JOHNS HOPKINS VS. STEVENSON (CC-MAC BOWL SERIES)

The Game

« Johns Hopkins (7-3) makes one of the shortest road trips in program history as the Blue Jays travel to Owings Mills, Maryland to take on Stevenson (8-2) in the 2019 Centennial-MAC Bowl Series. Kickoff at Mustang Stadium is set for 1 pm on Saturday, November 23.

A Look Back

« Johns Hopkins scored its second straight victory to close the regular season as the Blue Jays went on the road and topped rival McDaniel, 42-0, last Saturday.
« Stevenson closed the regular season with a 31-0 victory at home against Lycoming last Saturday. The win was the seventh straight for the Mustangs.

The Facts

« This is the 135th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
« Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 562-487-58 (.534).
« In this decade (since the start of the 2010 season), the Blue Jays are 99-17 (.853) overall and 82-8 (.911) in the Centennial Conference.
« JHU owns 14 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 10 times (all since 2005).

Oh Captain, My Captain

« Five players were selected to serve as captains of the 2019 Johns Hopkins football team in a vote of the team last spring.
« Senior **Mike Kalanik** is in his second year as a co-captain and is joined by classmates **James Closser**, **Joe Figueroa** and **David Tammara** and junior **Macauley Kilbane**.
« Dating back to 1947, Kalanik is just the 13th player to serve as a captain more than one season.

JM "Pride and Poise" Helmet Sticker

« The Johns Hopkins football team will be wearing a sticker on its helmets throughout the 2019 season honoring former coach **Jim Margraff**, who passed away suddenly on January 2, 2019 - just weeks after leading the Blue Jays to the 2018 NCAA Semifinals.

« The sticker features Margraff's initials "JM" and the team's "Pride and Poise" mantra. Margraff, who guided the Blue Jays for 29 seasons, led Johns Hopkins to a 221-89-3 (.711) record. He finished the 2018 season as the career leader in wins in Johns Hopkins, Centennial Conference and Maryland state history.

« Margraff introduced the "Pride and Poise" slogan to the Blue Jay football team after taking over in 1990 ... in short, every Blue Jay football player was taught to play and live with "Pride and Poise."



Things to Know - Stevenson

« Stevenson welcomes Johns Hopkins to Mustang Stadium for the first-ever meeting with the Blue Jays.
« The Mustangs are 8-2 overall and finished 7-1 in the Middle Atlantic Conference to secure the top spot in the MAC standings for the CC-MAC Bowl Series.

« The two losses on the season for the Mustangs came in back-to-back weeks against Bridgewater and Delaware Valley in September. Those two teams are both in the NCAA Playoffs and are a combined 19-1 right now.

« Stevenson enters this week's game riding a seven-game winning streak - its longest since an eight-game run in 2016.

« The Mustangs are averaging 37.1 points and 432.1 yards per game - both of those marks would be school single-season records if the season ended today.

« SU features one of the top defenses in the nation as the Mustangs allow just 14.6 points and 298.1 yards per game. The 14.6 points allowed ranks 21st in the nation.

« Stevenson has held six of its last seven opponents to 15 points or less and four opponents have failed to top 10 points against SU this season.

Mustangs to Watch

Chaz Lyles (Sr. • WR)

« One of the most explosive players in the nation, Lyles earned First Team All-MAC honors as he punched up 69 receptions for 1,162 yards and 10 touchdowns on the year. He will finish his career ranked in the top three in SU history in all three categories as he is 141-1,866-16 right now.

Ryan Nowicki (Sr. • OL/C)

« The unquestioned leader of Stevenson's offensive line, Nowicki is a two-time All-MAC selection and was a CoSIDA Academic All-District pick in 2018 as well.

Isaiha Pitts (Sr. • LB)

« A two-time First Team All-MAC selection, Pitts has 48 tackles, including 3.5 for loss, three interceptions and three fumble recoveries. He recorded the 200th tackle of his career last week's win against Lycoming. He is just the sixth player in school history to reach 200 career tackles.

