... Johns Hopkins would improve to 41-5 since the current senior class arrived in 2015.

... The Blue Jays would improve to 86-10 in their last 96 games dating back to the 2010 season.

... JHU would advance to the second round of the NCAA Playoffs for the sixth time in school history (2009, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016).

... The Blue Jays would secure the ninth 10-win season in school history (2003, 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016).

The Game: Johns Hopkins (9-1) opens play in the 2018 NCAA Division III Football Playoffs by welcoming MIT (9-1) to Homewood Field.

A Look Back: Johns Hopkins made it eight straight in the win column as the Blue Jays topped rival McDaniel, 42-17, in their final regular season game last Saturday.

Poll Position: Johns Hopkins is ranked 13th in this week's AFCA Division III Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, Johns Hopkins has now appeared in the top 25 of the AFCA Poll 77 times in 79 weeks.

In addition to the #13 ranking from the AFCA, Johns Hopkins is also ranked 14th in this week's D3football.com Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, the Blue Jays have now appeared in the top 25 of the D3football.com poll 82 times in 90 weeks.

Johns Hopkins is also ranked second in the official NCAA South Region rankings this week.

Oh Captain, My Captain: Johns Hopkins will be led this season by co-captains **Michael Curry**, **Mike Kalanik**, **Luke McFadden** and **Addison Quinones**.

State of Affairs: The 96-man Johns Hopkins football team includes players from 22 different states.

Scouting the Engineers

MIT Quickly: MIT comes to Homewood Field having won two straight and fresh off a 22-7 win against Springfield that locked up the NEWMAC Championship.

Goyal Directs Offense: Senior QB **Udgam Goyal** directs the Engineer offense, which enters this week's game averaging 23.1 points and 301 yards per game.

Goyal has thrown for 1,636 yards and 18 touchdowns on the year and is the team's second-leading rusher with 282 yards.

Goyal has four strong targets in the passing game in **Eddy Garcia-Montes** (42-414-3), **Keithen Shepard** (37-490-6), **Eric Bradford** (27-295-3) and **Jack Montinaro** (21-282-3). They've combined for 127 of the team's 139 receptions and 15 of 18 TDs through the air.

Miguel Wagner leads the rushing attack with 492 yards and five scores despite not playing in the last three games.

Defense Wins Championships: The defense MIT will bring to Homewood Field this week is among the nation's best. The Engineers are allowing just 10.6 points and 242.8 yards per game; only three teams have gotten to 300 yards on them - and none of those have been since September. MIT has allowed exactly 20 points ... in its last five games combined.

The opportunistic Engineer defense, which counts 75 tackles for losses, 23 sacks and 23 forced turnovers, is led by **Andrew DeNucci**, who has a team-high 55 tackles on the year from his spot at linebacker.

Defensive end **Ben Wolz** is one of eight players with five or more TLFs on the year as he has a team-high 11.5 among his 47 stops. In addition to he and DeNucci, six other players have at least 40 tackles on the year.

Notes of Interest: The opposition is averaging just 2.3 yards per rushing attempt against the Engineers • The MIT offensive line has allowed just two sacks in more than 240 pass attempts on the year.

How They Got Here: Johns Hopkins earned the Centennial Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs (a Pool A bid), while MIT earned a Pool B bid. The lone Pool B bid available in the tournament is for independents and teams from leagues that do not qualify for an automatic bid.

Playoff Bound: Johns Hopkins is making its eighth straight trip to the NAAs, its ninth in 10 years and 10th overall. All 10 appearances have come since 2005.

Third Longest Streak: Johns Hopkins' eight consecutive appearances in the tournament rank as the third-longest active streak in the nation. Only Mount Union (27) and Mary Hardin-Baylor (17) have currently made more consecutive appearances than Johns Hopkins.

What's Next: The winner of the Johns Hopkins-MIT first round game will play the winner of the first round game between Frostburg St. and Western New England. That second round game will be played on Saturday, November 24 (noon). The location will be announced on Sunday, November 18.

Centennial Conference Champions: Johns Hopkins claimed its record 14th Centennial Conference title this season with all 14 championships coming since 2002. JHU's 14 CC titles are four more than Muhlenberg, which shared the title with the Blue Jays this season.

Eight in a Row: Johns Hopkins ran its winning streak to eight games with last week's 42-17 win against McDaniel.

This marks the eighth time since **Jim Margraff** took over as the head coach at Johns Hopkins (1990) that the Blue Jays have had a winning streak of eight games or longer. Prior to Margraff's arrival, Johns Hopkins had never won eight games in a row (in one season or even bridging two seasons).

477 is 3rd .. and 1st: Johns Hopkins has scored 477 points entering this week's game against MIT. The 477 points rank as the third-highest single-season total in school history and the most ever in the regular season.

Among the National Leaders: Entering this week's game against MIT, Johns Hopkins ranks second in the nation in total offense (549.2), fourth in passing offense (349.8) and fifth in scoring offense (47.7). The Blue Jays also rank fifth in third-down percentage (.523) and the 266 first downs JHU has accumulated are the fifth most of any team in the nation.

