- « Johns Hopkins improved to 5-0 overall and 4-0 in the Centennial Conference with a 66-10 win over Franklin & Marshall on October 2. The Blue Jays had a bye last weekend.
- « Muhlenberg picked up its second consecutive win with a 54-19 win at Gettysburg on October 2.

Johns Hopkins Football

The Facts

- « This is the 136th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
- « Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 568-487-58 (.536).
- $^{\prime\prime}$ Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 105-17 (.861) overall and 86-8 (.915) in the Centennial Conference.
- « Overall, JHU owns 14 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 10 times (all since 2005).

Oh Captain, My Captain

- $^{ ext{ iny In}}$ In a vote of the team last spring, four players were selected to serve as captains of the 2021 Johns Hopkins football team.
- « Graduate student **Macauley Kilbane** (DB) and seniors **Ross Andersson** (DB), **Joe Tischler** (DL) and **Emmett Turner** (TE) will lead the Blue Jays this season. This will be Kilbane's second season serving as a co-captain.
- $^{\mbox{\tiny (4)}}$ Dating back to 1947, Kilbane is just the 14th player to serve as a captain more than once.

Poll Position

- « Despite not playing last weekend, Johns Hopkins continued to inch up in the national rankings as the Blue Jays are in the top 15 in both the AFCA (11th) and D3football.com (14th) polls this week.
- « Johns Hopkins was listed as receiving votes in the D3football.com preseason poll, but jumped to #25 in the first in-season poll (Sept. 5) and has steadily moved up to 21st, 18th, 15th and now 14th.
- «Since the AFCA Poll debuted in 1999, this week's #11 ranking marks the 103rd time JHU has been ranked in the top 25. More recently, the Blue Jays are in the top 25 for the 86th time in the last 94 polls dating back to 2011

Things to Know - Muhlenberg

- « Muhlenberg welcomes Johns Hopkins to Scotty Wood Stadium riding the crest of a two-game winning streak. The Mules have outscored the opposition 77-19 during the two-game run.
- « As always, Muhlenberg features perhaps the top defense in the Centennial Conference as the Mules rank first in the league in interceptions (10) and sacks (16), second in scoring defense (14.8) and rushing defense (58.6) and third in total defense (272.4).
- « More than half of the 74 points the Mules have allowed this season came in 42-35 loss to Ursinus.
- « Like Johns Hopkins, Muhlenberg features one of the most prolific passing attacks in the nation as the Mules are averaging 348.2 yards per game through the air. MC ranks sixth in the nation in passing offense.
- « The Mules have scored at least 34 points in four of their five games and in 12 of 15 regular season games dating back to the start of the 2019 season.

Mules to Watch

Michael Feaster (Sr. • WR)

- « The third of three Feaster brothers to play football at Muhlenberg.
- « Leads the Mules in receiving this season with 43 receptions for 505 yards and five touchdowns. Has eight or more receptions in four of five games thus far in 2021 and three games with 100+ receiving yards.

Michael Hnatkowsky (Sr. • QB)

- « One of the top quarterbacks in the nation. Has thrown for 1,706 yards and 18 touchdowns in five games this season after a 407-yard, six-touchdown effort in the Mules' last game at Gettysburg.
- « One of nine active quarterbacks in all four NCAA divisions - the only one in Division III - with at least 10,000 career passing yards, and he leads all active NCAA quarterbacks with 115 career touchdown passes (tied for 16th in Division III history).

Pat Palmer (Sr. • LB)

- « Has emerged as the most disruptive player on the typically strong Muhlenberg defense.
- « Ranks second on the team in tackles (22) and leads the team in tackles for loss (8.5) and sacks (5.0). Tied for the Centennial Conference lead in sacks and tied for second in TFLs. Has 19.5 career TFLs to his credit.

Ranked vs. Ranked

- « This week's game will mark the second time in three seasons (2018) that Johns Hopkins and Muhlenberg enter their matchup with both teams ranked in the top 25 in both the AFCA and D3football.com Polls.
- « In 2018, the Blue Jays topped the Mules, 27-16, at Homewood Field with Hopkins carrying rankings of 21st (AFCA) and 23rd (D3football.com) into the game. The Mules entered that matchup ranked 22nd (AFCA) and 18th (D3football.com).
- $^{\circ}$ In 2014 (JHU-12th, Muhlenberg-23rd) and 2016 (JHU-9th, Muhlenberg-24th) both teams were ranked in the top 25 by the AFCA at the time of the game.

