

- Third season with Marshall after being hired in July of 2018 as the fourth head coach in Marshall softball history.

After setting program record with 79 home runs in 2019, then in 2020 Herd ed NCAA in home runs per game with 1.92 (48 total) and was on pace for over 100 before remainder of year was canceled due to COVID-19 pandemic.
 - Herd bats hit 150th home run during coach Smith Lyon's tenure in game two vs. Bellarmine on March 27. It was just the 103 game of her time at Marshall.
- Became the fastest coach in program history to reach 50 wins (76 games) with 8-0 victory over Rhode Island on Feb. 23, 2020.
- Won 1st game with the Herd in MU debut vs. UC-Riverside, 5-2 win (Feb. 8). Went 4-1 during the first tournament at the helm for Marshall.
- Earned 400th career coaching win Feb. 16, 2019 with 10-1 victory over Presbyterian. Herd also tied single-game, program record with 5 HRs in the win.

Marshall finished the 2021 season with a 20-13 record.
Despite also playing two games in the Conference USA
Tournament, the Herd played fewer games last season than
any other league team due to COVID and scheduling resrictions. UTER, who did not make the postseason tourney, played the next fewest at 37.

Coming off the 2021 season, Marshall looks to replace departed veterans Blakely Burch, Sierra Huerta, Laney Jones and Megan Stauffer.

However, the Herd returns an experienced, and very dangerous lineup. Back for another round with the Green & White are fifth year seniors Aly Harrell, Katie Adams, Armani Brown, Saige Pye and Madison Whitaker. Followed next by seniors Mya Stevenson, Grace Chelemen and Camryn Michallas. Redshirt junior pitcher Cailey Joyce returns after her first season in Huntington in 2021. Junior pitcher Ashley Blessin and sophomores Kay Kay Kenney and Brianna McCown are back as well.Amaya Lee returns after missing all of 2021 with a shoulder injury.

Newcomers to town are led by two transfers in redshirt juniors Sydney Nester and Autum Owen. Nester, a fright-handed pitcher, starred for North Carolina State for three seasons. Owen, a catcher, comes from Gardner-Webb where she nearly rewrote the record book as a freshman in 2019. Owen missed all of last season with an injury. Both Nester and Owen have two years of eligibility

The freshman class brings six new faces that possess great talent, add incredible depth, and keep the future looking bright for MUSB. The new class consists of four infielders in Laney and Lauren Love (Matthews, N.C.), Rielly Lucas (Huntington, WVa.), and Brooklyn Ulrich (Mesa, Áriz.). Alex Coleman (Asheboro, N.C.) is an outfielder and Bub Feringa (Glendale, Ariz.) is a pitcher and a hitter.

Laney was born on December 31, 2002. Lauren was born on January 1, 2003. Both are talented infielders who piled up accolades during their respective prep careers at Porter Ridge High School.

Marshall's first set of twins were Amanda and Jessica Williams who played from 2003-06. Both players reside in the Marshall Athletics Hall of Fame.

Harrell, Stevenson and Pye Preseason All-C-USA Aly Harrell, Saige Pye and Mya Stevenson selected to the Preseason All-Conference USA Team.

All three players were selected prior to the 2021 season as well. The Herd was picked to finish fifth overall in the coaches' poll.

Harrell enters her fifth season at Marshall after being granted the additional year with the 2020 COVID season. Harrell led the Herd in 2021 in batting average (.415), hits (39), home runs (10), RBI (29), total bases (77), slugging percentage (.819) and on base percentage (.526). The power hitter with the great eye at the plate, struck out only three times in 94 at bats over 30 games played in 2021. The Gahanna, Ohio, native continued her assault on the Marshall record books as well ranking in the rop 10 all-Marshall record books as well, ranking in the top 10 allitime in 11 offensive categories and three defensive. Harrell is tops all-time in career on base percentage at .547. She is second in walks (131) to four-time All-American Rachel Folden (2005-08). Harrell was named First Team All-C-USA and First Team AÍI-Mideast Region.

Harrell and Stevenson have been in a friendly battle, rising up the home run charts as both players set their sights on Folden's record of 58. Harrell and Stevenson ended the 2021 season with 40 homers each, good for second all-time. Harrell hit her 40th of her career at Charlotte on May 8, with a two-run blast to right field. Stevenson launched two shots in the Conference USA Tournament

to catch back up and tie Harrell once again.