Post-Season Talk

« Johns Hopkins is making its 12th consecutive and 16th overall post-season appearance. All 16 post-season appearances have come since 2002.
« This week's game will be the 25th all-time post-season game in program history.

« Johns Hopkins is 13-11 all-time in the post-season, including 9-10 in the NCAA Playoffs and 4-1 in ECAC Bowl games.

« This is the first time Johns Hopkins has participated in the Centennial-MAC Bowl Series. The Bowl Series debuted in 2015 and to-date there have been nine games played. The Centennial is 5-4 in those nine.

« All 2019 Centennial-MAC Bowl games will be played at campus sites on November 23 with the following schedule:

Seniors Closing Strong Careers

« This week's game against Stevenson will be the final game in the careers of the seniors on the 2019 Johns Hopkins football team. This year's senior class will go down as one of the most accomplished in program history. Below is a look at some of their collective team achievements since arriving in 2016:

- Johns Hopkins won three Centennial Conference titles and made three trips to the NCAA Playoffs during their career.

- The Blue Jays are 39-8 since the current seniors arrived at Homewood. Included in that record is a 35-5 regular season mark and a 21-3 record at Homewood Field

- The current seniors were part of four NCAA Playoff victories. That's the second-most NCAA victories by any class in school history.

- The 39 wins the current seniors have amassed rank sixth in program history for any class. They could become just the sixth class in school history to reach 40 wins during their career with one more win.

November Reign

« Including playoff games, Johns Hopkins is 52-14 (.788) in the month of November in this century. Included in that mark is a 12-9 record in playoff games and a 40-5 record in regular season games.

Bidding For 100

« Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an overall record of 99-17 (.853) this decade (2010-19). The 99 wins are already 25 more than JHU had ever previously won in a decade (74 ... 2000-09).

« With a win this week, Johns Hopkins would become just the sixth team in the nation reach 100 wins this decade. The five teams that have already reached the 100-win mark this century are Mount Union, Mary Hardin-Baylor, Wisconsin-Whitewater, St. Thomas (MN) and Wesley.

« North Central (99) and Linfield (97) also have a chance to join the 100-win club for this decade - meaning that at best only eight Division III football programs could win 100+ games from 2010-19.

On This Date - Part I

- « This week's game will be the 12th the Blue Jays have played on this date - and the first since Hopkins fell to Wesley, 29-24, in the first round of the 2013 NCAA Playoffs.
- « The Blue Jays are 3-7-1 all-time in games played on November 23 and have currently won three of their last five games played on this date.

On This Date - Part II

- « This week's game at Stevenson falls on the 17-year anniversary of the first post-season game in Johns Hopkins football history.
- « The Blue Jays played their first post-season game on November 23, 2002 and picked up a 24-21 win at Frostburg St. in the ECAC Southwest Championship game.

Another Shutout

- « Johns Hopkins picked up its second shutout of the 2019 season with last week's 42-0 win at rival McDaniel. The shutout was JHU's first against the Green Terror since 1984.
- « This is the second straight year that Johns Hopkins has posted two shutouts and the 15th time in program history that the Blue Jays have posted two or more shutouts in a season.

A Defensive Group

- « Through 10 games, the Johns Hopkins defense is allowing just 16.8 points and 324.2 yards per game.
- « Johns Hopkins ranks third in the Centennial in scoring defense, fourth in total defense and first in passing defense (147.8). For the record, the last time Johns Hopkins allowed 150 or fewer passing yards per game was 2011(141.2).
- « The opposition has completed just 47.0% of its passes against the Blue Jays (125-of-266) with eight touchdown passes against 11 interceptions.
- « JHU ranks 12th in the nation in pass efficiency defense (97.80 rating) and 10th in passing yards allowed per game.

