<u>JOHNS HOPKINS VS. MORAVIAN</u>

The Game

« Johns Hopkins (1-1, 0-1 Centennial) plays the second of two straight games at Homewood Field as the Blue Jays welcome Moravian (0-2, 0-1 CC) to Baltimore for the 21st all-time meeting between the two teams.

A Look Back

- « Then seventh-ranked Johns Hopkins dropped a 28-27 decision to Susquehanna last Saturday at Homewood Field. The Blue Jays led 24-7 early in the fourth quarter before the River Hawks rallied for the victory.
- « Moravian was less than 30 seconds away from grabbing its first win of the season before a late McDaniel touchdown gave the Green Terror a 13-10 win in Bethlehem.

The Facts

- « This is the 135th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
- « Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 556-485-58 (.532).
- $^{\circ}$ In this decade (since the start of the 2010 season), the Blue Jays are 93-15 (.861) overall and 76-6 (.927) in the Centennial Conference.
- $^{\prime\prime}$ JHU owns 14 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 10 times (all since 2005).

For the Record

« This week's game against Moravian will be the 1,100th in school history.

- « Johns Hopkins is ranked 21st in this week's 2019 D3football.com Poll.
- « The Blue Jays picked up three preseason top 10 rankings as JHU was ranked fifth by Street & Smith's and Lindy's and sixth by D3football.com Every preseason ranking the Blue Jays drew this year is the highest in school history.

JM "Pride and Poise" Helmet Sticker

- $^{\circ}$ The Johns Hopkins football team will be wearing a sticker on its helmets throughout the 2019 season honoring former coach **Jim Margraff**, who passed away suddenly on January 2, 2019 just weeks after leading the Blue Jays to the 2018 NCAA Semifinals.
- « The sticker features Margraff's initials "JM" and the team's "Pride and Poise" mantra. Margraff, who guided the Blue Jays for 29 seasons, led Johns Hopkins to a 221-89-3 (.711) record. He finished the 2018 season as the career leader in wins in Johns Hopkins, Centennial Conference and Maryland state history.
- $^{\prime\prime}$ Margraff introduced the "Pride and Poise" slogan to the Blue Jay football team after taking over in 1990 ... in short, every Blue Jay football player was taught to play and live with "Pride and Poise."



Things to Know - Moravian

- « Moravian comes to JHU looking to snap a twogame season-opening losing streak and a five-game skid that dates back to the end of the 2018 season.
- « The Greyhound defense has been strong thus far as the opposition is averaging just 18 points and 323.0 yards per game and has scored a touchdown on just two-of-eight trips to the red zone.
- « The Greyhounds feature one of the top running backs in the league in senior **Roberto Diez**, who is third in the CC in rushing with 159 yards in two games. He accounts for 159 of Moravian's 189 rushing yards through two games.
- « The 'Hounds could just as easily be 2-0 as both losses have come by a field goal. In last week's 13-10 loss to McDaniel, Moravian gave up the game-winning TD with 12 seconds remaining.
- $^{\rm w}$ Moravian has turned the ball over nine times and is minus eight in turnover margin through two games.

Greyhounds to Watch

Jackson Buskirk (Jr. • DB)

- « Emerged in the Greyhound secondary last season with a nod as a Second Team All-Centennial selection after notching 40 tackles and two fumble recoveries.
- « Counts 11 tackles, including two for losses, and two pass breakups this season and his next tackle this season will be the 125th of his career.

Nick Petros (Jr. • WR)

- « One of the top returning wide receivers in the Centennial Conference after earning First Team All-CC honors in 2018. Totaled 57 receptions for 1,017 yards and an MC single-season record 11 TDs last season.
- « Ranks second in the CC in receiving this season with 13 catches for 142 yards and one touchdown. Needs 18 receptions to become 11th player in school history to amass 100 career receptions.

Brett Poling (Sr. • OL)

- « Two-time All-Centennial selection at center for the Greyhounds after grabbing honorable mention honors as a sophomore and junior.
- « Leader of a veteran Moravian offensive line that counts five senior starters. Poling has played in 32 games since arriving in Bethlehem.

For Openers

- « Johns Hopkins ran its winning streak in season openers to nine games with the 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon on September 5.
- « Since the start of the century (the 2000 season), the Blue Jays are now 16-4 in season openers.

