With a Victory ...

... Johns Hopkins would improve to 38-5 since the current senior class arrived in 2015.

... Johns Hopkins would improve to 74-5 in the Centennial Conference this decade (since the start of the 2010 season).

... The Blue Jays would improve to 83-10 in their last 93 games dating back to the 2010 season.

... JHU would run its winning streak in the month of October to 29 games dating back to a 26-17 loss at Ursinus on October 16, 2010.

The Game: Johns Hopkins (6-1, 5-1 Centennial) welcomes Muhlenberg (7-0, 6-0 CC) to Homewood Field for a matchup of the two teams that sit atop the Centennial Conference standings.

A Look Back: Johns Hopkins made it five straight in the win column as the Blue Jays topped Gettysburg, 51-14, on the road last Saturday (October 20).

Poll Position: Johns Hopkins is 21st in this week's AFCA Division III Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, Johns Hopkins has now appeared in the top 25 of the AFCA Poll 74 times in 76 weeks.

In addition to the #21 ranking from the AFCA, Johns Hopkins is also ranked 22nd in this week's D3football.com Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, the Blue Jays have now appeared in the top 25 of the D3football.com poll 79 times in 87 weeks.

Game of the Week: This week's game between 21st-ranked Johns Hopkins and 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg is the only Division III football game in the nation featuring two ranked teams. Both teams are also ranked in the top 25 of the D3football.com Poll this week with JHU checking in at 23rd and Muhlenberg ranked 18th.

Ranked vs. Ranked: For the third time in five years, both Johns Hopkins and Muhlenberg enter the game against each ranked in the top 25 by the AFCA. Below is a look at the three instances this has now happened:

Scouting the Mules

Muhlenberg Quickly: Muhlenberg comes to Homewood Field for the first time since 2015 riding the crest of a seven-game season-opening winning streak and a 10-game run that dates back to last season. The Mules are ranked 18th this week by D3football.com and 22nd by the AFCA.

Two Away: Muhlenberg's current 10-game winning streak is two shy of the school record. The Mules won 12 in a row from 2006-07. The Mules' current 10-game winning streak is also the fourth-longest active streak in the nation.

The "D" in Muhlenberg: Officially, there is no "D" in Muhlenberg. However, the "D" the Mules will bring with them to Baltimore is the best in the Centennial Conference. Entering this week's game against Johns Hopkins, the Muhlenberg defense is allowing just 18.3 points and 295.1 yards per game. The opposition is averaging just 71.7 rushing yards per game and MC leads the league in interceptions (12) and sacks (26).

Mickey Kober leads the team in tackles (47), while **Jack Fitzsimmons** and **Frankie Feaster** have combined for 17.5 tackles for losses. In all, 13 different players have been in on at least one of the Mules' 26 sacks in seven games and 16 players have at least one tackle for loss.

Hnatkowsky Leads Offense: Looking for a front-runner for Centennial Offensive Player of the Year? Look no farther than Muhlenberg sophomore quarterback **Michael Hnatkowsky**, who has thrown for 1,882 yards and 18 touchdowns against just two interceptions. Hnatkowsky directs an offense that is averaging 37.9 points and 459.3 yards per game.

The top weapons on the outside include **Max Kirin** (31-463-7), **Nick Ugarte** (26-313-1) and **Ryan Curtiss** (25-377-4). Curtiss is a matchup nightmare at tight end and was a Third-Team D3football.com All-American last season.

The Mules are hardly reliant just on the pass as sophomore **James Diggs** leads a ground game that averages 182.6 yards per game. Diggs has rushed for 640 yards and seven touchdowns and his 91.4 yards per game leads the Centennial. Junior **Mark Riggio** is the perfect complement to the elusive Diggs as he has rushed for 364 yards and five touchdowns.

Number 300: The season-opening game against Randolph-Macon was the 300th for **Jim Margraff** as the head coach at Johns Hopkins. Margraff boasts a record of 215-88-3 (.708) since taking over in 1990 and his 215 victories rank second among active Division III coaches.

Oh Captain, My Captain: Johns Hopkins will be led this season by co-captains **Michael Curry**, **Mike Kalanik**, **Luke McFadden** and **Addison Quinones**.

