With a Victory ...

... Johns Hopkins would improve to 42-5 since the current senior class arrived in 2015.

... The Blue Jays would improve to 87-10 in their last 97 games dating back to the 2010 season.

... JHU would advance to the quarterfinal round of the NCAA Playoffs for the second time in school history (2009).

... The Blue Jays would secure the fourth 11-win season in school history (2014, 2015, 2016).

The Game: Johns Hopkins (10-1) heads to Frostburg St. (10-0) for the second round of the 2018 NCAA Division III Playoffs. Kickoff at Bobcat Stadium is set for 12 pm on Saturday, November 24.

A Look Back: Johns Hopkins made it nine straight in the win column as the Blue Jays topped MIT, 49-0, in the first round of the NCAA Playoffs last Saturday at Homewood Field.

Poll Position: Johns Hopkins is ranked 13th in the AFCA Division III Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, Johns Hopkins has now appeared in the top 25 of the AFCA Poll 77 times in 79 weeks.

In addition to the #13 ranking from the AFCA, Johns Hopkins is also ranked 14th in the D3football.com Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, the Blue Jays have now appeared in the top 25 of the D3football.com poll 82 times in 90 weeks.

Johns Hopkins also ranked second in the final official NCAA South Region rankings.

Oh Captain, My Captain: Johns Hopkins will be led this season by co-captains **Michael Curry**, **Mike Kalanik**, **Luke McFadden** and **Addison Quinones**.

State of Affairs: The 96-man Johns Hopkins football team includes players from 22 different states.

Scouting the Bobcats

Frostburg Quickly: Frostburg welcomes Johns Hopkins to Bobcat Stadium fresh off a 42-24 win over Western New England in the first round of the NCAA Playoffs. FSU is 10-0 on the year ... this is the first 10-0 start in school history.

Home Sweet Home: The Bobcats are 5-0 at home this season and 15-1 at Bobcat Stadium over the last three seasons. The only loss for FSU at home over that time was a 27-24 loss in overtime to Wesley in 2017.

Balanced, Explosive on Offense: The Blue Jay defense will face the most balanced and explosive offense it has seen all year this week at Frostburg. FSU is averaging 42.1 points and 431.5 yards per game.

Quarterback **Connor Cox** directs the attack as he has thrown for 2,268 yards and 26 touchdowns against just three interceptions. He has also rushed for 220 yards and seven more scores.

There is no shortage of capable targets for Cox to throw to; **Malik Morris** is the home run threat as he is averaging 24.0 yards per reception (42-1,009-9).

A rushing game that is averaging 195 yards per game is led by **Jamaal Morant**, whose 796 yards and eight TDs lead the way.

Rugged, Opportunistic on Defense: The only thing tougher than the offense the Blue Jays face this weekend might be the defense. Frostburg is allowing just 14.4 points and 252.0 yards per game; the opposition is averaging just 3.1 yards per rushing attempt and has converted just 26% of its third-down chances.

Dre'Quan Reed leads the team in tackles (63), while **Zach Strand** has team-highs of 13.5 tackles for losses and 6.0 sacks. The Bobcats are averaging 9.3 tackles for loss per game, have 37 sacks on the year and have forced 25 turnovers.

Notes of Interest: FSU has outscored the opposition 265-74 in the first half • The Bobcats have scored at least 34 points nine times.

How They Got Here: Johns Hopkins earned the Centennial Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs (a Pool A bid) and advanced to the second round with last week's 49-0 win over MIT.

Frostburg earned the New Jersey Athletic Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs (also a Pool A bid) and topped Western New England, 42-24, in the first round.

Did You Know: Johns Hopkins was 2-0 in the regular season against teams still alive in the 2018 NCAA Division III Football Playoffs (wins against Randolph-Macon & Muhlenberg). The other 15 teams still alive combined for exactly two regular season wins against teams still alive in the playoffs.

Playoff Bound: Johns Hopkins is making its eighth straight trip to the NAAs, its ninth in 10 years and 10th overall. All 10 appearances have come since 2005.

Back Where it Began: Saturday's game at Frostburg St. will be played 16 years and one day to the date of the last time Johns Hopkins and Frostburg last met. The significance of that game? The game was the first post-season game in Johns Hopkins football history. The Blue Jays topped the Bobcats, 24-21, on November 23, 2002 in the ECAC South-west Championship game.