Six in 132, Seven in 21: In the first 132 seasons of Johns Hopkins football, the Blue Jays had six games of 600+ yards of total offense. In the last

All-Centennial Jays

The Johns Hopkins football team was well represented on the 2018 All-Centennial Football Team, which was announced on November 13. The Blue Jays placed 14 players on the team, including nine first team picks, three second team selections and a pair of honorable mention honorees.

In addition, junior quarterback **David Tammamro** was named the Centennial Offensive Player of the Year and freshman linebacker **Robert Fletcher** grabbed Rookie of the Year honors.

21 games, the Blue Jays have topped the 600-yard mark seven times.

Record-Breaking: Johns Hopkins rolled up 692 yards of total offense in the 56-0 win at Juniata earlier this season. That ranks as the second-highest single-game total in school history and the Blue Jays' school-record-breaking fourth 600-yard game of the season (665 vs. Ursinus, 680 @ Moravian, 606 vs. Randolph-Macon). The previous school record for 600-yard games was three in 2017.

Third-Best Passing Day: Junior **David Tammamro** (305 yards) and sophomore **Nick Leongas** (190) combined to throw for 495 yards in the win at Juniata. The 495-yard passing total ranks third in school history - surpassed only by a 545-yard effort at Gettysburg in 2011 and a 527-yard showing against Georgetown in 1991.

A Program First, Twice: The Blue Jays rolled up 428 yards passing and 252 yards rushing in the win at Moravian. That marked the first time in school history that the Blue Jays have totaled more than 400 yards passing and 250 yards rushing in the same game.

Margraff Holds State Record: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** became the winningest college football coach in Maryland state history with a 42-14 win at Ursinus late in the 2014 season as that gave him 175 career victories, a mark he upped to 218 with last week's win against McDaniel.

Margraff now sports a career record of 218-88-3 (.710) entering this week's NCAA First Round game against MIT.

So, after never having turned the 400/250 trick in 133 seasons (plus two games), the Blue Jays did it twice in three weeks as they followed up the effort at Moravian with a 405-yard passing, 262-yard rushing performance against Ursinus.

Amazingly, only once prior to this had JHU had even 250+ rushing yards and 350+ passing yards in one game (vs. Juniata in 2017).

Second-Best Quarter, Half Totals: The 33 points Johns Hopkins scored in the second quarter and the 46 points the Blue Jays rolled up in the first half against Dickinson are the second best totals in a quarter and half in school history.

That's a Record: JHU led Dickinson 46-0 at the half on September 22. The 46-point halftime margin is the largest in school history. Previously, the largest lead the Blue Jays held at halftime was 42 (49-7 lead at McDaniel in 2017).

A Special Senior Class

This year's senior class will go down as one of the most accomplished in program history. Below is a look at some of their collective team achievements since arriving in 2015:

- JHU has won four Centennial Conference titles and appeared in the NCAA Playoffs in each of their four seasons.



- The Blue Jays have compiled a record of 40-5 since the current seniors arrived. The 40 wins are the fifth-most in school history by one class.

- Johns Hopkins posted a 38-2 regular season record since the start of the 2015 season.

- The Blue Jays did not lose a regular season home game during their career.

Big Plays: Through 10 games, the Johns Hopkins offense has 78 plays of 20 yards or longer (an average of 7.8 such plays per game) and 208 plays of 10 yards or longer (20.8 such plays per game). Note that this includes offensive plays only (rushing and passing plays).

It's Been a While - Part I: The shutout for the Blue Jays in the 56-0 win at Juniata on November 3 was the first road shutout for Johns Hopkins since October 13, 2012, when JHU topped Dickinson, 49-0.

It's Been a While - Part II: The 56-0 win at Juniata was JHU's largest shutout victory since September 19, 1997, when the Blue Jays topped Swarthmore 73-0.

Seven or Less Under Rehring: Since **Mickey Rehring** took over as the Blue Jay defensive coordinator in 2013, Johns Hopkins has held the opposition to seven points or less 15 times - including the three-point performance by Moravian on September 15, the six-point effort by Ursinus a week later and the shutout at Juniata on November 3.

82 in 8: After allowing an average of 34 points per game in the first two games, the Blue Jay defense has worked its way into form and has allowed a total of just 82 points in the last eight games - all Blue Jay victories.

Defense Fuels Win Over Muhlenberg: The Johns Hopkins defense forced six turnovers and totaled three sacks and 11 pass breakups to fuel the 27-16 victory over 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg. The Blue Jays last forced six or more turnovers in 2010 and the 11 pass breakups are the most by Johns Hopkins since the Jays had 11 in a win against McDaniel in 2005. Hopkins held the Mules 21 points and more than 120 yards below their season averages entering the game.

