With a Victory ...

... Johns Hopkins would improve to 39-5 since the current senior class arrived in 2015.

... Johns Hopkins would improve to 75-5 in the Centennial Conference this decade (since the start of the 2010 season).

... The Blue Jays would improve to 84-10 in their last 94 games dating back to the 2010 season.

... JHU would run its regular season winning streak in the month of November to 14 games dating back to 2012.

The Game: Johns Hopkins (7-1, 6-1 Centennial) heads to Huntingdon, Pennsylvania for the Blue Jays' penultimate regular season game of the 2018 season against Juniata (0-8, 0-7 CC).

A Look Back: Johns Hopkins made it six straight in the win column as the Blue Jays topped then 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg, 27-16, last Saturday (Oct. 27) at Homewood Field.

Poll Position: Johns Hopkins is 18th in this week's AFCA Division III Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, Johns Hopkins has now appeared in the top 25 of the AFCA Poll 75 times in 77 weeks.

In addition to the #18 ranking from the AFCA, Johns Hopkins is also ranked 17th in this week's D3football.com Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, the Blue Jays have now appeared in the top 25 of the D3football.com poll 80 times in 88 weeks.

Johns Hopkins also debuted at #3 in the official NCAA South Region rankings this week.

Number 300: The season-opening game against Randolph-Macon was the 300th for **Jim Margraff** as the head coach at Johns Hopkins. Margraff boasts a record of 216-88-3 (.708) since taking over in 1990 and his 216 victories rank second among active Division III coaches.

Oh Captain, My Captain: Johns Hopkins will be led this season by co-captains **Michael Curry**, **Mike Kalanik**, **Luke McFadden** and **Addison Quinones**.

Scouting the Eagles

Juniata Quickly: Juniata (0-8, 0-7 Centennial) welcomes Johns Hopkins to Knox Stadium for the Eagles' final regular season home game of the year. JC will close the season at Susquehanna next week.

Don't Be Deceived: Don't be deceived by the Eagles' winless record thus far in 2018. While the ultimate outcome of just one game has been closer than two touchdowns, a closer look at the box scores reveals much more competitive games.

Juniata led F&M (17-7) and McDaniel (14-7) at the half, trailed Muhlenberg just 14-7 with three minutes left in the first half and was within four points of Grove City, Gettysburg and Moravian in the third quarter.

Passing Attack Fuels Offense: Juniata has played three quarterbacks with some regularity at different points this season. Seniors **Tim Graham** and **Jason Jones** and junior **Austin Montgomery** have combined to throw for 1,594 yards and 13 touchdowns and 14 different players have at least one catch on the year.

Daulton Synder and **Shaheed Ross** are the top two threats on the outside as they've combined for 76 receptions for 817 yards and six TDs. **Sean Owens** also has 24 receptions with four of those ending as touchdowns.

Defense Thrives on Turnovers: The Juniata defense is allowing 38.8 points and 420.0 yards per game, but the Eagles are tied for third in the Centennial with 17 forced turnovers in eight games.

The unit is led by senior defensive back **Joel Reighard**, who leads the team with 62 tackles and seven pass breakups on the year. Linebackers **Jamel Foster** and **Dan Drop** have combined for 6.0 sacks and 14.5 tackles for losses among their 103 combined tackles.

Notes of Interest: The JC defense has posted at least two sacks in every game this season • The Eagles have lost the time of possession battle in every game and have had less than 26 minutes of possession five times.

State of Affairs: The 96-man Johns Hopkins football team includes players from 22 different states.

Six in a Row: Johns Hopkins ran its winning streak to six games with last week's 27-16 win over Muhlenberg. This marks the 11th time since **Jim Margraff** took over as the head coach at Johns Hopkins (1990) that the Blue Jays have won six games or more in a row. Prior to Margraff's arrival, Johns Hopkins had a total of seven, six-game winning streaks in its history (1882-1989) and just one in the 30 years prior to his arrival.

After the Bye: Last week's game at Muhlenberg was the second for the Blue Jays after the bye week. Since 2011, Johns Hopkins is now 35-1 in regular season games played after its bye week.

