Head Coach Joe Mihalich: Now in his sixth season at the helm of the Hofstra Men's Basketball program in 2018-19, Joe Mihalich has engineered a strong resurgence of the Pride during his tenure. Mihalich has already captured 88 wins while at Hofstra, an average of nearly 18 victories per season in Hempstead. Mihalich has led Hofstra to 78 wins over the past four seasons and the Pride has averaged more than 17 wins a season since Mihalich took over a program coming off a seven-win campaign. Since taking over the team he has led Hofstra to a pair of postseason appearances, including a spot in the NIT in 2015-16. Mihalich's strong ability to recruit talented student-athletes has seen Hofstra capture two Colonial Athletic Association Player of the Year awards during his five years in Hempstead as Juan'ya Green won it in 2015-16 and Justin Wright-Foreman captured the award in 2017-18. In addition, his attention to detail as it relates to the academic welfare of the student-athlete has seen the men's basketball program earn the NCAA APR Public Recognition Award for having a multi-year APR in the top 10 percent of all men's basketball programs nationally. The 2017-18 campaign saw Hofstra win 19 games as Wright-Foreman and Rokas Gustys rewrote the record books. While Wright-Foreman was picking a multitude of awards as the season progressed, Gustys became the program's all-time leader in rebounds at the NCAA Division I level and finished second all-time in the CAA. He also scored nearly 1,200 points during his spectacular career. Both Wright-Foreman and Gustys received postseason honors from the conference and Jalen Ray was also recognized on the CAA All-Rookie Team.

Jerry West Award: Hofstra senior guard Justin Wright-Foreman received one the highest preseason honors of his tremendous career when he was named to the 2019 Jerry West Award Pre-Season Watch List, it was announced on October 16 by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced today the 20 watch list members for the 2019 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award. Named after Class of 1980 Hall of Famer and 1959 NCAA Final Four Most Valuable Player Jerry West, the annual honor in its fifth year recognizes the top shooting guards in Division I men's college basketball. A national committee comprised of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2019 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award will be narrowed to just 10. In March, five finalists will be presented to Mr. West and the Hall of Fame's selection committee. The winner of the 2019 Jerry West Award will be presented at the ESPN College Basketball Awards Show presented by Wendy's in Los Angeles, CA on Friday, April 12, 2019, along with the other four members of the Naismith Starting 5. Additional awards being presented include the Bob Cousy Point Guard Award, the Julius Erving Small Forward Award, the Karl Malone Power Forward Award and the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center Award.
