Quick Hitters

- Kat Harris is averaging 19.8 points in HPU's three home games this season. The senior has hit 15-of-25 three-point attempts inside the Millis Center this season. That's compared to a 8.4 points per game and a .174 mark from three-point land in the squad's five road contests in 2017-18.
- After struggling at home in the first three home contests,
 Camryn Brown amassed 21 points on 7-of-16 shooting in
 Monday night's setback to Davidson.
- Kennedy Currie is a burgeoning force in the paint for the Purple & White. The redshirt-junior has led the team in rebounding in each of the past six games (9.5/game) and is averaging 1.8 blocks per outing during the same span.
- The HPU starting five of Camryn Brown, Emma Bockrath, Lindsey Edwards, Shea Morgan and Kennedy Currie along with top reserve Kat Harris have accounted for 372 of the team's 400 minutes played over the last two contests (93 percent).
- Hendrix finally has a veteran roster to work with for the first time since 2014-15. HPU has had at least 70 percent of its roster comprised by underclassmen each of the last two years, but have nine upperclassmen this season.

- During her first season as the team's main point guard, Brown leads the Big South with a 2.1 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- HPU has assisted on 59.1 percent of its made field goals on the year. That's just behind the highest mark in the program's D-I era behind the 2010-11 squad's 60.4 percent mark.
- High Point has had at least one 20-point scorer in seven on nine games going 3-4 in those contests as six different players have eclipsed 20 in a game. But despite all that firepower, the Purple & White have had six games with three of fewer double-digit scorers and are just 1-5 in such outings.
- HPU is the only Big South team with three players in the top-10 in scoring with Harris (5th), Brown (6th) and Bockrath (7th).
- Bockrath (17) and Harris (15) combined for half of the squad's points in last season's 73-64 setback at Western Carolina.
- The Panthers 49-22 in home games under DeUnna Hendrix and 13-8 against non-conference foes at home during that span.
- High Point has the next week off to celebrate Christmas before wrapping up its non-conference slate against UNCG in Greensboro on Dec. 28 at 7:00 p.m.

All-Time Series with Western Carolina

HPU and WCU record books record a different amount of meetings with WCU claiming a 17-8 mark, while High Point records show a 13-8 margin for the Catamounts. Either way, High Point is 2-4 against WCU since moving to Division I competition in 1999-2000.

Scouting the Catamounts

While carrying just a 2-9 record into Friday's contest, WCU is 2-1 against Big South opponents this season with wins over Radford and UNC Asheville and a seven-point loss to Campbell. Sherae Bonner leads the way with 10.9 points and 8.6 rebounds per contest.

Matchup to Watch

The Panthers are one of the best three-point shooting and three-point defenses in the nation. Meanwhile, Davidson is struggling from beyond the arc hitting just 28 percent of its three-point attempts and allows its opponents to knock down 30 percent of their attempts.

Defensive Learning Curve

Playing a more up-tempo defense under associate head coach Heather Kearney, the Panthers are limiting opponents to 25 percent shooting from beyond the arc, but have shown a tendency to get in foul trouble. HPU ranks 343 out of 349 teams in fouls per game (23.3/game).

Winning the Long-Range Battle

- The Panthers rank 16th in the nation in three-point percentage defense (25 percent) with their new in-your-face style brought over by associate head coach Heather Kearney. Last year, the team allowed opponents to shoot 31 percent and ranked 144th.
- Offensively, the Purple & White are 26th in the country hitting 39.0 percent of their three-point attempts on the year. That, too, is an improvement on a program-record 35.7 percent mark in 2016-17.

All Kinds of Threats

- The Panthers had four different leading scorers in the first four games of the season.
- Six different members of the Purple & White have scored 20 points in a single game in 2017-18.
- Eight of the 11 Panthers to play in a game this season have posted a career-high scoring outing through the first nine contests.