October Has Been Good of Late: The calendar flipped to October for the Blue Jays' game at F&M and the second month of the season has been kind to the Blue Jays of late. Including the win last week against Muhlenberg, Johns Hopkins has won 29 consecutive games in the month of October dating back to a 26-17 loss at Ursinus on October 16, 2010.

November Reign: Johns Hopkins enters this week's game at Juniata having won 13 consecutive regular season games in the month of November dating back to 2012.

The Race for the Boot: The race for the Centennial Conference championship and possession of the championship "boot" enters the final two weeks of the regular season with several teams in contention for at least a share of the title.

Below is a quick look at the most obvious scenarios still in play.

Johns Hopkins - The Blue Jays earn no worse than a share of the title and will claim the Centennial's automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs with two wins.

Muhlenberg - The Mules earn no worse than a share of the title with two wins. Muhlenberg grabs the Centennial's automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs with two wins and one loss by Johns Hopkins.

Franklin & Marshall - The Diplomats claim a share of the title with two wins and at least one loss by Johns Hopkins and Muhlenberg. The Dips grab the AQ to the NCAAs with two wins and two losses each by Johns Hopkins and Muhlenberg.

Moravian, Susquehanna, Ursinus - While each of these teams needs a little help, none of the three has been eliminated in the race for at least a share of the Centennial title - although one win by Johns Hopkins or Muhlenberg would end the hopes for all three.

Centennial Favorites

For the 10th consecutive year and the 13th time in the last 15 years, Johns Hopkins was selected as the favorite in the Centennial Conference preseason poll of coaches and athletic communications directors.

The Blue Jays received 14 of 20 first-place votes and totaled 158 points to out-distance F&M, which checked in at number two in the poll with five first-place votes and 148 points.

What's Next: The recipient of the Centennial Conference's automatic bid to the upcoming NCAA Playoffs will learn its draw when the bracket for the 2018 tournament is announced on Sunday, November 11 (5:30 pm on ncaa.com).

379 is 10th: Johns Hopkins has scored 379 points through eight games - that marks the most points the Blue Jays have ever scored in an eight-game span in school history.

In fact, the 379 points the Blue Jays have scored this season are already the 10th-highest single-season total in school history.

Looking at 400: With 21 more points scored this season, Johns Hopkins would top the 400-point mark for just the eighth time in school history. The previous seven times have, coincidentally, been the last seven years.

Chart Toppers: Johns Hopkins leads the Centennial Conference in scoring offense (47.4 ppg), total offense (535.5 ypg.), passing yards per game (341.2 ypg.) and rushing offense (194.2). The Blue Jays are also first in third-down percentage (.500) and first downs per game (26.0).

Among the National Leaders: Entering this week's game against Juniata, Johns Hopkins ranks third in the nation in total offense (535.5), fifth in passing offense (341.2) and fifth in scoring offense (47.4). The Blue Jays also rank 10th in third-down percentage (.500) and the 208 first downs JHU has accumulated are the seventh most of any team in the nation.

Margraff Holds State Record: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** became the winningest college football coach in Maryland state history with a 42-14 win at Ursinus late in the 2014 season as that gave him 175 career victories, a mark he upped to 216 with last week's win against Muhlenberg.

Margraff now sports a career record of 216-88-3 (.708) entering this week's Centennial Conference game at Juniata.

Walters Scores 51st Career Touchdown: Senior running back **Stuart Walters** tied the Johns Hopkins record for career touchdowns with his 51st in last week's 27-16 win over Muhlenberg. He pulled even with **Andrew Kase** (2006-09) atop the JHU career touchdowns list and is also now tied for third in Centennial Conference history.

PK Enters the Record Book - Part I: Junior defensive back **Patrick Kelly** intercepted a Gettysburg pass on the last play of the game and returned it 90 yards before being tackled. The 90-yard interception return is the longest in school history - 10 yards longer than **Les Matthews'** 80-yard return against then Western Maryland (McDaniel) on November 18, 1972.