State of Affairs: The 96-man Johns Hopkins football team includes players from 22 different states.

Before the Bye: Johns Hopkins hit its bye week after the win at Franklin & Marshall on October 6. Since 2011, and including the game against F&M, Johns Hopkins is 40-2 in the 42 combined games played before its week bye. Included were perfect 5-0 marks each year from 2011-2016.

After the Bye: Last week's game at Gettysburg was the first for the Blue Jays after the bye week. Since 2011, Johns Hopkins is 34-1 in regular season games played after its bye week.

October Has Been Good of

Late: The calendar flipped to October for the Blue Jays' game at F&M and the second month of the season has been kind to the Blue Jays of late. Including the win last week at Gettysburg, Johns Hopkins has won 28 consecutive games in the month of October dating back to a 26-17 loss at Ursinus on October 16, 2010.

Ironically, the Blue Jays were just 10-8 in their previous 18 games in the month of October before jump-starting the current 28-game run with a 49-24 win at Susquehanna on October 23, 2010.

What's at Stake: This week's game between Johns Hopkins and Muhlenberg pits the two Centennial Conference teams that control their own fate in the race for at least a share of the league title and the CC's automatic bid to the upcoming NCAA Playoffs.

With three wins, Johns Hopkins would secure no worse than a share of the title and would earn the automatic bid to the playoffs.

Muhlenberg would secure at least a share of the title with a win this week. The Mules would lock up the CC's automatic bid this week with a win and a Moravian loss.

Centennial Favorites

For the 10th consecutive year and the 13th time in the last 15 years, Johns Hopkins was selected as the favorite in the Centennial Conference preseason poll of coaches and athletic communications directors.

The Blue Jays received 14 of 20 first-place votes and totaled 158 points to out-distance F&M, which checked in at number two in the poll with five first-place votes and 148 points.

352 is 10th: Johns Hopkins has scored 352 points through seven games - that marks the most points the Blue Jays have ever scored in a seven-game span in school history.

In fact, the 352 points the Blue Jays have scored this season are already the 10th-highest single-season total in school history.

35+ in Seven Straight: Johns Hopkins has scored at least 35 points in each of the first seven games this season. That ties the school record for most consecutive games scoring 35+. The Blue Jays scored 35+ in seven straight games late in the 2016 season.

Chart Toppers: Johns Hopkins leads the Centennial Conference in scoring offense (50.3 ppg), total offense (558.3 ypg.), passing yards per game (352.6 ypg.) and rushing offense (205.7). The Blue Jays are also first in third-down percentage (.512) and first downs per game (26.6).

Margraff Holds State Record: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** became the winningest college football coach in Maryland state history with a 42-14 win at Ursinus late in the 2014 season as that gave him 175 career victories, a mark he upped to 215 with last week's win at Gettysburg.

Margraff now sports a career record of 215-88-3 (.708) entering this week's Centennial Conference game against Muhlenberg.

Among the National Leaders: Entering this week's game against Muhlenberg, Johns Hopkins ranks second in the nation in total offense (558.3), sixth in passing offense (352.6) and fifth in scoring offense (50.2). The Blue Jays also rank ninth in third-down percentage (.512) and the 186 first downs JHU has accumulated are the ninth most of any team in the nation.

Walters Scores 50th Career Touchdown: Senior running back **Stuart Walters** touched the ball just seven times last week at Gettysburg, but three of those seven ended with Walters in the end zone.

The three touchdowns give Walters 14 on the season and push his career total to 50 touchdowns. He is just the second Johns Hopkins player and the fourth in Centennial Conference history to score 50 career touchdowns.

Entering this week's game against Muhlenberg, Walters needs just one touchdown to tie **Andrew Kase's** (2006-09) JHU career mark of 51 touchdowns.

PK Enters the Record Book - Part I: Junior defensive back **Patrick Kelly** intercepted a Gettysburg pass on the last play of the game last week and returned it 90 yards before being tackled. The 90-yard interception return is the longest in school history - 10 yards longer than **Les Matthews'** 80-yard return against then Western Maryland (McDaniel) on November 18, 1972.

