference mark and was named SoCon Coach of the Year. The Catamounts won regular season title along with 6 players named all-conference (5 1st team), 2 All-Region 2nd team and the 2006 Pitcher of the Year (Mendy McKenzie). Western Carolina broke conference single season home run record with 81 and ranked 3rd in NCAA in home runs per game, 14th in slugging percentage and 19th in scoring.

Spent two seasons as the head coach at Young Harris and had a 79-41 record. Finished as the NJCAA Regional Runner-up both years.

Prior to coaching at Kansas, spent three seasons as an assistant at LSU under Yvette Girouard. Tigers won the 2007 SEC Tournament, the Stanford Regional in the NCAA Tournament and finished the year with 55 wins. LSU ended the regular season 3rd in the ESPN/USA Today Poll.

Also an assistant coach at Charlotte in 2003 and for her alma mater UNC in 2004. The Tar Heels made the NCAA Tournament (Waco regional) that season.

Played third base at UNC for Donna J. Papa from 1996-99. Still listed fifth all-time in career assists with 380. Team finished first in the ACC in 1996 and 1998. Won 30+ games in a season three times, record of 125-106 during playing days.

Also played against Marshall three times as a player at UNC. The Tar Heels won two of the three games. UNC won the first 3-2 on Feb. 25, 1996. Marshall won the second, I-0, Feb. 21, 1997. UNC took the third one, 8-0 on March 14, 1997.

Harrell and Stevenson Race up the MUSB Home Run Charts

Aly Harrell and Stevenson Race up the MUSB Home Run Charts
Aly Harrell and Mya Stevenson have been in a friendly competitive arms race since the two became teammates in 2019. Through 19 games in 2021, both hitters are tied for second all-time in program history with 36 homers each. Aly and Mya both surpassed Shaelynn Braxton (2013-15, '17) in the series at Middle Tennessee. Harrell hit her 35th in game two to tie Stevenson and Braxton. Harrell then cranked her 36th career bomb in the third inning of game three to take the lead. Three innings later, Stevenson moved ahead of Braxton and tied Harrell with her 36th. The two have combined for 61 home runs since becoming teammates in 2019, Harrell hit 11 her freshman season in 2018, and 72 overall for the Herd. Four-time All-American, and current minor league hitting coach for the Chicago Cubs, Rachel Folden (2005-08) still holds the all-time mark with 58. However, there are two sluggers who are closing in quickly.

2021 Season Finally Gets Started

Head coach Megan Smith Lyon returns a very talented lineup in her third season. Marshall was picked to finish second in the east division in Conference USA. The offensive lineup that led the nation in 2020 in home runs per game (1.92) comes back nearly intact. The only player who hit a home run for the Herd in 2020 that is not back in the lineup is departed senior Haleigh Christopher who hit six. Marshall has 42-of-48 homers smashed back for 2021.

Junior Mya Stevenson led the team and tied for the NCAA lead with 12 home runs. Graduate Sierra Huerta, who was able to come back for another season, was second on the team with nine and senior Saige Pye cranked out eight in her first year at Marshall.All three players were named to the Conference USA All-Preseason Team as voted on by the league's coaches.

Senior Aly Harrell was named the 2021 Conference USA Preseason Player of the Year. Harrell, who finished fifth on the team with five home runs, bat .441 a year ago and led the team with 23 walks and an on base percentage of .602. Since 2019, no one in the NCAA has been issued more free passes to first base from a walk or hit-by-pitch, than Harrell. The Gahanna, Ohio native combined for 114 free passes (91 walks and 23 hit-by-pitches) in 89 games, with Bailey Hemphill of Alabama as the next closest player with 86.

Along with the bats, Marshall returns a solid defense with playmakers at every position, and a pitching staff that is bringing back 16-of-18 wins from 2020. Senior Laney Jones finished last season with an 8-2 record and 61 strikeouts. Jones recorded four saves as well, tied for sixth in the NCAA, and tied a program record set back in 2004. Sophomore Ashley Blessin went 7-0 and tossed two shutouts. Senior Megan Stauffer also spent time in the circle with 13 innings and a 1-1 record. The only pitcher not back for Marshall is departed senior Kailee Williamson who threw 22.1 innings in 2020.