PK Enters the Record Book - Part II: Not only did **Patrick Kelly** set a Johns Hopkins record with a 90-yard interception return at Gettysburg, he also become the first player in school history with two different types of 90+ yard plays. Kelly had a 95-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Gettysburg last season and added the 90-yard INT return this season.

The only other player in school history with two 90-yard plays is **Harrison Bernstein**, who had kickoff returns of 95 and 92 yards during his career from 1996-99.

Record-Tying: Johns Hopkins rolled up 665 yards of total offense in the 52-6 win over Ursinus. That ranks as the fourth-best single-game total in school history and ties the school record for most 600-yard games in one season (3 / 680 @ Moravian, 606 vs. Randolph-Macon). JHU also had three 600-yard games in 2017.

Six in 132, Six in 19: In the first 132 seasons of Johns Hopkins football, the Blue Jays had six games of 600+ yards of total offense. In the last 19 games, the Blue Jays have topped the 600-yard mark six times.

A Program First, Twice: The Blue Jays rolled up 428 yards passing and 252 yards rushing in the win at Moravian. That marked the first time in school history that the Blue Jays have totaled more than 400 yards passing and 250 yards rushing in the same game.

So, after never having turned the 400/250 trick in 133 seasons (plus two games), the Blue Jays did it twice in three weeks as they followed up the effort at Moravian with a 405-yard passing, 262-yard rushing performance against Ursinus.

Amazingly, only once prior to this had JHU had even 250+ rushing yards and 350+ passing yards in one game (vs. Juniata in 2017).

Second-Best Quarter, Half Totals: The 33 points Johns Hopkins scored in the second quarter and the 46 points the Blue Jays rolled up in the first half against Dickinson are the second best totals in a quarter and half in school history.

That's a Record: JHU led Dickinson 46-0 at the half on September 22. The 46-point halftime margin is the largest in school history. Previously, the largest lead the Blue Jays held at halftime was 42 (49-7 lead at McDaniel in 2017).

Big Plays: Through eight games, the Johns Hopkins offense has 60 plays of 20 yards or longer (an average of 7.5 such plays per game) and 161 plays of 10 yards or longer (20.1 such plays per game). Note that this includes offensive plays only (rushing and passing plays).

Defense Fuels Win Over Muhlenberg: The Johns Hopkins defense forced six turnovers and totaled three sacks and 11 pass breakups to fuel the victory over Muhlenberg. The Blue Jays last forced six or more turnovers in 2010 and the 11 pass breakups are the most by Johns Hopkins since the Jays had 11 in a win against McDaniel in 2005. Hopkins held the Mules 21 points and more than 120 yards below their season averages entering the game.

It's Been a While: The three points the Blue Jays allowed at Moravian are the fewest points Johns Hopkins has allowed in a road game since October 13, 2012, when JHU topped Dickinson, 49-0.

Seven or Less Under Rehiring: Since **Mickey Rehiring** took over as the Blue Jay defensive coordinator in 2013, Johns Hopkins has held the opposition to seven points or less 14 times - including the three-point performance by Moravian on September 15 and the six-point effort by Ursinus a week later.

65 in 6: After allowing an average of 34 points per game in the first two games, the Blue Jay defense has worked its way into form and has allowed a total of just 65 points in the last six games - all Blue Jay victories.

The 65 points Johns Hopkins has allowed over the last six games are the fewest in a six-game span since the Blue Jays allowed just 44 in the first six games of the 2011 season.

Sack Party: The Johns Hopkins defense has totaled 24 sacks on the year, including 14 in the last three games. With six sacks at Franklin & Marshall and five at Gettysburg, the Blue Jays had five or more sacks in back-to-back games for the first time since notching six against Randolph-Macon and five against Susquehanna early in the 2012 season.

Block Party: Freshman **Robert Fletcher** needed exactly three minutes to impact the first game of his career as he blocked a Randolph-Macon punt that was returned 32 yards for a touchdown by senior **Tyler Messinger**. The blocked punt return for a touchdown was the first for Johns Hopkins since **Adam Schweyer** took one back 36 yards for a score against Juniata on October 30, 2010.

