JOHNS HOPKINS VS. McDANIEL

The Game

« Johns Hopkins (6-3, 5-3 Centennial) closes out 2019 regular season schedule as the Blue Jays make the short trip to Westminster, Maryland to take on rival McDaniel (3-6, 2-6 CC) for the 98th time. Kickoff at Gill Stadium is set for 12 pm.

A Look Back

- « Johns Hopkins topped Juniata, 57-26, in its final regular season home game last Saturday.
- « McDaniel dropped a 49-7 decision at 19th-ranked Susquehanna last Saturday night in Selinsgrove, PA.

The Facts

- « This is the 135th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
- « Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 561-487-58 (.533).
- $^{\circ}$ In this decade (since the start of the 2010 season), the Blue Jays are 98-17 (.852) overall and 81-8 (.910) in the Centennial Conference.
- $^{\circ}$ JHU owns 14 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 10 times (all since 2005).

Oh Captain, My Captain

- $^{ ext{ iny Five}}$ Players were selected to serve as captains of the 2019 Johns Hopkins football team in a vote of the team last spring.
- « Senior Mike Kalanik is in his second year as a co-captain and is joined by classmates James Closser, Joe Figueroa and David Tammaro and junior Macauley Kilbane.
- « Dating back to 1947, Kalanik is just the 13th player to serve as a captain more than one season.

Post-Season Talk

- $^{\rm w}$ Johns Hopkins can officially lock up a berth in the Centennial-MAC Bowl Series with a win this week at McDaniel.
- $^{\rm w}$ This would be the first time Johns Hopkins has participated in the Bowl Series. The Centennial-MAC Bowl Series debuted in 2015 and to-date there have been nine games played. The Centennial is 5-4 in those nine .

JM "Pride and Poise" Helmet Sticker

- « The Johns Hopkins football team will be wearing a sticker on its helmets throughout the 2019 season honoring former coach **Jim Margraff**, who passed away suddenly on January 2, 2019 just weeks after leading the Blue Jays to the 2018 NCAA Semifinals.
- « The sticker features Margraff's initials "JM" and the team's "Pride and Poise" mantra. Margraff, who guided the Blue Jays for 29 seasons, led Johns Hopkins to a 221-89-3 (.711) record. He finished the 2018 season as the career leader in wins in Johns Hopkins, Centennial Conference and Maryland state history.
- « Margraff introduced the "Pride and Poise" slogan to the Blue Jay football team after taking over in 1990 ... in short, every Blue Jay football player was taught to play and live with "Pride and Poise."



Things to Know - McDaniel

- « McDaniel closes out its regular season by welcoming rival Johns Hopkins to Gill Stadium. The Green Terror will honor their seniors prior to Saturday's game.
- « The Green Terror have been one of the most opportunistic teams in the nation this season as McDaniel is +14 in turnover margin and is tied for fifth in the nation in that category.
- « Junior **Tyler Palermiti** directs the McDaniel offense and he's thrown for 1,159 yards with six touchdowns against just two interceptions. Five different players have 14 or more receptions with freshman **Jevon Hamilton** (18-306-1) leading the way.
- « The McDaniel defense has been stingy against the run this season as the opposition is averaging just 151.9 yards per game.
- « The Terror lead the Centennial Conference in punt return average (15.5) and rank second in the league in red zone scoring percentage (.818).
- « A win this week against Johns Hopkins would be McDaniel's first in October or November in the last three years.

Green Terror to Watch

Nah'Shon Godrey (Sr. • DB)

« One of the proverbial "stat sheet filler-uppers" in the league, Godfrey enters this week's game with 58 tackles, three interceptions, four pass breakups and one blocked kick on the season. He enters this week's game just one tackle shy of 125 for his career and he also has 12 PBUs and four INTs to his credit. Godfrey was a Second Team All-Centennial pick as a junior.