Almost a Record

- « The Johns Hopkins defense held four Gettysburg quarterbacks to a combined 1-of-22 passing with one interception for just one yard in the 63-7 win on October 25.
- « The one passing yard allowed is the second-lowest recorded total in school history; Johns Hopkins held Washington & Lee to zero passing yards on October 21, 1961.

For the Record

- « The 132 yards of total offense the Blue Jays allowed against Moravian on September 20 are the fewest JHU has surrendered since holding Susquehanna to 122 yards on September 14, 2013.
- « Hopkins allowed just 35 passing yards against Moravian - at the time that was the fewest JHU had allowed since limiting Juniata to just 16 passing yards on October 1, 2011.
- « JHU held McDaniel to 139 yards of total offense in the 42-0 regular-season-ending victory. Coupled with the 132 yards Moravian managed earlier in the season, this marks the first time since 2011 that JHU has held two opponents to less 140 yards in the same season.

Getting On Track

- « The Johns Hopkins offense has scored 27 or more points seven times this season, including efforts of 57 (Juniata) and 63 (Gettysburg) in their last two home games and 42 at McDaniel in the final regular season game of the year. The Blue Jays are averaging 34.9 points per game, which ranks third in the Centennial Conference.
- « JHU punched up 550 yards two weeks ago against Juniata - that is the second-highest single-game total of the season for the Blue Jays (682 vs. Gettysburg). The Blue Jays followed that with a 483-yard showing last week at McDaniel.
- « The 550-yard effort against Juniata marked the 36th time in school history that JHU has rolled up 550 or more yards of total offense in a game. Of those 36, 31 of them have come since the start of the 2010 season.
- « Through 10 games, Johns Hopkins ranks first in the Centennial in total offense (454.4) and first in passing offense (324.8).

60+

- « The 63-point showing in the recent 63-7 win against Gettysburg marked the 12th time in school history that Johns Hopkins has scored 60 or more points in a game.
- « Five of JHU's 60-point games have come since the start of the 2011 season and three have come since the start of the 2018 season.

Just the Second Time

- « Johns Hopkins totaled 370 passing yards against Susquehanna on September 14 and came back with 374 against Moravian on September 20. Remarkably, this was just the second time in school history that Johns Hopkins has thrown for 370+ yards in back-to-back games.
- « JHU rolled up 433 passing yards against Dickinson and 545 against Gettysburg in back-to-back games in 2011 for the only other consecutive 350-yard passing efforts in school history.
- « JHU missed throwing for 350+ in three straight games by just three yards as the Blue Jays had 347 passing yards at Dickinson.

Tammaro in the Record Book

« Senior QB **David Tammaro** was 23-of-31 for 236 yards with three touchdowns and also rushed for a score in last week's game at McDaniel. In the process, he broke two more school records.

« In the win against McDaniel, Tammaro recorded the 100th overall touchdown of his career (now has 102 ... 82 passing/20 rushing), surpassed 10,000 career passing yards (10,037) and inched closer to 11,000 career yards of total offense (10,986). He is just the second player in Centennial history to account for 100 career touchdowns and just the third to reach 10,000 career passing yards,

« In addition, with 51 rushing yards, he'll become the second player in CC history with 10,000 passing yards and 1,000 rushing yards.

Wellmann Leads Centennial in Receiving

« Sophomore wide receiver **Harrison Wellmann** ended the regular season as the Centennial Conference leader in receptions (72), receiving yards (1,106) and touchdown receptions (11). He also leads the league in all-purpose yards (1,579) and all-purpose yards per game (157.9) and ranks second in kickoff return average (25.8).

« In the JHU record book, Wellmann's 72 receptions rank eighth on the Blue Jays' single-season list, while his 1,106 yards and 11 TDs are both fourth.

« Wellmann tied the Johns Hopkins and Centennial Conference single-game record for receptions in a game with 16 (for 189 yards and one touchdown) in the Blue Jays' recent game at then sixth-ranked Muhlenberg. This came one week after he earned Centennial Conference Offensive Player of the Week honors after he had nine receptions for 224 yards and two touchdowns in the 63-7 win against Gettysburg.

