Claxton led Hofstra to a 21-11 record in his first year, guided the Pride to a 25-10 mark in his second season, and posted a 20-13 record last year.

Three-Pointer Streak: With its six three-pointers against Drexel on January 20, Hofstra has now made at least one three-pointer in 430 consecutive games. The last time the Pride didn't hit a three-pointer was on December 6, 2011, when Hofstra went 0-9 from beyond the arc against Wagner.

Winning Formula: Speedy Claxton is one of just four head coaches out of the 57 hired prior to the 2021-22 season to earn at least 20 wins in each of the last three seasons — and one of only three to do it at one school. Tommy Lloyd has recorded 88 wins at Arizona while Hubert Davis has 78 wins at North Carolina. Steve Lutz, who is now the head coach at Oklahoma State, collected 69 wins between Texas A&M-Corpus Christi and Western Kentucky.

CAA Players of the Year: The Hofstra men's basketball program has made a habit out of producing the CAA Player of the Year. Last year, Tyler Thomas became the latest member of the program to earn the conference's top prize. Remarkably, Thomas receiving the CAA's top honor marks the third consecutive season the program has had the conference's player of the year. In addition, Hofstra will have had the CAA's Player of the Year in six of the last nine seasons with Thomas joining Aaron Estrada (2023 and 2022), Justin Wright-Foreman (2019 and 2018), and Juan'ya Green (2016). Other winners from Hofstra since the program joined the CAA include Charles Jenkins (2011 and 2010) and Loren Stokes (2007). The last CAA school to earn three consecutive CAA Player of the Year Awards was George Mason in 1999 (George Evans), 2000 (George Evans), and 2001 (George Evans).

Chairman Of The Boards: Graduate forward Michael Graham had a season-best 15 rebounds for Hofstra in its 68-63 overtime win over Rice on November 29. It is the most for a Pride player in a game since Abayomi lyiola also had 15 in an 87-80 win over James Madison on January 9, 2022.

Free Throw Perfection: Hofstra was a perfect 17-17 from the free throw line against Quinnipiac on December 29. It marked the first time the Pride was perfect from the line with at least 10 attempts since going 10-10 against Princeton on December 1, 2021. The 17-17 showing at the line is the best in the nation this season with at least 15 attempts as Wisconsin was 16-16 against Holy Cross on November 4 and Tulane was 15-15 against Alcorn State on November 11.

Top Four Seed: The Hofstra men's basketball team has remarkably earned a top-four seed at the CAA Championship in seven consecutive seasons. It ranks as the sixth-longest current streak of a top-four seed in the conference tournament in the nation.

Gonzaga (West Coast Conference) - 33 Vermont (America East) - 18 Yale (Ivy League) - 15 South Dakota State (Summit) - 13 UC Irvine (Big West) - 12 Hofstra (CAA) - 7

Yale's streak dates back to the 2008-09 season, but the lvy League didn't hold a postseason tournament until 2017 and didn't compete in 2020-21 due to the pandemic.

Rookie Debut: Freshman Joshua DeCady had 11 points and five rebounds in his collegiate debut against SUNY Old Westbury. It marks the third straight season that a freshman reached double figures in the season opener after KiJan Robinson had 11 points vs. St. Joseph's (NY) in 2023 and Amar'e Marshall tallied 15 against Princeton in 2022.

Transfer Debut: Sophomore Jean Aranguren scored a career-high 25 points against SUNY Old Westbury — the most points by a Hofstra player in his debut since graduate student Zach Cooks had 26 points in the 83-75 overtime loss to #15 Houston on November 9, 2021. Aranguren, Cooks and the late Demetrius Dudley are the only players to score at least 25 points in their Hofstra debuts since 1991. Dudley had 33 points for Hofstra in an 85-62 win over Navy on November 23, 1991.

KiJan Was On Fire: KiJan Robinson had a game to remember against St. Joseph's (L.I.) on December 6. He tallied career-highs of 28 points and seven assists, while also adding five rebounds. Robinson was a spectacular 10-12 from the field and 8-9 from three-point range in the contest. The 28 points were the most in a game by a Pride player this season. besting the total of 25 by Jean Aranguren against SUNY Old Westbury. Robinson's eight three-pointers are the most for a Pride player since Tyler Thomas had eight against St. Joseph's (L.I.) on November 6, 2023. The eight three-pointers are the second-most by a CAA player this season and his assist total was the fifth-most by a CAA player in 2024-25. The 8-9 from three-point range ranks as the second-highest percentage (88.9%) from beyond the arc of players in NCAA Division I this season with at least eight made three-pointers. His scoring total was the 12th-most points off the bench by an NCAA Division I player this season.

