# JOHNS HOPKINS VS. URSINUS

#### The Game

« Johns Hopkins (3-1, 2-1 Centennial) plays the second of two straight on the road as the Blue Jays head to Collegeville, PA to take on Ursinus (3-1, 2-1 CC).

#### **A Look Back**

- « Johns Hopkins went on the road and picked up its second straight win as the Blue Jay spoiled Homecoming at Dickinson with a 37-15 victory last Saturday.
- « Ursinus bounced back from its first loss of the season as the Bears went on the road and topped Moravian, 35-28, last Saturday.

#### The Facts

- « This is the 135th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
- « Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 558-485-58 (.533).
- $^{\circ}$  In this decade (since the start of the 2010 season), the Blue Jays are 95-15 (.864) overall and 78-6 (.929) in the Centennial Conference.
- $^{\rm w}$  JHU owns 14 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 10 times (all since 2005).

#### **Poll Position**

- « Johns Hopkins is ranked 18th in this week's AFCA Poll and 19th in the D3football.com Poll.
- « The Blue Jays picked up three preseason top 10 rankings as JHU was ranked fifth by *Street & Smith's* and *Lindy's* and sixth by D3football.com Every preseason ranking the Blue Jays drew this year is the highest in school history.

#### Oktoberfest

- « Johns Hopkins flips the calendar to October for this week's game at Ursinus and the month has been good to the Blue Jays of late.
- $^{\rm w}$  The Blue Jays enter this week's game at Ursinus having won 29 consecutive games in the month of October dating back to a 26-17 loss at coincidentally Ursinus on October 26, 2010.
- « Ironically, the Blue Jays had been just 10-8 in their previous 18 games in the month of October before jump-starting the current 29-game run with a 49-24 win at Susquehanna (10-23-2010).



#### JM "Pride and Poise" Helmet Sticker

- « The Johns Hopkins football team will be wearing a sticker on its helmets throughout the 2019 season honoring former coach **Jim Margraff**, who passed away suddenly on January 2, 2019 just weeks after leading the Blue Jays to the 2018 NCAA Semifinals.
- « The sticker features Margraff's initials "JM" and the team's "Pride and Poise" mantra. Margraff, who guided the Blue Jays for 29 seasons, led Johns Hopkins to a 221-89-3 (.711) record. He finished the 2018 season as the career leader in wins in Johns Hopkins, Centennial Conference and Maryland state history.
- « Margraff introduced the "Pride and Poise" slogan to the Blue Jay football team after taking over in 1990 ... in short, every Blue Jay football player was taught to play and live with "Pride and Poise."



#### Things to Know - Ursinus

- « Ursinus welcomes Johns Hopkins to Patterson Field looking to build on the momentum of last week's 35-28 win against Moravian. The Bears are 3-1 overall and 2-1 in the Centennial Conference.
- « UC has scored at least 35 points in each of its last three games and features the most balanced offense in the CC as the Bears are averaging 218.8 passing yards and 218.0 rushing yards.
- « Stingy defense has always been a calling card for Ursinus and 2019 is no different. UC is allowing just 290.5 yards and 23.0 points per game. In addition, the opposition has completed just 48.0% of its pass attempts and is averaging just 3.0 yards per rush.
- « Ursinus is tied for the Centennial lead with 18 sacks through four games and the Bears have already scored three defensive touchdowns on the year. All three TDs came in a 48-10 win at Gettysburg.
- « UC is minus seven in turnover margin.

#### Bears to Watch

#### Thomas Garlick (Sr. • QB)

- « The top dual-threat quarterback in the Centennial Conference, Garlick has thrown for 868 yards and eight scores and rushed for 205 yards and three more TDs thus far in 2019.
- $^{\circ}$  An Honorable Mention All-Centennial pick last season, Garlick is one of just five players in CC history with more than 7,000 career passing yards (7,067) and 1,000 career rushing yards (1,258).

#### Samuel Ragland (Jr. • RB)

- « A returning First Team All-Centennial Conference selection, Ragland currently ranks third in the CC in rushing yards per game (90.8), second in all-purpose yards per game (149.3) and is fourth in the league, and first among RBs, in receptions (20).
- Ragland rushed for 954 yards and 18 touchdowns last season and already has 1,806 rushing yards and 29 TDs in just 25 career games.