Coach Smith Lyon has also gathered a talented group of newcomers that add depth and assistance. Newcomers to the Herd for the 2021 season include five freshmen and six transfers. The freshman class consists of pitcher Brianna McCown, catcher Kat Sackett, infielder Amaya Lee, and outfielders Kay Kay Kenney and Paige Halliwill. The transfers are pitchers Cailey Joyce (La Salle University) and Madi Garay (University of Louisiana), and infielders Camryn Michallas (Gulf Coast State College), and Madison Whitaker (Wright

Mya Stevenson Shatters Home Run Records
Since Mya Stevenson put on a Marshall uniform, she has been smashing long-held home run records. Everyone knows about her 20 home runs as a freshman that not only led the nation among freshmen, but broke the Herd's freshman record and single-season mark. The freshman record was just a year old as Aly Harrell hit 11 in 2018. However, the single-season record of 18 was set back in 2006 four-time All-American Rachel Folden (2005-08). This season, Stevenson's power has continued to shine. On March 7 against Rutgers, the sophomore slugger hit her 10th home run and became the fastest player in program history to reach double-digit homers in a season, in just her 22nd game of the year. The old record was again set by Folden in 2006 who hit her 10th home run in her 23rd game of the season. Stevenson's 10th of the year was also her 30th of her career, again reaching that milestone faster than anyone else. It tools just 83 games. Folden had been the quickest to 30 before, doing it in 119 games shortly in to her junior season. Over an 11-game stretch last season, Stevenson hit eight homers. Folden hit nine in an 11-game span (Feb. 24-March 12) in 2006. Entering the 2021 season, Stevenson is tied with one of Folden's classmates, Samantha Rodriguez, for third all-time in team history with 32 career home runs. Marshall and Florida Atlantic is a still fairly young series going back to two meetings at USF in 2013. The Herd won both of those contests including a 2-1 win with a walkoff sacrifice fly in the eighth inning from Alyssa Woodrum, scoring Jazmine Valle. Once FAU joined Conference USA before the 2014 season, the series has been dominated by whoever is the home team. Down in Boca Raton, Marshall is just 2-7. However at Dot Hicks Field, the Herd is 7-1.

The first conference series took place in Boca Raton in 2014. Marshall won the first meeting and then fell in the next two. In 2015, the three-game series was cut down to just two games with the Sunday meeting being cancelled due to weather. The teams split the Saturday doubleheader. The Owls took the pitcher's duel in game one between Kylee Hanson for FAU and Jordan Dixon for Marshall, 3-0. Game two featured another walkoff for the Herd. The Owls tied the game at 5-5 with three runs in the top of the seventh. In the bottom of the inning, Morgan Zerkle led off with an infield single and then moved to second on a sac bunt from Kaelynn Greene. Elicia D'Orazio then pushed one into left field that sent the speedy Zerkle home for the winner.

In 2016, the series returned to Boca Raton, the Owls were ranked No. 24, and swept a struggling Marshall squad. The Herd managed to score just one run during the weekend off a solo home run by Raquel Escareno in the second inning of game one. The series returned to Huntington in 2017 as Marshall was receiving votes in the top 25 and swept the Owls. In game one, Taylor "The Sniper" McCord threw out back-to-back runners in the fifth inning attempting to steal second. Dixon earned the first two wins and then Ali Burdette won game three. Dixon was named C-USA Pitcher of the Week that Monday.

Marshall went down back down to Boca Raton in 2018 and won the first game before dropping the next Game two was a close contest until the Owls went off or six runs in the bottom of the sixth for the local was at it again as she tied a team record with three runners caught stealing. The Herd trailed 2-0 in game three before tying things up with two runs in the top of the sixth. In the bottom of the seventh, Kailee Williamson picked up a big strikeout on Emily Lochten to send the game to extra innings. Marshall scored one in the top of the eighth, however, FAU scored one in the bottom of the inning as well. The Owls finally ended the series finale in the bottom of the ninth with a walkoff double from Samantha Lageyre.