On This Date

- $\,^{<}$ Since 1950, Johns Hopkins has played six games on October 15 and the Blue Jays are 1-5 all-time on this date.
- « Surprisingly, the Blue Jays have not played a game on October 15 since 1988.
- « JHU's last two games on this date, in 1983 and 1988, were both against Muhlenberg and both were won by the Mules (16-0, and 26-13).

Road Warriors

- « This week's game at Muhlenberg is the third in a stretch that will see the Blue Jays play four of five games on the road.
- « The Blue Jays played at Juniata (Sept. 18) and at Moravian (Sept. 25), hosted F&M (Oct. 2), play at Muhlenberg (Oct. 15) and then at Gettysburg (Oct. 23) during this five-game stretch.

Before The Bye

- « The game against F&M on Oct. 2 was the last game for the Blue Jays before their bye week. Including the win against the Diplomats and dating back to 2011, the Blue Jays are 45-3 in games played before their bye.
- « The Centennial Conference went to the leaguewide bye in the middle of the season in 2011.

After the Bye

- « Dating back to 2011, when the Centennial Conference went to a league-wide bye in the middle of the season, Johns Hopkins is 40-3 in regular season games played after the bye week.
- « In games played after the bye since 2011, the Blue Jays are 19-2 in regular season games played on the road and 21-1 in regular season games played at home.

Series History

- « Johns Hopkins and Muhlenberg are meeting for the 53rd time with the Blue Jays holding a slender 27-24-1 advantage.
- « The two teams have combined of win at least a share of the last 14 Centennial titles and all but one (2006) since 2001.
- ' JHU has won nine of the last 11 meetings, and is 21-16 against MC since the Centennial Conference was formed in 1983.
- « Close, well-played games have been the norm as the 36 Centennial Conference games show an average score of Johns Hopkins-21.4, Muhlenberg-18.8.

Oktoberfest

- « Johns Hopkins flipped the calendar to October for its game against F&M and the month has been good to the Blue Jays of late.
- « Including the win against the Diplomats, the Blue Jays have won 32 of their last 33 games in the month of October dating back 2010. The lone loss came in 2019, when F&M topped the Blue Jays, 20-17, at Homewood Field (10-19-19).
- « Ironically, the Blue Jays had been just 10-8 in their previous 18 games in the month of October before jump-starting the current 33-game run with a 49-24 win at Susquehanna (10-23-2010).

Friday Night Lights

- « Dating back to 1982, when the Blue Jays began regularly scheduling games on Friday night, this week's game will be the 58th for Johns Hopkins under the Friday night lights.
- « Johns Hopkins is 40-16-1 (.711) on Friday nights, including 36-13-1 (.730) at Homewood Field.
- $^{\circ}$ This week's game will be just the eighth away from Homewood on a Friday night since 1982 with the Jays sporting a 4-3 record in the previous seven.
- « Johns Hopkins and Muhlenberg are meeting for fifth time on a Friday night with the last meet-

ing coming in 1998. JHU won each of the previous four with all of those games played at Homewood Field between 1992 and 1998.

JHU Leads the Nation in Scoring

« Johns Hopkins enters this week's game at Muhlenberg as the top scoring team in the nation in all divisions of the NCAA.

« The Blue Jays are currently averaging 59.8 points per game « JHU is one of just seven Division III teams averaging better than 50 points per game and one of just 10 teams in all divisions averaging better than 50 per outing.

Scoring Notes of Interest

« Johns Hopkins has scored 299 points in its first five games of the 2021 season. That's the most points JHU has scored in any five-game span in school history.

« Dating back to the 2019 season, JHU has

scored at least 42 points in eight straight games, 49 or more in six straight and 50 or more in six of the last eight.