Sack Party: The Johns Hopkins defense has totaled 34 sacks on the year, including 24 in the last five games. With six sacks at Franklin & Marshall and five at Gettysburg, the Blue Jays had five or more sacks in back-to-back games for the first time since notching six against Randolph-Macon and five against Susquehanna early in the 2012 season. The Blue Jays added three in the win against Muhlenberg, six at Juniata and four against McDaniel.

Walters Breaks TD Record: Senior running back **Stuart Walters** tied the Johns Hopkins record for career touchdowns with his 51st in the 27-16 win over Muhlenberg and took the top spot to himself with three in the regular-season-ending win against McDaniel. His three TDs against McDaniel, which all came on the ground, also tied him with **Andrew Kase** (2006-09) atop the JHU career rushing touchdowns list (44).

PK Enters the Record Book - Part I: Junior defensive back **Patrick Kelly** intercepted a Gettysburg pass on the last play of the game and returned it 90 yards before being tackled. The 90-yard interception return is the longest in school history - 10 yards longer than **Les Matthews'** 80-yard return against then Western Maryland (McDaniel) on November 18, 1972.

PK Enters the Record Book - Part II: Not only did **Patrick Kelly** set a Johns Hopkins record with a 90-yard interception return at Gettysburg, he also became the first player in school history with two different types of 90+ yard plays. Kelly had a 95-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Gettysburg last season and added the 90-yard INT return this season.

The only other player in school history with two 90-yard plays is **Harrison Bernstein**, who had kickoff returns of 95 and 92 yards during his career from 1996-99.

Block Party: Freshman **Robert Fletcher** needed exactly three minutes to impact the first game of his career as he blocked a Randolph-Macon punt that was returned 32 yards for a touchdown by senior **Tyler Messinger**. The blocked punt return for a touchdown was the first for Johns Hopkins since **Adam Schweyer** took one back 36 yards for a score against Juniata on October 30, 2010.

Fletcher was back at it against Dickinson as he partially blocked a first-quarter Red Devil punt that led to a Johns Hopkins touchdown and also got a piece of Franklin & Marshall's first punt to give him three blocks on the year; he is tied for 11th in the nation with his three blocked kicks.

More Blocks: Johns Hopkins has blocked a total of seven kicks on the year. That ties the Blue Jays for 14th in the nation entering this week's game against MIT.

Pick Six: Sophomore **Macauley Kilbane** scored the second of four, fourth-quarter touchdowns for the Blue Jays in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon as he returned an interception 34 yards for a score with 13:20 remaining.

The interception return for a score was the first for the Blue Jays since **Dan Johnson's** 23-yard return for a touchdown against F&M on November 7, 2013.

Because You'll Ask - Part I: For the record, the last time Johns Hopkins scored a touchdown on offense, defense and special teams - prior to turning the trick in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon - was on November 10, 2007, when **Richard Hill** returned the opening kickoff 90 yards for a touchdown, **Adam Winter** returned an interception 12 yards for a score and the Blue Jay offense scored a pair of touchdowns in a 31-3 win at McDaniel.

Because You'll Ask - Part II: With the three returns for touchdowns this season (FR, INT, Blocked PR), Johns Hopkins has now scored 49 touchdowns on returns since head coach **Jim Margraff** took over in 1990 (see chart to right for complete list).

Record-Tying: Senior punter **Brandon Hong-Dominguez** tied the Johns Hopkins record for the longest punt in school history with a 75-yard bomb late in the fourth quarter against Dickinson. It is just the fifth 70+ yard punt in school history and tied **Ben Scott's** school record (vs. Rochester / 2005).

At Home at Homewood: Johns Hopkins has parlayed its home field advantage into victories in recent years. In fact, the Blue Jays are 48-5 (.906) in the home blacks since the start of the 2010 season.

More Homewood: Including the 42-17 win against McDaniel, Johns Hopkins has now won 43 straight regular season home games. The Blue Jays last dropped a home game in the regular season on October 2, 2010 when Muhlenberg topped JHU, 30-27.

Number Four: Johns Hopkins boasts a 61-7 record since the start of the 2013 season. The Blue Jays' .897 winning percentage over that time ranks fourth among Division III teams. 61 Under to 61 Over: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** inherited a program with an all-time record that was 61 games **UNDER** .500 when he arrived (334-395-56). With the win against Juniata on November 4, 2017, Johns Hopkins moved its all-time record to 61 games **OVER** .500. Entering this week's game against MIT, Johns Hopkins has an all-time record of 552-483-59 (+69).

Close Calls: Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of seven games. Those seven losses have come by five, three, five, seven, four, three and two points (including playoff games). Translation ... JHU has lost seven games in 5+ seasons by a total of 29 points.

On a Roll: Johns Hopkins is 81-3 in its last 84 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season and 85-10 in its last 95 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

Sustained Success: Since the start of the 2002 season, the Blue Jays sport a 152-38 (.800) record. Taking it back farther, the Blue Jays are 158-41 (.794) since the start of the 2001 season and 163-46 (.780) since the beginning of the 2000 season.