PK Enters the Record Book - Part II: Not only did **Patrick Kelly** set a Johns Hopkins record with a 90-yard interception return at Gettysburg, he also become the first player in school history with two different types of 90+ yard plays. Kelly had a 95-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Gettysburg last season and added the 90-yard INT return last week.

The only other player in school history with two 90-yard plays is **Harrison Bernstein**, who had kickoff returns of 95 and 92 yards during his career from 1996-99.

Record-Tying: Johns Hopkins rolled up 665 yards of total offense in the 52-6 win over Ursinus. That ranks as the fourth-best single-game total in school history and ties the school record for most 600-yard games in one season (3 / 680 @ Moravian, 606 vs. Randolph-Macon). JHU also had three 600-yard games in 2017.

Six in 132, Six in 18: In the first 132 *seasons* of Johns Hopkins football, the Blue Jays had six games of 600+ yards of total offense. In the last 18 *games*, the Blue Jays have topped the 600-yard mark six times.

A Program First, Twice: The Blue Jays rolled up 428 yards passing and 252 yards rushing in the win at Moravian. That marked the first time in school history that the Blue Jays have totaled more than 400 yards passing and 250 yards rushing in the same game.

So, after never having turned the 400/250 trick in 133 seasons (plus two games), the Blue Jays did it twice in three weeks as they followed up the effort at Moravian with a 405-yard passing, 262-yard rushing performance against Ursinus.

Amazingly, only once prior to this had JHU had even 250+ rushing yards and 350+ passing yards in one game (vs. Juniata in 2017).

Second-Best Quarter, Half Totals: The 33 points Johns Hopkins scored in the second quarter and the 46 points the Blue Jays rolled up in the first half against Dickinson are the second best totals in a quarter and half in school history.

That's a Record: JHU led Dickinson 46-0 at the half on September 22. The 46-point halftime margin is the largest in school history. Previously, the largest lead the Blue Jays held at halftime was 42 (49-7 lead at McDaniel in 2017).

Big Plays: Through seven games, the Johns Hopkins offense has 56 plays of 20 yards or longer (an average of 8.0 such plays per game) and 148 plays of 10 yards or longer (21.1 such plays per game). Note that this includes offensive plays only (rushing and passing plays).

Defense Steps Up: The Johns Hopkins defense enjoyed its strongest outing of the season in the 47-3 win at Moravian. The Blue Jays held the Greyhounds to just 216 yards of total offense, including just 70 in the first half, limited MC to a 2-of-14 showing on third-down chances, recorded two takeaways, two sacks and nine tackles for losses.

It's Been a While: The three points the Blue Jays allowed at Moravian are the fewest points Johns Hopkins has allowed in a road game since October 13, 2012, when JHU topped Dickinson, 49-0.

Seven or Less Under Rehiring: Since **Mickey Rehiring** took over as the Blue Jay defensive coordinator in 2013, Johns Hopkins has held the opposition to seven points or less 14 times - including the three-point performance by Moravian on September 15 and the six-point effort by Ursinus a week later.

49 in 5: After allowing an average of 34 points per game in the first two games, the Blue Jay defense has worked its way into form and has allowed a total of just 49 points in the last five games - all Blue Jay victories.

The 49 points Johns Hopkins has allowed over the last five games are the fewest in a five-game span since the Blue Jays allowed just 45 in a five-game span midway through the 2017 season. This is also just the second time Johns Hopkins has allowed less than 50 points in a five-game span since **Mickey Rehiring** became the Blue Jays' defensive coordinator in 2013.

Sack Party: The Johns Hopkins defense has totaled 21 sacks on the year, including 11 in the last two games. With six sacks at Franklin & Marshall and five at Gettysburg, the Blue Jays have five or more sacks in back-to-back games for the first time since notching six against Randolph-Macon and five against Susquehanna early in the 2012 season.

Block Party: Freshman **Robert Fletcher** needed exactly three minutes to impact the first game of his career as he blocked a Randolph-Macon punt that was returned 32 yards for a touchdown by senior **Tyler Messinger**. The blocked punt return for a touchdown was the first for Johns Hopkins since **Adam Schweyer** took one back 36 yards for a score against Juniata on October 30, 2010.