Centennial Openers

- $\,^{\vee}\,$ Including last week's loss to Susquehanna, Johns Hopkins is 25-12 in its 37 league-opening games.
- « JHU had won 10 straight league openers before falling at Susquehanna last season in its CC opener.
- « Johns Hopkins' 25 CC-opening wins are the most in league history.

Its Been a While

- « Last week's loss to Susquehanna snapped a pair of winning streaks for the Blue Jays.
- « The 28-27 setback to the River Hawks snapped a 12-game overall home winning streak for the Blue Jays that dated to a 28-21 loss to Mount Union in the second round of the 2016 NCAA Playoffs.
- « The loss to the River Hawks was Johns Hopkins' first regular season home loss since the Blue Jays dropped a 30-27 decision against Muhlenberg on October 2, 2010. Since that loss to the Mules, Johns Hopkins had won 43 consecutive regular season home games.

Chimera Wins First Game as Head Coach

- « The 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon was the first for Greg Chimera as head coach of the Blue Jays. Chimera was named the head coach on February 22, 2019 after long-time coach Jim Margraff passed away suddenly on January 2, 2019.
- « Chimera played at Johns Hopkins from 2005-08 before spending the 2009-18 seasons as an assistant coach under Margraff.
- « In 10 seasons as a member of the coaching staff, Chimera helped guide the Blue Jays to a record of 102-17, 10 consecutive Centennial Conference titles and nine trips to the NCAA Playoffs.
- « Chimera served as the Blue Jay offensive coordinator from 2014-18. During that time, Johns Hopkins averaged 502.9 yards and 42.1 points per game (over a span of 61 games).

Nearly a Century

- « With the 17-12 win at Randolph-Macon in his head coaching debut, **Greg Chimera** became the first Johns Hopkins football coach in 99 years to win his first game.
- « Prior to Chimera, the last Johns Hopkins football coach to win his first game was **Ray Van Orman**, who picked up a 34-14 win against Mount St. Mary's on October 2, 1920.
- « After Van Orman's win in his debut, 10 different Blue Jay head coaches dropped their opening game before Chimera broke the streak with the win at Randolph-Macon.

Series History

- « This week's game will be the 21st in a series that dates to a 40-20 Moravian victory on November 1, 1975.
- « The Blue Jays lead the all-time series 13-7 and have won 10 straight against Moravian.
- « JHU is 10-2 against MC since the Greyhounds joined the CC in 2007. Moravian won the first two games between the teams as CC foes (2007, 2008) before JHU jump-started its current 10-game run with a 27-0 victory in 2009.
- « Johns Hopkins has held Moravian to seven points or less in five of the last 10 meetings.

On This Date

- « This week's game will be just the seventh game the Blue Jays have played on this date. Johns Hopkins has won four of the previous six September 20th games.
- « The Blue Jays have won each of their last four games played on September 20, including a 33-14 win against Moravian at Homewood Field in its last game on this date (2014).
- $^{\circ}$ For what it's worth, Johns Hopkins has scored at least 24 points in each of its last four games played on September 20 and has punched up 33 or more in three of those four.

Friday Night Lights - For the 50th Time at Homewood

- « Johns Hopkins continues a tradition that started on September 25, 1982 with the Friday night game at Homewood Field this week against Moravian. This is the first of two Friday night games at Homewood this season as the Blue Jays will host Gettysburg on October 25.
- « This week's game against Moravian will be the 50th Friday night game Johns Hopkins will host since that first one against Widener in 1982.
- « The Blue Jays are 35-13-1 at home on Friday nights and have won 10 straight games at Homewood under the Friday night lights.
- « This will be the first time Moravian visits Homewood on Friday night. Moravian joins Dickinson, Gettysburg, Muhlenberg and Ursinus as current Centennial Conference teams to play at Johns Hopkins on Friday night.

Hubley Matches Career Highs

- « Junior wide receiver **Ryan Hubley** enjoyed one of the finest games of his career last week against Susquehanna as he totaled 12 receptions for 161 yards and also returned two kickoffs for 41 yards.
- « The 12 receptions and 161 receiving yards both match Hubley's previous career highs and the 202 all-purpose yards are a personal best.
- « Hubley now leads the team and the Centennial Conference with 15 receptions on the year and he jumped into 13th place on JHU's career receptions list with his 12 last week (127).

