JOHNS HOPKINS VS. SUSQUEHANNA

The Game

« Johns Hopkins (1-0) returns home and welcomes Susquehanna (1-0) to Homewood Field for the Centennial Conference opener for both teams.

A Look Back

« Then sixth-ranked Johns Hopkins went on the road and topped 24th-ranked Randolph-Macon, 17-12, last Thursday night.
« Susquehanna opened the 2019 season at home last Saturday and topped rival Lycoming, 42-26.

The Facts

« This is the 135th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
« Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 556-484-58 (.533).
« In this decade (since the start of the 2010 season), the Blue Jays are 93-14 (.869) overall and 76-5 (.938) in the Centennial Conference.
« JHU owns 14 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 10 times (all since 2005).

Poll Position

« Johns Hopkins is ranked seventh in this week's 2019 D3football.com Poll.
« The Blue Jays picked up three preseason top 10 rankings as JHU was ranked fifth by *Street & Smith's* and *Lindy's* and sixth by D3football.com. Every preseason ranking the Blue Jays drew this year is the highest in school history.

For Openers

« Johns Hopkins ran its winning streak in season openers to nine games with last week's 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon.
« Since the start of the century (the 2000 season), the Blue Jays are now 16-4 in season openers.

Centennial Openers

« Since the formation of the Centennial Conference for football in 1983, Johns Hopkins is 25-11 in its 36 league-opening games.

JM "Pride and Poise" Helmet Sticker

« The Johns Hopkins football team will be wearing a sticker on its helmets throughout the 2019 season honoring former coach **Jim Margraff**, who passed away suddenly on January 2, 2019 - just weeks after leading the Blue Jays to the 2018 NCAA Semifinals.

« The sticker features Margraff's initials "JM" and the team's "Pride and Poise" mantra. Margraff, who guided the Blue Jays for 29 seasons, led Johns Hopkins to a 221-89-3 (.711) record. He finished the 2018 season as the career leader in wins in Johns Hopkins, Centennial Conference and Maryland state history.

« Margraff introduced the "Pride and Poise" slogan to the Blue Jay football team after taking over in 1990 ... in short, every Blue Jay football player was taught to play and live with "Pride and Poise."



Things to Know - Susquehanna

« Susquehanna comes to Homewood Field fresh off a 42-26 season-opening win against local rival Lycoming.

« The River Hawks have won a Centennial Conference-best six consecutive games dating back to last season, including a 17-7 win over Stevenson in the 2018 Centennial-MAC Bowl Series.

« SU rolled up a Centennial-high 541 yards of total offense in the week-one victory, including 294 through the air and 247 on the ground. The River Hawks were the only team in the league to top the 500-yard mark in week one.

« Defensively, Susquehanna allowed just 81 rushing yards, limited the Warriors to just 50% completions through the air (16-of-32) and Lyco converted just 5-of-16 (.313) third-down chances.

« Six of Lycoming's seven second-half drives against SU's defense lasted three plays or less and 75 of the Warriors' 105 second-half yards came on one drive.

River Hawks to Watch

Da'Avian Ellington (Jr. • RB)

« Shredded the Lycoming defense for a career-high 179 yards and two touchdowns to fuel the season-opening win against the Warriors. The 179 yards nearly match his season total of a year ago (226).

« Had touchdown runs of 63 and 61 yards to account for his two scores on the day and enters this week's action as the CC's leading rusher.

Michael Ruisch (So. • QB)

« One of the top young quarterbacks in the nation after throwing for 1,747 yards and 13 touchdowns in 10 games as a freshman.

« Was 18-of-30 for 294 yards with two scores and accounted for 309 yards of total offense in the season-opening win against Lycoming. The 294 yards are the second highest total of his career.

Danial Shelton (Sr. • CB)

« The top defensive back in the Centennial Conference, Shelton is a two-time First Team All-Centennial selection and was a Second Team AFCA All-American in 2018.

« The Centennial Conference Rookie of the Year in 2016, Shelton totaled 64 tackles, seven pass breakups and one interception last season despite teams rarely throwing to his side of the field.

« Susquehanna handed JHU a 37-35 loss in the CC-opener for both teams last season - that snapped a streak of 10 consecutive CC-opening wins for the Blue Jays.

« Johns Hopkins' 25 CC-opening wins are the most in league history.

Chimera Wins First Game as Head Coach

« Last week's 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon was the first for **Greg Chimera** as head coach of the Blue Jays. Chimera was named the head coach on February 22, 2019 after long-time coach **Jim Margraff** passed away suddenly on January 2, 2019.

« Chimera played at Johns Hopkins from 2005-08 before spending the 2009-18 seasons as an assistant coach under Margraff.

« In 10 seasons as a member of the coaching staff, Chimera helped guide the Blue Jays to a record of 102-17, 10 consecutive Centennial Conference titles and nine trips to the NCAA Playoffs.

« Chimera served as the Blue Jay offensive coordinator from 2014-18. During that time, Johns Hopkins averaged 502.9 yards and 42.1 points per game (over a span of 61 games).

It's Been a While

« With the 17-12 win last week at Randolph-Macon in his head coaching debut, **Greg Chimera** became the first Johns Hopkins football coach in 99 years to win his first game.

« Prior to Chimera, the last Johns Hopkins football coach to win his first game was **Ray Van Orman**, who picked up a 34-14 win against Mount St. Mary's on October 2, 1920.

