With a Victory ...

... Johns Hopkins would improve to 37-5 since the current senior class arrived in 2015.

... Johns Hopkins would improve to 73-5 in the Centennial Conference this decade (since the start of the 2010 season).

... The Blue Jays would improve to 82-10 in their last 92 games dating back to the 2010 season.

... JHU would run its winning streak in the month of October to 28 games dating back to a 26-17 loss at Ursinus on October 16, 2010.

The Game: Johns Hopkins (5-1, 4-1 Centennial) hits the road for the fourth time this season as the Blue Jays head north to Pennsylvania to take on Gettysburg (1-5, 1-4 CC).

A Look Back: Johns Hopkins made it four straight in the win column as the Blue Jays topped Franklin & Marshall, 42-12, on the road on October 6.

Poll Position: Johns Hopkins is tied for 23rd in this week's AFCA Division III Poll. The Blue Jays had been listed as receiving votes in the first two AFCA Polls of the 2018 season. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, Johns Hopkins has now appeared in the top 25 of the AFCA Poll 72 times in 74 weeks.

In addition to the #23 ranking from the AFCA, Johns Hopkins is also ranked 25th in this week's D3football.com Poll. The Blue Jays debuted at #19 in the D3football.com Preseason Poll and were ranked 18th in the first regular season poll before the narrow loss at Susquehanna on September 8; the Blue Jays were ranked 25th last week and now 25th again this week.

Number 300: The season-opening game against Randolph-Macon was the 300th for **Jim Margraff** as the head coach at Johns Hopkins. Margraff boasts a record of 214-88-3 (.707) since taking over in 1990 and his 214 victories rank second among active Division III coaches.

Oh Captain, My Captain: Johns Hopkins will be led this season by co-captains **Michael Curry**, **Mike Kalanik**, **Luke McFadden** and **Addison Quinones**.

Scouting the Bullets

Gettysburg Quickly: Gettysburg (1-5, 1-4 CC) welcomes Johns Hopkins to Musselman Stadium as the featured event for Family Week-end activities on the GC campus.

Looking to Build: After dropping its first five games of the season, the Bullets enter this week's game against the Blue Jays fresh off a 33-17 victory over Juniata. GC scored the first 20 points and the last 13 of the game to hand first-year head coach **Kevin Burke** his first victory at Gettysburg.

Offense Growing: After scoring a total of 34 points through the third quarter of its fifth game, something has clicked for the Gettysburg offense. GC scored 20 points in the fourth quarter at Moravian and then 33 against Juniata.

Sophomore quarterback **Mike Welsh** directs the GC offense; he has thrown for 596 yards and three scores and rushed for 217 yards and two more.

Senior **Nick Rella** leads the team in rushing (259 yards, 1 TD), while **Andrew Howard** (13 receptions-140 yards), **Johnny Davis** (12-228-0) and **Chase Fee** (12-67-1) are Welsh's top outside targets.

Skinner, Aikey Lead Defense: Senior line-backer **Jake Skinner** leads the Gettysburg defense - and ranks fifth in the Centennial - with 56 tackles on the year, while classmate **Logan Aikey** paces the CC in tackles for losses (12.0) and ranks third in sacks (6.0).

The GC defense is allowing 34.5 points and 371.3 yards per game, but that could be a bit deceiving. The Bullet offense has turned the ball over 23 times in six games and averages just over 27 minutes of possession per game - leaving the defense in too many tough sports.

Notes of Interest: The GC defense is tied for fourth in the CC in sacks (17) • The Bullets are 2nd in the league in red zone offense (86.7%), but last in 3rd-down percentage (25.2%) • **Justin Geisel** is perfect on eight FG attempts.

State of Affairs: The 96-man Johns Hopkins football team includes players from 22 different states.

Before the Bye: Johns Hopkins hit its bye week after the win at Franklin & Marshall on October 6. Since 2011, and including the game against F&M, Johns Hopkins is 40-2 in the 42 combined games played before its week bye. Included were perfect 5-0 marks each year from 2011-2016.

After the Bye: This week's game at Gettysburg is the first for the Blue Jays after the bye week. Since 2011, Johns Hopkins is 33-1 in regular season games played after its bye week.

October Has Been Good of Late: The calendar flipped to October for the Blue Jays' game at F&M and the second month of the season has been kind to the Blue Jays of late. Including the win against the Diplomats, Johns Hopkins has won 27 consecutive games in the month of October dating back to a 26-17 loss at Ursinus on October 16, 2010.

Ironically, the Blue Jays were just 10-8 in their previous 18 games in the month of October before jump-starting the current 27-game run with a 49-24 win at Susquehanna on October 23, 2010.

Looking Ahead: Johns Hopkins will return home next week (October 27) for its only home game between October 1 and November 10. The Blue Jays will welcome league-leading Muhlenberg (6-0, 5-0 CC) to Homewood Field for a showdown featuring the two teams that have earned at least a share of every Centennial Conference title since 2001 except one (2006).

301 in First Six: Johns Hopkins has scored 301 points through six games - that marks the most points the Blue Jays have ever scored in a six-game span in school history.

