Season Preview

The High Point University men's soccer team enters the 2016 season with a new look roster as the Panthers look to post their 10th-consecutive finish of .500 or better and win their first Big South Championship.

The Panthers return 13 players from the 2015 team that finished 8-6-7 overall and advanced to the Big South Championship game, where it lost in penalty kicks to Winthrop. Among the returners are All-Big South selections Renato Punyed, Ebe Kudolo and Johnny Fenwick and All-Freshman pick Rashid Tetteh. High Point will also welcome a class of 17 newcomers that include three transfers, two redshirt-freshmen and 12 freshmen.

"This is a young team this year but a very talented group," head coach EJ O'Keeffe said. "We have a lot of things to work on with so many young players, teaching them how to balance academics and soccer. We like the mix of returners and new guys, but it will take us some time to gel and get on the same page. That being said, if guys buy in and we continue to work hard every day we can get to where we want to be."

High Point was picked second in the preseason Big South Coaches Poll behind 2015 Big South Regular Season co-Champion Radford. HPU received 64 points in the poll and finished ahead of Winthrop, Campbell, Liberty, Longwood, UNC Asheville, Gardner-Webb and Presbyterian College.

GOALKEEPERS

High Point will feature a new face in goal following the graduation of four-year starter Kody Palmer. The competition for the starting nod is between a pair of redshirt-freshmen in Keegan Meyer and Pat Fallon and freshman Camden Cook.

"I have been pleased with our goalkeepers so far this preseason," O'Keeffe said. "We have three solid goalkeepers and while Kody Palmer was very good for us last season, I don't really expect us to drop off in that area of the field."

Meyer spent last season redshirting with the Panthers and soaking up as much as possible from Palmer. He is an athletic shot stopper who does a very good job controlling his box. He played prep soccer with powerhouse high school program DeMatha Catholic in Washington, D.C., and finished his prep career with a 0.24 goals-against average.



Fallon transferred to High Point from the University of New Hampshire where he redshirted as a freshman. Fallon is a strong shot stopper who is a vocal presence, skilled in positioning his defenders in front of him. He attended high school at Archmere Academy and was a two-time All-State selection.

Cook joins the Panthers from Eastern Technical High School where he was a four-year letter winner who finished his prep career with a 0.70 goals-against average and 25 shutouts in 32 games. He will provide valuable depth behind Meyer and Fallon while also pushing the pair throughout the season.

DEFENDERS

High Point featured its best defense in the program's Div. I history in 2015, allowing just 19 goals in 21 games for a 0.83 goals-against average. The Panthers will look to continue that standard this season and a big part of their success will rely on a trio of returners in senior Erien Campbell and sophomores Johnny Fenwick and Rashid Tetteh.

"We have a good crop of guys on the backline this season," O'Keeffe said. "Our defensive prowess has been our calling card and I don't expect that to change this season. I believe that the guys we have back there will continue that trademark of High Point soccer of taking pride in defending and not allowing goals."

Campbell (1g, 1a) played in 14 games for HPU last season, first at center back then at outside back. At 6-4, Campbell is a physical presence in the back that is very comfortable both in the air and with the ball at his feet. He is expected to start the season at right back, providing a matchup nightmare for opposing wingers.

Fenwick (1g, 0a) was named second-team All-Big South after starting all 21 games in his freshman season. The Newcastle, England native is a leader in the back despite entering just his second season with the team. Tetteh (0g, 0a) entered the starting lineup at center back following an injury to Campbell and immediately showed a smoothness on the ball that is rarely seen in the college game. His ability to defend and distribute out of the back allowed the Panthers to shift Campbell to outside back when he returned.

The one open position along the back line is at left back following the departure of All-Big South fullback Austin Yearwood who is now playing with the Charlotte Independence in the USL. The two players expected to battle it out at the position are redshirt-senior transfer Nate Lee and freshman Chad Poarch. Lee returns to the Panthers after redshirting at HPU during his freshman season. Lee spent the last three years at Penn State where he played in 32 games with 19 starts. He is a Guam International who has been capped four times by the national team. Poarch is a US U20 player who comes to HPU from Middletown High School in Middletown, Del. The freshman is a highly athletic player that can get up and down the wing and deliver a great cross while also using that athleticism to win one-v-

one battles on the defensive end.

Redshirt-junior Jonathan Ware, junior Poli Rodriguez, sophomore Ryeong Choi and junior transfer Dan McClintock will battle for minutes while providing added depth at the outside back position. Redshirt-freshman Hunter Allen and freshman Tommy Spear will back up Fenwick and Tetteh at the center back position.

MIDFIELDERS

High Point returns two All-Conference level players in the midfield in the form of senior Renato Punyed and Ebe Kudolo who will serve as the leaders of a dynamic group of young players in the middle of the pitch.

Punyed (2g, 4a) is a two-way midfielder who is capable of pulling the strings for the Panthers either from an attacking position or deeper lying spot in the midfield. He has appeared in 59 games over three seasons and notched nine assists with eight coming over the past two seasons. Kudolo (1g, 6a) has been two-year starter since coming to HPU from Ghana and has led the team in assists in each of his first two seasons. Kudolo is a skilled box-to-box player who excels with the ball at his feet.

Redshirt-senior Pat Shelton (1g, 0 a) also returns this season and will see time both at forward and in the midfield. Shelton burst onto the scene as a redshirt-freshmen with six goals and will look to regain that form in his final collegiate campaign.