Pick Six

- « Junior **Ryan Weed** notched his second interception of the young season against Susquehanna and returned it 45 yards for a touchdown that gave Hopkins a 21-7 second-quarter lead.
- « The pick-six was the first for Johns Hopkins since **Macauley Kilbane** took one back 34 yards in a 63-31 win against Randolph-Macon in the 2018 season opener.
- « Weed's interception return for a score is the 16th for Johns Hopkins since the 2000 season and the 11th since the start of the 2009 season.

Kalanik Closing on 25, 50

- « Senior defensive end **Mike Kalanik** totaled six tackles, including 1.5 sacks, in last week's game against Susquehanna and now has 15 tackles, 3.0 tackles for losses and 2.5 sacks on the year.
- « With his efforts through the first two games, Kalanik now has 24.5 career sacks and 47.0 tackles for loss.
- « With another sack, he'll become the seventh Centennial Conference player since 2000 to reach 25. With three TFLs he'll be the sixth CC player since 2000 to reach 50.

Blue Jays Pick Four

- ${\tt ~~The~Johns~Hopkins~defense~intercepted~four~passes~-~all~in~the~fourth~quarter~-~in~last~week's~17-12~win~at~Randolph-Macon.}\\$
- « The four interceptions mark the 13th time since 2001 that the Johns Hopkins defense has intercepted four or more passes in a game. Prior to the game at RMC, the last four-INT game for JHU came last October in a 27-16 win over 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg.
- « The last time Johns Hopkins came up with four or more interceptions in a season opener was in 2008, when the Blue Jays had five in a 34-3 win against St. Lawrence at Homewood Field. The starting fullback for Johns Hopkins that day? Greg Chimera.

I'm Honored

- « Johns Hopkins returns seven players who earned All-Centennial Conference honors in 2018, including the CC's Offensive Player of the Year (David Tammaro QB) and Rookie of the Year (Robert Fletcher S).
- « Returning First Team All-Centennial performers for the Blue Jays include **Joe Figueroa** (OL), **Ryan Hubley** (WR), **Macauley Kilbane** (CB) and **David Tammaro** (QB).
- « Back after earning Second Team All-Centennial honors is **Mike Kalanik** (DE), while Honorable Mention All-Centennial picks **Robert Fletcher** (S) and **Frank Petracco** (OL) also return.

More Honors

- « In addition to returning seven All-Centennial performers from last season, the Blue Jays also count two returning All-Americans (Joe Figueroa
- OL 2nd Team AP, HM D3football.com and **David Tammaro** QB 2nd Team D3football.com) and three D3football.com All-South selections in Tammaro (1st Team), **Joe Figueroa** (OL 1st Team) and **Mike Kalanik** (DE 2nd Team).

 m ext{ iny Johns Hopkins}}$ placed eight players on the 2018 CoSIDA Google Cloud Academic All-District Team a mark that was tied for the most among all Division III teams in the nation.
- « Returning CoSIDA Academic All-District selections for the Blue Jays include ${\bf David\ Tammaro\ }$ (QB), ${\bf Ryan\ Hubley\ }$ (WR) and ${\bf Frank\ Petracco\ }$ (OL).
- « Quarterback **David Tammaro** went on to earn CoSIDA Academic All-America honors (2nd Team) to become the first quarterback in school history to be named an AAA.

A Record-Breaking Group

- $^{\circ}$ Johns Hopkins set school-records for points (45.8) and yards (550.9) per game in 2018. The Blue Jays finished sixth in the nation in scoring offense and second in total offense.
- « JHU scored 35 or more points in 12 of its 14 games last season and 27 or more in 13 of 14.

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of nine games. Those eight losses have come by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight and one point. Translation, Johns Hopkins eight losses since the start of the 2013 season have all come by a touchdown or less and by a total of just 37 points.

On a Roll

- « Johns Hopkins is 82-4 in its last 86 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.
- « The Blue Jays are 89-12 in their last 101 games overall since late in the 2010 season.
- $^{\circ}$ Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 156-40 (.796) since the start of the 2002 season, 162-43 (.790) since the start of the 2001 season and 167-48 (.777) since the start of the 2000 season.

At Home at Homewood

- « Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 50-6 (.893) at Homewood Field.
- $^{\rm w}$ Johns Hopkins had won 12 consecutive games at Homewood Field before the loss on September 14 against Susquehanna. This is tied for the longest home winning streak in school history. JHU previously won 12 straight games at home from 2014-15.
