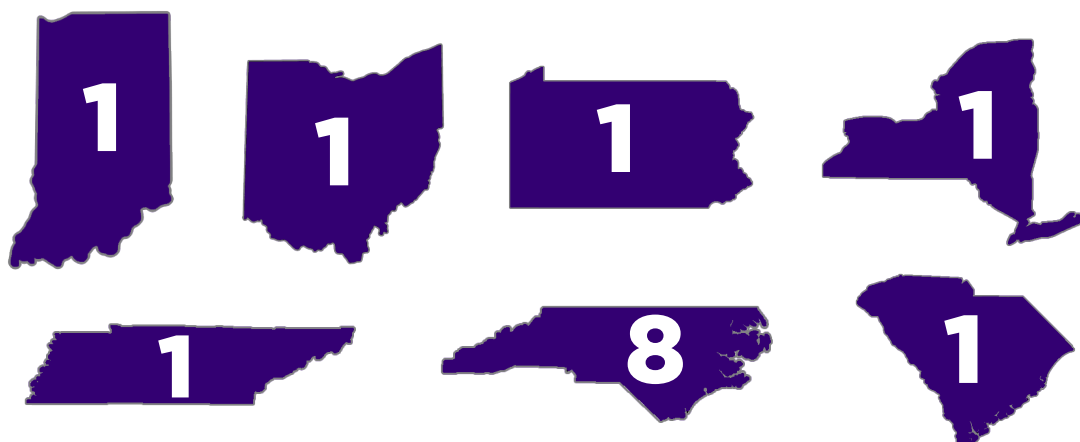

HEAD COACH CHELSEA BANBURY

2ND SEASON • ALMA MATER: FGCU '07

Chelsea Banbury was named the fifth Division I head coach of High Point University's women's basketball team in June 2019.

During her first season as a collegiate head coach, Banbury lead High Point to a 16-13 record and a 14-6 mark in conference play for a third-place finish after being projected to finish in sixth. She brought the three-point style of offense with her from Florida Gulf Coast, with the Panthers finishing the season third in the country in three-point attempts (917) and fifth in triples made (305), both school records. Under her tutelage, Camryn Brown became the fourth Panther in program history to be named the Big South Player of the Year, and just the fifth player in conference history to take home Player of the Year and Scholar-Athlete of the Year honors in the same season. Banbury's first season was cut short before HPU could compete in the quarterfinals of the Big South Tournament due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Banbury joined the Panthers after serving 11 years on the coaching staff at FGCU, including the last five as the Eagles' associate head coach.

During Banbury's 11-year coaching career at FGCU, the Eagles produced a 306-72 overall record with a 173-13 conference record. The Eagles played in the NCAA Tournament or WNIT in all 11 seasons and captured nine regular season conference titles and six conference tournament crowns.

FGCU advanced twice with Banbury on the coaching staff to the NCAA Second Round in 2015 and 2018 and was the WNIT runner-up in 2016. The Eagles finished in the national rankings at No. 21 in 2014-15 and No. 25 in 2017-18. The Eagles were in the top five in 3-point field goals made in each of the last three seasons, including No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 1 in 2017-18 and No. 4 in 2018-19. In addition, Banbury-coached Eagle squads picked up wins over national-ranked opponents, including No. 15 Missouri, No. 20 Kentucky and No. 21 DePaul.

Banbury played women's basketball and earned two degrees at FGCU – a bachelor's in finance in 2007 and a master's in business administration in 2010. In 2008, she was the female recipient of the Eagle Scholar-Athlete Award, which went to the student-athlete with the highest GPA.

The Fort Collins, Colo., native played basketball at Poudre High School where she was named First Team All-Conference and Honorable Mention All-Colorado. Banbury is joined in High Point by her husband, Greg, and son, Jackson.