#### Jacob McCain (Sr. • LB)

- « Honorable Mention All-Centennial selection in 2018 after totaling 112 tackles. His 112 tackles last season rank sixth in school history and are the most by a UC player since 1995.
- « Leads the team and ranks second in the CC with 43 tackles thus far.

#### **Sweet September**

- « With last week's win, the Blue Jays completed the decade (2010-19) with a 38-4 record in the month of September.
- « Breaking it down, the Blue Jays went 19-1 at home and 19-3 on the road in the month of September in this decade.

#### **Before The Bye**

- « This week's game at Ursinus will be the last game for the Blue Jays before their bye week. After the game at UC, they will return to action on Saturday, October 19 when F&M visits Homewood Field.
- « Dating back to 2011, the Blue Jays are 43-3 in games played before their bye.
- « The Centennial Conference went to the leaguewide bye in the middle of the season in 2011.

#### **On This Date**

« This week's game will be just the 11th the Blue Jays have played on this date. Games on October 5th have not been kind to the Blue Jays, who lost their first nine all-time games on this date before topping Juniata, 65-10, in 2013.

#### **Another Shutout**

- « The recent 41-0 shutout of Moravian was the first for head coach **Greg Chimera** and defensive coordinator **Harrison Green**.
- « Dating back to last season, the Blue Jays have now posted three shutouts in their last 10 games after topping Juniata (56-0) and MIT (49-0) late in 2018.

#### **A Defensive Group**

- « Through four games, the Johns Hopkins defense is allowing just 13.8 points and 312.0 yards per game.
- « Johns Hopkins leads the Centennial Conference in scoring defense (13.8), ranks third in passing defense (173.8) and fifth in total defense (312.0).
- « The 55 points JHU has allowed are the fewest through four games since 2013, when Hopkins allowed just 48 points in its first four games.
- « The Blue Jays have allowed just two touchdowns and 21 total points in the first three quarters of their four games thus far.
- « The opposition has completed just 46.3% of its passes against the Blue Jays (56-of-121) with four touchdown passes against eight interceptions.

#### For the Record

- « The 132 yards of total offense the Blue Jays allowed against Moravian on September 20 are the fewest JHU has surrendered since holding Susquehanna to 122 yards on September 14, 2013.
- « Hopkins allowed just 35 passing yards against

Moravian, the fewest JHU has allowed since limiting Juniata to just 16 passing yards on October 1, 2011.

#### **Getting On Track**

- « Johns Hopkins scored a season-high 41 points in the 41-0 victory over Moravian (9-20) and followed that with a 37-point effort at Dickinson last week. After scoring 17 points at Randolph-Macon, the Blue Jays have scored 27, 41 and 37 points in their last three games.
- « In addition to the scoring being up over the last three games, the yards have started to pile

#### **Series History**

- « Johns Hopkins and Ursinus are meeting for the 62nd time in a series that dates to a 12-0 Johns Hopkins victory on October 11, 1958.
- « The Blue Jays lead the all-time series 36-21-4 and are 21-14-1 against UC since the formation of the Centennial Conference in 1983. JHU has currently won seven of the last eight against UC.
- « The 36 games between the two teams since the formation of the Centennial Conference have generally either been very tight (15 decided by six points or less) or blowouts (15 decided by 14+).
- « UC had won five of six vs. JHU before the Blue Jays' current 7-1 run against the Bears.

up for the Blue Jays as well. After punching up 277 yards of total offense in the season-opener at Randolph-Macon, JHU has 409 (Susquehanna), 484 (Moravian) and 482 (Dickinson) yards in its last three games,

#### **Just the Second Time**

- « Johns Hopkins totaled 370 passing yards against Susquehanna on September 14 and came back with 374 against Moravian on September 20. Remarkably, this is just the second time in school history that Johns Hopkins has thrown for 370+ yards in back-to-back games.
- « JHU rolled up 433 passing yards against Dickinson and 545 against Gettysburg in back-to-back games in 2011 for the only other consecutive 350-yard passing efforts in school history.
- $^{\circ}$  JHU missed throwing for 350+ in three straight games by just three yards last week as the Blue Jays had 347 passing yards at Dickinson.