« After Van Orman's win in his debut, 10 different Blue Jay head coaches dropped their opening game before Chimera broke the streak with the win at Randolph-Macon.

State of Affairs

« The 87-man Johns Hopkins roster features players from 22 different states.

On This Date

« This week's game will be just the fourth for Johns Hopkins on September 14. The Blue Jays topped Washington & Lee (21-14 in OT) in 2002, fell to Gettysburg (41-7) in 2007 and knocked off Susquehanna (24-7) in their three previous games on this date.

Kilbane Honored

« Johns Hopkins junior cornerback **Macauley Kilbane** was named the Centennial Conference Defensive Player of the Week for his efforts in the 17-12 season-opening win at Randolph-Macon.

« Kilbane posted five tackles, four pass breakups and one interception in the win against the Yellow Jackets to earn CC Defensive Player of the Week honors for the first time in his career.

« With his performance last week at RMC, Kilbane is now just one tackle shy of 100 for his career.

Defense on a Regular Season Roll

« The Johns Hopkins defense held Randolph-Macon to just 279 yards of total offense and 12 points in last week's season-opening victory.

« The 12 points the Blue Jays allowed marked the ninth consecutive regular season game in which Johns Hopkins has allowed 17 points or less.

Series History

« This week's game will be the 18th game in a series that dates to an 8-7 Susquehanna win on November 1, 1941.

« JHU leads the all-time series 12-4-1 and has currently won nine of the last 10 meetings, including eight of nine since the River Hawks joined the Centennial Conference in 2010.

« The last two meetings have been decided in the last minute as JHU edged Susquehanna, 38-34, at Homewood Field in 2017 before the 'Hawks grabbed a 37-35 win early last season.

« Ironically, the last team to top 17 points against JHU in a regular season game was Susquehanna, which scored 37 in a 37-35 win against the Blue Jays early in the 2018 season.

« Overall, after allowing an average of 34 points per game in the first two games of the 2018 season, the Blue Jay defense held 10 of its final 12 opponents to 17 points or less.

« Over the final 12 games of the 2018 season, only top-ranked Mount Union (28 in a 28-20 win over JHU in the NCAA Semifinals) and sixth-ranked Frostburg St. (27 in a 58-27 JHU win in the second round of the NAAs) topped 17 points against the Blue Jays.

Blue Jays Pick Four

« The Johns Hopkins defense intercepted four passes - all in the fourth quarter - in last week's 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon.

« The four interceptions mark the 13th time since 2001 that the Johns Hopkins defense has intercepted four or more passes in a game. The last four-INT game for JHU came last October in a 27-16 win over 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg.

« The last time Johns Hopkins came up with four or more interceptions in a season opener was in 2008, when the Blue Jays had five in a 34-3 win against St. Lawrence at Homewood Field. The starting fullback for Johns Hopkins that day? Greg Chimera.

I'm Honored

« Johns Hopkins returns seven players who earned All-Centennial Conference honors in 2018, including the CC's Offensive Player of the Year (**David Tammaro** - QB) and Rookie of the Year (**Robert Fletcher** - S).

« Returning First Team All-Centennial performers for the Blue Jays include **Joe Figueroa** (OL), **Ryan Hubley** (WR), **Macauley Kilbane** (CB) and **David Tammaro** (QB).

« Back after earning Second Team All-Centennial honors is **Mike Kalanik** (DE), while Honorable Mention All-Centennial picks **Robert Fletcher** (S) and **Frank Petracco** (OL) also return.

More Honors

« In addition to returning seven All-Centennial performers from last season, the Blue Jays also count two returning All-Americans (**Joe Figueroa** - OL - 2nd Team AP, HM D3football.com and **David Tammaro** - QB - 2nd Team D3football.com) and three D3football.com All-South selections in Tammaro (1st Team), **Joe Figueroa** (OL - 1st Team) and **Mike Kalanik** (DE - 2nd Team).

It's All Academic

« Johns Hopkins placed eight players on the 2018 CoSIDA Google Cloud Academic All-District Team - a mark that was tied for the most among all Division III teams in the nation.

« Returning CoSIDA Academic All-District selections for the Blue Jays include **David Tammaro** (QB), **Ryan Hubley** (WR) and **Frank Petracco** (OL).

« Quarterback **David Tammaro** went on to earn CoSIDA Academic All-America honors (2nd Team) to become the first quarterback in school history to be named an AAA.

A Record-Breaking Group

« Johns Hopkins set school-records for points (45.8) and yards (550.9) per game in 2018. The Blue Jays finished sixth in the nation in scoring offense and second in total offense.

« JHU scored 35 or more points in 12 of its 14 games last season and 27 or more in 13 of 14.

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of eight games. Those eight losses have come by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two and eight points.

On a Roll

« Johns Hopkins is 82-3 in its last 85 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.

« The Blue Jays are 89-11 in their last 100 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

« Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 156-39 (.800) since the start of the 2002 season, 162-42 (.794) since the start of the 2001 season and 167-47 (.780) since the start of the 2000 season.

At Home at Homewood

« Johns Hopkins has won 12 consecutive games at Homewood Field. This is tied for the longest home winning streak in school history. JHU previously won 12 straight games at home from 2014-15.

« Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 50-5 (.909) at Homewood Field.
