... Johns Hopkins would improve to 40-5 since the current senior class arrived in 2015.

... Johns Hopkins would improve to 76-5 in the Centennial Conference this decade (since the start of the 2010 season).

... The Blue Jays would improve to 85-10 in their last 95 games dating back to the 2010 season.

... JHU would run its regular season winning streak in the month of November to 15 games dating back to 2012.

The Game: Johns Hopkins (8-1, 7-1 Centennial) closes the regular season by welcoming McDaniel (3-6, 2-6 CC) to Homewood Field.

A Look Back: Johns Hopkins made it seven straight in the win column as the Blue Jays went on the road to beat Juniata, 56-0, in the final road game of the regular season.

Poll Position: Johns Hopkins is 16th in this week's AFCA Division III Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, Johns Hopkins has now appeared in the top 25 of the AFCA Poll 76 times in 78 weeks.

In addition to the #18 ranking from the AFCA, Johns Hopkins is also ranked 16th in this week's D3football.com Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, the Blue Jays have now appeared in the top 25 of the D3football.com poll 81 times in 89 weeks.

Johns Hopkins is also ranked third in the official NCAA South Region rankings this week.

Number 300: The season-opening game against Randolph-Macon was the 300th for **Jim Margraff** as the head coach at Johns Hopkins. Margraff boasts a record of 217-88-3 (.709) since taking over in 1990 and his 217 victories rank second among active Division III coaches.

Oh Captain, My Captain: Johns Hopkins will be led this season by co-captains Michael Curry, Mike Kalanik, Luke McFadden and Addison Quinones.

Scouting the Green Terror

McDaniel Quickly: McDaniel comes to Homewood Field for the regular season finale after dropping a 20-3 decision at home against Susquehanna last Saturday. The Terror are looking to snap a four-game losing streak.

Closer Than You Think: McDaniel's 3-6 overall record could just as easily be flipped to 6-3. The Terror's first three losses of the season were all by seven points or less. In all, four of McDaniel's nine games have been decided by just one score.

Centennial's Top Defense: Johns Hopkins will face perhaps the Centennial's top defensive unit this week. McDaniel ranks in the top four in the league in total defense (3rd/296.9), passing defense (2nd/180.2), rushing defense (4th/116.7) and scoring defense (4th/20.8) - the opposition is also converting just 36.4% of its third-down chances against the Terror, including just 9-of-29 (.310) in the last two weeks.

Linebacker **Jarius Ransom**, a strong candidate for CC Defensive Player of the Year honors, leads the team in tackles (87) and tackles for loss (14.5). He ranks fifth in the league in tackles per game (9.7) and third in TFLs.

Ransom is one of four McDaniel players with 50 or more tackles as **Angelo Payne** (54), **Nah'Shon Godfrey** (52) and **Anthony Crawley** (50) all have at least 50 stops on the year.

Palermiti, Igo Directing Offense: Sophomores Tyler Palermiti and Ben Igo have split time at quarterback this season and have combined to go 108-of-235 (.460) for 1,200 yards and three touchdowns. The top targets include Davon Ingram (30-403-0), Patrick Bartlett (21-132-0) and Breon Herbert (20-201-2).

The Terror feature a strong one-two punch at running back in Isaac Murray (106-583-4) and John Chamberlin (127-491-4), who pace a rushing attack that is averaging nearly 140 yards per game. McDaniel is one of just two teams in the league with two players who have more than 490 rushing yards on the year.

McDaniel is averaging 17.1 points and 270.7 yards per game.

State of Affairs: The 96-man Johns Hopkins football team includes players from 22 different states.

Honoring Our Seniors: This week's game against McDaniel will be the final regular season home game in the careers of the seniors on the 2018 Johns Hopkins football team. This year's senior class will go down as one of the most accomplished in program history. Below is a look at some of their collective team achievements since arriving in 2015:

- JHU has won three Centennial Conference titles and appeared in the NCAA Playoffs in each of their first three seasons.
- The Blue Jays have compiled a record of 39-5 since the current seniors arrived. The 39 wins are the fifth-most in school history by one class.
- Johns Hopkins has posted a 37-2 regular season record since the start of the 2015 season.
- The Blue Jays have not lost a regular season home game during their career.