Reserves Needed

.. Big South Network

- The Panthers are 4-1 when the bench outscores their opponent's reserves and 0-4 when that margin is reversed.
- HPU averages a 28-15 edge in its wins and a 19-15 deficit in losses. Harris has accounted for 57 of the 73 bench points in the team's five losses.

Consecutive Starts Record

Bockrath has started 70 straight games through the last two-plus seasons leaving her four games short of tying HPU's D-I record. (See ranking on right.)

The Hunt for Win No. 100

Head coach DeUnna Hendrix sits at 90 career wins with all of them coming at HPU. Hendrix is already third in all-time wins and would join Tooey Loy as the only two 100-win coaches since the program moved to D-I competition.

Replacing Keys

Kaylah Keys finished her career with 1,869 points - the most in Division I in HPU history. Despite the loss of the prolific scorer, the Panthers return 78 percent of their scoring and 89 percent of their rebounding from 2016-17.

Incredible First Half of Career

Bockrath ranks in the top six among all Division I Panthers in points, rebounds, assists, steals, field goals and three-pointers through their first two collegiate seasons.

Panthers in the Preseason Poll

After finishing the 2016-17 season tied with Campbell for second, HPU begins the 2017-18 campaign in fourth in the league's poll. The Big South's coaches tabbed the defending regular season champions, Radford, as the favorite with Liberty and Campbell ahead of the Panthers as well.

Pacing the League in Points

- During Hendrix's five seasons at the helm for the squad is averaging 68.2 points per game. That's nearly two points per contest higher than second-place Liberty (66.3 ppg).
- High Point led the conference in scoring last year with 68.2 points per game, which was the third time in five years that Hendrix's squad achieved the feat.
- HPU leads the conference in scoring this season averaging 70.0 points per game 4.3 higher than second place.
- During that span High Point joins Liberty as the only two programs to win at least 10 Big South contests every year.

Well, They're Free

- High Point finished the 2016-17 campaign ranked 33rd in the nation with a 75.3 free-throw percentage.
- Only one Panther who attempted at least 10 free throws on the season shot lower than 70 percent from the line.
- •After starting the season 22-of-41 (.537) in the first three games, the team is 76-of-96 (.792) from the line during the last six contests.

Fresh Faces

High Point has added Kayla Stephens (North Carolina) and Jiselle Thomas (Ohio) to round out the roster for the 2017-18 season. Both players scored over 2,000 career points during their decorated high school careers.

Hendrix Introduces the Freshmen

- Jiselle is going to come in as an athletic wing who can get to the rim and penetrate. She is really good in the open court, but might be even more important for us in the half court as she will give us more of a creator in the half court. She obviously scored a lot of points in high school, but defensively she'll add another dimension as well. She is similar to Lindsey Edwards on defense with her ability to pick up 94 feet and harass ball-handlers.
- Kayla is going to give us a different kind of point guard than what we currently have in Camryn Brown. Kayla excels in transition and likes to play in the open court. Kayla brings an acceleration and explosiveness that we don't possess on our roster. Plus, she has a mid-range game that could end up being as dangerous as Emma Bockrath's. She's going to give us options at the point guard position because Cam is more of a table-setter while Kayla is more of a scoring guard.

Addition to the Staff

After playing the 2016-17 season with just two assistant coaches, head coach DeUnna Hendrix hired associate head coach Heather Kearney in June. Kearney will focus on coaching the defense as well as post players. She comes to HPU after serving as the associate head coach at Coastal Carolina where she revived the Chanticleers defensive efforts.

Ramping Up the Defense

- With Kearney joining the staff, Hendrix envisions HPU's up-tempo offense being matched by its in-your-face pressure defense.
- Not only did Kearney improved CCU's scoring defense by four points per contest, but the Chanticleers jumped for 175th in steals to 16th nationally in her first season at Coastal Carolina.
- After the move to the Sun Belt last year, the Chanticleers continued wreaking havoc and ranked 48th in the nation in steals per outing.