Florida Atlantic returned to Huntington in 2019 needing wins to qualify for the C-USA Tournament. Marshall rained on those plans with another sweep to end the regular season, and the Owls year. Game one was tied at 3-3 in the sixth before Sierra Huerta smacked a solo home run to give the Herd the lead. Pitcher Abigail Tolbert finished off the Owls with two strikeouts and then a fly out for the 4-3 win. Marshall dominated game two with a 10-0 win in six innings. Mya Stevenson and Hannah Giammarino both went deep. Kailee Williamson turned in a great performance in the circle allowing just five hits in six innings for the shutout innings for the shutout.

The Herd again took command in the final game on senior day, 8-0, in five innings. FAU senior Madisyn Palmer entered the weekend needing six stolen bases to pass Marshall's Elicia D'Orazio to be the all-time leader in C-USA. After nabbing three thefts in the Saturday doubleheader, Tolbert struck Palmer out three times to completely keep her off the bases, including for the final out of the game. D'Orazio kept the top spot with 166, and Palmer is second with 164. Rachel Rousseau had a triple and a home run, driving in five to help lead the way for the will to help lead the way for the win.

Head Coach 3rd Season North Carolina '99



Megan Smith Lyon enters her third season leading the Marshall softball team after being hired as the program's fourth head coach on July 25, 2018. Coach Smith became the fastest to reach 50 wins in program history, needing just 76 games to get there, as she earned her 50th at Marshall with a dominating 8-0 win in five innings over Rhode Island on Feb. 23,

Coach Smith's record at Marshall is 72-36, a .667 winning percentage, and 465-301 overall (14 years).

Marshall was off to a record-breaking start offensively in 2020 before the year came to an abrupt end after 25 games, due to the cancellation of the season from the outbreak of the COVID-19 virus. The Herd was on the season from the outbreak of the COVID-19 virus. The Herd was on pace to eclipse records that were set just the season before. As a team Marshall was batting .357, slugging .643, an on base percentage of .440, and was leading the nation in home runs per game with 1.92 (48 total). The team was on pace to hit the century mark in homers by the end of the regular season. The offensive onslaught started from the beginning of the year and picked up pace during the Pirate Classic (Feb. 28-March 1) as Marshall blasted 15 home runs in five games. The Herd tied its single-game record of five home runs twice. The first time came against the Delaware State Hornets (Feb. 28) and then at No. 11 Kentucky (March 11). Marshall was seventh in the nation in scoring with 7.56 runs per game, with the old team record of 5.40 set in 2015. Other per game averages that displayed the Herd's offensive prowess included 9.84 hits (old record 9.28 in 2015), 1.64 doubles (1.40 set in 2008), 6.96 RBI (4.88 set in 2019), 17.72 total bases (12.31 set in 2017), and 3.48 walks per contest (3.44 set in 2019). Marshall had eight wins by the mercy rule, tied for third-most in a season (2006) in team history. (2006) in team history.

Coach Smith led a big turnaround for the Herd with a 17-win improvement (tied for second-best in program history) at 42-22.

Her first season with the Herd was a record-breaking one along with leading the team to the Conference USA Championship game for the first time since 2014 as the No. 4 seed in the tournament. Following the 3-1 championship game loss to No. 2 seed Louisiana Tech, Marshall received an invite to the National Invitational Softball Championship and played in the Lynchburg, Va., Regional. Again Marshall fought its way into the regional championship game before falling to the host Liberty Flames. The Herd ended the season tying the record for most wins in a season with 42.

Coach Smith won her debut game for the Green and White with a 5-2 victory over UC-Riverside (Feb. 8) in San Diego, Calif. She earned her 400th career coaching victory with a 10-1 win against Presbyterian (Feb. 16). The Herd finished the early part of the season with a 17-6 record before diving into Conference USA action. Marshall was predicted to finish eighth in the preseason coaches' poll but battled through to a 17-7 record with the series win in 7-of-8 conference matchups. The Herd played well at home with a 13-6 record including two walk-off victories at the Dot in conference action against WKU and Louisiana Tech.

