The Game

« For the fifth time in seven games, Johns Hopkins (5-1, 4-1 CC) hits the road as the Blue Jays travel to Gettysburg to take on the Bullets (1-5, 1-4 CC).

A Look Back

- « Johns Hopkins fell from the ranks of the unbeaten last week as the Blue Jays dropped a 21-6 decision at then 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg.
- « Gettysburg dropped its second straight to a nationally-ranked opponent as the Bullets lost 47-7 at then 20th-ranked Susquehanna.

The Facts

- « This is the 136th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
- « Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 568-488-58 (.536).
- « Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 105-18 (.854) overall and 86-9 (.905) in the Centennial Conference.
- « Overall, JHU owns 14 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 10 times (all since 2005).

Oh Captain, My Captain

- $^{ ext{ iny In}}$ In a vote of the team last spring, four players were selected to serve as captains of the 2021 Johns Hopkins football team.
- « Graduate student Macauley Kilbane (DB) and seniors Ross Andersson (DB), Joe Tischler (DL) and Emmett Turner (TE) will lead the Blue Jays this season. This will be Kilbane's second season serving as a co-captain.
- « Dating back to 1947, Kilbane is just the 14th player to serve as a captain more than once.

Poll Position

- « Despite suffering its first loss of the season, the Blue Jays maintained their top 25 rankings in both the AFCA (21st) and D3football.com (20th) polls this week. « Since the AFCA Poll debuted in 1999, this week's #21 ranking marks the 104th time JHU has been ranked in the top 25. More recently, the Blue Jays are in the top 25 for the 87th time in the last 95 polls dating back to 2011.
- « Since the D3football.com Poll debuted in 2003, this week's #20 ranking marks the 118th time Johns Hopkins has appeared in the top 25.

Things to Know - Gettysburg

- « Gettysburg welcomes Johns Hopkins to Musselman Stadium for Family Weekend at the Battlefield.
- «This week's game is the third straight for the Bullets against a team ranked in the top 25 as Gettysburg played Muhlenberg and Susquehanna in its last two games.
- « This is the first season for head coach Maurice Banks, whose previous coaching stops included stints at his alma mater, Georgetown, and Penn.
- «The Bullet defense has been opportunistic through six games as GC leads the Centennial Conference in sacks (18) and has forced 13 turnovers in six games. The Bullets have also been stingy against the run (103.3 yards/game and 3.5 yards/rush).
- «If things come down to the end, the Bullets feel good about their chances as place-kicker **Doug Cummnigs** recently hit a Centennial-record 55-yard field goal and has seven field goals on the year. Each of his four misses has been outside 40 yards and three of the four were 44+.

Bullets to Watch

Sal DeBenedetto (Sr. • WR)

- « Gettysburg's big play threat in an offense that is averaging just 16.2 points per game. DeBenedetto has 14 receptions for 310 yards (22.1) and one touchdown.
- $^{\rm w}$ Averaging better than 20 yards per reception in his career with 36 receptions for 726 yards (20.2).

Alex Raimondo (Sr. • DL)

- « One of the most disruptive defensive linemen in the Centennial Conference. Has 23 tackles, 7.5 tackles for losses and 5.0 sacks this season.
- « Currently tied for third in the Centennial Conference in TFLs and ranks 10th in sacks this season.
- « Needs 23 tackles to reach 100 in his career and already counts 26.0 tackles for losses and 16.5 sacks to his credit despite the cancellation of the 2020 season.

Mason Stolarik (Jr. • QB)

- « In his first season as the starting quarterback at GC after not seeing any game action as a freshman in 2019.
- « Is 88-of-158 for 938 yards with four touchdowns against eight interceptions. Threw for a career-high 270 yards and two TDs against nationally-ranked Muhlenberg.

Road Warriors

- « This week's game at Gettysburg is the fourth in a stretch that will see the Blue Jays play four of five games on the road.
- « The Blue Jays played at Juniata (Sept. 18) and at Moravian (Sept. 25), hosted F&M (Oct. 2), played at Muhlenberg (Oct. 15) and close the stretch at Gettysburg (Oct. 23) during this five-game stretch.

Before The Bye

- « The game against F&M on Oct. 2 was the last game for the Blue Jays before their bye week. Including the win against the Diplomats and dating back to 2011, the Blue Jays are 45-3 in games played before their bye.
- « The Centennial Conference went to the leaguewide bye in the middle of the season in 2011.