Margin Of Victory: Hofstra's 68-point margin of victory in the win over St. Joseph's Long Island ranks as the largest in program history. The previous mark was a 65-point win over the United States Merchant Military Academy in 1955-56. It is the 11th time in program history the Pride has won by at least 50 points.

Edmead To Join Pride: Hofstra University Head Men's Basketball Coach Speedy Claxton continued to showcase his strong recruiting as the program announced on November 15 the addition of Preston Edmead. Edmead will join the Pride and begin his academic and athletic career with the Pride in the fall of 2025. "Preston is a highly-talented and highly-skilled player that will be a huge asset to our program," said Claxton. "We are thrilled to add someone with his skillset to our roster and look forward to his development here at Hofstra." Edmead, a native of Deer Park, New York, attends The Williston Northampton School in Easthampton, Massachusetts. A 6-0 guard, Edmead averaged 23.9 points per game for Deer Park High School before moving on to Williston Northampton. In his first year at Williston Northampton, he was named to the All-NEPSAC Class A team and the All Western New England Prep First Team. Edmead averaged 21.9 points per game as a junior. Edmead comes from an athletic family as his brother, Aaren, played basketball at Wagner and North Carolina A&T, another brother, Malik, plays basketball at Merrimack, and his father, John, played basketball at Dowling.

CAA Players of the Week: Hofstra has won a pair of conference player of the week awards this season. With those two tallies, a Hofstra player has won at least one Player of the Week award in each of the last 22 seasons dating back to 2003-03, which is easily the longest active streak in the CAA. Another way to put that is that a Hofstra player has earned Player of the Week honors in every single season the school's been in the CAA except 2002-03. In addition, with Davis taking home the honors, Hofstra has now had a whopping 28 players combine to earn 85 Player of the Week awards dating back to the school's first season in the CAA in 2001-02. That's the most players to earn a Player of the Week award and the most Player of the Week awards earned by any CAA school in that span. Delaware ranks second in both categories, but their 25 honorees have combined for 47 awards — barely half that of Hofstra.

Overtime Success: With its 68-63 win over Rice on November 29, Hofstra extended its then win streak to four consecutive overtime games. It was the Pride's longest overtime win streak since also winning four straight in overtime from December 8, 2010 to November 18, 2012.

Overtime Success Part II: With its 68-63 overtime win over Rice on November 29 and its 75-71 overtime victory over Massachusetts on November 16, consecutive victories came in overtime. It marks the first time that back-to-back wins have come in the same overtime fashion (but not necessarily back-to-back games) since March 5 and 6, 1994 when Hofstra defeated Troy State, 90-89, in the semifinals of the East Coast Conference Championship and followed that up with an 88-86 double overtime win over Northeastern Illinois in the championship game on March 6.

Historic Defensive Performance: Hofstra held Northeastern to only 37 points in the Pride's 55-37 victory over the Huskies on January 4. How incredible was the performance by Hofstra's defense in the game? Check out these notes about the defensive performance.

The 37 points are the fewest the Pride has allowed in a game since a 48-34 win over Rider on January 18, 1989. In addition, it is the first time Hofstra has allowed fewer than 40 points in a game since a 44-39 win over Manhattan on December 9, 2009. It was also Northeastern's fewest points in a game since a 49-34 loss to Old Dominion on January 5, 2011.

Bench Scoring: Hofstra placed five players in double figures in the win over St. Joseph's Long Island. Interestingly enough, all five players who scored in double figures came off the bench. It marked the first time the Pride did not have a starter reach double figures since January 9, 2013 against Delaware.

A Dozen Scorers: 12 different players scored for Hofstra in the win over St. Joseph's Long Island. It is the first time 12 different players have scored for the Pride in a game since December 17, 2005 against Dartmouth.

Perfection From DeCady: Freshman Joshua DeCady was a perfect 4-4 from the field and 4-4 from the free throw line in the win against St. Joseph's Long Island. DeCady is the first Hofstra player to go perfect from the field as well as the free throw line (minimum four attempts) since Dec. 22, 2018, when Jacquil Taylor scored 18 points while going 7-of-7 from the field and 4-of-4 from the line against Rosemont.

Make It A Double: Hofstra has had 11 different players score in double figures at least once this season. They rank among the nation's leaders in that category.
