OPENING TIP

NATIONALLY RANKED HILLTOPPERS

- West Liberty enters the season ranked #8 in Division II by the National Association of Basketball Coaches. After the 2-0 start, WLU moved up from 7th in the D2SIDA National Media Poll to a tie for 6th this week.
- West Liberty swept the awards in the Mountain East Conference last season, winning its 5th straight regular season title and 3rd tournament title. WLU is the top team in the MEC Preseason Poll for the 5th straight season.

A LOOK AT THE 2022-23 SQUAD

- The 2022-23 Hilltoppers feature seven returners and seven newcomers, with four of the seven being transfers.
- Bryce Butler leads the returners after being named an NCAA D2 All-American, along with Atlantic Region Player of the Year and MEC Player of the Year. Buter averaged 18.1 points and 7.5 rebounds per game a year ago.
- Malik McKinney, Zach Rasile, Christian Montague, & Ben Sarson all averaged over 7 points per game last season.
- Transfers Stephen Cannaday, Alek West, Michael Sampson, and Chaz Hinds all are expected to see time for WLU.

BUTLER MEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Bryce Butler netted back-to-back 30-point games on opening weekend to earn the first Mountain East Conference
Player of the Week of the 2022-23 season. Butler posted a 30-point, 10-rebound double-double in game one
versus Shepherd, then followed it with 35 points and nine boards against Cal (Pa.) the next night.

LAST TIME OUT FOR WLU

West Liberty went 2-0 on opening weekend inside the ASRC, capped off with a 94-85 win over Cal (Pa.). The
Hilltoppers fended off a late comeback that brought the WLU lead from 18-points down to one with under 3:00 to
play. Zach Rasile and Christian Montague hit back-to-back three pointers to halt the Vulcan comeback effort.

SCOUTING THE MOUNTAIN CATS

- Pitt-Johnstown got off to a 2-0 start with a 73-51 win over Wesleyan and 72-65 victory over Charleston last weekend in its home tip-off tournament.
- UPJ is coming off back-to-back-20-win seasons, going 21-9 in 2021-22, with 4 four starters and 7 of the team's top-8 contributors returning led by 6-7 senior forward John Paul Kromka, who was named an NABC All-American and has won three PSAC West Defensive Player of the Year awards. Kromka paced the offense averaging 18.5 points and tied Jared Jakubick, a 6-4 senior guard, at 6.0 rebounds a game on opening weekend.