During the season, the team as well as individual players were ranked nationally in many statistical categories. By the end of the season Marshall was ranked in the top 100 in home runs (19th), shutouts (tied for 21st), slugging percentage (27th), on base percentage (40th), runs per game (45th), winning percentage (51st) and fielding percentage (97th). Individually Aly Harrell led the country in total walks (68) and combined free passes with 85 (68 walks and 17 hit-by-pitches). Sierra Huerta led the nation in hit-by-pitches with 30 which was also good for 12th most all-time in NCAA history. Freshman Mya Stevenson led all freshman across Division I with 20 homers. Marshall players in total ranked in the top 50 in the I with 20 homers. Marshall players in total ranked in the top 50 in the country 17 times by the end of the 2019 season.

Smith, who sported a career record of 393-265 prior to coming to Marshall, led the Jayhawks to six consecutive 30-win seasons and back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 2014 and 2015 during her nine seasons at the helm. The 2015 campaign yielded the first 40-win season for the program in 23 years, the best start in school history for the second time in her tenure (12-0) and seven consecutive weeks in the top 25. Her 2013 team recorded the program's highest winning percentage (.680) in 21 years, broke the Big 12 record for batting average (.345), the highest mark in the NCAA that season. In 2012, Kansas had a 20-game win streak and, the year before, boasted an 11.5 game won-loss record improvement, the 16th-best turnaround in NCAA history. The 26-3 mark to open the 2011 season was also the best start in the program's history.

"I am extremely honored and excited to be a part of the Marshall family," said Smith. "There is such a strong history and tradition of success within the softball program and I am humbled to now be a part of that. I want to thank Mike Hamrick for this incredible opportunity for me and my son Cooper. I am eager to get to know the players and to get started this fall!"

At Kansas, she coached one All-American, one academic All-American, 20 All-Big 12 selections, 20 NFCA (National Fastpitch Coaches Association) All-Region selections, 50 All-Big 12 Academic Team honorees, three Big 12 Scholar Athletes of the Year and three student-athletes taken in the NPF (National Pro Fastpitch) Draft. The program also set single-season fielding percentage (2014, .979-second-highest nationally) and home run records during her time as head coach (60, 2011).

Prior to her time in Lawrence, Smith was an assistant for LSU for three seasons, where she helped the Tigers in winning the 2007 SEC Tournament and the Stanford Regional in the NCAA Tournament en route to 55 wins. LSU finished the regular season ranked third in the ESPN/USA Today poll. The following season, the Tigers picked up 44 wins on their way to a #9 national seed in the NCAA Tournament. During her tenure, she mentored two All-Americans and five NFCA All-South Region honorees.

Smith started the softball program at Western Carolina and posted a 41-20 record in WCU's inaugural season, earning 2006 Southern Conference Coach of the Year honors, while leading the Catamounts to the league's regular season title. That season, five student-athletes garnered first-team all-league acclaim, with another on the second team and two more were tabbed on the NFCA Southeast All-Region second team. She also coached the conference's 2006 Pitcher of the Year and Freshman of the Year.WCU broke the league's single-season home run record (81) that year, part of an explosive offensive season for the program (third in the nation in home runs per game, 14th in slugging percentage, 19th in scoring).

She also had assistant coaching stops at her alma mater North Carolina (2004), where she helped the Tar Heels reach the NCAA Tournament, and at Charlotte in 2003.

Her first head coaching position came at Young Harris College in Georgia, where she put up a 79-41 record over two seasons.

"We are very much looking forward to Megan leading our softball program," said Marshall Director of Athletics Mike Hamrick. "She is a proven winner and has a reputation for helping mold top-quality student-athletes. Our program is eager for her arrival in Huntington."

Smith, who is an NCAA Division I Softball Committee member, graduated from North Carolina in May 1999 with a Bachelor of Arts in Physical Education and Recreation Studies. She received her Master of Science in Human Performance and Sport Studies from Tennessee in August of 2000.

A Walkertown, N.C. native, Smith and the late Paul Buske have one son, Cooper.

Smith and assistant coach Corey Lyon, married on May 22, 2020.