Fletcher was back at it against Dickinson as he partially blocked a first-quarter Red Devil punt that led to a Johns Hopkins touchdown and also got a piece of Franklin & Marshall's first punt to give him three blocks on the year; he is tied for fourth in the nation with his three blocked kicks.

Series History

One of the most competitive series in the Centennial Conference renews itself for the 51st time as Johns Hopkins welcomes Muhlenberg to Homewood Field for a matchup featuring two teams that have combined to win at least a share of the last 11 CC titles. JHU leads the series 26-23-1.

Taking it back to 2001, Johns Hopkins has won 13 CC titles, while the Mules have at least a share of seven. Only once since 2001 (2006) has Johns Hopkins or Muhlenberg not earned at least a share of the title/represented the CC in the NCAA Playoffs.

Johns Hopkins has won eight of the last nine meetings, including seven straight. Since the inception of the Centennial Conference in 1983, JHU holds a tight 20-15 advantage. How close has the series been since 1983? JHU has outscored the Mules 748-650 in those 35 games (+2.8 ppg.).

Eight of the last 15 games have been decided by eight points or less. Taking it back farther, six of the last 21 have been three-point affairs and 11 of the 21 have been decided by eight points or less.

Pick Six: Sophomore **Macauley Kilbane** scored the second of four, fourth-quarter touchdowns for the Blue Jays in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon as he returned an interception 34 yards for a score with 13:20 remaining.

The interception return for a score was the first for the Blue Jays since **Dan Johnson's** 23-yard return for a touchdown against F&M on November 7, 2013.

Because You'll Ask - Part I: For the record, the last time Johns Hopkins scored a touchdown on offense, defense and special teams - prior to turning the trick in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon - was on November 10, 2007, when **Richard Hill** returned the opening kickoff 90 yards for a touchdown, **Adam Winter** returned an interception 12 yards for a score and the Blue Jay offense scored a pair of touchdowns in a 31-3 win at McDaniel.

Because You'll Ask - Part II: With the three returns for touchdowns this season (FR, INT, Blocked PR), Johns Hopkins has now scored 49 touchdowns on returns since head coach **Jim Margraff** took over in 1990.

Record-Tying: Senior punter **Brandon Hong-Dominguez** tied the Johns Hopkins record for the longest punt in school history with a 75-yard bomb late in the fourth quarter against Dickinson. It is just the fifth 70+ yard punt in school history and tied **Ben Scott's** school record (vs. Rochester / 2005).

At Home at Homewood: Johns Hopkins has parlayed its home field advantage into victories in recent years. In fact, the Blue Jays are 46-5 (.902) in the home blacks since the start of the 2010 season.

More Homewood: Including the 52-6 win against Ursinus, Johns Hopkins has now won 41 straight regular season home games. The Blue Jays last dropped a home game in the regular season on October 2, 2010 when Muhlenberg topped JHU, 30-27.

Number Four: Johns Hopkins boasts a 58-7 record since the start of the 2013 season. The Blue Jays' .892 winning percentage over that time ranks fourth among Division III teams. 61 Under to 61 Over: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** inherited a program with an all-time record that was 61 games **UNDER** .500 when he arrived (334-395-56). With the win against Juniata on November 4, 2017, Johns Hopkins moved its all-time record to 61 games **OVER** .500. Entering this week's game against Muhlenberg, Johns Hopkins has an all-time record of 549-483-59 (+66).

Centennial Conference Champions: Johns Hopkins claimed its record 13th Centennial Conference title last season with all 13 championships coming since 2002. JHU's 13 CC titles are four more than Dickinson and Muhlenberg have accumulated.

Close Calls: Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of seven games. Those seven losses have come by five, three, five, seven, four, three and two points (including playoff games). Translation ... JHU has lost seven games in 5+ seasons by a total of 29 points.

On a Roll: Johns Hopkins is 78-3 in its last 81 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season and 82-10 in its last 92 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

Sustained Success: Since the start of the 2002 season, the Blue Jays sport a 149-38 (.797) record. Taking it back farther, the Blue Jays are 155-41 (.791) since the start of the 2001 season and 160-46 (.777) since the beginning of the 2000 season.