Jevon Hamilton (Fr. • WR)

« One of the top freshmen in the Centennial, Hamilton leads the team in receiving (18-306-1) and is averaging 16.4 yards per kickoff return. His 85-yard TD reception against Muhlenberg on October 26 was McDaniel's longest play from scrimmage in 15 years.

Perry Stefanelli (Gr. • RB)

« Stefanelli has accounted for nearly 50% of McDaniel's rushing yards this season with 459 of the team's 949 on the year. He has rushed for 1,779 yards and 12 touchdowns in his career and has 2,736 career all-purpose yards to his credit.

Seniors Closing Strong Careers

- « This week's game against McDaniel will be the final regular season game in the careers of the seniors on the 2019 Johns Hopkins football team. This year's senior class will go down as one of the most accomplished in program history. Below is a look at some of their collective team achievements since arriving in 2016:
- Johns Hopkins won three Centennial Conference titles and made three trips to the NCAA Playoffs during their career.
- The Blue Jays are 38-8 since the current seniors arrived at Homewood. Included in that record is a 34-5 regular season mark and a 21-3 record at Homewood Field
- The current seniors were part of four NCAA Playoff victories. That's the second-most NCAA victories by any class in school history.
- The 38 wins the current seniors have amassed are tied for the sixth-most in program history for any class. They could become just the sixth class in school history to reach 40 wins during their career with two more wins.

November Reign

- $^{
 m w}$ Johns Hopkins is regular season games played in the month of November this century, including 20-2 this decade (2010-).
- « JHU had won 15 consecutive regular season games in November dating back to 2012 before falling at sixth-ranked Muhlenberg, 31-16, on November 2.

Series History

- « Johns Hopkins and McDaniel are meeting for the 98th time in a series that dates to a 16-0 win by then Western Maryland in 1894.
- « JHU leads the all-time series 57-35-5 and has won 18 straight against the Green Terror.
- « The teams have met every year since 1947 except one (1963 game canceled after President Kennedy assassination).
- « JHU topped then Western Maryland, 21-14, on November 10, 2001 to snap WMC's 33-game Centennial winning streak.
- « Since the win in 2001, JHU has won 18 straight against the Terror, has scored at least 42 points in seven straight meetings and has held McDaniel to 14 points or less 12 times in those 18 games.

After the Bye

- « Dating back to 2011, when the Centennial Conference went to a league-wide bye in the middle of the season, Johns Hopkins is 39-3 in regular season games played after the bye week.
- « In games played after the bye since 2011, the Blue Jays are 18-2 in regular season games played on the road and 21-1 in regular season games played at home.

On This Date

- « This week's game will be the 18th the Blue Jays have played on this date and the first since Hopkins topped McDaniel, 52-21, in 2013.
- « The Blue Jays are 9-7-1 all-time in games played on November 16 and have currently won three straight and six of their last seven games played on this date.

A Defensive Group

- « Through nine games, the Johns Hopkins defense is allowing just 18.7 points and 344.8 yards per game.
- « Johns Hopkins ranks third in the Centennial in scoring defense, fifth in total defense and first in passing defense (150.6). For the record, the last time Johns Hopkins allowed 150 or fewer passing yards per game was 2011(141.2).
- $^{\circ}$ The opposition has completed just 47.9% of its passes against the Blue Jays (113-of-236) with eight touchdown passes against 11 interceptions.
- « JHU ranks 19th in the nation in pass efficiency defense (100.77 rating).

Almost a Record

- $^{ ext{ ext{ iny The Johns Hopkins}}}$ defense held four Gettysburg quarterbacks to a combined 1-of-22 passing with one interception for just one yard in the 63-7 win on October 25.
- « The one passing yard allowed is the second-lowest recorded total in school history; Johns Hopkins held Washington & Lee to zero passing yards on October 21, 1961.