JODI KEST

**Assistant Coach • Second Season
Slippery Rock '84**

Jodi Kest is entering her second season on the HPU staff and joined the Panthers after spending the 2018-19 season as an assistant coach at Lynn University. Formerly the bench boss at Akron, Kest has amassed over 400 victories as a head coach in her career.

Kest is Akron's all-time winningest coach in program history with 179 victories over 12 seasons. Kest led the Zips to at least 19 wins in four consecutive seasons from 2012-16 and took Akron to four postseason berths in the span of five seasons (NCAA 2014, WNIT 2013, 2015 and

2016) and five overall postseason appearances in eight seasons. Kest coached Sina King and Rachel Tecca to MAC Player of the Year awards and WBCA Honorable Mention All-American honors during her tenure.

Prior to her time at Akron, Kest was the head coach at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (TAMU-CC) for four seasons, being named the Independent Coach of the Year in three of those for years and saw Terra Andrews win the Division I Independent Player of the Year award in three consecutive seasons (2003-05).

Before TAMU-CC, Kest served as head coach at Gannon University in Erie, Pa., for six seasons (1996-2002). During that time, she developed a two-time Division II All-American, 10 All-Conference players, a pair of Freshmen of the Year winners and five All-Defensive First Team honorees. She left Gannon with the most victories in program history at 105.

In 1986, she received a master of science in education from Northwest Missouri State, where she served as a graduate assistant coach from 1984-86.

Kest graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree in physical education in 1984 from Slippery Rock University and earned a Master of Science in education from Northwest Missouri State in 1986. At Slippery Rock she was a two-sport athlete, playing basketball and tennis, earning All-American honors in basketball in her final two seasons. Kest left SRU as the all-time leading scorer and rebounder.

JAIME GLUESING

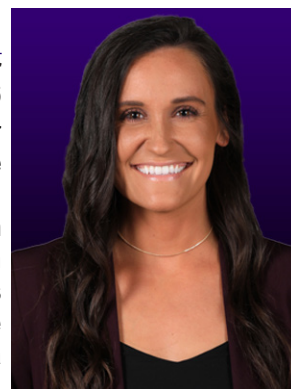
**Assistant Coach / Recruiting Coordinator
Second Season • FGCU '16**

Jaime Gluesing is entering her second season as an assistant coach and the recruiting coordinator for the Panthers. She joined High Point after being an assistant coach at the University of Wisconsin Milwaukee for the 2018-19 season. She was a graduate manager and video analyst for the Panthers in the two seasons prior to taking a coaching position.

The Solon, Ohio native helped Milwaukee register 21 wins and earn an at-large bid to the WNIT during the 2017-18 season. In 2016-17, the Panthers tied their program record with 22 wins and notched the first two postseason victories in the program's history en route to the WBI semifinals.

Gluesing went to Milwaukee after a four-year playing career at Florida Gulf Coast University. While at FGCU, she made 62 career starts and played in all but one game during her collegiate career. The Eagles qualified for postseason play in all four of her seasons, including two trips to the NCAA Tournament and a run to the WNIT Championship Game her senior year.

Gluesing graduated from Milwaukee with a master's degree in Administrative Leadership in 2018, after obtaining her bachelor's degree in Business Management with a concentration in Sports Management from FGCU in 2016.



BRITTANY BROWN

**Assistant Coach • Second Season
FGCU '10**

Brittany Brown is entering her second season on Banbury's staff and comes to High Point after spending the 2018-19 season as an assistant at Delaware State.

Prior to her time in Dover, Del. she served as the head coach at the Community College of Rhode Island from 2013-18. While she was at the helm for the Knights, Brown captured three regional

championships (2010-13), a district title (2013) and produced its first Women's Basketball Coaches Association All-American.

She played semi-professionally for the Flint (Mich.) Monarchs before getting into her coaching career.

As a player, Brown helped lead Florida Gulf Coast University to an Atlantic Sun Conference Championship, two Women's National Invitation Tournament appearances and a 50-12 overall record from 2008-10. Prior to playing at FGCU, she was an All-Jay Hawk Conference and All-Region selection at Labette Community College (Kan.).