A group of three newcomers comprised of redshirt-freshman Bana Ganidekam and freshmen Ryan Inman and Jon Bolanos will join Punyed, Kudolo and Shelton in the midfield in 2016. Ganidekam redshirted with the Panthers last season after coming to High Point from Ghana. He is a creative attacking midfielder who is deadly with the ball on his foot both

attacking the defense or delivering the final pass. Inman is a talented central midfielder who hails from Birmingham, England where he played in the Birmingham City Academy system. He is a ball winner who will bring a needed bite in the center of the field. Bolanos is a very smart player who sees things on the field before they happen. He was a first-team All-Broward County pick as a junior at Somerset Academy Charter before leaving the team as a senior to play with the Kendall Academy in the USSDA.

Two other freshmen, Connor Jones and Jed Dalton, will provide added depth in central midfield.

FORWARDS

High Point has added several dynamic pieces to a forward corps that struggled at times putting the ball in the back of the net last season. O'Keeffe believes that these additions combined with the returning experience provided by players like senior Chris Ramsell and redshirt-sophomore Justen Shear will rejuvenate the Panther attack in 2016.

"We struggled with some things in the attacking third last year and had trouble manufacturing goals," O'Keeffe said. "This season's forward group is a lot more dynamic and has some real personality to them. As this season goes along we will create some great partnerships and charisma in this group, which should lead to more goals."

Ramsell (5g, 3a) is High Point's leading scorer among returners this season and he will once again slot in on the wing for the Panthers. He is a skilled two-way player on the outside who combines well to find space and can deliver a great cross from the flank. Shear (1g, 0a) will try and make a jump in his second season at HPU after transferring in from Clemson last season. He is a true winger that likes to get to the end line and whip in crosses.

High Point has added three freshmen forward this season in the form of Sigg

Benonysson, Connor Cesar and Jaime Vasconcellos. Benonysson is a center forward out of Iceland who has seen time with the Icelandic Youth National Team. He is an excellent finisher who also has great movement off the ball. Cesar played alongside Inman at the Birmingham City Academy in Birmingham, England. He is a very athletic winger who uses his pace to get behind the defense. Vanconcellos is originally from Belem, Brazil but he spent last year playing prep soccer at the American Hebrew Academy in Greensboro, N.C. He is a tall strong target striker who can hold the ball up in the box and win balls in the air.

Two other returners who will bring added depth to the forward unit are redshirt-junior Yosef Teffera (1g, 0a) and redshirt-freshman Ben Hietala (1g, 0a). Teffera appeared in nine games last season while Hietala played in four games before missing the rest of the season with an injury.

EJ O'Keeffe enters his second year at the helm of the HPU men's soccer program and his seventh season overall with the Panthers in 2016.

In his first season as head coach, O'Keeffe led High Point to an 8-6-7 finish, the program's ninth-straight finish of .500 or better, and an appearance in the Big South Championship game. The Panthers set a new program single-season record with a 0.83 goals-against average, allowing 19 goals in 21 contests.

O'Keeffe was named the third HPU men's soccer coach in the program's Div. I history in July 2015. O'Keeffe ascended to the head coach position after five years with the Panthers in which he rose from the Volunteer Assistant position to Associate Head Coach.

During O'Keeffe's tenure, the High Point University men's soccer program has achieved unprecedented success. The team has posted a combined 55-34-12 record (.604), including an impressive 29-11-6 (.696) mark in Big South play. The Purple & White have set the top-4 single-season program win marks during that time, including a 2010 season in which the team became the first in Big South history to post a perfect 8-0-0 mark in league play. The Panthers also have recorded the top-5 single-season point totals in program history while registering school records for shutouts in 2010 and 2012.

Over the course of O'Keeffe's five seasons, the program has churned out 25 all-Big South selections while 12 student-athletes have earned NSCAA all-region accolades. Karo Okiomah earned NSCAA All-America honors for the Panthers in 2010 and is one of four players to be drafted into Major League Soccer during the five-year span.

In the classroom, two Panthers have garnered Academic All-America accolades while the team has been selected for an NSCAA Team Academic Award in each of the five seasons.

O'Keeffe has been a stalwart on the recruiting circuit for the Panthers and was instrumental in inking HPU's top-25 recruiting class in 2013. The Panthers are the only Big South team to

accomplish the feat since 2010. In addition, O'Keeffe has recruited three HPU Freshman All-Americans and was responsible for signing High Point's all-time leading scorer, Mamadee Nyepon, in 2011.

O'Keeffe played for three seasons as a defender for UNCG. He appeared in 61 games in his three seasons, compiling nine points on three goals and three assists. He was named to the All-Southern Conference team in 2008 and was a team captain in 2009. During his time at UNCG, the Spartans appeared in two Southern Conference championship games, winning in 2008 and advancing to the NCAA "Sweet 16."

O'Keeffe graduated with a B.S. in Business Administration from UNCG in 2010. He played for the Carolina Dynamo PDL team from 2007-10.

O'Keeffe holds a USSF National "A" Coaching License and a National "Youth" Coaching License. He graduated from UNC Greensboro in 2010 with a B.S. in Business Administration with a concentration in Entrepreneurship. O'Keeffe is both a native and current resident of Greensboro, N.C.