In Case You Hadn't Noticed

- « The Johns Hopkins defense had at least one interception in each of the first five games this season before failing to come up with one against F&M. JHU had one against Gettysburg and Muhlenberg and has posted at least one INT in nine of the last 12 games dating back to last season.
- $^{ ext{ iny }}$ JHU has 16 interceptions in the last 12 games dating back to 2018 and has recorded multiple INTs in four of the 12.
- « JHU intercepted four passes all in the fourth quarter in the 17-12 season-opening win at Ran-

dolph-Macon. The four interceptions mark the 13th time since 2001 that the Johns Hopkins defense has intercepted four or more passes in a game. Prior to the game at RMC, the last four-INT game for JHU came last October in a 27-16 win over 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg.

For the Record

- « The 132 yards of total offense the Blue Jays allowed against Moravian on September 20 are the fewest JHU has surrendered since holding Susquehanna to 122 yards on September 14, 2013.
- « Hopkins allowed just 35 passing yards against Moravian at the time that was the fewest JHU had allowed since limiting Juniata to just 16 passing yards on October 1, 2011.

Getting On Track

- « The Johns Hopkins offense has scored 27 or more points six times this season, including efforts of 57 (Juniata) and 63 (Gettysburg) in their last two home games. The Blue Jays are averaging 34.1 points per game, which ranks third in the Centennial Conference.
- « JHU punched up 550 yards in last week's win over Juniata that is the second-highest single-game total of the season for the Blue Jays (682 vs. Gettysburg).
- « The 550-yard effort against Juniata marks the 36th time in school history that JHU has rolled up 550 or more yards of total offense in a game. Of those 36, 31 of them have come since the start of the 2010 season.
- $^{\circ}$ Through nine games, Johns Hopkins ranks first in the Centennial in total offense (451.2) and first in passing offense (326.1).

60+

- « The 63-point showing in the recent 63-7 win against Gettysburg marked the 12th time in school history that Johns Hopkins has scored 60 or more points in a game.
- « Five of JHU's 60-point games have come since the start of the 2011 season and three have come since the start of the 2018 season.

Just the Second Time

- « Johns Hopkins totaled 370 passing yards against Susquehanna on September 14 and came back with 374 against Moravian on September 20. Remarkably, this was just the second time in school history that Johns Hopkins has thrown for 370+ yards in back-to-back games.
- « JHU rolled up 433 passing yards against Dickinson and 545 against Gettysburg in back-to-back games in 2011 for the only other consecutive 350-yard passing efforts in school history.
- « JHU missed throwing for 350+ in three straight games by just three yards as the Blue Jays had 347 passing yards at Dickinson.

Tammaro in the Record Book

- « Senior QB **David Tammaro** was 25-of-32 for 298 yards with three touchdowns and also rushed for two touchdowns in last week's game against Juniata. In the process, he broke two more school records.
- « Tammaro's 298-yard effort was his 32nd career 200-yard passing game, which moved him into sole possession of first place on JHU's career list. He also broke Hewitt Tomlin's JHU record for career total offense as he now has 10, 732 (Tomlin's record was 10,677) and he needs just 199 yards to join Tomlin as the only 10,000-yard passers in school history.
- « In addition, with 69 rushing yards, he'll become the second player in CC history with 9,000 passing yards and 1,000 rushing yards and with two more total touchdowns (rushing or passing), he'll become the second player in CC history to amass 100 career touchdowns.