That was the first of 21 post-season games to date in Johns Hopkins history. The Blue Jays are 11-10 overall in the post-season, including 7-9 in the NCAA Playoffs and 4-1 in ECAC Bowl Games.

Third Longest Streak: Johns Hopkins' eight consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament rank as the third-longest active streak in the nation. Only Mount Union (27) and Mary Hardin-Baylor (17) have currently made more consecutive appearances than Johns Hopkins.

What's Next: The winner of the Johns Hopkins-Frostburg St. second round game will play the winner of the second round game between Brockport and RPI. That quarterfinal game will be played on Saturday, December 1 (noon). The location will be announced on Sunday, November 25.

Centennial Conference Champions: Johns Hopkins claimed its record 14th Centennial Conference title this season with all 14 championships coming since 2002. JHU's 14 CC titles are four more than Muhlenberg, which shared the title with the Blue Jays this season, has earned.

Nine in a Row: Johns Hopkins ran its winning streak to nine games with last week's 49-0 win against MIT.

This marks the eighth time since **Jim Margraff** took over as the head coach at Johns Hopkins (1990) that the Blue Jays have had a winning streak of nine games or longer. Prior to Margraff's arrival, Johns Hopkins had never won more than seven

All-Centennial Jays

The Johns Hopkins football team was well represented on the 2018 All-Centennial Football Team, which was announced on November 13. The Blue Jays placed 14 players on the team, including nine first team picks, three second team selections and a pair of honorable mention honorees

In addition, junior quarterback **David Tammaro** was named the Centennial Offensive Player of the Year and freshman linebacker **Robert Fletcher** grabbed Rookie of the Year honors.

Blue Jays Top 500: Johns Hopkins' 49-point outburst against MIT last week pushed the Blue Jays' season scoring total to 526 points, a mark that ranks second in school history. The Blue Jays scored a school-record 548 points in 2015 (12 games) to account for the only other season in school history in which Johns Hopkins has scored 500 or more points.

Margraff Holds State Record: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** became the winningest college football coach in Maryland state history with a 42-14 win at Ursinus late in the 2014 season as that gave him 175 career victories, a mark he upped to 219 with last week's win against MIT.

Margraff now sports a career record of 219-88-3 (.711) entering this week's NCAA Second Round game against Frostburg St.

ranked first in the nation in total offense (560.8), fourth in passing offense (354.1) and sixth in scoring offense (47.8). The Blue Jays also rank fourth in third-down percentage (.529) and the 296 first downs JHU has accumulated are the third most of any team in the nation.

Six in 132, Eight in 22:

In the first 132 seasons of Johns Hopkins football, the Blue Jays had six games of 600+ yards of total offense. In the last 22 games, the Blue Jays have topped the 600-yard mark eight times.

Record-Breaking: Johns Hopkins extended its school single-season record of 600-yard games to five with a 677-yard outburst against MIT in the first round of the NCAA Playoffs. The Blue Jays had never previously had more than three 600-yard games in one season prior to this year.

Below is a look at JHU's five 600-yard games this season and where those totals rank on the school single-game total offense chart:

A Special Senior Class

This year's senior class will go down as one of the most accomplished in program history. Below is a look at some of their collective team achievements since arriving in 2015:

- JHU has won four Centennial Conference titles and appeared in the NCAA Playoffs in each of their four seasons.



- The Blue Jays have compiled a record of 41-5 since the current seniors arrived. The 41 wins are tied for the fourth-most in school history by one class.

- Johns Hopkins posted a 38-2 regular season record since the start of the 2015 season.

- The Blue Jays did not lose a regular season home game during their career.

Second-Best Passing Season: Johns Hopkins quarterbacks have combined to throw for 3,895 yards in 11 games this season. The 3,895 yards rank as the second-highest single-season total in school history and put the Blue Jays within striking distance of the record of 4,106, which was set in 12 games in 2016. JHU enters this week's game at Frostburg St. needing 212 yards to break the record.

Blue Jays Tie Touchdown Record: Johns Hopkins' seven touchdowns in last week's 49-0 win against MIT boost the Jays' total number of touchdowns on the year to 75. That ties the school single-season record for touchdowns - the 2015 team also scored 75.