Stevenson was one of just two players to play in all 33 games last season, starting in 32. She struggled early but exploded in conference play. Stevenson ended the season batting .293 with 29 hits, 27 runs scored (led team), eight doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI and slugged .616. During the 16 league games in 2021, the slugger hit .385 with 20 hits, 13 runs, seven doubles, three homers and slugged .692. Along with being tied for second all-time at Marshall in home runs, Stevenson's name can also be found throughout the record book. The Mesquite, Texas, native enters her fourth season second in slugging percentage enters her fourth season second in slugging percentage (.755). Last year Stevenson became the 13th member of the Marshall 100 RBI Club, with a bomb at Chattanooga and currently as 114 good for 10th. She was named Second Team All-C-USA in 2021.

Pye enters her third season with the Herd and her fifth year of collegiate action, also being granted the extra year after the 2020 COVID season. Pye's bat has been a key factor in Marshall's offense since she transferred to Huntington before the 2020 season from Georgia Tech. Last season, Pye hit .395 with 34 hits, 14 runs, five doubles, six home runs, 23 RBI, slugged .663 and had a .459 on base percentage. The Stockton, California, native also went off in league action beginning with a great series against Florida Atlantic. In the three games played, Pye hit .462 (6-of-13) with nine RBI. She tied the program single-game record with three doubles in game three of the series, and her third double drove in two runs in the bottom of the seventh to tie the game. Harrell won it in the ninth. Pye had a 12-game hitting streak toward the end of the season and reached base safely in the final 18 games. She was named First Team All-C-USA and Third Team All-Mideast Region.

From walk-on to All-Conference performer, Cooper knew how to get her teammates fired up and ready on game day.... (Pause in video for WE ARE clip).... In 2015, players were told to pick one word that held significant meaning to them and Cooper chose "Warrior". Her identity statement for that season was "I am a confident Warrior. I am the fire in C-USA that will always keep burning." On March 13, 2015 at Dot Hicks Field, Cooper came to plate in the 10th inning with Rebecca Myslenski at first, as Marshall was locked against WKU in a scoreless game. Before Emileigh went up to the in a scoreless game. Before Emileigh went up to the plate she turned around and looked at teammate Elicia D'Orazio who was due up next and said, "Don't worry about getting ready. I'm going to end this now." Two pitches later she did just that hitting a walk-off home run. A Warrior.

Rebecca Myslenski won the inaugural Warrior Award in 2017 as a member of the MUSB Family who stuck through major injuries, being medically disqualified, and stayed with the team taking on a major role with the staff. Myslenski played sparingly during her freshman and sophomore seasons due to knee injuries. Howels are the staff of the staff o ever, when she was in the game she could be relied ever, when she was in the game she could be relied on to make the tough plays, especially while playing at first base. She had to stop playing after her sophomore year, but instead of leaving the team or Marshall, Myslenski came back as a student assistant and helped the Herd over the next two years in many capacities. She still kept a great attitude despite not being able to play, and did whatever she could to help MUSB.

Madi Marshall won the award in 2018. The senior health rains wolf uite award in 2016. The Sellion showed grit and fight while struggling through some health issues to always have a great attitude and could keep the team in great spirits. Madi's electric personality was well in line with Cooper's as Madi was able to learn from Cooper during Madi's freshman year in 2015. She kept a smile on her face even when not in the strategic mount and again would do what were in the starting lineup and again would do whatever was needed to help MUSB. Madi played second base, outfield, came in as a pinch runner or a pinch hitter. She hit the only home run of her career as a grand slam against FIU during senior weekend in 2016. Madi also set a team record as a pinch runner, scoring a run in 10-straight contests in 2017.

Hayden Ellis earned the honor in 2019. The senior catcher battled through adversity on and off the field. She stuck with the Herd backing up Taylor McCord at catcher through her first three years. As a senior, Hayden fought her way back from a shoulder injury that took away most of her junior season to have a career year. She set career-highs in every category

and even had an explosive weekend against Louisiana Tech at home. During the Saturday doubleheader, as the Herd celebrated its Strikeout Cancer Day, Hayden perced times nome runs in the two games with her father in attendance who had going through his cancer battle. The next day, on Emileigh Cooper Day, she was given the Warrior Award on the field before the series finale. belted three home runs in the two games with her

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic cutting the season short after just 25 games, no Warrior Award was given in 2020.