#### **Tammaro Reaches 9,000**

- « With 377 yards of total offense last week at Dickinson (30 rushing 347 passing), senior quarterback **David Tammaro** went over 9,000 career yards of total offense. He now has 8,382 passing yards and 717 rushing yards for 9,099 of total offense a mark that ranks second in school history (**Hewitt Tomlin** (2008-11) ... 10,677).
- « Tammaro is now 649-of-1,002 for 8,382 yards with 68 touchdowns against 12 interceptions in his career. He ranks in the top three in every career passing record in school history (see chart page 4).
- « Tammaro also holds the Johns Hopkins career touchdowns responsible for record with 84 (68 passing / 16 rushing).
- $^{\rm w}$  Tammaro is the sixth Centennial Conference quarterback to top 8,000 career passing yards and 9,000 yards of total offense and the seventh to account for 80 or more touchdowns.

#### **Hubley Climbing**

- « Junior wide receiver **Ryan Hubley** continued his hot streak with six receptions for 62 yards and one touchdown at Dickinson, which followed a productive outing against Moravian when he had 10 receptions for 112 yards and one touchdown. This came one week after one of the finest games of his career against Susquehanna as he totaled 12 receptions for 161 yards and also returned two kickoffs for 41 yards against the River Hawks.
- « The 12 receptions and 161 receiving yards against Susquehanna both matched Hubley's previous career highs and the 202 all-purpose yards are a personal best.
- « With 10 receptions against Moravian, he is the first Johns Hopkins player with 10 or more receptions in back-to-back games since current Blue Jay special teams coordinator/defensive line coach **Dan Wodicka** had 13 against McDaniel and 12 against St. John Fisher in 2011 (Wodicka also did it earlier in the 2011 season against Dickinson (11) and Gettysburg (15)).
- « Hubley leads the team and the Centennial Conference in receptions (31) and receiving yards (368) yards and has two touchdown on the year.
- « With his recent efforts, Hubley ranks 10th in school history in career receptions (143) and 15th in receiving yards (1,600).

#### **Wellmann Enters**

- « Sophomore wide receiver **Harrison Wellmann** enjoyed the finest game of his career in the win at Dickinson with 298 all-purpose yards, a kickoff return for a touchdown and a career-high 142 receiving yards.
- « Wellmann's 95-yard kickoff return for a TD against the Red Devils is tied for the longest in school history and he returned three kickoffs on the day for 156 yards (52.0 yards/game). He added eight receptions for 142 yards to ring up his 298-yard all-purpose performance. For his efforts he was named the Centennial Conference Special Teams Player of the Week.
- « Wellmann's 298 all-purpose yards against Dickinson rank as the eighth-best total in school history and he now has 25 receptions for 367 yards and four touchdowns and 10 kickoff returns for 323 yards and the one score this season. His 172.5 all-purpose yards per game lead the Centennial Conference and rank 16th nationally.

#### Kalanik Reaches 25 Sacks, 50 TFLs

- « Senior defensive end **Mike Kalanik** totaled five tackles, including three for losses and one sack, in the win against Moravian and added three tackles, including one TFL, at Dickinson. He now has 23 tackles on the season, including team highs of 7.0 for loss and 3.5 sacks.
- « With his recent efforts, Kalanik now has 25.5 career sacks and 51.0 career tackles for losses. He is the seventh Centennial Conference player since 2000 to reach 25 career sacks and the sixth CC player since 2000 to reach 50 career TFLs.

#### In Case You Hadn't Noticed

- « The Johns Hopkins defense has at least one interception in each of the first four games this season, in five straight games dating back to last season and in six of the last seven.
- « JHU has 13 interceptions in the last seven games dating back to 2018 and has recorded multiple INTs in four of the seven.
- « JHU intercepted four passes all in the fourth quarter in the 17-12 season-opening win at Randolph-Macon. The four interceptions mark the 13th time since 2001 that the Johns Hopkins defense has intercepted four or more passes in a game. Prior to the game at RMC, the last four-INT game for JHU came last October in a 27-16 win over 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg.