Fletcher was back at it against Dickinson as he partially blocked a first-quarter Red Devil punt that led to a Johns Hopkins touchdown and also got a piece of Franklin & Marshall's first punt to give him three blocks on the year; he is tied for sixth in the nation with his three blocked kicks.

Pick Six: Sophomore **Macauley Kilbane** scored the second of four, fourth-quarter touchdowns for the Blue Jays in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon as he returned an interception 34 yards for a score with 13:20 remaining.

The interception return for a score was the first for the Blue Jays since **Dan Johnson's** 23-yard return for a touchdown against F&M on November 7, 2013.

Because You'll Ask - Part I: For the record, the last time Johns Hopkins scored a touchdown on offense, defense and special teams - prior to turning the trick in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon - was on November 10, 2007, when **Richard Hill** returned the opening kickoff 90 yards for a touchdown, **Adam Winter** returned an interception 12 yards for a score and the Blue Jay offense scored a pair of touchdowns in a 31-3 win at McDaniel.

Series History

Johns Hopkins and Juniata are meeting for just the 13th time in a series that dates back to 1929. JHU holds an 11-1 advantage in the series and has won all 11 meetings since the Eagles joined the Centennial Conference in 2007.

Juniata won the first meeting, 7-0, on October 5, 1929 at Homewood Field, but the teams wouldn't meet again in the 20th century.

Nearly 80 years later, the Blue Jays picked up a 42-21 victory late in the 2007 season to even the series at one win apiece. A year later, in Juniata's first trip to Homewood Field as a member of the Centennial Conference, the Blue Jays led just 6-0 late in the fourth quarter before **Andrew Kase** ripped off a 46-yard touchdown run to seal the win.

Since that 12-point win in 2008, the Blue Jays have won decisively in all nine meetings. Hopkins has outscored the Eagles 451-87 in the last nine meetings, including a 57-14 victory last season at Homewood Field.

Because You'll Ask - Part II: With the three returns for touchdowns this season (FR, INT, Blocked PR), Johns Hopkins has now scored 49 touchdowns on returns since head coach **Jim Margraff** took over in 1990 (see chart to right for complete list).

Record-Tying: Senior punter **Brandon Hong-Dominguez** tied the Johns Hopkins record for the longest punt in school history with a 75-yard bomb late in the fourth quarter against Dickinson. It is just the fifth 70+ yard punt in school history and tied **Ben Scott's** school record (vs. Rochester / 2005).

At Home at Homewood: Johns Hopkins has parlayed its home field advantage into victories in recent years. In fact, the Blue Jays are 47-5 (.904) in the home blacks since the start of the 2010 season.

More Homewood: Including the 27-16 win against Muhlenberg, Johns Hopkins has now won 42 straight regular season home games. The Blue Jays last dropped a home game in the regular season on October 2, 2010 when Muhlenberg topped JHU, 30-27.

Number Four: Johns Hopkins boasts a 59-7 record since the start of the 2013 season. The Blue Jays' .894 winning percentage over that time ranks fourth among Division III teams. 61 Under to 61 Over: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** inherited a program with an all-time record that was 61 games **UNDER** .500 when he arrived (334-395-56). With the win against Juniata on November 4, 2017, Johns Hopkins moved its all-time record to 61 games **OVER** .500. Entering this week's game against Juniata, Johns Hopkins has an all-time record of 550-483-59 (+67).

Centennial Conference Champions: Johns Hopkins claimed its record 13th Centennial Conference title last season with all 13 championships coming since 2002. JHU's 13 CC titles are four more than Dickinson and Muhlenberg have accumulated.

Close Calls: Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of seven games. Those seven losses have come by five, three, five, seven, four, three and two points (including playoff games). Translation ... JHU has lost seven games in 5+ seasons by a total of 29 points.

On a Roll: Johns Hopkins is 79-3 in its last 82 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season and 83-10 in its last 93 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

Sustained Success: Since the start of the 2002 season, the Blue Jays sport a 150-38 (.798) record. Taking it back farther, the Blue Jays are 156-41 (.792) since the start of the 2001 season and 161-46 (.778) since the beginning of the 2000 season.