Wellmann Ties JHU Record

- « Sophomore wide receiver **Harrison Wellmann** continues to pace the Blue Jays and the Centennial Conference in receiving as he has 62 receptions for 1,017 yards and 10 touchdowns. He leads the league in receptions and receiving yards and is tied for the CC-lead in TD catches.
- « At 165.6 yards per game, Wellmann also leads the CC in all-purpose yards per game, while his 25.6 yards per kickoff return rank second.
- $^{\circ}$ In the JHU record book, Wellmann's 62 receptions are tied for 15th on the single-season list, while his 1,017 yards rank seventh; his 10 TDs are tied for sixth-most in a season
- « Wellmann tied the Johns Hopkins and Centennial Conference single-game record for receptions in a game with 16 (for 189 yards and one touchdown) in the Blue Jays' recent game at sixth-ranked Muhlenberg. This came one week after he earned Centennial Conference Offensive Player of the Week honors after he had nine receptions for 224 yards and two touchdowns in the 63-7 win against Gettysburg.
- « Wellmann enjoyed one of the finest games of his career in the win at Dickinson with 298 all-purpose yards, a kickoff return for a touchdown and a then career-high 142 receiving yards.
- « Wellmann's 95-yard kickoff return for a TD against the Red Devils is tied for the longest in school history and he returned three kickoffs on the day for 156 yards (52.0 yards/game). He added eight receptions for 142 yards to ring up his 298-yard all-purpose performance. For his efforts he was named the Centennial Conference Special Teams Player of the Week and his 298 all-purpose yards against Dickinson rank as the eighth-best total in school history.

Kalanik Reaches 25 Sacks, 50 TFLs

- « Senior defensive end **Mike Kalanik** enters this week's game with 50 tackles, including 15.5 for losses and 5.5 sacks. He ranks fourth on the team in tackles and leads the team in TFLs and sacks.
- « Kalanik passed Brian Cook (2002-06) for first place on JHU's career sack list in last week's 57-26 win over Juniata with his 2.5 sacks against the Eagles. Kalanik now has 28.5 career sacks, which tops the 28.0 Cook had during his career.
- « With his recent efforts, Kalanik now has 184 tackles, 28.5 sacks and 59.5 tackles for losses in his career. Already the all-time leader in career TFLs at Johns Hopkins, he is the seventh Centennial Conference player since 2000 to reach 25 career sacks and the sixth CC player since 2000 to reach 50 career TFLs. He ranks second among Centennial Conference players in career TFLs since the 2000 season.

Offensive Player Notes of Interest

- « Freshman Lance Large ranks sixth on the team in receiving with 10 receptions for 131 yards.
- « Freshman RB **Jonas Larson** ranks third on the team in rushing with 192 yards on 41 carries (4.7) and has six receptions for 101 yards and a touchdown on the year. He had three receptions for 83 yards, including a 56-yard touchdown reception, in the win against Gettysburg.
- « Junior QB **Nick Leongas** was 8-of-12 for 96 yards in the win against Gettysburg and 2-for-2 for 39 yards and one touchdown against Juniata. On the year, he is now 12-of-16 for 147 yards and one touchdown. In his career, he is 47-of-85 for 778 yards with five touchdowns against just one interception. He has also rushed for 396 yards and four scores.
- « Senior **Dane Rogerson** enjoyed the finest game of his career against Juniata as he rushed for a career-high 157 yards and two touchdowns and totaled a career-best 217 all-purpose yards in the victory. He now leads the team in rushing with 395 yards and four touchdowns, has added 21 receptions for 130 yards and is averaging 83.3 all-purpose yards per game (3rd on the team).
- « Sophomore TE Emmett Turner ranks fourth on the team in receiving with 24 receptions for 258 yards and one touchdown in nine games. He had four receptions for 69 yards and one TD against F&M and five receptions for 52 yards against sixth-ranked Muhlenberg; the 69 receiving yards against F&M are a career high.
- « RB **Luke Yakely** tied his career high with two rushing touchdowns at Ursinus and now has 147 rushing yards and four TDs on the year after rushing for 31 yards and one TD against Gettysburg.
- « Senior WR **Jacob Yohr** posted the best game of his career with 13 receptions for 167 yards and two touchdowns in the 57-26 win against Juniata. He now ranks third on the team in receiving with 27 receptions for 371 yards and four TDs on the year and last week's effort against the Eagles bumped his career totals to 44 receptions for 579 yards and six scores.