In fact, the 301 points the Blue Jays have scored this season are already the 11th-highest single-season total in school history.

35+ in Six Straight: Johns Hopkins has scored at least 35 points in each of the first six games this season. That is one game shy of the longest such run in school history. The Blue Jays scored 35+ in seven straight games late in the 2016 season.

Chart Toppers: Johns Hopkins leads the Centennial Conference in scoring offense (50.2 ppg), total offense (564.7 ypg.), passing yards per game (356.7 ypg.) and rushing offense (216.2). The Blue Jays are also first in third-down percentage (.553) and first downs per game (27.8).

Among the National Leaders: Entering this week's game against Gettysburg, Johns Hopkins ranks second in the nation in total offense (564.7), sixth in passing offense (356.7) and fourth in scoring offense (50.2). The Blue Jays also rank fourth

Centennial Favorites

For the 10th consecutive year and the 13th time in the last 15 years, Johns Hopkins was selected as the favorite in the Centennial Conference preseason poll of coaches and athletic communications directors.

The Blue Jays received 14 of 20 first-place votes and totaled 158 points to out-distance F&M, which checked in at number two in the poll with five first-place votes and 148 points.

in third-down percentage (.553) and the 167 first downs JHU has accumulated are the seventh most of any team in the nation.

Record-Tying: Johns Hopkins rolled up 665 yards of total offense in the 52-6 win over Ursinus. That ranks as the fourth-best single-game total in school history and ties the school record for most 600-yard games in one season (3 / 680 @ Moravian, 606 vs. Randolph-Macon). JHU also had three 600-yard games in 2017.

Six in 132, Six in 17: In the first 132 seasons of Johns Hopkins football, the Blue Jays had six games of 600+ yards of total offense. In the last 17 games, the Blue Jays have topped the 600-yard mark six times.

A Program First, Twice: The Blue Jays rolled up 428 yards passing and 252 yards rushing in the win at Moravian. That marked the first time in school history that the Blue Jays have totaled more than 400 yards passing and 250 yards rushing in the same game.

So, after never having turned the 400/250 trick in 133 seasons (plus two games), the Blue Jays did it twice in three weeks as they followed up the effort at Moravian with a 405-yard passing, 262-yard rushing performance against Ursinus.

Amazingly, only once prior to this had JHU had even 250+ rushing yards and 350+ passing yards in one game (vs. Juniata in 2017).

Margraff Holds State Record: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** became the winningest college football coach in Maryland state history with a 42-14 win at Ursinus late in the 2014 season as that gave him 175 career victories, a mark he upped to 214 with the recent 42-12 win over F&M.

Margraff now sports a career record of 214-88-3 (.707) entering this week's Centennial Conference game against Gettysburg.

Second-Best Quarter, Half Totals: The 33 points Johns Hopkins scored in the second quarter and the 46 points the Blue Jays rolled up in the first half against Dickinson are the second best totals in a quarter and half in school history.

That's a Record: JHU led Dickinson 46-0 at the half on September 22. The 46-point halftime margin is the largest in school history. Previously, the largest lead the Blue Jays held at halftime was 42 (49-7 lead at McDaniel in 2017).

Big Plays: Through six games, the Johns Hopkins offense has 46 plays of 20 yards or longer (an average of 7.6 such plays per game) and 133 plays of 10 yards or longer (22.2 such plays per game). Note that this includes offensive plays only (rushing and passing plays).

Defense Steps Up: The Johns Hopkins defense enjoyed its strongest outing of the season in the 47-3 win at Moravian. The Blue Jays held the Greyhounds to just 216 yards of total offense, including just 70 in the first half, limited MC to a 2-of-14 showing on third-down chances, recorded two takeaways, two sacks and nine tackles for losses.

It's Been a While: The three points the Blue Jays allowed at Moravian are the fewest points Johns Hopkins has allowed in a road game since October 13, 2012, when JHU topped Dickinson, 49-0.

Seven or Less Under Rehiring: Since **Mickey Rehiring** took over as the Blue Jay defensive coordinator in 2013, Johns Hopkins has held the opposition to seven points or less 14 times - including the three-point performance by Moravian on September 15 and the six-point effort by Ursinus a week later.

35 in 4: After allowing an average of 34 points per game in the first two games, the Blue Jay defense has worked its way into form and has allowed a total of just 35 points in the last four games - all Blue Jay victories.

The 35 points Johns Hopkins has allowed over the last four games are the fewest in a four-game span since the Blue Jays allowed just 32 in a four-game span midway through the 2016 season.

Block Party: Freshman **Robert Fletcher** needed exactly three minutes to impact the first game of his career as he blocked a Randolph-Macon punt that was returned 32 yards for a touchdown by senior **Tyler Messinger**. The blocked punt return for a touchdown was the first for Johns Hopkins since **Adam Schweyer** took one back 36 yards for a score against Juniata on October 30, 2010.

Fletcher was back at it against Dickinson as he partially blocked a first-quarter Red Devil punt that led to a Johns Hopkins touchdown and also got a piece of Franklin & Marshall's first punt to give him three blocks on the year; he is tied for fourth in the nation with his three blocked kicks.