After the Bye

- « Dating back to 2011, when the Centennial Conference went to a league-wide bye in the middle of the season, Johns Hopkins is 40-4 in regular season games played after the bye week.
- « In games played after the bye since 2011, and including last week's game at Muhlenberg, the Blue Jays are 19-3 in regular season games played on the road and 21-1 in regular season games played at home.

Oktoberfest

- « Johns Hopkins flipped the calendar to October for its game against F&M and the month has been good to the Blue Jays of late.
- « Including the two games in October this season, the Blue Jays have won 32 of their last 34 games in the month of October dating back 2010.
- « Ironically, the Blue Jays had been just 10-8 in their previous 18 games in the month of October before jump-starting the current 34-game run with a 49-24 win at Susquehanna (10-23-2010).

Scoring Notes of Interest

- «Johns Hopkins has scored 305 points in its first six games of the 2021 season. That's the most points JHU has scored in any six-game span in school history.
- «The previous JHU record for most points scored in a six-game span was 301, which the Blue Jays scored in the first six games of the 2018 season.
- « In 24 quarters this season, the Blue Jays have scored 10 or more points in 14 of the 24 and 20 or more in seven of 24.
- $^{\prime\prime}$ JHU has scored 108 points in the second quarter and has outscored the opposition 54-7 in the first quarter and 72-7 in the third quarter.

Series History

- « Johns Hopkins and Gettysburg are meeting for the 48th time in a series that dates to a 5-3 Gettysburg win in 1911.
- « JHU holds a 25-20-3 lead in the series and has won 12 straight and 23 of the last 25 matchups.
- « Prior to JHU's recent run of success against GC, the Bullets had gone 17-1-1 against the Blue Jays frm 1916 through 1994.
- « Johns Hopkins has scored 34 or more points in 11 of the last 12 meetings and the teams have combined for 50 or more points in 12 of the last 13.

JHU Ranks Fifth in the Nation in Scoring

« Among Division III teams, Johns Hopkins enters this week's game at Gettysburg tied for fourth in the nation in scoring offense at 50.8 points per game. JHU is one of just five NCAA Division III teams currently averaging more than 50 points per game.

« In addition to ranking fourth among Division III teams in scoring offense, Johns Hopkins is also one of just seven teams in all divisions of the NCAA to currently be averaging better than 50 points per game. The Blue Jays' 50.8 points per outing are tied for fifth among the 656 football-playing schools in the NCAA.

Scoring in All Three Phases

- « Johns Hopkins got two defensive touchdowns and had two kickoff returns for touchdowns in the 54-6 win at Moravian (Sept. 25). Add in a safety recorded by the defense, and 26 of JHU's 54 points did not come from the offense.
- « The last time JHU scored in all three phases (offense-defense-special teams) was in the 2018 season opener against Randolph-Macon.
- $^{\rm w}$ The last time Johns Hopkins scored twice on defense in a game was on September 10, 2011, when the Jays returned two INTs for TDs.

Quite a Run - Part I


- « Johns Hopkins was tied with Ursinus at 14-14 with six minutes remaining in the second quarter of its game against the Bears on September 11.
- « Since then, over a span of 18 quarters and six minutes, the Blue Jays have outscored the opposition 238-44.

Quite a Run - Part II

- « Since allowing touchdowns on two of the first three drives against Ursinus, the Blue Jay defense has been more than just a little stingy. Consider ...
- Prior to allowing touchdowns on back-to-back drives against Muhlenberg in the second half last week, the Blue Jay defense had not allowed a touchdown in 65 consecutive possessions dating back to the second quarter against Ursinus.
- During that 65-possession run, the Blue Jays allowed just three field goals. The lone TDs allowed during that time came when Ursinus recovered a fumbled Blue Jay punt in the end zone and F&M & Muhlenberg blocked punts that recovered in the end zone for touchdowns.
- Those 65 opponent possessions ended with 1 safety, 3 field goals, 6 interceptions, 6 fumbles lost, 5 turnovers on downs and 38 punts ... six others ended with the conclusion of either the second or fourth quarter.