#### Chimera Wins First Game as Head Coach

- « The 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon was the first for **Greg Chimera** as head coach of the Blue Jays. Chimera was named the head coach on February 22, 2019 after long-time coach **Jim Margraff** passed away suddenly on January 2, 2019.
- « Chimera played at Johns Hopkins from 2005-08 before spending the 2009-18 seasons as an assistant coach under Margraff.

- « In 10 seasons as a member of the coaching staff, Chimera helped guide the Blue Jays to a record of 102-17, 10 consecutive Centennial Conference titles and nine trips to the NCAA Playoffs. « Chimera served as the Blue Jay offensive coordinator from 2014-18. During that time, Johns
- Hopkins averaged 502.9 yards and 42.1 points per game (over a span of 61 games).

#### **Nearly a Century**

- « With the 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon in his head coaching debut, **Greg Chimera** became the first Johns Hopkins football coach in 99 years to win his first game.
- « Prior to Chimera, the last Johns Hopkins football coach to win his first game was **Ray Van Orman**, who picked up a 34-14 win against Mount St. Mary's on October 2, 1920.
- « After Van Orman's win in his debut, 10 different Blue Jay head coaches dropped their opening game before Chimera broke the streak.

#### **State of Affairs**

« The 87-man Johns Hopkins roster features players from 22 different states.

#### Pick Six

- $\,^{\vee}$  Junior Ryan Weed notched his second interception of the young season against Susquehanna and returned it 45 yards for a touchdown that gave Hopkins a 21-7 second-quarter lead.
- « The pick-six was the first for Johns Hopkins since **Macauley Kilbane** took one back 34 yards in a 63-31 win against Randolph-Macon in the 2018 season opener.
- « Weed's interception return for a score is the 16th for Johns Hopkins since the 2000 season and the 11th since the start of the 2009 season.

#### I'm Honored

- « Johns Hopkins returns seven players who earned All-Centennial Conference honors in 2018, including the CC's Offensive Player of the Year (David Tammaro QB) and Rookie of the Year (Robert Fletcher S).
- « Returning First Team All-Centennial performers for the Blue Jays include **Joe Figueroa** (OL), **Ryan Hubley** (WR), **Macauley Kilbane** (CB) and **David Tammaro** (QB).
- « Back after earning Second Team All-Centennial honors is **Mike Kalanik** (DE), while Honorable Mention All-Centennial picks **Robert Fletcher** (S) and **Frank Petracco** (OL) also return.

#### **More Honors**

« In addition to returning seven All-Centennial performers from last season, the Blue Jays also count two returning All-Americans (Joe Figueroa - OL - 2nd Team AP, HM D3football.com and David Tammaro - QB - 2nd Team D3football.com) and three D3footbal.com All-South selections in Tammaro (1st Team), Joe Figueroa (OL - 1st Team) and Mike Kalanik (DE - 2nd Team).

#### It's All Academic

- $^{\rm w}$  Johns Hopkins placed eight players on the 2018 CoSIDA Google Cloud Academic All-District Team a mark that was tied for the most among all Division III teams in the nation.
- « Returning CoSIDA Academic All-District selections for the Blue Jays include **David Tammaro** (QB), **Ryan Hubley** (WR) and **Frank Petracco** (OL).
- « Quarterback **David Tammaro** went on to earn CoSIDA Academic All-America honors (2nd Team) to become the first quarterback in school history to be named an AAA.

#### **Close Calls**

 $^{\prime\prime}$  Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of nine games. Those nine losses have come by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight and one point. Translation, Johns Hopkins' nine losses since the start of the 2013 season have all come by a touchdown or less and by a total of just 37 points.

#### On a Roll

- $\scriptstyle\rm w$  Johns Hopkins is 84-4 in its last 88 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.
- « The Blue Jays are 91-12 in their last 103 games overall since late in the 2010 season.
- « Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 158-40 (.798) since the start of the 2002 season, 164-43 (.792) since the start of the 2001 season and 169-48 (.779) since the start of the 2000 season.

#### At Home at Homewood

- $\scriptstyle\rm <\! <$  Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 51-6 (.895) at Homewood Field.
- $^{\prime\prime}$  Johns Hopkins had won 12 consecutive games at Homewood Field before the loss on September 14 against Susquehanna. This is tied for the longest home winning streak in school history. JHU previously won 12 straight games at home from 2014-15.