Blakely Burch won the award in 2021. The redshirt senior fought back from a serious knee injury that ended her 2020 season early, even before it ended for everyone else. Blakely came to Huntington in the summer of 2017 after spending her freshman season at USC Upstate. Over the next four years, Blakely developed into a leader on and off the field, and came through clutch in many situations. She starred in the 2019 setting the team record for triples in a season through clutch in many situations. She starred in the 2019 setting the team record for triples in a season with seven. Blakely had two walkoffs in her career with one in 2020 against East Tennessee State, and a 2-run double to defeat Louisiana Tech on, none other than Emileigh Cooper Day. She worked her way back from surgery, while also finishing school, planning a wedding and getting accepted into the nursing program at Jacksonville. Her fire and passion was always present on the field and in the dugout, and will forever have a permanent place in Marshall Softball History.

Head Coach 4th Season North Carolina '99



Megan Smith Lyon enters her fourth season in 2022 leading the Marshall softball team after being hired as the program's fourth head coach on July 25, 2018. Coach Smith Lyon became the fastest to reach 50 wins in program history, needing just 76 games to get there, as she earned her 50th at Marshall with a dominating 8-0 win in five innings over Rhode Island on Feb. 23, 2020.

Coach Smith Lyon's record at Marshall is 80-42, a .656 winning percentage, and 473-307 overall (15 years).

Despite no postseason awards been given out in 2020 due to the season being canceled, in her tenure Smith Lyon has had eight players named all-conference, eight C-USA player/pitchers of the week and four all-region. Her players have starred in the classroom as well with players named to the C-USA Commissioner's Honor Roll 45 times, seven receiving the Academic Medal, and 10 as NFCA Academic All-Americans.

Smith Lyon carried her team through a difficult year in 2021 dealing with restrictions from the COVID-19 pandemic, and still finished with a winning record of 20-13. The Herd still ranked among the nation's best in doubles per game (seventh), home runs per game (12th), slugging percentage (16th), on base percentage (23rd) and scoring (27th).

Marshall was off to a record-breaking start offensively in 2020 before the year came to an abrupt end after 25 games, due to the cancellation of the season from the outbreak of the COVID-19 virus. The Herd was on the season from the outbreak of the COVID-19 virus. The Herd was on pace to eclipse records that were set just the season before. As a team Marshall was batting .357, slugging .643, an on base percentage of .440, and was leading the nation in home runs per game with 1.92 (48 total). The team was on pace to hit the century mark in homers by the end of the regular season. The offensive onslaught started from the beginning of the year and picked up pace during the Pirate Classic (Feb. 28-March 1) as Marshall blasted 15 home runs in five games. The Herd tied its single-game record of five home runs twice. The first time came against the Delaware State Hornets (Feb. 28) and then at No. 11 Kentucky (March 11). Marshall was seventh in the nation in scoring with 7.56 runs per game, with the old team record of 5.40 set in 2015. Other per game averages that displayed the Herd's offensive prowess included 9.84 hits (old record 9.28 in 2015), 1.64 doubles (1.40 set in 2008), 6.96 RBI (4.88 set in 2019), 17.72 total bases (12.31 set in 2017), and 3.48 walks per contest (3.44 set in 2019). Marshall had eight wins by the mercy rule, tied for third-most in a season (2006) in team history.

Coach Smith led a big turnaround for the Herd with a 17-win improvement (tied for second-best in program history) at 42-22.

Her first season with the Herd was a record-breaking one along with leading the team to the Conference USA Championship game for the first time since 2014 as the No. 4 seed in the tournament. Following the 3-1 championship game loss to No. 2 seed Louisiana Tech, Marshall received an invite to the National Invitational Softball Championship and played in the Lynchburg, Va., Regional. Again Marshall fought its way into the regional championship game before falling to the host Liberty Flames. The Herd ended the season tying the record for most wins in a season with 42.

Coach Smith won her debut game for the Green and White with a 5-2 victory over UC-Riverside (Feb. 8) in San Diego, Calif. She earned her 400th career coaching victory with a 10-1 win against Presbyterian (Feb. 16). The Herd finished the early part of the season with a 17-6 record before diving into Conference USA action. Marshall was predicted to finish eighth in the preseason coaches' poll but battled through to a 17-7 record with the series win in 7-of-8 conference matchups. The Herd played well at home with a 13-6 record including two walk-off victories at the Dot in conference action against WKU and Louisiana Tech.

