### Quick Hitters

• Kat Harris tied HPU's single-game three-point record drilling 7-of-8 en route to a career-high 29 points on Dec. 3 when the Panthers took on UAB in the Millis Center.

• Harris averaged 6.7 points per game in the first three contests of the season, but has exploded averaging 20.3 over the last four. The Charlotte, N.C. native had never scored more than 20 points in a game before doing in twice in the last four.

• HPU has assisted on 60.5 percent of its made field goals on the year. That's the highest mark in the program's Division I era with a slight lead of the 2010-11 squad's 60.4 percent mark.

• Kennedy Currie is a burgeoning force in the paint for the Purple & White. The redshirt-junior has led the team in rebounding in each of the past four games (8.8/game) and is averaging 2.5 blocks per outing during the last two weeks.

• HPU is 36-43 in road games under DeUnna Hendrix and 6-23 in non-conference road outings in that span. However, the team has won each of its last two non-conference road games.

• During her first season as the team's main point guard, Camryn Brown is second in the conference in assist-to-turnover ratio with 2.0 assists for every miscue.

• The Panthers have relied heavily on its backcourt in road games this season. Emma Bockrath (16.5 ppg) and Brown (15.8 ppg) have combined for 54 percent of the team's scoring in four road contests this season.

• High Point has hit more three-pointers and shot a better three-point percentage than six of its seven opponents this season.

• HPU has attempted fewer free throws than all seven of its opponents, but have made more free throws in three contests.

• The Purple & White are 2-39 against current members of Power-5 conferences since joining the Division I ranks in 1999-2000. That record includes a 1-18 mark against the ACC with the win coming against Pitt on Dec. 2, 2011. The other victory came against Florida on Dec. 21, 2009.

• Hendrix finally has a veteran roster to work with for the first time since 2014-15. HPU has had at least 70 percent of its roster comprised by underclassmen each of the last two years, but have nine upperclassmen this season.

• High Point is right back in action on Monday, Dec. 18 when they host Davidson in the Millis Center.

## All-Time Series with Virginia Tech

The Hokies are 2-0 in the series with an average victory of 97-48 from two contests in 2006 and 2007. Against the Big South, Virginia Tech is 66-11 with nine losses to Radford and one apiece to Longwood and Liberty.

## Scouting the Hokies

Virginia Tech is one of the most balanced lineups in the nation with four players averaging 12 or more points per contest. Chanette Hicks ranks in the top-10 in the country with 7.0 assists per game while also averaging 12.3 points. Behind Hicks, the team has been dominant at home winning its six games by an average of 83.7 to 52.3 including its 68-42 win over Radford.

## Matchup to Watch

Virginia Tech gets to the line more than 20 times per contest while the Panthers are among the nation's leaders in fouls per game. Staying out of foul trouble and making the Hokies score against HPU's stout defense will be key.

## Winning the Long-Range Battle

• The Panthers rank 13th in the nation in three-point percentage defense (22 percent) with their new in-your-face style brought over by associate head coach Heather Kearney. Last year, the team allowed opponents to shoot 31 percent and ranked 144th.

• Offensively, the Purple & White are 14th in the country hitting 40.5 percent of their three-point attempts on the year. That, too, is an improvement on a program-record 35.7 percent mark in 2016-17.

## All Kinds of Threats

• The Panthers had four different leading scorers in the first four games of the season.

• Five different members of the Purple & White have scored 20 points in a single game in 2017-18.

• Eight of the 11 Panthers to play in a game this season have posted a career-high scoring outing through the first seven contests.

## Reserves Needed

• The Panthers are 4-0 when the bench outscores their opponent's reserves and 0-3 when that margin is reversed.

• HPU averages a 28-15 edge in its wins and a 13.3-22.7 deficit in losses. Harris has accounted for 37 of the 40 bench points in the team's three losses.

## Defensive Learning Curve

Playing a more up-tempo defense under associate head coach Heather Kearney, the Panthers are limiting opponents to 22 percent shooting from beyond the arc, but have shown a tendency to get in foul trouble. HPU ranks 346 out of 349 teams in fouls per game (23.6/game).