Balanced Scoring: Johns Hopkins' 75 touchdowns this season are split nearly even as the Blue Jays count 37 rushing touchdowns and 35 passing touchdowns on the year (JHU also scored once each on a blocked punt return, interception and fumble return). Only once previously (2015) has JHU scored 35 or more touchdowns on the ground and through the air (the 2015 team had 38 rushing TDs and 36 passing TDs).

More, Firsts and Records: In addition to the records noted above, the Blue Jays have left a mark in a number of other places in the record book. Below are several additional notes of interest about the Blue Jay offense:

- The Blue Jays rolled up 428 yards passing and 252 yards rushing in the win at Moravian. That marked the first time in school history that the Blue Jays have totaled more than 400 yards passing and 250 yards rushing in the same game. After never having turned the 400/250 trick in 133 seasons (plus two games), the Blue Jays did it twice in three weeks as they followed up the effort at Moravian with a 405-yard passing, 262-yard rushing performance against Ursinus.

- The 33 points Johns Hopkins scored in the second quarter and the 46 points the Blue Jays rolled up in the first half against Dickinson are the second best totals in a quarter and half in school history.

- JHU led Dickinson 46-0 at the half on September 22. The 46-point halftime margin is the largest in school history. Previously, the largest lead the Blue Jays held at halftime was 42 (49-7 lead at McDaniel in 2017).

- Johns Hopkins has scored 40 or more points nine times this season; that ties the school record for most 40-point games in a season (2016).

Big Plays: Through 11 games, the Johns Hopkins offense has 89 plays of 20 yards or longer (an average of 8.1 such plays per game) and 230 plays of 10 yards or longer (20.9 such plays per game). Note that this includes offensive plays only (rushing and passing plays).

It's Been a While - Part I: The shutout for the Blue Jays in the 56-0 win at Juniata on November 3 was the first road shutout for Johns Hopkins since October 13, 2012, when JHU topped Dickinson, 49-0.

It's Been a While - Part II: The 56-0 win at Juniata was JHU's largest shutout victory since September 19, 1997, when the Blue Jays topped Swarthmore 73-0.

Twice in Three Weeks: Johns Hopkins notched its second shutout of the season with the 49-0 win against MIT in the first round of the NCAA Playoffs. That gives the Blue Jays two shutouts in the same season for the first time since 2011.

Seven or Less Under Rehiring: Since **Mickey Rehiring** took over as the Blue Jay defensive coordinator in 2013, Johns Hopkins has held the opposition to seven points or less 16 times - including the three-point performance by Moravian on September 15, the six-point effort by Ursinus a week later, the shutout at Juniata on November 3 and the shutout against MIT last week.

82 in 9: After allowing an average of 34 points per game in the first two games, the Blue Jay defense has worked its way into form and has allowed a total of just 82 points in the last nine games - all Blue Jay victories.

Defense Fuels Win Over Muhlenberg: The Johns Hopkins defense forced six turnovers and totaled three sacks and 11 pass breakups to fuel the 27-16 victory over 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg. The Blue Jays last forced six or more turnovers in 2010 and the 11 pass breakups are the most by Johns Hopkins since the Jays had 11 in a win against McDaniel in 2005. Hopkins held the Mules 21 points and more than 120 yards below their season averages entering the game.

Sack Party: The Johns Hopkins defense has totaled 35 sacks on the year, including 25 in the last six games. With six sacks at Franklin & Marshall and five at Gettysburg, the Blue Jays had five or more sacks in back-to-back games for the first time since notching six against Randolph-Macon and five against Susquehanna early in the 2012 season. The Blue Jays added three in the win against Muhlenberg, six at Juniata, four against McDaniel and one against MIT.

Walters Breaks TD Records: Senior running back **Stuart Walters** tied the Johns Hopkins record for career touchdowns with his 51st in the 27-16 win over Muhlenberg and took the top spot to himself with three in the regular-season-ending win against McDaniel. He added one rushing touchdown against MIT to take over the top spot on JHU's career rushing touchdowns list as well (45).

PK Enters the Record Book - Part I: Junior defensive back **Patrick Kelly** intercepted a Gettysburg pass on the last play of the game and returned it 90 yards before being tackled. The 90-yard interception return is the longest in school history - 10 yards longer than **Les Matthews'** 80-yard return against then Western Maryland (McDaniel) on November 18, 1972.

PK Enters the Record Book - Part II: Not only did **Patrick Kelly** set a Johns Hopkins record with a 90-yard interception return at Gettysburg, he also became the first player in school history with two different types of 90+ yard plays. Kelly had a 95-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Gettysburg last season and added the 90-yard INT return this season.