Defense Among the Centennial/National Leaders

- « The Blue Jay defense enters this week's game ranked among the best in the Centennial Conference and the NCAA in a number of statistical categories.
- « Through six games, JHU ranks first in the Centennial in scoring defense (12.7) and rushing defense (60.3) and second in total defense (265.5), pass defense (205.2) and sacks (17).
- « Nationally, the Blue Jays rank 10th in rushing defense, 21st in scoring defense and 24th in opponent third-down percentage (.283).



Starting QB Streak at 11

- « **Ryan Stevens** got his first career start at quarterback in the 53-18 season-opening win at Stevenson. With that, he became the first Blue Jay other than **David Tammaro** to start a game at quarterback since early in the 2017 season, when **Zack Baker** started a game at Dickinson.
- «Including that win and dating back to 2006, 11 consecutive Johns Hopkins quarterbacks have now won their first career start for the Blue Jays, a streak that started with **Shane Kibbe's** 21-14 win over Randolph-Macon early in that 2006 season.

Returning All-Centennial Selections

- « Johns Hopkins returns three players who earned All-Centennial Conference honors in 2019 in graduate students **Macauley Kilbane** (DB) and **Ryan Hubley** (WR) and senior **Harrison Wellmann** (WR).
- « Kilbane earned First Team All-CC in 2018 and 2019, while Hubley was a first team selection in 2018 and a second team honoree in 2019; Wellmann was a first team honoree in 2019.

Returning D3football.com All-South Honorees

« In addition to earning All-Centennial honors in 2019, **Macauley Kilbane** (2nd Team) and **Harrison Wellmann** (3rd Team) also earned D3football.com All-South honors that year as well.

It's All Academic - Part I

- « Johns Hopkins led Division III and tied Stanford for the national lead among all NCAA schools with four CoSIDA Academic All-America selections in 2020-21 (AAA teams were selected with career statistics the primary criteria instead of season statistics in 2020-21 due to COVID-19 limiting or eliminating some teams' seasons).
- « Ryan Hubley (WR) and Macauley Kilbane (DB) were named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-Americans, while Ross Andersson (DB) and Jacob Fetterolf (OL) were second team selections.
- « The four Academic All-America selections are the most in school history, topping the three AAAs Johns Hopkins produced in 2011, 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017.
- « The four AAA selections for the football team were part of a haul of 18 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans Johns Hopkins produced across all of its athletic programs in 2020-21 ... the 18 are a school record for one year (previous record was 13 in 2013-14).

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 12 games. Those 12 losses have come by a total of 71 points with setbacks by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight, one, three and 15 points (twice). Translation, 10 of Johns Hopkins' 12 losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less.

On a Roll

- « Johns Hopkins is 93-7 in its last 100 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.
- $\scriptstyle <$ The Blue Jays are 102-15 in their last 117 games overall since late in the 2010 season.
- « Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 168-43 (.796) since the start of the 2002 season, 174-46 (.791) since the start of the 2001 season and 179-51 (.778) since the start of the 2000 season.

At Home at Homewood

- « Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 55-7 (.887) at Homewood Field.
- « Johns Hopkins had won 12 consecutive games at Homewood Field before the loss on September 14, 2019 against Susquehanna. This is tied for the longest home winning streak in school history. JHU previously won 12 straight games at home from 2014-15.

Offensive Player Notes of Interest

Ryan Hubley (Gr. • WR)

- « Second on the team in receiving with 38 receptions for 518 yards and three touchdowns.
- « Ranks eighth in school history in receptions (191), 11th in receiving yards (2,147) and tied for 16th in touchdown receptions (14).
- « Has at least three receptions in 29 straight games and 32 of the 33 he's played in during his career.

Will Leger (Fr. • TE)

« Got the start at tight end in the season opener at Stevenson and responded with four receptions for 37 yards. Included in his career-opening effort was a three-yard touchdown reception just before halftime that gave JHU a 27-3 lead. « Added one reception in each of the next three games and now has seven catches for 58 yards and one TD in five games.

