Quite The Debut: Hofstra freshman Preston Edmead had a stellar debut for the Pride against UCF on November 3. The Long Island native had 16 points and six assists in his first collegiate contest. It marked the most points by a freshman in their Hofstra debut since Eli Pemberton scored 20 points against Coppin State on November 11, 2016.

Elite Rookie: Hofstra freshman Preston Edmead has shown himself to be one of the top freshmen in the nation so far this season. Edmead is one of only nine freshmen nationally to be averaging at least 13.5 points and 4.5 assists per game.

In Memoriam: Hofstra University Athletics is saddened to announce the passing of former head men's basketball coach Roger Gaeckler. A significant figure in the history of the Pride men's basketball program, Coach Gaeckler guided Hofstra from 1972 to 1979 and helped lead the team to its first-ever NCAA Division I Tournament appearances. During his seven seasons at Hofstra, Coach Gaeckler compiled 84 victories and captured East Coast Conference titles and NCAA Tournament berths in the 1975-76 and 1976-77 seasons. His leadership laid important groundwork for the future success of Hofstra men's basketball. Gaeckler and the entire 1975-76 men's basketball team were inducted into the Hofstra Athletics Hall of Fame in 2015.

CAA Players of the Year: The Hofstra men's basketball program has made a habit out of producing the CAA Player of the Year. In 2023-24, Tyler Thomas became the latest member of the program to earn the conference's top prize. Remarkably, Thomas receiving the CAA's top honor marked the third consecutive season at the time that the program had the conference's player of the year. In addition, Hofstra has had the CAA's Player of the Year in three of the last four, five of the last eight, six of the last 10, and eight of the last 16 seasons with Thomas joining Aaron Estrada (2023 and 2022), Justin Wright-Foreman (2019 and 2018), and Juan'ya Green (2016). Other winners from Hofstra since the program joined the CAA include Charles Jenkins (2011 and 2010) and Loren Stokes (2007). The last CAA school to earn three consecutive CAA Player of the Year Awards was George Mason in 1999 (George Evans), 2000 (George Evans), and 2001 (George Evans).

Yes, even X (#19 Xavier on December 14, 1996). This note was the brainchild of Hofstra Associate Director of Athletics for External Affairs Jessica Kalbfleisch.

30-Piece vs. The ACC: Hofstra junior Cruz Davis poured in 36 points in the win over Pitt on December 7. He is the first CAA player to score 30 or more points in a win over an ACC team since Jamal Shuler of VCU had 30 vs. Maryland on December 2, 2007. It is also only the fifth 30-point game for a CAA team vs. an ACC team this century.

CAA Players of the Week: Cruz Davis earned Hofstra's first CAA Player of the Week Award this season on December 8. With that honor, a Hofstra player has won at least one Player of the Week award in each of the last 24 seasons dating back to 2003-03, which is easily the longest active streak in the CAA. Another way to put that is that a Hofstra player has earned Player of the Week honors in every single season the school's been in the CAA except 2002-03. In addition, with Davis taking home the honors, Hofstra has now had a whopping 28 players combine to earn 85 Player of the Week awards dating back to the school's first season in the CAA in 2001-02. That's the most players to earn a Player of the Week award and the most Player of the Week awards earned by any CAA school in that span. Delaware, which departed the CAA after last season, ranks second in both categories, but their 25 honorees have combined for 47 awards — barely half that of Hofstra.
