PAW PRINTS

- The High Point University men's basketball team continues Big South Conference play Saturday (Jan. 12) at Winthrop in Rock Hill, S.C. Tip-off at the Winthrop Coliseum is set for 2 p.m. and the game will be broadcast on ESPN3.
- This will be the 44th all-time meeting between the two programs, with the Eagles leading the series, 29-14. Winthrop won both meetings last season.
- HPU head coach Tubby Smith is 2-0 against Winthrop in his head coaching career.
- The Panthers are coming off a 74-58 victory over Presbyterian on Thursday (Jan. 10). HPU never trailed in the game.
- With the win over PC, High Point is 2-0 in Big South play for the first time since the 2015-16 season.
- HPU has started 2-0 in Big South play seven times since joining the conference for the 1999-2000 season. The other times were 2001-02, 2003-04, 2004-05, 2006-07, 2010-11 and 2015-16.
- The Panthers are on a three-game win streak for the second time this season.

- Senior Ricky Madison recorded his third double-double of the season with 10 points and a career-high 17 rebounds against Presbyterian. He also picked up double-doubles against Air Force and The Citadel.
- Junior Brandonn Kamga led all scorers with 25 points, the sixth time this season he has scored 20 or more points.
- Senior Jordan Whitehead followed up a double-double against Charleston Southern (11 points, 10 rebounds) with 10 points and eight rebounds against Presbyterian. The former walk-on is averaging career highs in minutes (25.7), points (6.9) and rebounds (5.6).
- The Panthers started off conference play with a 51-50 win at Charleston Southern Jan. 5 in North Charleston. S.C.
- After being led in scoring by guards in 13 of its previous 14 games, High Point was led by senior forward Jordan Whitehead with 11 points and junior forward 10 Cliff Thomas Jr. added 10 off the bench.
- The Big South moved back to a 16-game schedule this season after being 18 for the last few. HPU will play each of the teams from Virginia and North Carolina home and away and the four schools from South Carolina only once. HPU plays only at CSU and Winthrop, while PC and USC Upstate will only play in High Point.

HIGH POINT UNIVERSITY 2018-19 Men's Basketball Game Notes

Last Time Out: High Point 74, Presbyterian 58 Buc Dome | North Charleston, S.C. | Jan. 5, 2019

The High Point University men's basketball team defeated PC, 74-58, Jan. 10 at the Millis Center.

The Panthers moved to 2-0 in Big South play for the first time since the 2015-16 season and have their second three-game win streak of the season.

In the first half, the Panthers jumped out to a 23-7 lead and shot 53.3 percent (16-30) on the way to a 40-23 lead at halftime. High Point scored nine of the first 12 points of the second half and opened up a 23-point lead at 49-26, but the Blue Hose cut the lead to nine at 55-46 with 6:49 left. Junior Brandonn Kamga followed with a layup to push the lead back to double-digits and 11 was as close as Presbyterian would get the rest of the way.

High Point ended up shooting 45.6 percent (26-57) and held Presbyterian to 32.8 percent shooting (20-61). The Panthers out-rebounded the Blue Hose, 48-32.

The Panthers were led by Kamga with 25 points, the sixth time this season he has scored 20 or more. Senior Ricky Madison recorded his third double-double of the season with 10 points and a career-high 17 rebounds.

HISTORY vs. WINTHROP

This will be the 44th meeting all-time between the programs, with Winthrop leading the series, 29-14. The Eagles won both meetings last season, including a 76-60 win in Rock Hill, S.C., on Dec. 30, 2017 and an 82-70 win at the Millis Center on Feb. 10, 2018.

HISTORY vs. OPPONENTS FROM SOUTH CAROLINA

High Point has complied a 83-100 (.454) record all-time against Division I programs hailing from the Palmetto State. HPU's most common opponents are Winthrop (14-29), Charleston Southern (22-18) and Coastal Carolina (16-21). High Point is 54-56 against Big South programs from South Carolina and 29-44 against the rest of the state's Div. I teams. The Panthers are 2-2 this season against teams from South Carolina, winning against Charleston Southern and Presbyterian, but falling to Wofford and The Citadel.