Defensive Player Notes of Interest

- « Sophomore **Ross Andersson** had a career-high 11 tackles at Ursinus, added six last week against Juniata and now has 43 tackles and is tied for the team-lead with three INTs on the year.
- « Sophomore **Robert Fletcher** has 49 tackles, two pass breakups, two INTs and two forced fumbles on the year. He is now just one tackle shy of 150 for his career and also has 9.5 TFLs, eight PBUs, three INTs and three blocked kicks to his credit.
- « Senior **Nick Hartman** recorded the 50th tackle of his career at Ursinus and is now just one shy of 75 for his career. He posted four tackles last week against Juniata and ranks third on the team in tackles (56) and has two forced fumbles and two pass breakups on the year.
- « Junior **Macauley Kilbane** counts 34 tackles, a team-high nine pass breakups and three blocked kicks on the year. He had his third block of the season against Juniata as he blocked an extra point that he scooped up and returned for two points against the Eagles. He recorded the 125th tackle of his career at Muhlenberg and his 21 career pass breakups are third-best among Johns Hopkins players since 2000.

- « Junior **Kyle Roberts** had a career-high nine tackles and added a personal-best two sacks at Ursinus, had eight tackles and one TFL at Muhlenberg and added eight tackles against Juniata. He now has 47 tackles, 5.5 TFLs and 3.5 sacks this season and 101 tackles, 16.0 TFLs and 7.5 sacks in his career.
- « Sophomore **Nick Seidel** totaled nine tackles and one sack in last week's win against Juniata. He is second on the team in tackles (63) through nine games, has three interceptions this season and recorded the 100th tackle of his career last week against the Eagles.
- « Senior Corey Tull is seeing the most extensive playing time of his career and has 36 tackles this season after posting four against Gettysburg, five at Muhlenberg and three against Juniata in the last three games.
- « Junior **Ryan Weed** notched eight tackles at Muhlenberg and 11, including a sack, against Juniata he now leads the team with 66 tackles on the year. He also has two interceptions and five pass breakups on the year and recorded the 100th tackle of his career against Juniata.
- $^{\circ}$ Junior **Finn Zechman** counts 22 tackles and three PBUs to his credit this season. He recorded the 50th tackle of his career in the win at Dickinson.

Chimera Wins First Game as Head Coach

- « The 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon was the first for Greg Chimera as head coach of the Blue Jays. Chimera was named the head coach on February 22, 2019 after long-time coach Jim Margraff passed away suddenly on January 2, 2019.
- $^{\rm w}$ Chimera played at Johns Hopkins from 2005-08 before spending the 2009-18 seasons as an assistant coach under Margraff.
- $^{\circ}$ In 10 seasons as a member of the coaching staff, Chimera helped guide the Blue Jays to a record of 102-17, 10 consecutive Centennial Conference titles and nine trips to the NCAA Playoffs.
- « Chimera served as the Blue Jay offensive coordinator from 2014-18. During that time, Johns Hopkins averaged 502.9 yards and 42.1 points per game (over a span of 61 games).

Nearly a Century

- « With the 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon in his head coaching debut, **Greg Chimera** became the first Johns Hopkins football coach in 99 years to win his first game.
- « Prior to Chimera, the last Johns Hopkins football coach to win his first game was **Ray Van Orman**, who picked up a 34-14 win against Mount St. Mary's on October 2, 1920.
- « After Van Orman's win in his debut, 10 different Blue Jay head coaches dropped their opening game before Chimera broke the streak.

State of Affairs

« The 87-man Johns Hopkins roster features players from 22 different states.

Pick Six

- « Junior **Ryan Weed** notched his second interception of the season against Susquehanna and returned it 45 yards for a touchdown that gave Hopkins a 21-7 second-quarter lead.
- $\scriptstyle\rm <\!$ The pick-six was the first for Johns Hopkins since Macauley Kilbane took one back 34 yards in a 63-31 win against Randolph-Macon in the 2018 season opener.
- « Weed's interception return for a score is the 16th for Johns Hopkins since the 2000 season and the 11th since the start of the 2009 season.

Close Calls