Ryan Stevens (Jr. • QB)

- « Is 153-of-227 (.674) for 2,132 yards and 16 touchdowns against five interceptions through six games.
- « Ranks second in the nation in passing yards per game (355.3), fourth in total offense (364.0), 24th in pass efficiency (165.1), 17th in completion percentage (.674) and 24th in TD passes (16).
- « Went 31-of-46 for 483 yards with 5 TDs against 1 INT in the season opener against Stevenson.
- « 483 passing yards is the most ever by a JHU quarterback in a season opener and the thirdbest total in school history.
- « Five TD passes are the most in an opener for a JHU QB since Jon Germano had five at Randolph-Macon in 2015.
- «Followed up effort in opener by going 22-of-25 (.880) for 364 yards with six TDs and one INT in a 49-21 win over Ursinus.
- « Went 24-of-36 for 358 yards with three TDs in a 77-0 win at Juniata and was 27-of-37 for 276 yards with one TD and one INT at Moravian.
- « Wrapped up first half of season by going 23-of-35 for 376 yards with one TD and added 24 rushing yards for 400 yards of total offense against F&M.
- « Was 26-of-48 for 275 yards with no touchdowns and two INTs at #22 Muhlenberg.
- « The 483 passing yards against Stevenson are the most ever by a left-handed QB in Centennial Conference history (Michael McCabe - Muhl. 471 vs. DC - 1999).
- « Named Centennial Conference Offensive Player of the Week and to the D3football.com Team of the Week after wins against Stevenson and Ursinus.

Quinn Revere (Gr. • WR)

« Third on the team in receiving with 36 receptions for 539 yards and four touchdowns in six games.

- « Enjoyed a memorable first game as a Blue Jay with seven receptions for 126 yards and one touchdown in the 53-18 season-opening victory at Stevenson.
- « The 126 receiving yards are the most by a Johns Hopkins player in his first game since Sam Skinner had 137 against FDU-Madison on September 13, 1996.
- « Came back with six receptions for 115 yards and one touchdown (60 yards) in a 49-21 win over Ursinus, added six receptions for 112 yards and two scores against Juniata and had a career-best nine receptions for 107 yards at Moravian.
- « Added seven receptions for 68 yards against F&M.
- « Four consecutive 100-yard receiving games to start the season tied the JHU record (Bill Stromberg/1980-81) Revere is the first to have four straight 100-yard receiving games in one season.

Harrison Wellmann (Sr. • WR)

- « Leads the team in receiving with 50 receptions for 776 yards and eight touchdowns in six games.
- « Had scored at least two touchdowns in five straight games dating back to last season before scoring just once against F&M. Still, has scored 12 TDs in last seven games (10 receiving / 2 KOR).
- « Ranks 10th in the nation in receiving TDs (8), eighth in receptions per game (8.3) and fourth in receiving yards per game (129.3).
- « Posted 11 receptions for 230 yards and two touchdowns in the 53-18 season-opening victory at Stevenson.
- « The 230 receiving yards are a career high and the third-highest single-game total in school history.
- « Came back with eight receptions for 68 yards and a career-high three touchdown receptions in a 49-21 win over Ursinus and added 10 receptions for 142 yards and two scores at Juniata.
- « Had seven receptions for 72 yards and returned two kickoffs for touchdowns (90, 73) in a 54-6 win at Moravian. Named Centennial Special Teams Player of the Week for his effort, which set a JHU record and tied an NCAA Division III record for kickoff returns for a TD in a game.
- $\,$ « Counted nine receptions for 180 yards and one TD in a win against F&M and had five receptions for 84 yards at #22 Muhlenberg.
- $^{\rm w}$ Boosted his career totals to 148 receptions for 2,300 yards and 25 touchdowns with effort against Muhlenberg.
- «Ranks ninth in school history in career receiving yards, 11th in receptions, tied for fifth in touchdown receptions and seventh in kickoff return yards (902).

Danny Wolf (Jr. • RB)

- $^{\rm w}$ Leads the team in rushing with 84 carries for 424 yards and 10 touchdowns and has 11 receptions for 148 yards and one TD in six games.
- « Led the Blue Jays in rushing with 11 carries for 45 yards against Stevenson and added one reception for 18 yards in the victory.
- « Came back with nine carries for 63 yards and one TD (27 yards) and added a 22-yard reception against Ursinus and added 55 yards with one touchdown on 10 carries at Juniata.
- $^{\rm w}$ Had 13 carries for 49 yards and two TDs and two receptions for 35 yards and one TD in a 54-6 win at Moravian.
- « Set JHU single-game record with 5 rushing & overall TDs in a win against F&M, when he rushed 21 times for a career-high 129 yards.
- « Rushed 20 times for 83 yards and a TD and had a career-high five receptions for 26 yards against 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg.
- « Has touched the ball 136 times on offense in his career (119 rushes, 17 receptions) and has 17 touchdowns - one every 8.0 touches.