TUBBY SMITH vs. WINTHROP

HPU head coach Tubby Smith has faced Winthrop two times in his head coaching career. The first game was when Coach Smith's Georgia Bulldogs defeating the Eagles in Rock Hill, S.C., 81-55, on Dec. 10, 1995. Coach Smith also took down Winthrop to open the 2003-04 season with Kentucky, a 65-44 win on Nov. 21, 2003.

A LOOK AT THE WINTHROP

The Eagles are 10-5 on the season and 2-0 in Big South play after defeating Campbell, 90-86, on Thursday (Jan. 10). Winthrop has four players averaging double figures in scoring, led by Nych Smith with 16.8 points per game. Josh Ferguson is leading the squad with 7.7 rebounds per contest to go along with 11.5 points per game.

NEXT UP

The Panthers will continue Big South play against USC Upstate on Wednesday (Jan. 16). Tip-off at the Millis Center is set for 7 p.m. and the game will be broadcast on ESPN+.

PROCTOR NOT JUST A SCORER

Junior Jahaad Proctor led the Panthers with 3.0 assists per game in 2017-18, while also leading the team in scoring at 16.4 points per game. High Point was 5-0 last season when Proctor recorded five or more assists.

This season, the Panthers are 3-1 when he records 5+ assists. Proctor again leads the squad with 19.5 points and 3.4 assists per contest.

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

HPU defeated Washington College (Md.), 101-60, on Jan. 2 at the Millis Center. It was the first time the Panthers had reached the century mark since Toccoa Falls on Dec. 10, 2017, a 110-39 victory.

Four Panthers scored in double figures and three more had nine points each. Junior Brandonn Kamga led all scorers with 18 points, while redshirt freshman Caden Sanchez scored a career-high 10 points.

STARTING STRONG

The first half continues to be important for the Panthers, as HPU is 6-1 when leading or tied at the break and only 3-6 when trailing at halftime.

PANTHERS FOR TWO

High Point scores 58.5 percent of its points from 2-point field goals, which is the eighth-highest ratio in the country.

PROCTOR PICKING UP THE ACCOLADES

Junior Jahaad Proctor was named to the Bimini Jam All-Tournament team after averaging 22.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists over the three games. Proctor was also named the Big South Co-Player of the Week by the conference and the Big South Player of the Week by College Sports Madness for his efforts against Air Force and East Carolina.

Proctor was named Big South Player of the Week for a second time on Dec. 17 for his efforts against Western Carolina. He was a Big South Preseason All-Conference Second-Team honoree.

SPREADING THE LOVE AROUND

Five Panthers scored in double figures at The Citadel on Nov. 27. It was the first time HPU has had five in double-digit scoring since Jan. 15, 2018 against Presbyterian.

WIN #600 FOR COACH SMITH

The Panthers picked up a 55-52 win at East Carolina on Nov. 24. The win was No. 600 for HPU head coach Tubby Smith. High Point had won three of four games after starting the season 0-2.

Smith, in his 28th season, became the 15th active NCAA Division I head coach to earn 600 wins and the 27th active NCAA head coach across all divisions.

TAKING ADVANTAGE OF FIRST OPPORTUNITY

Freshman Curtis Holland III made his first collegiate start against UMBC and scored 18 points, including five 3-point field goals. In his collegiate debut against South Dakota, Holland had four steals.

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON POLL

The Panthers were picked seventh out of 11 teams in the Big South preseason poll. Defending tournament champion Radford was picked to win the league with 28 out of 33 first-place votes.

WHITEHEAD'S EFFORT IN PRACTICE HAS PAID OFF

Senior Jordan Whitehead has continued his emergence as a starter for the Panthers. After walking-on his first three years in the Purple & White, the senior from Morris Plains, N.J., earned a scholarship for his final year at High Point after setting careerhighs in minutes, points, and rebounds in 2017-18. Whitehead has continued his strong play with 11 points at William & Mary and a career-high 13 points at The Citadel. He picked up a careeer-high 13 rebounds against NC Wesleyan.

PROCTOR AND KAMGA STARTING WHERE THEY LEFT OFF

HPU dropped its season opener, 79-69, at William & Mary on Nov. 7, but juniors Jahaad Proctor and Brandonn Kamga combined for 49 points with Proctor leading all scorers with 25 and Kamga adding 24.