During the season, the team as well as individual players were ranked nationally in many statistical categories. By the end of the season Marshall was ranked in the top 100 in home runs (19th), shutouts (tied for 21st), slugging percentage (27th), on base percentage (40th), runs per game (45th), winning percentage (51st) and fielding percentage (97th). Individually Aly Harrell led the country in total walks (68) and combined free passes with 85 (68 walks and 17 hit-by-pitches). Sierra Huerta led the nation in hit-by-pitches with 30 which was also good for 12th most all-time in NCAA history. Freshman Mya Stevenson led all freshman across Division I with 20 homers. Marshall players in total ranked in the top 50 in the

country 17 times by the end of the 2019 season.

Smith, who sported a career record of 393-265 prior to coming to Mar-Smith, who sported a career record of 393-265 prior to coming to Marshall, led the Jayhawks to six consecutive 30-win seasons and back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 2014 and 2015 during her nine seasons at the helm. The 2015 campaign yielded the first 40-win season for the program in 23 years, the best start in school history for the second time in her tenure (12-0) and seven consecutive weeks in the top 25. Her 2013 team recorded the program's highest winning percentage (.680) in 21 years, broke the Big 12 record for batting average (.345), the highest mark in the NCAA that season. In 2012, Kansas had a 20-game win streak and, the year before, boasted an 11.5 game won-loss record improvement, the 16th-best turnaround in NCAA history. The 26-3 mark to open the 2011 season was also the best start in the program's history. season was also the best start in the program's history.

"I am extremely honored and excited to be a part of the Marshall family," said Smith. "There is such a strong history and tradition of success within the softball program and I am humbled to now be a part of that. I want to thank Mike Hamrick for this incredible opportunity for me and my son Cooper. I am eager to get to know the players and to get started this fall!"

At Kansas, she coached one All-American, one academic All-American, 20 All-Big 12 selections, 20 NFCA (National Fastpitch Coaches Association) All-Region selections, 50 All-Big 12 Academic Team honorees, three Big 12 Scholar Athletes of the Year and three student-athletes taken in the NPF (National Pro Fastpitch) Draft. The program also set single-season fielding percentage (2014, 979-second-highest nationally) and home run records during her time as head coach (60, 2011).

Prior to her time in Lawrence, Smith was an assistant for LSU for three seasons, where she helped the Tigers in winning the 2007 SEC Tournament and the Stanford Regional in the NCAA Tournament en route to 55 wins. LSU finished the regular season ranked third in the ESPN/USA Today poll. The following season, the Tigers picked up 44 wins on their way to a #9 national seed in the NCAA Tournament. During her tenure, she mentored two All-Americans and five NFCA All-South Region honorees.

Smith started the softball program at Western Carolina and posted a 41-20 record in WCU's inaugural season, earning 2006 Southern Conference Coach of the Year honors, while leading the Catamounts to the league's

regular season title. That season, five student-athletes garnered first-team all-league acclaim, with another on the second team and two more were tabbed on the NFCA Southeast All-Region second team. She also coached the conference's 2006 Pitcher of the Year and Freshman of the Year. WCU broke the league's single-season home run record (81) that year, part of an explosive offensive season for the program (third in the nation in home runs per game, 14th in slugging percentage, 19th in scoring).

She also had assistant coaching stops at her alma mater North Carolina (2004), where she helped the Tar Heels reach the NCAA Tournament, and at Charlotte in 2003.

Her first head coaching position came at Young Harris College in Georgia, where she put up a 79-41 record over two seasons.

"We are very much looking forward to Megan leading our softball pro-

gram," said Marshall Director of Athletics Mike Hamrick. "She is a proven winner and has a reputation for helping mold top-quality student-athletes. Our program is eager for her arrival in Huntington."

Smith, who is an NCAA Division I Softball Committee member, graduated from North Carolina in May 1999 with a Bachelor of Arts in Physical Education and Recreation Studies. She received her Master of Science in Human Performance and Sport Studies from Tennessee in August of 2000.

A Walkertown, N.C. native, Smith and the late Paul Buske have one son, Cooper.

Smith and assistant coach Corey Lyon, married on May 22, 2020.