« Wellmann enjoyed one of the finest games of his career in the win at Dickinson with 298 all-purpose yards, a kickoff return for a touchdown and a then career-high 142 receiving yards.

« Wellmann's 95-yard kickoff return for a TD against the Red Devils is tied for the longest in school history and he returned three kickoffs on the day for 156 yards (52.0 yards/game). He added eight receptions for 142 yards to ring up his 298-yard all-purpose performance.

Kalanik Closing on 200, 60, 30

« Senior defensive end **Mike Kalanik** enters the final game of his career with 187 tackles, 59.5 tackles for loss and 28.5 career sacks. He is JHU's career leader in TFLs and sacks.

« On the year, Kalanik counts 53 tackles, including 15.5 for losses and 6.5 sacks, to his credit. His 15.5 TFLs are the sixth-highest single-season total in school history and give him three seasons with 15+ TFLs (21.0 in 2017 ... 18.0 in 2018 ... 15.5 in 2019); he accounts for three of the six instances in school history where a player has recored 15+ TFLs in a season.

« Kalanik is the seventh Centennial Conference player since 2000 to reach 25 career sacks and the sixth CC player since 2000 to reach 50 career TFLs. He ranks second among Centennial Conference players in career TFLs since the 2000 season.

Offensive Player Notes of Interest

« Freshman **Lance Large** ranks sixth on the team in receiving with 12 receptions for 153 yards.

« Freshman RB **Jonas Larson** ranks third on the team in rushing with 259 yards on 53 carries (4.9) and has seven receptions for 105 yards and a touchdown on the year. He rushed for a career-high 67 yards and one touchdown in the 42-0 win at McDaniel.

« Junior QB **Nick Leongas** was 8-of-12 for 96 yards in the win against Gettysburg, 2-for-2 for 39 yards and one touchdown against Juniata and 6-of-11 for 40 yards at McDaniel. On the year, he is now 18-of-27 for 187 yards and one touchdown. In his career, he is 53-of-96 for 818 yards with five touchdowns against just one interception. He has also rushed for 432 yards and four scores.

« Senior **Dane Rogerson** enjoyed the finest game of his career against Juniata as he rushed for a career-high 157 yards and two touchdowns and totaled a career-best 217 all-purpose yards in the victory. He leads the team in rushing with 395 yards and four touchdowns, has added 21 receptions for 130 yards and is averaging 83.3 all-purpose yards per game (3rd on the team).

« Sophomore TE **Emmett Turner** ranks fourth on the team in receiving with 27 receptions for 293 yards and one touchdown in 10 games. He had four receptions for 69 yards and one TD against F&M and five receptions for 52 yards against sixth-ranked Muhlenberg; the 69 receiving yards against F&M are a career high.

« Freshman RB **Danny Wolf** got the first start of his career at McDaniel and responded by rushing for 49 yards and one touchdown on four carries. He now has 123 yards rushing on 18 attempts this season with two touchdowns. His 6.8 yards per rush is the highest on the team among players with 10 or more carries.

« RB **Luke Yakely** tied his career high with two rushing touchdowns at Ursinus and now has 156 rushing yards and four TDs on the year after rushing for 31 yards and one TD against Gettysburg.

« Senior WR **Jacob Yohr** posted the best game of his career with 13 receptions for 167 yards and two touchdowns in the 57-26 win against Juniata and came back with two receptions for 49 yards at McDaniel. He now ranks third on the team in receiving with 29 receptions for 420 yards and four TDs on the year and his recent efforts have bumped his career totals to 46 receptions for 628 yards and six scores.

Defensive Player Notes of Interest

« Sophomore **Ross Andersson** had a career-high 11 tackles at Ursinus, added six against Juniata and now has 45 tackles and is tied for the team-lead with three INTs on the year.