Brown graduated from FGCU with a bachelor's degree in Communication Arts in 2010.

JESSICA CATTANI

**Director of Operations • Second Season
FGCU '18**

Jessica Cattani is entering her second season as the HPU women's basketball director of operations.

Prior to joining the Panthers, she spent the 2018-19 season as a graduate assistant at Western Kentucky, where the Lady Toppers finished the season with a 20-15 record and a run to the Round of 16 in the WNIT.

Before her time in Bowling Green, Ky., she played at Florida Gulf Coast, where she averaged 6.9 points per game and led the ASUN in 3-point field goal percentage at 42.9 percent during the 2017-18 campaign. She finished sixth in the conference in 3-point field goals made during ASUN competition with 24. Cattani earned the Eagles' Arrow Award her senior season after setting career-highs in field goals made (84), field goal percentage (.519), 3-point field goals made (52), 3-point field goals attempted (119), 3-point field goal percentage (.437), offensive rebounds (16), steals (22), points (235) and games played (34).

Cattani is a Muskego, Wis., native and graduated from FGCU with a bachelor's degree in Finance in 2018.



ACROSS THE COURT

OPPONENT PREVIEW - LIBERTY

The Liberty Series

High Point and Liberty meet on Wednesday for the 49th time in HPU's Division I history, and the first since the Lady Flames eliminated the Panthers from the 2018 Big South Tournament. Liberty holds a 37-11 advantage in the overall series and a 16-6 mark in the Millis Center. High Point's last win in the series came at home back on Valentine's Day of 2017, a 78-69 victory for the Purple and White. With the most seasoned Panthers on the 2020-21 squad playing in just their third season, this will be the first time any current High Point player has played against the Lady Flames.

Scouting The Lady Flames

Liberty is 3-3 on the season and is 0-3 on the road, but enters Wednesday winners of its last two. The Lady Flames won 16 regular-season championships and 17 tournament titles in their 27 years in the Big South but are playing a former Big South opponent for the first time since leaving for the ASUN in 2018. Head coach Carey Green is in his 22nd year at the helm of Liberty and ranked 23rd on the list of the winningest active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches (by win percentage) entering the season, compiling a .709 win rate through his first 21 years.

Leading Liberty

Redshirt senior Emily Lytle leads Liberty's scoring attack with an average of 15.7 points per game. She's a perfect 15-15 from the free-throw line this season and has made 27-straight attempts from the stripe dating back to last season. Bridgette Rettstatt and Ashtyn Baker also score in double digits for the Lady Flames, averaging 11.7 and 10.8 PPG, respectively. Mya Berkman is the leader on the glass for Liberty, grabbing an average of 6.8 rebounds per game. Kennedy Williams is the Lady Flames' lead ball distributor through the first six games, dishing out a total of 23 assists for an average of 3.8 assists per game, despite coming off the bench in all six.

HIGH POINT PLAYER AND TEAM NOTES

Last Time Out

High Point continued its impressive week on Wednesday last week, defeating NC Wesleyan 108-71 for back-to-back victories. Junior Skyler Curran led the way with 31 points to match her career-high and hit nine shots from behind the arc, a career-best and one off the school and conference record. The 108 points are the third-most in program history and were just three shy of matching HPU's point total from the first time the schools met.

Nifty Newcomer

Freshman Claire Wyatt was named the Big South Freshman of the Week on Monday (Dec. 14), becoming the first Panther to win a weekly award from the conference this season. She scored 20 points across the two games, with a career-high 11 points against NC Central on Monday, and grabbed a career-best seven rebounds on Wednesday against Wesleyan. She also picked up a pair of steals in both games, making it three straight games the freshman has recorded multiple steals.

Rivalry Renewed

Wednesday is the first meeting between High Point and Liberty since the Lady Flames left the Big South for the ASUN in 2018 and will be the first game against any former Big South foe for Liberty in that period.