## Consecutive Starts Record

Bockrath has started 68 straight games through the last two-plus seasons leaving her five games short of tying HPU's D-I record. (See ranking on right.)

### The Hunt for Win No. 100

Head coach DeUnna Hendrix sits at 90 career wins with all of them coming at HPU. Hendrix is already third in all-time wins and would join Tooley Loy as the only two 100-win coaches since the program moved to D-I competition.

### Replacing Keys

Kaylah Keys finished her career with 1,869 points - the most in Division I in HPU history. Despite the loss of the prolific scorer, the Panthers return 78 percent of their scoring and 89 percent of their rebounding from 2016-17.

### Incredible First Half of Career

Bockrath ranks in the top six among all Division I Panthers in points, rebounds, assists, steals, field goals and three-pointers through their first two collegiate seasons.

### Panthers in the Preseason Poll

After finishing the 2016-17 season tied with Campbell for second, HPU begins the 2017-18 campaign in fourth in the league's poll. The Big South's coaches tabbed the defending regular season champions, Radford, as the favorite with Liberty and Campbell ahead of the Panthers as well.

### Pacing the League in Points

- During Hendrix's five seasons at the helm for the squad is averaging 68.2 points per game. That's nearly two points per contest higher than second-place Liberty (66.3 ppg).

- High Point led the conference in scoring last year with 68.2 points per game, which was the third time in five years that Hendrix's squad achieved the feat.

- HPU leads the conference in scoring this season averaging 70.4 points per game - 4.3 higher than second place.

- During that span High Point joins Liberty as the only two programs to win at least 10 Big South contests every year.

### Well, They're Free

- High Point finished the 2016-17 campaign ranked 33rd in the nation with a 75.3 free-throw percentage.

- Only one Panther who attempted at least 10 free throws on the season shot lower than 70 percent from the line.

- After starting the season 10-of-22 in the first two games, the team is 50-of-65 (.769) from the line during the last five contests.

### Fresh Faces

High Point has added Kayla Stephens (North Carolina) and Jiselle Thomas (Ohio) to round out the roster for the 2017-18 season. Both players scored over 2,000 career points during their decorated high school careers.

### Hendrix Introduces the Freshmen

- Jiselle is going to come in as an athletic wing who can get to the rim and penetrate. She is really good in the open court, but might be even more important for us in the half court as she will give us more of a creator in the half court. She obviously scored a lot of points in high school, but defensively she'll add another dimension as well. She is similar to Lindsey Edwards on defense with her ability to pick up 94 feet and harass ball-handlers.

- Kayla is going to give us a different kind of point guard than what we currently have in Camryn Brown. Kayla excels in transition and likes to play in the open court. Kayla brings an acceleration and explosiveness that we don't possess on our roster. Plus, she has a mid-range game that could end up being as dangerous as Emma Bockrath's. She's going to give us options at the point guard position because Cam is more of a table-setter while Kayla is more of a scoring guard.

### Addition to the Staff

After playing the 2016-17 season with just two assistant coaches, head coach DeUnna Hendrix hired associate head coach Heather Kearney in June. Kearney will focus on coaching the defense as well as post players. She comes to HPU after serving as the associate head coach at Coastal Carolina where she revived the Chanticleers defensive efforts.

### Ramping Up the Defense

- With Kearney joining the staff, Hendrix envisions HPU's up-tempo offense being matched by its in-your-face pressure defense.

- Not only did Kearney improve CCU's scoring defense by four points per contest, but the Chanticleers jumped for 175th in steals to 16th nationally in her first season at Coastal Carolina.

- After the move to the Sun Belt last year, the Chanticleers continued wreaking havoc and ranked 48th in the nation in steals per outing.

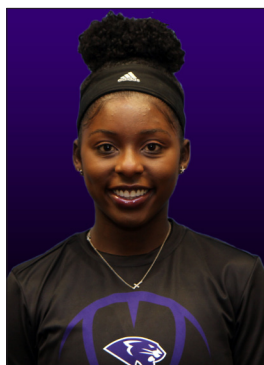