The only other player in school history with two 90-yard plays is **Harrison Bernstein**, who had kickoff returns of 95 and 92 yards during his career from 1996-99.

Block Party: Freshman **Robert Fletcher** needed exactly three minutes to impact the first game of his career as he blocked a Randolph-Macon punt that was returned 32 yards for a touchdown by senior **Tyler Messinger**. The blocked punt return for a touchdown was the first for Johns Hopkins since **Adam Schweyer** took one back 36 yards for a score against Juniata on October 30, 2010.

Fletcher was back at it against Dickinson as he partially blocked a first-quarter Red Devil punt that led to a Johns Hopkins touchdown and also got a piece of Franklin & Marshall's first punt to give him three blocks on the year; he is tied for 11th in the nation with his three blocked kicks.

More Blocks: Johns Hopkins has blocked a total of eight kicks on the year. That ties the Blue Jays for sixth in the nation entering this week's game against Frostburg St.

Pick Six: Sophomore **Macauley Kilbane** scored the second of four, fourth-quarter touchdowns for the Blue Jays in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon as he returned an interception 34 yards for a score with 13:20 remaining.

The interception return for a score was the first for the Blue Jays since **Dan Johnson's** 23-yard return for a touchdown against F&M on November 7, 2013.

Because You'll Ask - Part I: For the record, the last time Johns Hopkins scored a touchdown on offense, defense and special teams - prior to turning the trick in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon - was on November 10, 2007, when **Richard Hill** returned the opening kickoff 90 yards for a touchdown, **Adam Winter** returned an interception 12 yards for a score and the Blue Jay offense scored a pair of touchdowns in a 31-3 win at McDaniel.

Because You'll Ask - Part II: With the three returns for touchdowns this season (FR, INT, Blocked PR), Johns Hopkins has now scored 49 touchdowns on returns since head coach **Jim Margraff** took over in 1990 (see chart to right for complete list).

Record-Tying: Senior punter **Brandon Hong-Dominguez** tied the Johns Hopkins record for the longest punt in school history with a 75-yard bomb late in the fourth quarter against Dickinson. It is just the fifth 70+ yard punt in school history and tied **Ben Scott's** school record (vs. Rochester / 2005).

At Home at Homewood: Johns Hopkins has parlayed its home field advantage into victories in recent years. In fact, the Blue Jays are 49-5 (.907) in the home blacks since the start of the 2010 season.

Number Four: Johns Hopkins boasts a 62-7 record since the start of the 2013 season. The Blue Jays' .899 winning percentage over that time ranks fourth among Division III teams. In order, the top five teams in the nation in winning percentage since the start of the 2013 season (with records included):

61 Under to 61 Over: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** inherited a program with an all-time record that was 61 games **UNDER** .500 when he arrived (334-395-56). With the win against Juniata on November 4, 2017, Johns Hopkins moved its all-time record to 61 games **OVER** .500. Entering this week's game against Frostburg St., Johns Hopkins has an all-time record of 553-483-59 (+70).

Close Calls: Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of seven games. Those seven losses have come by five, three, five, seven, four, three and two points (including playoff games). Translation ... JHU has lost seven games in 5+ seasons by a total of 29 points.

On a Roll: Johns Hopkins is 81-3 in its last 84 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season and 86-10 in its last 96 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

Sustained Success: Since the start of the 2002 season, the Blue Jays sport a 153-38 (.801) record. Taking it back farther, the Blue Jays are 159-41 (.795) since the start of the 2001 season and 164-46 (.781) since the beginning of the 2000 season.

It's All Academic

The Johns Hopkins football team dominated the 2018 CoSIDA Academic All-District II Football Team when it was announced on November 15. Johns Hopkins' eight selections were tied for the most in the nation among Division III schools (Carnegie Mellon).

This is the 10th consecutive year that the Johns Hopkins football program has produced six or more Academic All-District selections and pushes the Blue Jays' total to 108 Academic All-District selections in the last 16 years and 134 selections since 1991.

During JHU's current 10-year run at the top of the Centennial Conference the Blue Jays have now produced 79 Academic All-District players.

To be eligible for CoSIDA Academic All-District honors, a student-athlete must have at least a 3.30 cumulative GPA, be a sophomore or above and a starter or significant reserve.