Scoring at Will

High Point's offense was on fire last week, with the offense scoring 195 over the two games, the most points scored in any two consecutive games in program history. HPU needs 65 points on Wednesday against Liberty to extend the streak to the most points in any three consecutive games. Last week's scoring outburst has moved the Panthers to the top of the Big South with an average offensive output of 78.8 points per game, putting them in the top-50 of the country as well.

You Will Remember Wednesday for Centuries

Last Wednesday was the 10th time in HPU's Division I history the Panthers have scored 100 points or more and was the first of head coach Chelsea Banbury's career at the help of the Purple and White.

Extinguishing the Flame

Banbury was the associate head coach of FGCU in Liberty's first season in the ASUN and helped the Eagles take down the Lady Flames all three times the two teams played that year, including in the 2019 ASUN Championship game.

Foremost Facilitator

Junior Jordan Edwards leads the conference in assists per game, dishing out an average of 7.3 helpers each contest, putting her fifth in the country.

You Don't Make It, She Takes It

Curran leads the conference and is 11th in the country in defensive rebounds per game, snagging an average of 8.5 opponents misses off the glass per game.

The Panther Five

All five starters last Monday scored in double-digits - a feat HPU hadn't accomplished since Feb. 22, 2014, in an 82-75 victory over UNC Asheville. The Edwards' led the way with 23 for Jordan and 18 for Jenson, followed by Curran with 16, Wyatt with 11, and senior Chyna McMichel with 10.

Last Monday's Millis Milestone

The Panthers picked up their 200th Division I victory at the Millis Center last Monday after making the jump to D1 prior to the 1999-2000 season.

Up at the Top

Curran is tied for the lead in the conference in scoring and is 26th in the nation with an average of 22.0 points per game through the first four games of the season. Teammate Jenson Edwards is close behind her in fourth in the Big South with an average of 14.5 PPG.

A Better Education

Jenson and Jordan Edwards are both in the top-three in the Big South in three different assist categories. Jordan leads the Big South in assists per game with 7.3 while Jenson sits in third with an average of 4.2 APG. Jenson currently leads the conference in assist to turnover ratio with a 2.1 mark while Jordan is third with a ratio of 1.8. Jordan also leads the conference in total assists with 22 while Jenson's 17 are the second-most, making High Point the only team in the conference with two players in the top-five in assists.

Letting it Fly

After breaking the program record for three-pointers made in a single season last year, the Panthers continue to fire from deep, entering Wednesday in the top-30 in the country for three-pointers attempted, three-pointers made, and three-pointers per game. HPU makes an average of 10.5 long balls per game, good for 12th in the country, while the Purple and White's 42 total makes on 127 attempts rank 29th and 30th, respectively.

Getting Their Money's Worth

HPU took 40 free throws on Monday and converted on 30 of them. That's tied for the second-most attempts in school history and four shy of matching the record for makes. Nationally, the 30 makes are the sixth-most attempts in all of Division I. On the season, High Point shoots 78.9% from the stripe to lead the conference and sit 22nd in the country.

Climbing the Ranks

Curran entered the season with 137 career three-pointers made, good enough for eighth-most in the program's Division I history, and moved up to fourth place with 154 in her career after draining nine last Wednesday. Her 78 three-pointers made last season were the second-most in a single season for the Panthers, behind teammate Camryn Brown who made 83 three-pointers during last year's campaign. Curran is just 13 points away from entering the program's top-20 Division I scoring ranks and could easily move into the top-15 this season.

HIGH POINT PLAYER AND TEAM NOTES

Home Sweet Home

The Panthers are in the midst of a six-game homestand, with Wednesday's game being number four of the series. The stretch will last almost through the rest of the calendar year, including the first weekend of conference play against UNC Asheville on Dec. 19 and 20.

Double-Double Trouble

Jenson Edwards picked up her first double-double of the season last Monday (18 pts, 10 reb.) to join Curran as the only Panthers with double-doubles this season and bringing their career totals up to three and six, respectively.