Proctor's 25 points was the ninth time for the Purple & White he has scored 20 or more points. Kamga's 24 points was the second time he has scored 20 or more in his career. His career high was 26 at Charlotte on Nov. 24, 2017. Kamga was 3-3 from 3-point range and also added a career-high five steals.

RETURNING PANTHERS

HPU returns nine letterwinners and four players who started 22 or more games last season, including senior Jordan Whitehead (24 starts), juniors Brandonn Kamga (28) and Jahaad Proctor (24) and sophomore Denny Slay (22). The quartet accounts for 65.3 percent of games started last season.

NEW MEMBERS OF THE PANTHER FAMILY

The Panthers welcome four new players in 2018-19, including freshmen Curtis Holland III, John-Michael Hughes, Rob Peterson III and Othello Smith. In addition, sophomore Tim Cameron is eligible to play after sitting out last season due to NCAA quidelines after transferring from UTEP.

Eric Coleman Jr, a 6-8 forward from Buford, Georgia, officially joined the Panther family when he signed a National Letter of Intent on Nov. 15 and will join the Panthers in Fall of 2019. Coleman is an athletic forward, who has size that can play inside and out. Coleman is coached by Eddie Martin, who also coached Jodie Meeks, who played in the NBA and was coached by Tubby Smith at Kentucky. Coleman was a first-team all-region and all-state selection and a second-team all-metro honoree in his junior year at Buford High School.

PROCTOR EARNING THE PLAUDITS

Junior Jahaad Proctor was named to the Preseason All-Big South Second Team after being named to the All-Big South Second Team in 2017-18. Proctor was also recognized on the NCCSIA All-State Second Team.

Proctor also excels in the classroom for the Panthers, as we has team's representative on the Big South All-Academic Team, was named to the Google Cloud Academic All-District Team and earned NABC Honors Court accolades.

RETURNING IN NUMBERS



HEAD COACH TUBBY SMITH

HPU Athletics Hall of Famer Tubby Smith came home in March 2018 to become the 12th men's basketball head coach in program history. The former all-conference guard of High Point College came back to his alma mater after serving as the head coach at Memphis for two seasons.

Smith coached Kentucky to the 1998 national championship and is one of two head coaches to guide five different programs to the NCAA Division I Tournament (Tulsa, Georgia, Kentucky, Minnesota and Texas Tech).

Smith has been named National Coach of the Year three times (2003, 2005, 2016), conference coach of the year six times (1994, 1995, 1998, 2003, 2005, 2016) and was honored with the John R. Wooden Legends of Coaching Award in 2016. In 2000, Smith was an assistant coach on Rudy Tomjanovich's staff that led the United States to Olympic gold.

Smith has made 20 postseason appearances as a head coach, including nine Sweet Sixteen and four Elite Eight trips. Smith has mentored 18 student-athletes who have gone on to play in the NBA, including 13 NBA draft picks. In 27 seasons at six schools, Smith has amassed a combined record of 597-302 (.664).

Smith, a native of Scotland, Md., started his coaching career at Great Mills High School, his high school alma mater, in Great Mills, Md., before moving to Hoke County High School in Raeford, N.C. He had three assistant coach stops at VCU, South Carolina and Kentucky before earning his first Division I head coaching job at Tulsa in 1991.

Smith led Tulsa to a pair of Sweet Sixteen appearances in 1994 and 1995 before moving to Georgia where he accumulated a 45-19 record in two seasons. In 1997, Smith went back to Kentucky, this time as the head coach, and led the Wildcats to the 1998 national championship. He secured a 262-83 record with five Sweet Sixteen trips and 10 NCAA Tournament appearances in 10 seasons.

Smith also was the head coach at Minnesota for six seasons and turned around a fledgling program at Texas Tech in three seasons before moving to Memphis in 2016.

The former Panther standout was inducted into the High Point University Athletics Hall of Fame in 2016. In 2013, Smith was inducted into the University of Kentucky Athletic Hall of Fame.

Smith graduated with a degree in health and physical education from High Point in 1973.