Seven in a Row: Johns Hopkins ran its winning streak to seven games with last week's 56-0 win at Juniata. This marks the ninth time since Jim Margraff took over as the head coach at Johns Hopkins (1990) that the Blue Jays have won seven games or more in a row. Prior to Margraff's arrival, Johns Hopkins had a total of three, seven-game winning streaks in its history (1882-1989) with the last having occurred in 1959-60.

After the Bye: Last week's game at Juniata was the third for the Blue Jays after the bye week. Since 2011, Johns Hopkins is now 36-1 in regular season games played after its bye week.

November Reign: Johns Hopkins enters this week's game against McDaniel having won 14 consecutive regular season games in the month of November dating back to 2012.

More November: Johns Hopkins is 19-1 in its last 20 regular season home games in the month of November. Since the start of the 2001 season, JHU's only loss at home in the regular season in November came in 2007, when F&M took a 19-11 decision.

The Race for the Boot: The race for the Centennial Conference championship and possession of the championship "boot" enters the final week of the regular season with two teams, Johns Hopkins and Muhlenberg, in contention for at least a share of the title. Below is a look at how things set up for both teams entering this week's games.

Centennial Favorites

For the 10th consecutive year and the 13th time in the last 15 years, Johns Hopkins was selected as the favorite in the Centennial Conference preseason poll of coaches and athletic communications directors.

The Blue Jays received 14 of 20 first-place votes and totaled 158 points to out-distance F&M, which checked in at number two in the poll with five first-place votes and 148 points.

Johns Hopkins (hosts McDaniel) - The Blue Jays earn at least a share of the title and will claim the Centennial's automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs with a win.

Muhlenberg (at Moravian) - The Mules earn at least a share of the title with a win. Muhlenberg grabs the Centennial's automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs with a win and a loss by Johns Hopkins.

What's Next: The recipient of the Centennial Conference's automatic bid to the upcoming NCAA Playoffs will learn its draw when the bracket for the 2018 tournament is announced on Sunday, November 11 (5:30 pm on ncaa.com).

435 is 7th: Johns Hopkins has scored 435 points through nine games - that marks the most points the Blue Jays have ever scored in a nine-game span in school history.

In fact, the 435 points the Blue Jays have scored this season are already the seventh-highest single-season total in school history.

Chart Toppers: Johns Hopkins leads the Centennial Conference in scoring offense (48.3 ppg), total offense (552.9 ypg.), passing yards per game (358.3 ypg.) and rushing offense (194.6). The Blue Jays are also first in third-down percentage (.513) and first downs per game (27.0).

Among the National Leaders: Entering this week's game against McDaniel, Johns Hopkins ranks second in the nation in total offense (552.9), fourth in passing offense (358.3) and fifth in scoring offense (48.3). The Blue Jays also rank eighth

Margraff Holds State Record: Johns Hopkins head coach Jim Margraff became the winningest college football coach in Maryland state history with a 42-14 win at Ursinus late in the 2014 season as that gave him 175 career victories, a mark he upped to 217 with last week's win against Juniata.

Margraff now sports a career record of 217-88-3 (.710) entering this week's Centennial Conference game against McDaniel.

in third-down percentage (.513) and the 243 first ns JHU has accumulated are the fourth most of any team in the nation.

Six in 132, Seven in 20: In the first 132 seasons of Johns Hopkins football, the Blue Jays had six games of 600+ yards of total offense. In the last 20 games, the Blue Jays have topped the 600-yard mark seven times.

Record-Breaking: Johns Hopkins rolled up 692 yards of total offense in the 56-0 win at Juniata. That ranks as the second-highest single-game total in school history and the Blue Jays' school-record-breaking fourth 600-yard game of the season (665 vs. Ursinus, 680 @ Moravian, 606 vs. Randolph-Macon). The previous school record for 600-yard games was three in 2017.

Third-Best Passing Day: Junior David Tammaro (305 yards) and sophomore Nick Leongas (190) combined to throw for 495 yards in the win at Juniata. The 495-yard passing total ranks third in school history - surpassed only by a 545-yard effort at Gettysburg in 2011 and a 527-yard showing against Georgetown in 1991.

A Program First, Twice: The Blue Jays rolled up 428 yards passing and 252 yards rushing in the win at Moravian. That marked the first time in school history that the Blue Jays have totaled more than 400 yards passing and 250 yards rushing in the same game.