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« Sophomore **Robert Fletcher** has 52 tackles, three pass breakups, two INTs and two forced fumbles on the year. He recorded the 150th tackle of his career at McDaniel and also has 10.5 TFLs, nine PBUs, three INTs and three blocked kicks to his credit.

« Senior **Nick Hartman** recorded the 50th tackle of his career at Ursinus and the 75th against McDaniel. He posted four tackles against Juniata and five at McDaniel and ranks third on the team in tackles (61) and has two forced fumbles and two pass breakups on the year.

« Junior **Macauley Kilbane** counts 41 tackles, a team-high nine pass breakups and three blocked kicks on the year. He had his third block of the season against Juniata as he blocked an extra point that he scooped up and returned for two points against the Eagles. He recorded the 125th tackle of his career at Muhlenberg and his 21 career pass breakups are third-best among Johns Hopkins players since 2000.

« Junior **Kyle Roberts** had a career-high nine tackles and added a personal-best two sacks at Ursinus, had eight tackles and one TFL at Muhlenberg and added eight tackles against Juniata. He now has 48 tackles, 5.5 TFLs and 3.5 sacks this season and 102 tackles, 16.0 TFLs and 7.5 sacks in his career.

« Sophomore **Nick Seidel** totaled nine tackles and one sack against Juniata and added seven stops at McDaniel. He now leads the team in tackles (70) through 10 games, has three interceptions this season and recorded the 100th tackle of his career against Juniata.

« Senior **Corey Tull** is seeing the most extensive playing time of his career and has 37 tackles this season after posting four against Gettysburg, five at Muhlenberg and three against Juniata.

« Junior **Ryan Weed** notched eight tackles at Muhlenberg and 11, including a sack, against Juniata - he now ranks second on the team with 67 tackles on the year. He also has two interceptions and five pass breakups on the year and recorded the 100th tackle of his career against Juniata.

« Junior **Finn Zechman** counts 24 tackles and five PBUs to his credit this season. He recorded the 50th tackle of his career in the win at Dickinson.

Chimera Wins First Game as Head Coach

« The 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon was the first for **Greg Chimera** as head coach of the Blue Jays. Chimera was named the head coach on February 22, 2019 after long-time coach **Jim Margraff** passed away suddenly on January 2, 2019.

« Chimera played at Johns Hopkins from 2005-08 before spending the 2009-18 seasons as an assistant coach under Margraff.

« In 10 seasons as a member of the coaching staff, Chimera helped guide the Blue Jays to a record of 102-17, 10 consecutive Centennial Conference titles and nine trips to the NCAA Playoffs.

« Chimera served as the Blue Jay offensive coordinator from 2014-18. During that time, Johns Hopkins averaged 502.9 yards and 42.1 points per game (over a span of 61 games).

Nearly a Century

« With the 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon in his head coaching debut, **Greg Chimera** became the first Johns Hopkins football coach in 99 years to win his first game.

« Prior to Chimera, the last Johns Hopkins football coach to win his first game was **Ray Van Orman**, who picked up a 34-14 win against Mount St. Mary's on October 2, 1920.

« After Van Orman's win in his debut, 10 different Blue Jay head coaches dropped their opening game before Chimera broke the streak.

State of Affairs

« The 87-man Johns Hopkins roster features players from 22 different states.

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 11 games. Those 11 losses have come by a total of 56 points with setbacks by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight, one, three and 15 points. Translation, 10 of Johns Hopkins' 11 losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less. The 31-16 loss to Muhlenberg (November 2) marked the first time JHU has lost a regular season game by more than nine points in more than 10 years (2009 season opener at Delaware Valley).

On a Roll

« Johns Hopkins is 88-6 in its last 94 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.

« The Blue Jays are 95-14 in their last 109 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

« Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 162-42 (.794) since the start of the 2002 season, 168-45 (.789) since the start of the 2001 season and 173-50 (.776) since the start of the 2000 season.

At Home at Homewood