Pick Six: Sophomore **Macauley Kilbane** scored the second of four, fourth-quarter touchdowns for the Blue Jays in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon as he returned an interception 34 yards for a score with 13:20 remaining.

The interception return for a score was the first for the Blue Jays since **Dan Johnson's** 23-yard return for a touchdown against F&M on November 7, 2013.

Because You'll Ask: For the record, the last time Johns Hopkins scored a touchdown on offense, defense and special teams - prior to turning the trick in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon - was on November 10, 2007, when **Richard Hill** returned the opening kickoff 90 yards for a touchdown, **Adam Winter** returned an interception 12 yards for a score and the Blue Jay offense scored a pair of touchdowns in a 31-3 win at McDaniel.

Record-Tying: Senior punter **Brandon Hong-Dominguez** tied the Johns Hopkins record for the longest punt in school history with a 75-yard bomb late in the fourth quarter against Dickinson. It is just the fifth 70+ yard punt in school history and tied **Ben Scott's** school record (vs. Rochester / 2005).

At Home at Homewood: Johns Hopkins has parlayed its home field advantage into victories in recent years. In fact, the Blue Jays are 46-5 (.902) in the home blacks since the start of the 2010 season.

More Homewood: Including the 52-6 win against Ursinus, Johns Hopkins has now won 41 straight regular season home games. The Blue Jays last dropped a home game in the regular season on October 2, 2010 when Muhlenberg topped JHU, 30-27.

Number Four: Johns Hopkins boasts a 57-7 record since the start of the 2013 season. The Blue Jays' .890 winning percentage over that time ranks fourth among Division III teams. 61 Under to 61 Over: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** inherited a program with an all-time record that was 61 games **UNDER** .500 when he arrived (334-395-56). With the win against Juniata on November 4, 2017, Johns Hopkins moved its all-time record to 61 games **OVER** .500. Entering this week's game against Gettysburg, Johns Hopkins has an all-time record of 548-483-59 (+65).

Centennial Conference Champions: Johns Hopkins claimed its record 13th Centennial Conference title last season with all 13 championships coming since 2002. JHU's 13 CC titles are four more than Dickinson and Muhlenberg have accumulated.

Close Calls: Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of seven games. Those seven losses have come by five, three, five, seven, four, three and two points (including playoff games). Translation ... JHU has lost seven games in 5+ seasons by a total of 29 points.

On a Roll: Johns Hopkins is 77-3 in its last 80 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season and 81-10 in its last 91 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

Sustained Success: Since the start of the 2002 season, the Blue Jays sport a 148-38 (.796) record. Taking it back farther, the Blue Jays are 154-41 (.790) since the start of the 2001 season and 159-46 (.776) since the beginning of the 2000 season.

Series History

Johns Hopkins and Gettysburg are meeting for the 46th time in a series that dates to a 5-3 Gettysburg win in 1911. Johns Hopkins holds a 23-20-2 lead in the series and has won 10 straight and 21 of the last 23 matchups entering this week's game.

Surprisingly, only four of the last 19 meetings between the two teams have been decided by less than 12 points and nine of those 19 have seen margins of 20 points or more.

Prior to Hopkins' current run of 21 wins in the last 23 meetings, the Bullets had run up a 17-1-1 mark against the Blue Jays from 1916 through 1994. The only win for the Blue Jays during that stretch was a 28-14 win on September 29, 1990. That was the first Centennial Conference victory for current Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff**.

Fans of offense should enjoy this one as the teams have combined for at least 50 points in 10 of the last 11 meetings and more than 60 five times in the last 10 meetings. Johns Hopkins has scored 34 or more points in nine of the last 10 meetings.

Luke McFadden (WR)

- Tied for eighth on the team in receiving this season (7-104-1).
- Has career totals of 116-2,061-17.
- Became the 12th player in school history to reach 2,000 career receiving yards at Susquehanna - now has 2,061.
- Needs three TD receptions to reach 20 ... would be 7th JHU player to reach 20.

Tyler Messinger (RB)

- Needs 252 rushing yards for 1,000 ... would be 27th JHU player to reach 1,000.
- Had three receptions for 103 yards and 2 TDs at Moravian. First JHU RB with a 100-yard receiving game since Ryan Cary vs. Mount Union in 2016 (10-122-1).
- Rang up a career-high 160 all-purpose yards against Ursinus with 99 receiving yards and 61 rushing yards.
- 76-yard TD reception vs. Ursinus is tied for the second longest in school history by a running back. Scott Martorana had a 79-yard TD reception vs. Muhlenberg in 2000.
- Has scored two touchdowns in three of last four games.
- Has scored 17 career TDs on 156 touches ... one every 9.2 times he touches the ball.

Dane Rogerson (WR)

- Tied for third on the team in receiving with 12-201-1.
- Enjoyed best game of his career with 5-120-1 in 63-31 season-opening win vs. Randolph-Macon.

David Tamaro (QB)

- Tied school and Centennial Conference record with third career 400-yard passing game at Moravian (420).
- Fifth in school history with 42 career TD passes.
- Has thrown for 200 or more yards in a school and Centennial Conference-record 16 straight games.