- « In 16 quarters this season, the Blue Jays have scored 10 or more points in 14 of the 20 and 20 or more in seven of 20.
- « JHU has scored 108 points in the second quarter and has yet to allow a third-quarter point.

Scoring in All Three Phases

- « Johns Hopkins got two defensive touchdowns and had two kickoff returns for touchdowns in the 54-6 win at Moravian (Sept. 25). Add in a safety recorded by the defense, and 26 of JHU's 54 points did not come from the offense.
- « The last time JHU scored in all three phases (offense-defense-special teams) was in the 2018 season opener against Randolph-Macon.
- $^{\rm w}$ The last time Johns Hopkins scored twice on defense in a game was on September 10, 2011, when the Jays returned two INTs for TDs.



Quite a Run - Part I

- «Johns Hopkins was tied with Ursinus at 14-14 with six minutes remaining in the second quarter of its game against the Bears on September 11.
- « Since then, over a span of 14 quarters and six minutes, the Blue Jays have outscored the opposition 232-23.

Quite a Run - Part II

- « Since allowing touchdowns on two of the first three drives against Ursinus, the Blue Jay defense has been more than just a little stingy. Consider ...
- JHU has not allowed a touchdown in 57 consecutive possessions dating back to the second quarter against Ursinus.
- The Blue Jays have allowed just three field goals in the last 57 opponent possessions. The lone TDs allowed during the last 14 quarters came when Ursinus recovered a fumbled Blue Jay punt in the end zone and F&M blocked a punt that the Diplomats recovered in the end zone for a touchdown.
- The last 57 opponent possessions have ended with 1 safety, 3 field goals, 5 interceptions,
- 6 fumbles lost, 5 turnovers on downs and $32~\rm punts \dots$ five others ended with the conclusion of either the second or fourth quarter.

Starting QB Streak at 11

- « Ryan Stevens got his first career start at quarterback in the 53-18 season-opening win at Stevenson. With that, he became the first Blue Jay other than **David Tammaro** to start a game at quarterback since early in the 2017 season, when **Zack Baker** started a game at Dickinson.
- « Including that win and dating back to 2006, 11 consecutive Johns Hopkins quarterbacks have now won their first career start for the Blue Jays, a streak that started with **Shane Kibbe's** 21-14 win over Randolph-Macon early in that 2006 season.

Returning All-Centennial Selections

- « Johns Hopkins returns three players who earned All-Centennial Conference honors in 2019 in graduate students **Macauley Kilbane** (DB) and **Ryan Hubley** (WR) and senior **Harrison Wellmann** (WR).
- « Kilbane earned First Team All-CC in 2018 and 2019, while Hubley was a first team selection in 2018 and a second team honoree in 2019; Wellmann was a first team honoree in 2019.

Returning D3football.com All-South Honorees

« In addition to earning All-Centennial honors in 2019, **Macauley Kilbane** (2nd Team) and **Harrison Wellmann** (3rd Team) also earned D3football.com All-South honors that year as well.

It's All Academic - Part I

- « Johns Hopkins led Division III and tied Stanford for the national lead among all NCAA schools with four CoSIDA Academic All-America selections in 2020-21 (AAA teams were selected with career statistics the primary criteria instead of season statistics in 2020-21 due to COVID-19 limiting or eliminating some teams' seasons).
- « Ryan Hubley (WR) and Macauley Kilbane (DB) were named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-Americans, while Ross Andersson (DB) and Jacob Fetterolf (OL) were second team selections.
- « The four Academic All-America selections are the most in school history, topping the three AAAs Johns Hopkins produced in 2011, 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017.
- « The four AAA selections for the football team were part of a haul of 18 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans Johns Hopkins produced across all of its athletic programs in 2020-21 ... the 18 are a school record for one year (previous record was 13 in 2013-14).

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 11 games. Those 11 losses have come by a total of 56 points with setbacks by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight, one, three and 15 points. Translation, 10 of Johns Hopkins' 11 losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less. The 31-16 loss to Muhlenberg (Nov. 2, 2019) marked the first time JHU had lost a regular season game by more than nine points in more than 10 years (2009 season opener at Delaware Valley).