Return to the MACC

High Point women's basketball returns to the Millis Athletic and Convocation Center for a 29th and final season in 2020-21. The Millis Center was built on the old foundation of Alumni Hall in 1992 and has served as the home of the Panthers since. HPU has experienced 24 winning seasons at Millis and the Purple and White have racked up a total of 270 wins in the building.

The 1K Club

Last season, Brown was honored for becoming the 13th Panther in the Division I era of High Point women's basketball to score 1,000 points after hitting the milestone at UNC Asheville (Jan. 9) and finishing her career with 1,305 career points, the sixth-most in HPU's Division I history and 14th-most in program history all-time. After scoring 490 points last season, Curran will look to join Brown this season as the 14th Panther to score 1,000 career points, entering Wednesday with 801 in her career.

Two-For-One

For the second straight season, Big South Conference play will see High Point play each team in a 20-game round-robin schedule. Differing from last year is the format, which will be back-to-back contests against the same opponent at the same location on consecutive days this year, as opposed to the traditional home-and-home format used last year. The Panthers begin their conference slate on Dec. 19 and 20 when UNC Asheville comes to town.

I'm Honored

Curran was High Point's second-leading scorer a year ago, and her success last season earned her the top spot on the Big South's preseason honor list, being named the conference's Preseason Player of the Year. Curran was second in Player of the Year voting last season and was on the First Team All-Big South – the team's only returning All-Big South player. Curran picked up four Big South Player of the Week nods a season ago, in addition to being named College Sports Madness' Player of the Week in the Big South four times as well.

First Year Successes

In her first year as the program's fifth Division I head coach, Chelsea Banbury had record-breaking success, finishing the season with a 16-13 mark, going 14-6 in conference play. Her 14 Big South wins were the most by a first-year head coach in HPU history. Redshirt sophomore Jenson Edwards also had a successful first year in 2019-20, being named to the Big South All-Freshman/Rookie Team and being honored twice as the Big South Freshman of the Week.

New Faces

The Panthers welcome four newcomers to this year's squad with three freshmen and one transfer. Junior Jordan Edwards comes to High Point after spending two seasons at Niagara. The guard averaged 4.9 points and 1.7 rebounds per game last season. LaImani Simmons, Claire Wyatt, and Teegan Pifher will also look to make their Panther debuts in their first collegiate seasons.

Seeing Double

For the third time in its Division I history, HPU will have two players with the same last name on the team that are not related. Redshirt sophomore Jenson Edwards is entering her third season with the team and junior Jordan Edwards is in year one with the Purple and White after transferring from Niagara. Jenson was also involved in the most recent instance of sharing a last name with no relation as she redshirted her freshman year when Lindsey Edwards was a senior.

Walk the Plank!

HPU went 5-0 against swashbuckling opponents last season after sweeping the season series with the Hampton Lady Pirates. The Panthers also beat East Tennessee State and picked up two wins against the Charleston Southern Buccaneers. Dating back to her time as a player and assistant coach at Florida Gulf Coast, head coach Chelsea Banbury is 20-3 all-time against swashbuckling foes.

The West Forsyth Pipeline

The Panthers have two West Forsyth High School alumnae on this year's squad as Curran and sophomore Callie Scheier were teammates at the local high school in Clemmons, N.C. During her four years with the Titans, Scheier scored over 1,700 points and dished out over 500 assists while being named the 2019 Conference Player of the Year. Curran was a three-time All-Conference selection and was also named Conference Player of the Year her junior season when she was named to the All-North Carolina First Team. 2021 signee and two-time All-Northwest selection Shakira Baskerville will join the team next season as the third player from West Forsyth.

Qubein Arena

Next season the Panthers will play their inaugural season in the Qubein Arena and Conference Center, which will feature a 4,200-seat sports arena, a plush conference center, and meeting space for up to 2,500 and a luxury boutique hotel.