So, after never having turned the 400/250 trick in 133 seasons (plus two games), the Blue Jays did it twice in three weeks as they followed up the effort at Moravian with a 405-yard passing, 262-yard rushing performance against Ursinus.

Amazingly, only once prior to this had JHU had even 250+ rushing yards and 350+ passing yards in one game (vs. Juniata in 2017).

Second-Best Quarter, Half Totals: The 33 points Johns Hopkins scored in the second quarter and the 46 points the Blue Jays rolled up in the first half against Dickinson are the second best totals in a quarter and half in school history.

That's a Record: JHU led Dickinson 46-0 at the half on September 22. The 46-point halftime margin is the largest in school history. Previously, the largest lead the Blue Jays held at halftime was 42 (49-7 lead at McDaniel in 2017).

Big Plays: Through nine games, the Johns Hopkins offense has 71 plays of 20 yards or longer (an average of 7.9 such plays per game) and 191 plays of 10 yards or longer (21.2 such plays per game). Note that this includes offensive plays only (rushing and passing plays).

It's Been a While - Part I: The shutout for the Blue Jays in last week's 56-0 win at Juniata was the first road shutout for Johns Hopkins since October 13, 2012, when JHU topped Dickinson, 49-0.

It's Been a While - Part II: The 56-0 win at Juniata was JHU's largest shutout victory since September 19, 1997, when the Blue Jays topped Swarthmore 73-0.

Seven or Less Under Rehring: Since Mickey Rehring took over as the Blue Jay defensive coordinator in 2013, Johns Hopkins has held the opposition to seven points or less 15 times - including the three-

point performance by Moravian on September 15, the six-point effort by Ursinus a week later and the shutout last week against Juniata.

65 in 7: After allowing an average of 34 points per game in the first two games, the Blue Jay defense has worked its way into form and has allowed a total of just 65 points in the last seven games - all Blue Jay victories.

The 65 points Johns Hopkins has allowed over the last seven games are the fewest in a seven-game span since the Blue Jays allowed 65 in the first seven games of the 2011 season.

Defense Fuels Win Over Muhlenberg: The Johns Hopkins defense forced six turnovers and totaled three sacks and 11 pass breakups to fuel the 27-16 victory over 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg. The Blue Jays last forced six or more turnovers in 2010 and the 11 pass breakups are the most by Johns Hopkins since the Jays had 11 in a win against McDaniel in 2005. Hopkins held the Mules 21 points and more than 120 yards below their season averages entering the game.

Sack Party: The Johns Hopkins defense has totaled 30 sacks on the year, including 20 in the last four games. With six sacks at Franklin & Marshall and five at Gettysburg, the Blue Jays had five or more sacks in back-to-back games for the first time since notching six against Randolph-Macon and five against Susquehanna early in the 2012 season. The Blue Jays added three in the win against Muhlenberg and six more at Juniata.

Walters Scores 51st Career Touchdown: Senior running back Stuart Walters tied the Johns Hopkins record for career touchdowns with his 51st in the 27-16 win over Muhlenberg. He pulled even with

Andrew Kase (2006-09) atop the JHU career touchdowns list and is also now tied for third in Centennial Conference history.

PK Enters the Record Book - Part I: Junior defensive back Patrick Kelly intercepted a Gettysburg pass on the last play of the game and returned it 90 yards before being tackled. The 90-yard interception return is the longest in school history - 10 yards longer than Les Matthews' 80-yard return against then Western Maryland (McDaniel) on November 18, 1972.

PK Enters the Record Book - Part II: Not only did Patrick Kelly set a Johns Hopkins record with a 90-yard interception return at Gettysburg, he also became the first player in school history with two different types of 90+yard plays. Kelly had a 95-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Gettysburg last season and added the 90-yard INT return this season.

The only other player in school history with two 90-yard plays is **Harrison Bernstein**, who had kickoff returns of 95 and 92 yards during his career from 1996-99.

Block Party: Freshman **Robert Fletcher** needed exactly three minutes to impact the first game of his career as he blocked a Randolph-Macon punt that was returned 32 yards for a touchdown by senior **Tyler Messinger**. The blocked punt return for a touchdown was the first for Johns Hopkins since **Adam Schweyer** took one back 36 yards for a score against Juniata on October 30, 2010.