On a Roll

- « Johns Hopkins is 93-6 in its last 99 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.
- « The Blue Jays are 102-14 in their last 116 games overall since late in the 2010 season.
- « Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 168-42 (.800) since the start of the 2002 season, 174-45 (.795) since the start of the 2001 season and 179-50 (.782) since the start of the 2000 season.

At Home at Homewood

- « Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 55-7 (.887) at Homewood Field.
- « Johns Hopkins had won 12 consecutive games at Homewood Field before the loss on September 14, 2019 against Susquehanna. This is tied for the longest home winning streak in school history. JHU previously won 12 straight games at home from 2014-15.

Offensive Player Notes of Interest

Ryan Hubley (Gr. • WR)

- « Third on the team in receiving with 28 receptions for 418 yards and three touchdowns.
- « Ranks ninth in school history in receptions (181), tied for 11th in receiving yards (2,147) and tied for 16th in touchdown receptions (14).
- « Has at least three receptions in 28 straight games and 31 of the 32 he's played in during his career.

Will Leger (Fr. • TE)

« Got the start at tight end in the season opener at Stevenson and responded with four receptions for 37 yards. Included in his career-opening effort was a three-yard touchdown reception just before halftime that gave JHU a 27-3 lead. « Added one reception in each of the next three games and now has seven catches for 58 yards and one TD in five games.

Ryan Stevens (Jr. • QB)

- « Is 127-of-179 (.709) for 1,857 yards and 16 touchdowns against three interceptions through five games.
- « Ranks first in the nation in passing yards per game (371.4), fourth in total offense (378.8), 10th in pass efficiency (184.2), 11th in completion percentage (.709) and 12th in TD passes (16).
- « Went 31-of-46 for 483 yards with 5 TDs against 1 INT in the season opener against Stevenson.
- « 483 passing yards is the most ever by a JHU quarterback in a season opener and the thirdbest total in school history.
- « Five TD passes are the most in an opener for a JHU QB since Jon Germano had five at Randolph-Macon in 2015.
- «Followed up effort in opener by going 22-of-25 (.880) for 364 yards with six TDs and one INT in a 49-21 win over Ursinus.
- « Went 24-of-36 for 358 yards with three TDs in a 77-0 win at Juniata and was 27-of-37 for 276 yards with one TD and one INT at Moravian.
- « Wrapped up first half of season by going 23-of-35 for 376 yards with one TD and added 24 rushing yards for 400 yards of total offense against F&M.
- « The 483 passing yards against Stevenson are the most ever by a left-handed QB in Centennial Conference history (Michael McCabe - Muhl. 471 vs. DC - 1999).
- « Named Centennial Conference Offensive Player of the Week and to the D3football.com Team of the Week after wins against Stevenson and Ursinus.

Quinn Revere (Gr. • WR)

- « Second on the team in receiving with 35 receptions for 528 yards and four touchdowns in five games.
- « Enjoyed a memorable first game as a Blue Jay with seven receptions for 126 yards and one

- touchdown in the 53-18 season-opening victory at Stevenson.
- « The 126 receiving yards are the most by a Johns Hopkins player in his first game since Sam Skinner had 137 against FDU-Madison on September 13, 1996.
- « Came back with six receptions for 115 yards and one touchdown (60 yards) in a 49-21 win over Ursinus, added six receptions for 112 yards and two scores against Juniata and had a career-best nine receptions for 107 yards at Moravian.
- « Added seven receptions for 68 yards against
- « Four consecutive 100-yard receiving games to start the season tied the JHU record (Bill Stromberg/1980-81) Revere is the first to have four straight 100-yard receiving games in one season.

Harrison Wellmann (Sr. • WR)

- « Leads the team in receiving with 45 receptions for 592 yards and eight touchdowns in five games.
- « Had scored at least two touchdowns in five straight games dating back to last season before scoring just once against F&M. Still, has scored 12 TDs in last six games (10 receiving / 2 KOR). « Ranks seventh in the nation in receiving TDs (8), second in receptions per game (9.0) and third in receiving yards per game (138.4).
- « Posted 11 receptions for 230 yards and two touchdowns in the 53-18 season-opening victory at Stevenson.