Fletcher was back at it against Dickinson as he partially blocked a first-quarter Red Devil punt that led to a Johns Hopkins touchdown and also got a piece of Franklin & Marshall's first punt to give him three blocks on the year; he is tied for eighth in the nation with his three blocked kicks.

Series History

Johns Hopkins and McDaniel are meeting for the 97th time in a series that dates to a 16-0 win by then Western Maryland in 1894. Johns Hopkins leads the all-time series 56-35-5 and has won 17 straight against the Green Terror. The teams have met every year since 1947 except one (1963 game cancelled after President Kennedy assassination).

Both teams have had strings of success against the other in the head-to-head matchup with the last 21 serving as a perfect illustration. Then Western Maryland punctuated the first four of its six straight Centennial titles from 1997 through 2002 with regular-season-ending wins against Johns Hopkins.

The Blue Jays picked up perhaps the most stunning win in school history on November 10, 2001 when unranked Johns Hopkins shocked ninthranked Western Maryland, 21-14, to snap a 33-game league winning streak for the Green Terror.

That win jump-started JHU's current 17-game series winning streak, during which the Terror have scored more than 14 points just six times. Ten of the last 17 have been decided by 24 points or more and JHU has scored 48 or more in each of the last six meetings.

Pick Six: Sophomore **Macauley Kilbane** scored the second of four, fourth-quarter touchdowns for the Blue Jays in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon as he returned an interception 34 yards for a score with 13:20 remaining.

The interception return for a score was the first for the Blue Jays since **Dan Johnson's** 23-yard return for a touchdown against F&M on November 7, 2013.

Because You'll Ask - Part I: For the record, the last time Johns Hopkins scored a touchdown on offense, defense and special teams - prior to turning the trick in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon - was on November 10, 2007, when Richard Hill returned the opening kickoff 90 yards for a touchdown, Adam Winter returned an interception 12 yards for a score and the Blue Jay offense scored a pair of touchdowns in a 31-3 win at McDaniel.

Because You'll Ask - Part II: With the three returns for touchdowns this season (FR, INT, Blocked PR), Johns Hopkins has now scored 49 touchdowns on returns since head coach Jim Margraff took over in 1990 (see chart to right for complete list).

Record-Tying: Senior punter **Brandon Hong-Dominguez** tied the Johns Hopkins record for the longest punt in school history with a 75-yard bomb late in the fourth quarter against Dickinson. It is just the fifth 70+ yard punt in school history and tied **Ben Scott's** school record (vs. Rochester / 2005).

At Home at Homewood: Johns Hopkins has parlayed its home field advantage into victories in recent years. In fact, the Blue Jays are 47-5 (.904) in the home blacks since the start of the 2010 season.

More Homewood: Including the 27-16 win against Muhlenberg, Johns Hopkins has now won 42 straight regular season home games. The Blue Jays last dropped a home game in the regular season on October 2, 2010 when Muhlenberg topped JHU, 30-27.

Number Four: Johns Hopkins boasts a 60-7 record since the start of the 2013 season. The Blue Jays' .896 winning percentage over that time ranks fourth among Division III teams. 61 Under to 61 Over: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** inherited a program with an all-time record that was 61 games **UNDER** .500 when he arrived (334-395-56). With the win against Juniata on November 4, 2017, Johns Hopkins moved its all-time record to 61 games **OVER** .500. Entering this week's game against McDaniel, Johns Hopkins has an all-time record of 551-483-59 (+68).

Centennial Conference Champions: Johns Hopkins claimed its record 13th Centennial Conference title last season with all 13 championships coming since 2002. JHU's 13 CC titles are four more than Dickinson and Muhlenberg have accumulated.

Close Calls: Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of seven games. Those seven losses have come by five, three, five, seven, four, three and two points (including playoff games). Translation ... JHU has lost seven games in 5+ seasons by a total of 29 points.

On a Roll: Johns Hopkins is 80-3 in its last 83 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season and 84-10 in its last 94 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

Sustained Success: Since the start of the 2002 season, the Blue Jays sport a 151-38 (.799) record. Taking it back farther, the Blue Jays are 157-41 (.793) since the start of the 2001 season and 162-46 (.779) since the beginning of the 2000 season.
